THE STARTING FIVE

• Michigan State concludes the non-conference portion of the 2020-21 season against Oakland on Tuesday, Dec. 22 at 12 p.m. The Spartans are concluding a rough stretch of three games in five days after wins against Central Michigan (Dec. 18) and Northern Illinois (Dec. 20). This week, Michigan State is ranked No. 25 in the Associated Press poll.

• MSU improved to 6-0 with Sunday's win, the Spartans' first 6-0 start to a season since the 2012-13 season when they opened 8-0. This is the longest winning streak since Michigan State won eight-straight from Nov. 23-Dec. 30 during the 2018-19 season.

• Through six games, the Spartans stand second in the nation and first in the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.88). They are also third in the NCAA and first in the league in assists per game, averaging 22.5 ppg. Junior guard Nia Clouden is 11th in the country and first in the Big Ten this season with 35 assists.

• Junior guard Nia Clouden's 18 points against Northern Illinois on Dec. 20 gives her 948 career points, just 52 points away from the 1,000 career points milestone. She has scored in double figures in every game this season.

• After the holiday break, Michigan State returns to Big Ten action. The Spartans will take on Purdue on the road on Jan. 3, before returning to the Breslin Center to face No. 14/14 Maryland on Jan. 7.

The Golden Grizzlies bring a 3-3 overall record into Tuesday's tangle with the Spartans. Oakland is finishing up a hectic stretch of games, as Tuesday's game is the Grizzlies' third game in the last four days after playing at Horizon League foe Wright State on Saturday and Sunday. Oakland won Saturday's opener, 75-69, before falling, 74-49, Sunday, as OU suffered its first conference loss of the early season, now at 3-1, as well as having its three-game win streak snapped.

Oakland has two players scoring in double-figures, led by junior guard Kahlaijah Dean at 16.7 points per game, adding a team-best 2.0 steals per game, along with second on the team with 5.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists per contest. Sophomore guard Alona Blackwell adds 12.0 ppg and is the Grizzlies' leading 3-point shooter at 14-of-38 (.368), adding 3.2 rpg. Senior guard Chloe Guingrich leads OU with 5.2 rebounds per game.

As a team, Oakland is averaging 67.0 ppg, but allowing 72.3 ppg, for a scoring margin of -5.3. OU also has a -11.3 rebounding margin, getting out-rebounded by an average of 46.7-35.3 rpg. The Grizzlies are shooting 39.0 percent (142-of-364) from the field, including 28.8 percent (34-of-118) from 3-point range, making 5.7 treys per game, as well as 64.6 percent (84-of-130) at the free throw line. OU head coach Jeff Tungate is in his eighth season leading the Grizzlies, posting a 93-124 record.

SERIES HISTORY VS. OAKLAND

Tuesday will be the 21st meeting between MSU and Oakland, with the Spartans winning the last 12 meetings in a row and leading the all-time series, 16-4. The teams have met in each of the last 10 seasons since the 2011-12 season. MSU also holds a 10-2 lead in games in East Lansing, winning the last seven in a row on the Spartans' home court, including last season's 76-56 win on Nov. 19, 2019, that came on the heels of a 102-58 Spartan rout in Rochester on Dec. 5, 2018. Tuesday's game date of Dec. 22 is the latest the Spartans and Grizzlies have played in a season since the 1981-82 season, when they played on Feb. 9, 1982.

LAST TIME VS. OAKLAND

Taryn McCutcheon scored 16 points, Mardrekia Cook added 14 and No. 15/16 Michigan State women's basketball defeated Oakland 76-56 on Nov. 19, 2019 at the Breslin Center.

MSU had four in double figures led by 16 points by McCutcheon, while Cook added a season-high 14 points. Sophomore forward Kayla Belles was one point shy of matching her career high, scoring 11 points, while sophomore guard Nia Clouden added 10. Freshman forward Taiyier Parks was the first Spartan to reach double figures in rebounds with 10.

Kayla Luchenbach had 17 points and 10 rebounds for the Golden Grizzlies (2-2) with Jali-sha Terry scoring 16 points.

GIVING A HELPING HAND

Michigan State's 25 assists against NIU on Dec. 20 not only tied the second-most of the season, but was the Spartans' second-straight and fourth game this season in topping 20 or more helpers in the six games, joining 24 last time out vs. Central Michigan (Dec. 18), along with 25 in the season-opener vs. Saint Francis (Nov. 27), 26 vs. Detroit Mercy (Dec. 2).

Individually, the Spartans have two players in the top 10 in the Big Ten in assists per game. Nia Clouden is fourth, averaging 5.8 apg, while Tory Ozment is 10th with 4.8 apg. Ozment is also tied for fourth in assist/turnover ratio (3.22).

CLOUDEN WITH A CHANCE OF SCORING

Junior guard Nia Clouden had her three-game 20-point scoring streak halted with 18 points against Northern Illinois on Dec. 20. Clouden has now posted double-figures in all six games this season as part of 17 games in a row dating back to last season. She leads the team in scoring, averaging 19.2 points per game. She also is tops on the team in assists per game with 5.8 per game.

Clouden now has 17-straight career games in double-digits dating back to last year, having posted double-figures in 33 of her last 36 games played, doing so in every game but three last season. For her career, Clouden now has double-digits in 56 of her 69 games played.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

The Big Ten has six teams ranked in the Associated Press Top 25 this week and two more receiving votes. This is the most top 25 teams of any conference in the country this week and the most the Big Ten has had in a single week since Jan. 14, 2019. Michigan State enters the polls at No. 25, while Maryland leads way No. 14. The other ranked teams include - Northwestern (No. 15), Ohio State (No. 16), Michigan (No. 17) and Indiana (No. 19).

NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP

Several Spartan sophomores are showing no signs of a sophomore slump against Northern Illinois on Dec. 20.

- Julia Ayrault dished out a career-high five assists and swatted a season-high three blocks, tying her career-high.
- Taiyier Parks pulled down a season-high and career-best tying 10 rebounds for her second double-figure rebounding game of her career.

PUTTING UP BIG NUMBERS

After not having a pair of 20-point scorers in the same since Feb. 3, 2019 vs. Purdue when Shay Colley and Sidney Cooks netted 20 points apiece before Winston and Clouden did it last against Minnesota on Dec. 9, the Spartan duo has now reached that feat in back-to-back games with Winston's 25 points and Clouden's 21 points on Dec. 12 vs. Iowa.

Clouden and Winston's back-to-back 20-point games marks the first time that the Spartans have had two 20-point scorers in consecutive games since the 2016-17 season, when Aerial Powers (27) and Brannndais Agee (20) did so on Feb. 3. vs. Michigan, then Powers (31) and Agee (22) on Feb. 5 vs. Maryland.

LOOKING AHEAD

Michigan State women's basketball's game against Ohio State that was set for Thursday, Dec. 31 in Columbus, Ohio, has been postponed due to COVID-19 concerns within the Buckeyes' program.

The decision to pause activities and to postpone the games was made jointly by the Ohio State Department of Athletics and its sports medicine staff in consultation with the Big Ten Conference. SPARTANS AGAINST THE NCAA

After six games, the Spartans are currently third in the nation in assists per game (22.5 apg) and second in assists to turnover ratio (1.88). Michigan State is 13 in turnover margin +8.33 margin. Junior guard Nia Clouden is 11th in the nation and first in the Big Ten in assists with 35, while standing 20th in the country and fourth in the Big Ten in assists per game with 5.8 apg.

ERASE HATE

Michigan State women's basketball head coach Suzy Merchant is proud to launch the Erase Hate campaign for the 2020-21 season. The Erase Hate campaign aims to put the focus on student-athlete driven programming to address social injustice issues. Throughout this season, women's basketball players work to help lift up the voices of underrepresented groups both on campus and across the Greater Lansing area.

BIG TEN OPENERS

Michigan State is 19-19 in Big Ten openers, having won six of their last nine. MSU is now 8-5 in league openers in Coach Merchant's 13 seasons. Last season, the Spartans won their opener in East Lansing against No. 16 Iowa, 84-70. The last time that Michigan State played Minnesota in a Big Ten opener was to start the 2013-14 league action with MSU winning 81-56 on the road.

FAST OUT OF THE GATE

MSU scored a season-high 48 points in the first half on the way to a 48-38 lead at intermission at Minnesota on Dec. 9. The Spartans' 28 second-quarter points were their most in a quarter this season, bettering the previous quarter-high of 24 points, done twice, first in the opening quarter vs. Saint Francis (PA) in the season-opener on Nov. 27, and again in the fourth frame vs. Detroit Mercy on Dec. 2. Against Iowa on Dec. 12, the Spartans scored 44 points in the first half with 24 points in the first quarter.

MASK UP, MICHIGAN

Things will look very different in the Breslin Center to start the season. Currently, there will be no fans in the stands, including the families of the players. Crowd noise will be piped and the music will be going to get the players hyped up. From the comfort of home, fans can look for familiar faces in the cardboard cutouts in the stands. All postgame media will be done via Zoom this year.

MAGIC NUMBERS

In head coach Suzy Merchant's tenure, when two numbers on the scoreboard were achieved it typically has been a sign of a MSU win. The Green & White have won 152 of their last 170 games (.889) when scoring at least 70 points, and the Spartans are 170-28 (.859) under head coach Suzy Merchant when hanging at least 70 points on the scoreboard. The Spartans are now 6-0 this season when reaching the 70-point mark.

CLOSING OUT THE GAMES

The Spartans have been extremely effective closing out games over the last couple years, winning 215 of their last 228 games (.943) when leading with five minutes left, including 166 of their last 181. In Coach Merchant's tenure, Michigan State is 250-19 (.929) when holding a lead with five minutes left. This season, MSU is 6-0 when leading with five minutes remaining.

CLOUDEN EARNS PRESEASON HONORS

Michigan State junior guard Nia Clouden has been named Preseason All-Big Ten by both the coaches and media. During the 2019-20 campaign, Clouden finished the season first on the team in scoring, averaging 14.5 points per game, which was also eighth in the Big Ten. She also tied for 14th in the league in assists (3.3 apg) and 11th in steals (1.7 spg). Last season, Clouden captured second-team All-Big Ten honors after being named to the honorable mention squad as a freshman.

MICHIGAN STATE HEAD COACH SUZY MERCHANT



14th Season; Central Michigan '91
Career Record: 488-268 (.645)
Record at MSU: 287-148 (.660)

Michigan State head Suzy Merchant has established herself as one of the premier coaches in MSU history. With nearly 500 career wins, Merchant has proven to be one of the best coaches in Michigan State history and a force in the Big Ten Conference. Entering her 14th season as head coach of the MSU women's basketball program, Merchant has brought the Spartan program to the upper echelon at the Big Ten and national level. The Spartans have finished third or better in the Big Ten in eight of the last 13 seasons, and her conference record of 136-86 (61.3%) is in the top-12 career winning percentage in the 35-year history of the Big Ten. The Spartans have won at least 20 games in 10 of her 13 seasons.

The Great Lakes State native was hired at MSU on April 30, 2007, after spending time as a head coach at Eastern Michigan (1998-07) and Saginaw Valley State (1995-98). In her 25 years as a head coach, she has won nearly 65 percent of her games, collecting a 482-268 (.643) career record, including 281-148 (.655) in 13 seasons in East Lansing. Merchant became the fastest Spartan coach to 100 wins. She is also the winningest coach in Eastern Michigan history, compiling a 147-91 record in her nine seasons.

Through her first 13 seasons at MSU, 45 Spartans have earned All-Big Ten recognition and 60 have been named Academic All-Big Ten. A pair of Spartans have earned major Big Ten awards - Kalisha Keane was the Big Ten Player of the Year in 2010-11, following up the Sixth Player of the Year award as a junior, while Lykendrea Johnson (2010-11) and Allyssa DeHaan (2009-10) were

named Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year. DeHaan, who finished her career second all-time in NCAA history in blocked shots, and Keane were also named All-Americans following their senior seasons. In 2013-14, Aerial Powers became the first Spartan freshman to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Powers would go on to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors in 2014-15 and 2015-16, as well as being named an All-American both seasons. During the 2016-17 season, Tori Jankoska became the Spartan all-time leading scorer as well as earning first-team All-Big Ten and All-American honors.

Last season, a wave of injuries struck MSU before the COVID-19 pandemic wiped out the hopes of any post-season run. The Spartans ended the season with a 16-14 overall record and ending Big Ten play with a 9-9 record. After a mid-season lull, MSU won five of the last seven to end the year. Taryn McCutcheon capped off her stellar Spartan career, earning second-team All-Big Ten honors with second-team accolades by the coaches and honorable mention by the media. Sophomore Nia Clouden, who was a standout performer all season, picked up second-team honors. McCutcheon became MSU's all-time assist leader with 582 helpers.

During the 2018-19 campaign, the Spartans had some dazzling wins with victories over No. 3 Oregon and No. 16 Iowa, as MSU was 15-1 at the Breslin Center. Michigan State ended the season with a 21-12 overall record, going 9-9 in Big Ten play. The Spartans reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to national runner-up Notre Dame. Four Spartans earned All-Big Ten honors with Shay Colley picking up first-team honors by the coaches. Jenna Allen earned second-team accolades, as Nia Clouden captured honorable mention honors and was named to the All-Freshman team. McCutcheon rounded out the group with honorable mention honors.

The 2017-18 Spartans battled injuries throughout the season and still managed to make the Sweet 16 of the WNIT, ending the season with a 19-14 mark and a 7-9 Big Ten record. MSU earned its first-ever win over Maryland on Jan. 11. Four Spartans earned All-Big Ten honors: Brannndais Agee, Allen, Colley and McCutcheon earned honorable mention honors. Once again, Michigan State continued to fill the Breslin Center, finishing 10th in the nation and second in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 5,689 fans per game.

During the 2016-17 season, Michigan State reached the NCAA Tournament with a 21-12 record, including going 9-7 in Big Ten action. The year was filled with more record-breaking performances as Jankoska became the first Spartan to score over 2,000 points. Four Spartans

were honored with All-Big Ten honors. Jankoska was named first-team All-Big Ten, while Agee, Taya Reimer and McCutcheon were named to the honorable mention squad. MSU finished eighth in the nation and first in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 6,011 fans per game.

The 2015-16 season was a return to form for the Spartans, as MSU ended the season with a 25-9 overall record. Michigan State ended league play 13-5, which was good for third place in the ultra-competitive Big Ten Conference. Powers was once again named to the first team, while Tori Jankoska was named to the second team. Both Agee and Jasmine Hines earned honorable mention honors. Against Minnesota on Feb. 21, Merchant earned her 400th win as a head coach. The Spartans continue to pack the stands, finishing seventh in the NCAA in attendance with an average of 6,561 fans per game.

The 2014-15 Spartans suffered through an injury-plagued season, finishing 16-15 overall and 7-11 in Big Ten action. Powers and Jankoska earned All-Big Ten honors with Powers being named to the first team and Jankoska to the second. The Spartans finished 10th in the nation and second in the Big Ten in attendance, averaging 6,119 fans per game.

Merchant has accumulated international experience as well during her time at MSU. In the summer of 2009, she spent time with USA Basketball as an assistant coach for the Women's World University Games team in Belgrade, Serbia. Team USA went undefeated and took home the Gold medal, topping Russia, 83-64 in the championship game. In the summer of 2019, Merchant was the head coach of the U.S. Pan American team that captured the silver medal in Lima, Peru. The team went 4-1, falling to Brazil in the championship game.

In all her years in the Greater Lansing area, Merchant has gone to great lengths to become an integral part of the community. In her time off the court and out of the office, Merchant can be seen at many community service events in the Greater Lansing area. She has been an Honorary Chair for numerous events, including Ele's Place, Sparrow Foundation's Hike for Hospice, Women Working Wonders, MSU Children's Health Initiative, Women's Center of Lansing, Haven House, Ronald McDonald House, Advent House Ministries, Old Newsboys' Shoe and Coat Drive, and Muscular Dystrophy Association.

In 2016, Merchant helped create the EmpowHER Retreat. EmpowHER is designed to build confidence in girls by providing interactive workshops concentrated on the importance of self-empowerment, confidence, health and wellness and relationship building. In 2018, Merchant was honored with the ATHENA Leadership Award by the Lansing Regional Chamber of Commerce. The award honors individuals who strive towards the highest levels of professional accomplishment, who excel in their chosen field, have devoted time and energy to their community, and who pave paths for other women to follow.

During her tenure with the Eagles, Merchant guided Eastern Michigan to a record of 147-91 (.618), including three 20-win seasons, three postseason appearances and two Mid-American Conference West Division titles. Before coaching at Eastern Michigan, Merchant spent three seasons at Saginaw Valley State, posting a 54-29 (.651) record. Prior to becoming a head coach, Merchant was the top assistant for three years at Oakland University (1992-95).

A four-year starter and three-year captain at Central Michigan (1987-91), Merchant holds Chippewa records for assists with 463 and single-season assists with 156, and is tied for first in single-game assists with 11. She also finished her career third-best in made 3-point field goals with 75.

A native of Traverse City, Michigan, Merchant was a three-sport standout at Traverse City Central High School, lettering in basketball, volleyball and softball.
