### BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- In Saturday's lone Big Ten game, Iowa and Northwestern will be in the national television spotlight as they square off on BTN at 7 p.m. (ET) at Welsh-Ryan Arena in Evanston. Saturday's game is also available on the FOX Sports app.
- Michigan's Naz Hillmon piled up career highs of 35 points and 22 rebounds in the Wolverines' victory over Nebraska on Thursday. It was the first 30-point, 20-rebound game in NCAA Division I this season and the first by a Big Ten player since Jan. 24, 2016, when Nebraska's Jessica Shepard had 35 points and 20 rebounds at Michigan. It also was the second 30/20 game in Michigan program history and first since Jan. 20, 1979, when Abby Currier (33 points, 20 rebounds) did so against Notre Dame.
- Indiana's Grace Berger became the first NCAA Division I player this season with two triple-doubles, recording 15 points, 12 assists and 10 rebounds in the Hoosiers' win at Penn State on Thursday. Berger is the first Big Ten player with two triple-doubles in a season since 2014-15, when Iowa's Samantha Logic and Minnesota's Amanda Zahui B. both had a pair. Iowa's Caitlin Clark and Rutgers' Arella Guirantes also have triple-doubles this season, giving the Big Ten four of the seven triple-doubles registered by NCAA Division I players in 2020-21 and tying the conference record for triple-doubles in one season (set in both 2013-14 and 2014-15).
- Indiana was charged with only two turnovers in Thursday's win at Penn State, tying a Big Ten record for the fewest turnovers in a conference game. That mark was originally set on Dec. 29, 1996, when Purdue had just two giveaways against Northwestern.
- Maryland converted 33-of-38 (.868) free throws in its win at Michigan State on Thursday. The 33 made free throws ties for the fifth-most ever in a Big Ten game and most since Jan. 18, 2004, when Purdue made 34 free throws against Minnesota.
- Michigan is off to the best start in program history (8-0) following Thursday's win over visiting Nebraska. The Wolverines previously began 7-0 in 1999-2000, 2011-12 and 2015-16. In addition, when combined with the Wolverine men opening their season 10-0, Michigan is the only school in the country with both basketball teams currently undefeated.
- Ohio State improved to 6-0 with its victory at Illinois on Thursday night. It's the Buckeyes' best start since 2011-12, when they opened 15-0.
- The Big Ten has five schools appearing in the top 20 and eight in the top 35 of the latest NCAA NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool) rankings released Saturday. Both the Big Ten's five top-20 schools and eight top-35 programs are tied for the most of any conference in the country. The full NET rankings can be found on page 3 of this release.
- For the third week in a row, the Big Ten has six Top 25 teams in the Associated Press poll, while also now having six schools in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today Top 25 poll, with both being the most ranked teams among all conferences. This is the first time in Big Ten women's basketball history the conference has had six AP Top 25 teams for multiple weeks in the same season, let alone consecutive weeks (the Big Ten had six in the AP Top 25 for single weeks on Nov. 17, 2014 and Jan. 14, 2019).
- According to Saturday's NCAA statistics report, the Big Ten leads all Division I conferences in scoring (78.0 ppg.), field-goal percentage (.453) and assists (16.4 apg.), while ranking second in three-point percentage (.335) and fourth (tops among A5 conferences) in free-throw percentage (.724).
- Four Big Ten teams rank among the top 15 in the country (and three in the top five) in scoring offense.

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

## BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

Maryland is No. 2 in the nation at 95.3 points per game, followed by Iowa (3rd - 92.1), Ohio State (5th - 90.8) and Michigan (14th - 84.9). No other conference has more than two teams among the top 15 in the nation (and one in the top five) in scoring offense, as of Saturday.

- The Big Ten has six programs among the nation's top 25 (including four in the top 10) in field-goal percentage. Ohio State is No. 2 in the nation (.519), followed by Iowa (4th - .514), Michigan (6th - .507), Maryland (10th - .494) and Rutgers (22nd - .473). No other conference currently has more than three schools in the top 25 nationally (or two in the top 10) in field-goal percentage.
- Iowa's Caitlin Clark scored a career-high 37 points, the most by a Big Ten player this season, in the Hawkeyes' 92-79 win over Minnesota on Wednesday. Clark has four of the 10 30-point games (and three of seven 34-point games) by a Big Ten player this year, with two for Michigan's Naz Hillmon and Rutgers' Arella Guirantes and one each for Maryland's Ashley Owusu and Nebraska's Sam Haiby. By comparison, no other conference in the country has featured more than four 34-point games this year (the NCAA statistics report only lists scoring performances of 34 points or greater this season).
- Michigan junior guard Leigha Brown was named the Big Ten Player of the Week on Monday, while Iowa guard Caitlin Clark earned her fifth Big Ten Freshman of the Week award. On Tuesday, Clark was also chosen as the United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) National Freshman of the Week, the second national honor she has received this year (she was the espnW National Player of the Week on Dec. 14).
- With Wednesday's victory over Minnesota, Iowa extended its home winning streak to 42 games, the second-longest active string in the nation behind Baylor (61). The Hawkeyes' run began on Feb. 4, 2018, with a 92-84 win over Minnesota. Of note, the Big Ten record for consecutive home wins is 46, set by Iowa from Jan. 3, 1986 to Jan. 12, 1990.
- The Big Ten women's basketball television schedule has been updated

through Jan. 25 and now includes 18 games on linear television (16-BTN/FOX Sports app, 2-ESPN2/ESPN app) during the next 15 days, including nine days with at least one Big Ten women's basketball on linear television. Featured in this update are a trio of tripleheaders on BTN (Jan. 14, 18 and 21), as well as a Jan. 25 doubleheader. All conference games not airing on BTN or the ESPN family of networks through Jan. 25 will be streamed live on Big Ten Network+. - The Big Ten is in position to set a new conference record for the best non-conference winning percentage in regular-season games in a single campaign, currently posting an .846 (44-8) mark to date — the previous record was set last year when conference teams went .788 (123-33) in non-conference play. This year's record includes three non-conference wins over Top 25 teams — Maryland 115-96 over No. 14 Arkansas on Nov. 29 (a Big Ten record for points against a ranked team); Michigan 76-66 at No. RV/23 Notre Dame on Dec. 3; Iowa 82-80 over No. RV/24 Iowa State on Dec. 9.
- On Nov. 23, the Big Ten released its 2020-21 conference schedule, which will see schools play 20 Big Ten games, up two from the previous two seasons. Schools will play seven opponents twice (home and away) and the other six once (three at home and three on the road). To account for the additional games and preserve flexibility in the schedule, the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament has been moved to March 9-13 and will continue to be played at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis.
- On Oct. 23, the Big Ten Conference announced the launch of the 'United As One' social justice campaign. 'United As One' is among several conference-wide Equality Coalition initiatives dedicated to constructively and collectively recognizing and eliminating racism and hate in our society by creating resources for inclusion, empowerment and accountability.
- The Big Ten Conference established the Equality Coalition in 2020 with 227 members including presidents and chancellors, directors of athletics, coaches, student-athletes, conference and school administrators, alumni, families and friends representing all 14 institutions.



### **PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS**

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2019 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including 27 honorees during the 2019-20 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

### **A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS**

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 26 years, averaging nearly seven per year over that span.

Since the 2008-09 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 76 team national championships in 21 different sports.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available internationally via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. BTN Plus streams hundreds of additional events each season.
