THE STARTING FIVE

- Michigan State women's basketball will play its home Big Ten opener on Saturday, Dec. 12 at 4 p.m. The Spartans opened the season 3-0 overall and 1-0 in B1G action. MSU captured its Big Ten opener with a strong offensive performance against Minnesota on the road on Dec. 9. The Spartans handled the Gophers an 81-68 loss, behind 25 points by Nia Clouden.
- Junior guard Nia Clouden's game and seasonhigh 25 points combined with sophomore guard Alyza Winston's career-high 20 points Wednesday against Minnesota was MSU's first game with two 20-point scorers since Feb. 3, 2019 vs. Purdue when Shay Colley and Sidney Cooks netted 20 points apiece.
- The Spartans are third in the nation and first in the Big Ten in assists per game, averaging 22.7 per game. The MSU defense is also strong, as the Spartans are seventh in the NCAA and first in the league in steals per game with 14.7 spg. Against Minnesota on Dec. 9, Michigan State stole the ball away 17 times, including a career-high five by Nia Clouden.
- With a win over Nebraska last season on Dec. 31, Michigan State is 25-13 in B1G home openers.
- Junior guard Janai Crooms was granted immediate eligibility from the NCAA for the 2020-21 season on Dec. 4. In her first game in the Green and White against Minnesota, she scored three points with two rebounds and a block in just 13 minutes.



TEAM NOTES

SCOUTING IOWA

Iowa has started the season 4-0 overall and 1-0 in league play. The Hawkeyes have wins over in-state rivals Northern Iowa, Drake and Iowa State. In its Big Ten opener, Iowa defeated Wisconsin, 85-78. The Hawkeyes are 17th in the nation and fourth in the Big Ten in scoring offense, averaging 91.5 ppg. They are also 16th in the country and third in the league in assists per game, averaging 19.5 ppg.

Freshman Caitlin Clark continues her hot start to her lowa career. She is averaging 28.5 points and 5.8 rebounds per game. She scored 34 points in the come-from-behind win against lowa State on Dec. 9. Clark is one of four Hawkeyes averaging in double figures, along with Monika Czinano (20.0 ppg), McKenna Warlock (15.0 ppg) and Gabbie Marshall (10.0 ppg).

SERIES HISTORY VS. IOWA

This is the only regular-season meeting between the Spartans and the Hawkeyes. Last season, Iowa stopped Michigan State in Iowa City, 74-57.

Overall, Iowa leads the series 39-29, as the Spartans are looking to snap a two-game losing streak. The Hawkeyes have won four of the last five after MSU had won four of the last five prior to that. Michigan State's last win came at home on Feb. 1, 2018 with MSU coming up on top 84-70. That game was also the Spartans' home Big Ten opener. On Alumni Day, MSU used a strong offensive performance to upset No. 16 Iowa. Then-freshman Nia Clouden scored 27 points with Jenna Allen recording a career-high 17 boards.

LAST TIME VS. THE HAWKEYES

In front of over 13,000 fans, the Michigan State women's basketball team fought hard but was stopped by No. 19/21 lowa, 74-57, in lowa City on Jan. 26, 2020. It was a close battle until the fourth quarter when the Hawkeyes out-scored the Spartans, 28-9, and pulled away for the win.

Prior to the game, MSU head coach Suzy Merchant honored Iowa's Kathleen Doyle, who Merchant coached in the Pan Am Games over the summer.

The Spartans had two players in double figures led by senior guard Taryn McCutcheon who scored 12 points, despite continuing to play with a fractured finger.

BIG TEN OPENERS

Michigan State is 19-19 in Big Ten openers, having won six of their last nine. MSU is now 8-5 in league openers in Coach Merchant's 13 seasons. Last season, the Spartans won their opener in East Lansing against No. 16 Iowa, 84-70. The last time that Michigan State played Minnesota in a B1G opener was to start the 2013-14 league action with MSU winning 81-56 on the road.

BACK IN UNIFORM

Junior guard Janai Crooms, who was recently granted eligibility on Dec. 4 after transferring from Ohio State last summer, made her Spartan debut at 6:18 of the first quarter, checking in. Crooms wasted little time in making the first bucket of her career in a Green & White jersey, just minutes later, at 3:42 of the first quarter with a layup. Crooms ended up with three points, three rebounds, two assists, two steals and one block in her Spartan debut.

CLOUDEN WITH A CHANCE OF SCORING

Junior guard Nia Clouden made her teamleading 66th career start, as she continues to start every game of her Spartan career. She now has scored 888 points, heading toward her quest for 1,000 points.

Clouden posted double-digits for the third game this season with 14 points in the first quarter alone. Her 25 points was a new season-high and her 11th 20-point outing of her career, as well as just three points shy of her career-best of 28 points (at Notre Dame, 11/14/19). Clouden now has 14-straight career games in double-digits dating back to last year, having posted double-figures in 30 of her last 33 games played. For her career, Clouden now has double-digits in 53 of her 65 games played.

PASSING THE BALL

Michigan State distributed the ball nicely in the season opener against Saint Francis on Nov. 27. The Spartans recorded 25 assists in the win with five different players having at least three helpers. Against Detroit Mercy, MSU topped that with 26 assists on Dec. 2, adding 17 against Minnesota on Dec. 9. Overall, Michigan State is third in the nation and first in the Big Ten in assists, averaging 22.7 apg. Nia Clouden is seventh in the Big Ten in assist per game with 5.3 per game.

TEAM NOTES

BRING ON THE BENCH

The Spartan bench out-scored the Golden Gopher reserves, 35-7, against Minnesota on Dec. 9, which in addition to a season-high point total, also marked their third-straight game with over 30 points, having now out-scored the opposition's bench, 99-29, an average of 33.0-9.7. For the season, 41.3 percent of the Spartans' scoring comes from the bench. Sophomore Alyza Winston and Julia Ayrault, average 15.5 and 9.3 points off the bench, respectively.

ERASE HATE

Michigan State women's basketball head coach Suzy Merchant is proud to launch the Erase Hate campaign for the 2020-21 season. The Erase Hate campaign aims to put the focus on student-athlete driven programming to address social injustice issues.

Throughout this season, women's basketball players work to help lift up the voices of underrepresented groups both on campus and across the Greater Lansing area.

FAST OUT OF THE GATE

MSU scored a season-high 48 points in the first half on the way to a 48-38 lead at intermission at Minnesota. The Spartans' 28 second-quarter points were their most in a quarter this season, bettering the previous quarter-high of 24 points, done twice, first in the opening quarter vs. Saint Francis (PA) in the season-opener on Nov. 27, and again in the fourth frame vs. Detroit Mercy on Dec. 2. MSU scored 20+ points three of the four quarter Wednesday for the second game in a row and matching a season-high, having now netted 20 or more points in seven of the 12 quarters this season.

LOOKING AT THE NUMBERS

Against Detroit Mercy on Dec. 2, Michigan State forced a season-high 25 turnovers, leading to a season-high 33-8 points off turnovers advantage. MSU's bench also had a 31-5 edge. Against Minnesota on Dec. 9, the Spartans forced 23 turnovers. Through three games, MSU's opponents have 74 turnovers, compared to only 37 by the Spartans. Michigan State has scored 93 points off of turnovers, which is 38.8 percent of its offense.

SEASON OPENERS

All-time, the Spartans are now 34-15 in season openers, but also 26-2 when the opener is in East Lansing. Coach Merchant is 11-3 in season openers at MSU, and has won 17 of her last 20, including her time at Eastern Michigan.

FAST BIG TEN START

MSU opened conference play on Dec. 9 at Minnesota, which was the earliest Big Ten opener since falling to Indiana on Dec. 6, 2009. The Spartans first home Big Ten game will be against Iowa on Dec. 12. Michigan State will play a total of three league contests in December, concluding with a New Year's Eve road battle against Ohio State.

MASK UP, MICHIGAN

Things will look very different in the Breslin Center to start the season. Currently, there will be no fans in the stands, including the families of the players. Crowd noise will be piped and the music will be going to get the players hyped up. From the comfort of home, fans can look for familiar faces in the cardboard cutouts in the stands. All postgame media will be done via Zoom this year.

MAGIC NUMBERS

In head coach Suzy Merchant's tenure, when two numbers on the scoreboard were achieved it typically has been a sign of a MSU win. The Green & White have won 149 of their last 168 games (.887) when scoring at least 70 points, and the Spartans are 167-28 (.857) under head coach Suzy Merchant when hanging at least 70 points on the scoreboard. The Spartans are now 3-0 this season when reaching the 70-point mark.

CLOSING OUT THE GAMES

The Spartans have been extremely effective closing out games over the last couple years, winning 212 of their last 225 games (.942) when leading with five minutes left, including 162 of their last 177. In Coach Merchant's tenure, Michigan State is 247-19 (.929) when holding a lead with five minutes left. This season, MSU is 3-0 when leading with five minutes remaining.

CLOUDEN EARNS PRESEASON HONORS

Michigan State junior guard Nia Clouden has been named Preseason All-Big Ten by both the coaches and media. During the 2019-20 campaign, Clouden finished the season first on the team in scoring, averaging 14.5 points per game, which was also eighth in the Big Ten. She also tied for 14th in the league in assists (3.3 apg) and 11th in steals (1.7 spg). Last season, Clouden captured second-team All-Big Big Ten honors after being named to the honorable mention squad as a freshman.



MICHIGAN STATE HEAD COACH SUZY MERCHANT



14th Season; Central Michigan '91 <u>Career Record: 485-268 (.644)</u> <u>Record at MSU: 284-148 (.657)</u>

Michigan State head Suzy Merchant has established herself as one of the premier coaches in MSU history. With nearly 500 career wins, Merchant has proven to be one of the best coaches in Michigan State history and a force in the Big Ten Conference. Entering her 14th season as head coach of the MSU women's basketball program, Merchant has brought the Spartan program to the upper echelon at the Big Ten and national level. The Spartans have finished third or better in the Big Ten in eight of the last 13 seasons, and her conference record of 136-86 (61.3%) is in the top-12 career winning percentage in the 35-year history of the Big Ten. The Spartans have won at least 20 games in 10 of her 13 seasons.

The Great Lakes State native was hired at MSU on April 30, 2007, after spending time as a head coach at Eastern Michigan (1998-07) and Saginaw Valley State (1995-98). In her 25 years as a head coach, she has won nearly 65 percent of her games, collecting a 482-268 (.643) career record, including 281-148 (.655) in 13 seasons in East Lansing. Merchant became the fastest Spartan coach to 100 wins. She is also the winningest coach in Eastern Michigan history, compiling a 147-91 record in her nine seasons.

Through her first 13 seasons at MSU, 45 Spartans have earned All-Big Ten recognition and 60 have been named Academic All-Big Ten. A pair of Spartans have earned major Big Ten awards - Kalisha Keane was the Big Ten Player of the Year in 2010-11, following up the Sixth Player of the Year award as a junior, while Lykendra Johnson (2010-11) and Allyssa DeHaan (2009-10) were

named Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year. DeHaan, who finished her career second all-time in NCAA history in blocked shots, and Keane were also named All-Americans following their senior seasons. In 2013-14, Aerial Powers became the first Spartan freshman to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Powers would go on to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors in 2014-15 and 2015-16, as well as being named an All-American both seasons. During the 2016-17 season, Tori Jankoska became the Spartan all-time leading scorer as well as earning first-team All-Big Ten and All-American honors.

Last season, a wave of injuries struck MSU before the COVID-19 pandemic wiped out the hopes of any post-season run. The Spartans ended the season with a 16-14 overall record and ending B1G play with a 9-9 record. After a mid-season lull, MSU won five of the last seven to end the year. Taryn McCutcheon capped off her stellar Spartan career, earning second-team All-Big Ten honors with second-team accolades by the coaches and honorable mention by the media. Sophomore Nia Clouden, who was a standout performer all season, picked up second-team honors. McCutcheon became MSU's all-time assist leader with 582 helpers.

During the 2018-19 campaign, the Spartans had some dazzling wins with victories over No. 3 Oregon and No. 16 lowa, as MSU was 15-1 at the Breslin Center. Michigan State ended the season with a 21-12 overall record, going 9-9 in Big Ten play. The Spartans reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to national runner-up Notre Dame. Four Spartans earned All-Big Ten honors with Shay Colley picking up first-team honors by the coaches. Jenna Allen earned second-team accolades, as Nia Clouden captured honorable mention honors and was named to the All-Freshman team. McCutcheon rounded out the group with honorable mention honors.

The 2017-18 Spartans battled injuries throughout the season and still managed to make the Sweet 16 of the WNIT, ending the season with a 19-14 mark and a 7-9 Big Ten record. MSU earned its first-ever win over Maryland on Jan. 11. Four Spartans earned All-Big Ten honors: Branndais Agee, Allen, Colley and McCutcheon earned honorable mention honors. Once again, Michigan State continued to fill the Breslin Center, finishing 10th in the nation and second in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 5,689 fans per game.

During the 2016-17 season, Michigan State reached the NCAA Tournament with a 21-12 record, including going 9-7 in Big Ten action. The year was filled with more record-breaking performances as Jankoska became the first Spartan to score over 2,000 points. Four Spartans

were honored with All-Big Ten honors. Jankoska was named first-team All-Big Ten, while Agee, Taya Reimer and McCutcheon were named to the honorable mention squad. MSU finished eighth in the nation and first in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 6,011 fans per game.

The 2015-16 season was a return to form for the Spartans, as MSU ended the season with a 25-9 overall record. Michigan State ended league play 13-5, which was good for third place in the ultra-competative Big Ten Conference. Powers was once again named to the first team, while Tori Jankoska was named to the second team. Both Agee and Jasmine Hines earned honorable mention honors. Against Minnesota on Feb. 21, Merchant earned her 400th win as a head coach. The Spartans continue to pack the stands, finishing seventh in the NCAA in attendance with an average of 6,561 fans per game.

The 2014-15 Spartans suffered through an injury-plagued season, finishing 16-15 overall and 7-11 in Big Ten action. Powers and Jankoska earned All-Big Ten honors with Powers being named to the first team and Jankosko to the second. The Spartans finished 10th in the nation and second in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 6,119 fans per game.

Merchant has accumulated international experience as well during her time at MSU. In the summer of 2009, she spent time with USA Basketball as an assistant coach for the Women's World University Games team in Belgrade, Serbia. Team USA went undefeated and took home the Gold medal, topping Russia, 83-64 in the championship game. In the summer of 2019, Merchant was the head coach of the U.S. Pan American team that captured the silver medal in Lima, Peru. The team went 4-1, falling to Brazil in the championship game.

In all her years in the Greater Lansing area, Merchant has gone to great lengths to become an integral part of the community. In her time off the court and out of the office, Merchant can be seen at many community service events in the Great Lansing area. She has been an Honorary Chair for numerous events, including Ele's Place, Sparrow Foundation's Hike for Hospice, Women Working Wonders, MSU Children's Health Initiative, Women's Center of Lansing, Haven House, Ronald McDonald House, Advent House Ministries, Old Newsboys' Shoe and Coat Drive, and Muscular Dystrophy Association.

In 2016, Merchant helped create the EmpowHER Retreat. EmpowHER is designed to build confidence in girls by providing interactive workshops concentrated on the importance of self-empowerment, confidence, health and wellness and relationship building. In 2018, Merchant was honored with the ATHENA Leadership Award by the Lansing Regional Chamber of Commerce. The award honors individuals who strive towards the highest levels of professional accomplishment, who excel in their chosen field, have devoted time and energy to their community, and who pave paths for other women to follow.

During her tenure with the Eagles, Merchant guided Eastern Michigan to a record of 147-91 (.618), including three 20-win seasons, three postseason appearances and two Mid-American Conference West Division titles. Before coaching at Eastern Michigan, Merchant spenthree seasons at Saginaw Valley State, posting a 54-29 (.651) record. Prior to becoming a head coach, Merchant was the top assistant for three years at Oakland University (1992-95).

A four-year starter and three-year captain at Central Michigan (1987-91), Merchant holds Chippewa records for assists with 463 and single-season assists with 156, and is tied for first in single-game assists with 11. She also finished her career third-best in made 3-point field goals with 75.

A native of Traverse City, Michigan, Merchant was a three-sport standout at Traverse City Central High School, lettering in basketball, volleyball and softball.




