OPENING TIP-OFF

• Minnesota women's basketball opens Big Ten play Wednesday night when it hosts Michigan State (2-0) at 8 p.m. The game will be available to view on Big Ten Network and can be heard on the Gophers' radio home, 96.7 FM KFAN Plus.

• Minnesota is 16-22 all-time in Big Ten openers, including three straight wins, and 19-19 in conference home openers. This season will be the fifth time that the Gophers open league action against Michigan State with the Spartans holding a 3-1 edge in those games. The previous meetings occurred in 1988-89, 2007-08, 2012-13 and 2013-14; the Gophers' victory came in 2007-08 in East Lansing.

• **Jasmine Powell** leads the Gophers with a scoring average of 21.5 points per game after scoring 21 in the opener against EIU and adding 22 more against Drake. She's the first Gopher since **Carlie Wagner** in 2016-17 to score at least 20 points in each of the first two games in a season. In addition to her scoring prowess, which is currently fifth in the Big Ten (21.5), Powell leads the Big Ten and is fifth nationally in assists per game (7.5), and she is first in the conference in minutes played per game (38.82).

• In the season opener, **Kadi Sissoko** scored 24 points in her first game at Minnesota to tie a school record for points a debut (Kenisha Bell vs. VCU, 11/15/16). Her 24 points were also the most in a season opener by a Gopher since Carlie Wagner opened the 2016-17 campaign with 27 points against Harvard. Sissoko, who had a career-high eight rebounds in the contest, leads the Big Ten with 5.5 offensive rebounds per game and ranks eighth in rebounds per game (8.5) and 10th in scoring (18.0).

• Minnesota is coming off a 16-15 season (5-13 in Big Ten play) in which it reached the second round of the Big Ten Tournament in Lindsay Whalen's second season as head coach. The Gophers started the year 9-1, its fourth best 10-game start, while its 11-1 beginning was its fifth best one-loss start.

• The Golden Gophers return four letterwinners from last season's squad, including three of their top five scorers in Powell (12.1, 2nd), senior **Gadiva Hubbard** (11.2, 4th) and sophomore **Sara Scalia** (10.8, 5th). All three earned All-Big Ten honors a year ago as Powell was a consensus pick for both All-Big Ten Honorable Mention and the Big Ten All-Freshman Team, while Hubbard was an All-Big Ten Honorable Mention honoree by the media, as was Scalia, who also earned a place on the media's Big Ten All-Freshman Team.



Jasmine Powell is averaging 21.5 points, 7.5 assists and 6.0 rebounds through two games this season for Minnesota.

FACING MICHIGAN STATE

• Minnesota and Michigan State meet for the 68th time in their series history Wednesday. The Gophers trail in the all-time matchups 44-23. The teams have alternated wins in each of the last five contests with the home team winning each game.

• In Minneapolis, the Gophers trail the Spartans, 16-15. Minnesota has won two in a row at Williams Arena against Michigan State and three of the last four there.

• Under head coach **Lindsay Whalen**, the Gophers are 1-2 against the Spartans.

• Minnesota has one Michigan native on its roster. **Jasmine Powell** hails from Detroit, which is about 90 minutes southeast of East Lansing. She won two state championships at Detroit County Day School, including the 2017 title which took place at Michigan State's home court, the Breslin Center.

• Michigan State is 2-0 on the season with a 77-44 win over Saint Francis (PA) on Nov. 27 and a 82-45 defeat of Detroit Mercy on Dec. 2.

• Five Spartans are averaging at least 10 points per game with **Nia Clouden** leading the way at 15.0 points per contest. **Kendall Bostic** and **Taiyier Parks** are both at 11.5 points per game, while **Alyza Winston** (11.0) and **Tory Ozment** (10.5) are also in double figures.

• Parks is the team's leading rebounder at 6.5 boards per game, while Clouden is ninth in the country with 7.0 assists per contest.

• As a team, Michigan State leads the nation with 25.5 assists per game, is second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.22), ranks third in points allowed (44.5), is fourth in turnover margin (+14.0), seventh in turnovers forced per game (25.5) and 10th in scoring margin (+35.0).

LAST SEASON AGAINST THE SPARTANS

• Minnesota was tripped up on the road at Michigan State last season, 66-54.

• **Jasmine Powell** posted a team-high 15 points to go with four rebounds, two steals and an assist.

• Three other Gophers -- **Masha Adashchik**, **Jasmine Brunson** and **Sara Scalia** -- all had eight points, while **Taiye Bello** was the top rebounder with eight boards.

• It was a tight first quarter as neither team led by more than three, and the frame featured four lead changes and two ties. The Spartans held a slight 14-12 lead after the first 10 minutes and continued to maintain the advantage until the Gophers pulled ahead, 23-22, thanks to a 3-pointer from **Gadiva Hubbard**.

• Minnesota had its first lead since 9-8, but Michigan State countered with a 9-0 run and would not trail the rest of the way.

• Up 31-27 at intermission, the Spartans scored the first five points of the third quarter and 11 of the first 14 to push their lead into double digits. Michigan State led 50-38 with under two minutes to go in the third quarter but the Gophers ended the frame on a small 7-2 run to trail by seven, 52-45, heading to the fourth.

• Down 10 early in the fourth quarter, Powell answered with a field goal and Brunson hit a free throw to get it back to seven with 8:57 to play in the game. That would be as close as Minnesota would get the rest of the way.

LAST TIME IN MINNEAPOLIS

• Last time the teams met in Minneapolis, the Gophers and MSU closed out the 2018-19 regular season against one another, and Minnesota sent off its seniors in style with an 82-63 victory.

• **Destiny Pitts** led all scorers with 26 points, while **Kenisha Bell** posted 23 points, eight rebounds and four assists. Like Pitts, she was also a perfect 10-of-10 at the charity stripe. It was the first time in program history that two Gophers each attempted 10 free throws without a miss in the same game.

• **Taiye Bello** recorded a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds; she also blocked three shots. **Jasmine Brunson** was the fourth Gopher to reach double figures, scoring 13 to go with six rebounds.

• The game was even after the first quarter at 14-14, but Minnesota outscored Michigan State, 17-6, in the second quarter to take control of the contest. The Spartans were held without a point for the final 5:03 of the frame.

• Minnesota closed out the opening half on an 8-0 run and led 31-20 at intermission. An early bucket for Michigan State cut the lead to nine points less than a minute into the third quarter, but Bell answered with a layup and Minnesota led by double digits the rest of the way.

• The 19-point margin of victory marked the largest ever for the Gophers against the Spartans, bettering a 16-point win in Feb. of 2009.

RECAPING THE GAME AGAINST DRAKE

• Minnesota played its second and final non-conference game of the regular season Sunday with a 99-66 loss to Drake at Williams Arena.

• **Jasmine Powell** led the Gophers with 22 points, seven rebounds and seven assists. Coming off a 21-point performance in Wednesday's season opener, she's the first Gopher to score 20 points in each of the first two of a season since Carlie Wagner did it in the first four contests of the 2016-17 campaign.

• **Gadiva Hubbard** had 17 points, thanks in part to four 3-pointers. Also reaching double figures was **Kadi Sis-soko**, who was a rebound shy of her first career double double as she posted 12 points and nine rebounds. She also had a pair of blocks and two assists.

• Freshman **Caroline Strande** made her Minnesota debut with nine points, four rebounds and four steals.

• Drake scored the first eight points of Sunday's game and 19 of the first 24 to take control of the game early. The Bulldogs led 33-17 after one quarter of play, extended the lead to 56-34 at halftime and led by as many as 42 points in the second half.

WHALEN IN THIRD SEASON AT HELM OF ALMA MATER

• **Lindsay Whalen** entered her third season as the head coach of the Golden Gophers with a 37-26 record overall and 14-22 mark in Big Ten play.

• Her win total and win percentage (.587) are both the fourth highest all-time among Gopher coaches through her first two seasons.

• She is already fifth in program history for victories (38), while her win percentage (.585) is third best among those with at least 50 games coached.

• Including Whalen, there were 23 head coaches in NCAA Division I who made their debuts in 2018-19. Through two seasons, Whalen ranks second among them in wins and win percentage. She trails only Western Kentucky's Greg Collins (42 wins, .656 win percentage).

• Whalen has coached one WNBA draft pick, one All-American, seven All-Big Ten honorees, two members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team, one Big Ten All-Defensive Team player and 11 Academic All-Big Ten honorees.

POWELL, SCALIA MADE INSTANT IMPACT AS FRESHMEN

- Minnesota sophomores **Jasmine Powell** and **Sara Scalia** made immediate impacts on the program last year as both were All-Big Ten Honorable Mention honorees (coaches and media for Powell, media for Scalia) and earned spots on the All-Freshman Team.
- Powell who started each of the final 12 games after coming off the bench in the previous 19, led the Gophers in points (375), field goal attempts (346) and free throw attempts (131).
- She ranked fourth all-time among Minnesota freshmen in free throws made (99) and assists (96).
- Powell led all Big Ten freshmen in points per game (12.1) and free throw percentage (.756); also led B1G freshmen in scoring in conference games only (13.1).

- She became the first freshman ever in program history to lead the team in assists, the first freshman to lead in free throw percentage (min. 100 attempts) since Carol Ann Shudlick in 1990-91 and the first freshman to lead in free throws made since Ashley Ellis-Milan in 2006-07.

- Powell put up 19 points against Vermont on Nov. 10, the most by a non-starter at Minnesota since Nov. of 2017. She later posted a career-high 24 points at Wisconsin on Feb. 6, then went for 20 vs. Michigan on Feb. 10 and had 21 at Ohio State on Feb. 13, making her the only Gopher freshman to score 20+ in three straight games in at least the last 25 seasons.

- Powell scored in double figures in 19 games last year, including 13 of the last 14 contests. She had four 20-point games, all of which have come in the last nine contests.

- Scalia played in all 31 games a year ago with 30 starts, averaging 10.8 points per game.

- Scalia ranked fourth all-time among Minnesota freshmen in 3-pointers made (59) and minutes per game (32.3), and fifth in 3-pointers attempted (160), 3-point percentage (.369; min. 40 attempts), free throw percentage (.822; min. 40 attempts) and starts (30).

- She led all Big Ten freshmen in 3-pointers made per game (1.9); also led all B1G freshmen in conference games only in 3-point percentage (.367), 3's made per game (2.2) and minutes played per game (34.4).

- Against Bryant on Nov. 26, she scored 20 points and tied a career high with seven rebounds en route to being named B1G Freshman of the Week. Versus Iowa on Jan. 16, she had her first career double-double with

18 points and a career-high 10 rebounds then followed with 18 points at Purdue to earn her second B1G Freshman of the Week honor.

- Scalia had 15 games last season in double figures, seven contests with at least 15 points and three 20-point outings.

- With Powell and Scalia both earning spots on the Big Ten All-Freshman Team, it's the first time in program history that the Gophers have had multiple players named to the team in one season.

- In addition, Powell and Scalia each won Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors twice this season. It's the first time in program history that multiple Gophers have won multiple Freshman of the Week accolades in one season since the award was introduced in 2009-10. They are two of seven players in Gophers history with two or more Freshman of the Week accolades.

- With Powell averaging 12.1 points per game and Scalia at 10.8, the Gophers' duo combined for the third best scoring combination ever among Gopher freshmen. With records dating back to the 1977-78 season, only two other freshmen duos combined for more points in a season than Powell and Scalia: **Lindsay Whalen** (17.0) and **Tanisha Gilbert** (14.7) in 2000-01 and **Linda Roberts** (14.4) and **Joan Kowalsky** (11.2) in 1977-78. In fact, those are the only other times in team annals that two freshmen have each averaged double digits.

- The four freshmen that played last year (Powell (12.1), Scalia (10.8), **Klarke Sconiers** (2.5) and **Barbora Tomancova** (0.8)) combined for 26.2 points per game, the highest figure among Gopher freshmen in the last 13 years and fifth largest in program history.

HUBBARD BECOMES 26TH MEMBER OF 1,000-POINT CLUB

- **Gadiva Hubbard** was the only Gopher to start all 31 games a year ago, averaging 11.2 points, 3.4 rebounds, 1.8 assists and 1.7 steals while playing 32.3 minutes per game.

- Hubbard ranked fifth in the Big Ten last year in 3-pointers attempted (179), sixth in 3's made (63) and 3-point percentage (.352), eighth in 3's made per game (1.97) and 12th in steals per game (1.71).

- Hubbard was back on the court last year after missing all of the 2018-19 season following surgery on her right foot on Oct. 19, 2018.

- Hubbard scored a season-high 24 points against UC Davis (12/15) thanks to 4-of-7 shooting from 3-point range and 6-of-8 shooting at the free throw line. It was her best scoring outing since going for 25 points against Penn State in Feb. of 2018.

- She also enjoyed a 20 point-game against then-No. 19 Arizona State on Nov. 17, matched that with 20 points, including six 3-pointers, in a win at Notre Dame on Dec. 4 and tallied 20 points, her highest in league play, at Iowa on Feb. 27.

- With 10 points at Ohio State on Feb. 13, she became the 26th player in Gophers history to reach 1,000 points in her career.

GOPHERS WELCOME FIVE NEWCOMERS IN 2020-21

• Minnesota welcomes five newcomers to the roster this season with two transfers and three freshmen.

• **Laura Bagwell Katalinich** is a 6'0 senior forward who spent the past three seasons at Cornell University. A native of Minneapolis and graduate of Academy of Holy Angels, she joins Minnesota as a graduate transfer with one year of eligibility. In her two seasons of competition with the Big Red, Bagwell Katalinich played in all 52 games with 50 starts and averaged 14.8 points, 7.5 rebounds, 1.9 assists and 1.2 steals per game while shooting 45.6 percent from the floor and 79.9 percent on free throws. She has not played yet this season.

• **Kayla Mershon** spent her first two seasons at the University of Nebraska. A 6'3 forward from Minnetonka, Minn., Mershon played in all 60 games with 15 starts in her two seasons with the Huskers, averaging 2.4 points and 2.8 rebounds in 14.6 minutes of action per contest while shooting 35.8 percent from the floor and 30.0 percent on 3-pointers. She is sitting out this season as a transfer, per NCAA rules.

• A 6'2 native of New Berlin, Wis., **Erin Hedman** attended Eisenhower High School. A four-star recruit according to ESPN, she was the 75th-ranked player overall in the class and the No. 8 post player. Hedman earned AP Honorable-Mention All-State honors, WBCA Division 2 All-State recognition and was a McDonald's All-American Game nominee as a senior after averaging 12.0 points, 8.2 rebounds and 1.5 blocks per game. She was named second-team all-conference as a junior after averaging 8.4 points, 7.6 rebounds, 1.9 assists and 1.4 blocks per game.

• Hedman has started both contests and is averaging 4.0 points and 1.0 rebounds per game. With her start in the season opener, Hedman became the first freshman to start the season opener for the Gophers since Jasmine Brunson in 2016-17 and the first freshman forward to do so since Jackie Voigt in 2008-09.

• **Caroline Strande** is a 5'11 guard from Racine, Wis. A three-star recruit according to ESPN, Strande was touted as the No. 29 guard in the country. She finished her high school career as the fifth-leading scorer in state history and holds school career records for points (with over 2,500), field goals made, free throws made, steals and assists. Strande was the Journal Sentinel's Player of the Year, AP First Team All-State, WBCA Division 4 All-State and McDonald's High School All-American Game nominee as a senior after averaging 35.3 points (second in the state), 10.2 rebounds, 5.4 assists, 5.4 steals and 1.6 blocks per contest.

• Strande made her Minnesota debut with nine points, four rebounds and four steals against Drake Sunday.

WHALEN PUTS NO. 13 BACK INTO CIRCULATION

- Since **Lindsay Whalen** ended her playing career with the Golden Gophers in 2004, no player in the program has worn her No. 13. Now she wants to give someone else a chance to make their own memories in the number as she has put it back into circulation.
- "I am honored that my jersey hangs in the rafters of Williams Arena and am grateful for the impact the 'U' has had on my life," she said. "Moving forward, however, I would like to have the No. 13 available for others that come to the university and represent the Gophers on the court."
- None of the six numbers and seven jerseys (**Debbie Hunter** also wore No. 13) that have been raised to the rafters of Williams Arena have officially been retired. However, out of respect for Whalen and the impact she has had on the program, no player has been given her number since her career ended.
- In addition to Whalen and Hunter's No. 13, the other honored jerseys at Minnesota belong to **Rachel Banham** (No. 1), **Janel McCarville** (No. 4), **Linda Roberts** (No. 21), **Carol Ann Shudlick** (No. 42) and **Laura Coenen** (No. 44).

GOPHERS WELCOME THREE IN 2021 SIGNING CLASS

- Minnesota has announced the addition of three student-athletes that have signed National Letters of Intent to join the Minnesota women's basketball program for the 2021-22 season: **Katie Borowicz**, **Maggie Czinano** and **Alanna Micheaux**.
- A native of Roseau, Minn., Borowicz (buh-RAH-vitch) currently attends Roseau High School. A four-star recruit according to ESPN, she is the 98th-ranked player overall in the class and the No. 19 point guard. The 5'7 Borowicz is a three-time all-state honoree, including this past season as she averaged 31.3 points, 6.8 rebounds, 6.2 steals and 6.0 steals per. On the varsity team since seventh grade, she has scored over 2,000 points in her career and reached 1,000 by her sophomore season. Borowicz has helped Roseau to a state title in 2017, a runner-up finish in the following season and a spot in the semifinals in 2019.
- Hailing from Watertown, Minn., Czinano (sih-NON-oh) is a 6'0 guard who attends Watertown-Mayer High School. She's a three-time all-conference honoree and was named all-state this past season as she averaged 21 points, 2.2 steals and 2.1 assists per contest. Czinano has helped her school to a pair of conference championships, a section championship and a third-place finish at the 2017 state tournament. Her AAU team is the Minnesota Fury, which won back-to-back state titles in 2019 and 2020 and finished second at the 2019 UAA Nationals.
- Micheaux (mih-SHOW) comes to the Gophers from Wayne, Mich., and Wayne Memorial High School. A 6'2 forward, she is a four-star recruit, the No. 75 player overall in the country and the No. 9 power forward according to ProspectNation.com. Micheaux is coming off a junior season in which she was named first team all-state and all-region as she averaged 26.4 points, 14.0 rebounds, 3.2 blocks, 2.6 assists and 1.8 steals per contest while shooting 64 percent from the floor. She helped lead her team to district and regional championships and an appearance in the Final Four in her first two seasons at Wayne and a third district championship a year ago before COVID-19 brought the season to an end.

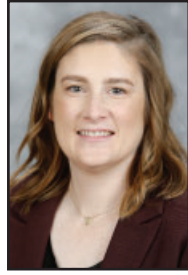

HEAD COACH LINDSAY WHALEN THIRD SEASON · MINNESOTA, 2004



One of the most decorated players in women's basketball history, Lindsay Whalen returned to her alma mater as the 12th head women's basketball coach at the University of Minnesota on April 13, 2018.

In her two seasons guiding the Golden Gophers, Whalen has led the team to a 37-26 mark (.587) with a trip to the WNIT in 2018-19. In addition, she has coached one WNBA draft pick, one All-American, seven All-Big Ten honorees, two members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team, one Big Ten All-Defensive Team player and 11 Academic All-Big Ten honorees.

In Whalen's second season, the team won 11 straight games at one point, which was the sixth longest win streak in program history. During the stretch, it won four straight on the road, the seventh longest such streak at Minnesota. Included in the streak was an 80-66 upset of then-No. 19 Arizona State.

Five members of the team took home season honors from the Big Ten. Taiye Bello was a consensus All-Big Ten Second Team selection by the league's coaches and media, while Jasmine Powell was a consensus pick for both All-Big Ten Honorable Mention and the Big Ten All-Freshman Team. Gadiva Hubbard was an All-Big Ten Honorable Mention honoree by the media, as was Sara Scalia, who also earned a place on the media's Big Ten All-Freshman Team.

In her first season at the helm of the Gophers, Whalen guided the team to a 21-11 record overall, a 9-9 mark in league play and a spot in the second round of the WNIT. She became the fifth coach in program history to lead the team to 20 wins in their first season. The Gophers enjoyed a 10-week run in the AP Poll, their longest stretch since the 2005-06 season.

Minnesota began the 2018-19 season by winning its first 12 games, tied for the third best streak in team history.

With the 12-0 start, Whalen tied her former coach, Pam Borton (2002-03), for the best undefeated start by a coach in their first year at a Big Ten school since the incorporation of women's athletics in the conference in 1982-83. The only coach at a Big Ten school with more wins in his or her first year there was Ohio State's Debbie Wilson, who started 14-0 in 1972-73.

Under Whalen's tutelage, Kenisha Bell earned honorable mention All-America honors from the AP, was a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Defensive Player of the Year Award, garnered consensus First Team All-Big Ten honors from the league's coaches and media and was a member of the All-Big Ten Defensive Team. In addition, Destiny Pitts was named First Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches (second team by the media), and Taiye Bello was an All-Big Ten honorable mention honoree.

Whalen returned to the Gophers after destroying the program's record book in the early 2000s, finishing her career as Minnesota's all-time points leader, along with being second all-time in assists and third all-time in steals. A four-time all-state selection at Hutchinson High School, about an hour west of Minneapolis, Whalen went on to become the catalyst for the most successful seasons in the history of Gopher women's basketball.

She was the first three-time All-American in program history, a three-time All-Big Ten selection and a three-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree. After a Sweet Sixteen appearance her junior season (2002-03), Whalen led the Gophers to their only Final Four in program history in 2004. Her jersey, No. 13, hangs in the rafters of Williams Arena.

Whalen went on to collect numerous honors and championships in the WNBA and with the U.S. National team. After playing five seasons with the Connecticut Sun, Whalen returned to her home state with the Minnesota Lynx and won four WNBA championships (2011, 2013, 2015, 2017). Whalen was named All-WNBA five times and finished third in WNBA history in assists, to go along with being in the top-20 in career points and steals. In 2017, she became the winningest player in WNBA history, having been a part of more than 300 wins in the league. She also played professionally in Turkey, Russia and the Czech Republic.

In international competition, Whalen was a key piece to dominant performances by Team USA in world championship and Olympic competition. Whalen played for two gold medal teams at the World Championships (2010, 2014) and has also won two Olympic gold medals (2012, 2016).

As part of Whalen's agreement to become head coach, she continued to play for the Minnesota Lynx before retiring at the end of the 2018 season. Previously, Whalen announced in February of 2018 that she was retiring from international competition. She had played for the U.S. National team since 2002, joining Team USA following her sophomore season with the Gophers.
