KICKIN' IT

Izzy Nino (31)

- Michigan State women's soccer returns home on Sunday, Oct. 9, as the Spartans play host to the Michigan Wolverines in a nationally televised contest on Big Ten Network.
- The Spartans continue the 2022 season following its most consequential road trip of the year, as MSU downed then-No. 6 Penn State by a 2-1 score on Sept. 29, before dominating Maryland, 4-0, on Oct. 2, winning road contests against both opponents for the first time.
- MSU is off to its best start to Big Ten play in program history, boasting a 4-0-1 league record in addition to the team's 9-1-3 overall ledger through this point in the year.
- The Green & White are receiving votes in the most recent United Soccer Coaches poll, released on Oct. 4. MSU received the most votes out of all teams outside the top 25.
- Michigan State has seen a quintet of players land a total of seven Big Ten women's soccer weekly honors, an MSU program record for a single season. Jordyn Wickes and Lauren Kozal won Offensive Player and Goalkeeper of the Week, respectively, on Oct. 4.

WATCHING THE WOLVERINES

- Fifth-year head coach Jennifer Klein leads Michigan into Sunday afternoon's contest boasting a 6-4-3 overall record coupled with a 1-2-2 mark in Big Ten Conference play. The team is coming off an undefeated weekend last week after dispatching Minnesota, 1-0, and tying lowa 1-1.
- The Wolverines return to action following a historic 2021 campaign that featured a Big Ten Tournament Championship in addition to an NCAA Tournament Elite Eight bid. Michigan was predicted to finish third in the conference in the Big Ten preseason coaches poll.
- Scoring leaders in graduate midfielder Meredith Haakenson and junior forward Sammi Woods are tied atop the team leaderboard with 15 points this year.
- Tending goal, graduate keeper Izzy Nino has racked up 31 saves so far in 2022 and leads the team in shutouts with three. Nino has started all but two games for UM.

STORY OF THE SERIES

- A part of one of the most contentious rivalries in college athletics, Michigan and Michigan State prepare for the 37th meeting of the all-time series on Sunday. UM holds a narrow 16-13-7 edge overall and has won each of the last four contests.
- Home field has played a significant role in the outcome of each game, with both programs dominating at their respective facilities. The Spartans are 9-4-4 in games played at DeMartin Stadium on Old College Field.
- MSU's most recent win was a 2-1 victory at home over the Wolverines on Oct. 15, 2017. Last season's game in Ann Arbor finished in 1-0 fashion in favor of Michigan.

UP NEXT

 Michigan State women's soccer remains in East Lansing for its final night game under the lights at DeMartin Stadium in 2022, as the Green & White welcome the Indiana Hoosiers to Old College Field on Thursday, Oct. 13, for a 7 p.m. start.

MSU Opponents are BOLDED

- In the most recent United Soccer Coaches NCAA DI Women Rankings, Michigan State fell two votes shy of cracking the top 25. MSU's 18 votes came second to 25th-ranked Harvard.
- The Green & White were one of six teams in the Big Ten that were either ranked or receiving votes in the poll released on Oct. 4, joining Northwestern (#6), Rutgers (#10), Ohio State (#16), Wisconsin (RV) and Penn State (RV). Michigan State's non-conference opponent Arkansas also appeared at No. 9.
- In the TopDrawerSoccer.com College Soccer National Rankings, five Spartan opponents cracked the top 25, including Rutgers (#7), Northwestern (#8), Arkansas (#13), Ohio State (#17) and Penn State (#18).

LION TAMERS

- Michigan State women's soccer recorded its highest-ranked win in at least a decade on Thursday, Sept. 29, as the Spartans stunned the hometown fans in a 2-1 road win over sixth-ranked Penn State.
- In the 30th all-time meeting between the two schools, MSU registered its first-ever win over the Nittany Lions on the road. The Green & White had previously been 0-11 in games played on Jeffrey Field.
- The Spartans improved to 2-1 against opponents ranked in the top-25, and have won each of their last two ranked matchups dating back to a 4-2 win over then-No. 19 Colorado in East Lansing.
- Sophomore forward Jordyn Wickes logged her fourth goal of the season and published what proved to be the game-winner in the 70th minute of action.

HATS OFF

- For the first time in program history, two different players for MSU recorded hat tricks in back-to-back contests. Graduate forward Camryn Evans scored three in the win over Colorado, while senior forward Lauren DeBeau notched a trio of scores in the Spartan win over Illinois.
- In the upset of Colorado, Evans led the way with her first career hat trick, publishing two in the run of play, including the game-winner, and one more on a second-half penalty kick.
- Evans' three-goal outburst was the first hat trick by a Michigan State player since Gia Wahlberg poured in four scores in a 5-1 demolition of the Marshall Thundering Herd on Aug. 25, 2019.
- DeBeau poured in her first career hat trick with three scores in the run of play in 11 minutes and two seconds. Her hat trick goes down in the Spartan record book as the fastest in program history in terms of time elapsed between the first and third scores.

THE SPARTAN DIFFERENCE

- Through the first 13 contests on the schedule, Michigan State stands in second place in the Big Ten Conference for average scoring margin, publishing a goal differential of 1.93 goals per game. MSU boasts the best scoring defense in the Big Ten Conference, allowing only 0.46 goals per
- game, clearing the next-best defensive side in Northwestern by 0.08 points.
- The Spartans also boast one of the most prolific offenses in the nation's premier soccer conference, amassing 2.39 goals per game. MSU stands in second place in the B1G behind a Rutgers offensive attack that averages 2.62 scores per contest.
- Additionally, Michigan State leads the Big Ten in total shot attempts with 229, and places second in corner kicks with 86 opportunities thus far in 2022, trailing Minnesota's 95.

#TITLEIX50

- Throughout the 2022-23 year, Michigan State Athletics will celebrate the 50th anniversary of Title IX. In recognition of the signing of Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 of the Civil Rights Act on June 23, 1972, Spartan Athletics will honor selected individual achievements as
- well as team milestones from the last half-century.
 Women's Soccer Head Coach Jeff Hosler said, "We are so grateful to all of those that have laid the foundation for equal opportunities throughout athletics and higher education. At the same time, we recognize that there is always work to be done to continue elevating our platform while moving forward collectively.'

#GOGREEN

BACK LINE? BRICK WALL.

- Through the first 13 games of the 2022 campaign, Michigan State has allowed six total scores from an opponent, putting up shutouts against eight challengers while allowing goals from Dartmouth, Arkansas, Colorado, Purdue and Penn State.
- MSU owns a whopping 229-107 differential in shots over its opponents and has only allowed 46 shots on target all season, resulting in 38 goalkeeper saves and two team saves.
- The Spartans rank 13th in the nation in terms of goals-against-average, notching a GAA of .462. MSU leads the Big Ten, with the next closest team, Northwestern, sitting at .538.

BIG TIME ATTACK

- The Green & White boast one of the most high-octane offenses in the Big Ten Conference, leading the league in shots (229) and shots on goal (105) while ranking second in multiple categories.
- MSU ranks second in goals scored with 31 through this point in the year, trailing only defending College Cup participant Rutgers, which has amassed 34 total scores in the 2022 campaign.
- The Spartans have tallied the second-most points in the league behind Rutgers. Michigan State
 has hauled in 91 total points split between their 31 goals and 29 assists. The Spartans average
 7.00 points per game, which is also the second-highest mark in the B1G.
- Michigan State is tied for the most goals and points in a single game this season among Big Ten teams, scoring seven goals over Central Michigan on Sept. 4, while hauling in 20 total points.

COLORADO ROCKIN'

- Michigan State published a significant program-building result on Sept. 11, as the Spartans stunned the 19th-ranked Colorado Buffaloes by a 4-2 margin on a rainy Old College Field.
- The Spartans concluded non-conference play by earning the first win over a ranked opponent in the Jeff Hosler era. MSU played three ranked opponents during Hosler's first season in 2021 and was within one score of all three challengers when time expired.
- MSU's victory was the first ranked win by any Spartan team since the Green & White defeated then-No. 16 Penn State on Oct. 22, 2016, in a Senior Day showdown at DeMartin Stadium.
- The Green & White's 4-2 victory featured a dominant shot margin of 25-10 in MSU's favor, while
 the Spartans nearly doubled the Buffaloes' total shots on goal, winning the battle 13-7.
- Michigan State edged its opponent in corners for the seventh time in 2022, compiling a 4-1 edge.

HOSLER'S HOUSE

- Among active NCAA Division I women's soccer coaches with 17-or-more years of head coaching
 experience, Jeff Hosler's winning percentage of 0.758 stands as the fourth-best mark in the nation. He trails North Carolina legend Anson Dorrance (.898), Stanford skipper Paul Ratcliffe (.779)
 and Iowa head coach Dave Dilanni (.757).
- In the first year of the Hosler era, Michigan State recorded the largest single-season increase in victories in program history with nine additional wins. MSU turned a one-win 2020-21 slate into 10 victories in the 2021 fall campaign.
- Despite being picked to finish 13th in the Big Ten in 2021, the Green & White finished in the top four
 of the league table for the first time since booking a 7-4-0 record with a third-place finish in 2011.

KEEPING KOZAL

- Senior goalkeeper Lauren Kozal continues the 2022 season as only the second United Soccer Coaches All-American in program history.
- Kozal earned preseason recognition as a MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List member, joining program legend Laura Heyboer as one of only two Spartans with that accolade.
- In the preseason, Kozal was one of 13 Division I goalkeepers named to the United Soccer Coaches Goalkeepers to Watch list, standing as the lone representative of the Big Ten Conference following her B1G Goalkeeper of the Year recognition last season.
- Kozal earned her third career Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Week award on Aug. 30, garnering weekly honors following a pair of shutouts against Central Michigan and Binghamton.
- Following winning decisions over No. 6 Penn State and Maryland, the senior garnered her second Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Week accolade of the year on Oct. 4.

DEBEAU, DA BEAST

- Senior forward Lauren DeBeau leads the Michigan State roster in goals scored (7), points (15), shot attempts (36) and shots on goal (21). Her 21 shots on goal lead the Big Ten.
- The Shelby Township, Michigan, native booked MSU's second consecutive hat trick in the 3-0 rout of Illinois to open Big Ten play. Her three scores came in a span of 11 minutes and two sec-
- onds, which stands as the fastest hat trick in Michigan State history.

 DeBeau owns the team lead in game-winning goals with three, booking the decisive score against Bowling Green on Aug. 18, Illinois on Sept. 18 and Maryland on Oct. 2.

 In the Big Ten weekly honors released on Sept. 20, DeBeau took home MSU's fifth accolade of
- the year and the first Offensive Player of the Week award of her collegiate career.

REVVIN' EVANS

- Graduate forward Camryn Evans stands in second on the team with 14 total points on the season split between six goals and two assists, including a dish on Justina Gaynor's goal against No. 6 Penn State.
- After notching her first career hat trick to pave the way for Michigan State's upset of then-No. 19 Colorado, Evans took home Big Ten Co-Offensive Player of the Week accolades on Sept. 13.
- Evans has put up 32 total shots through this point in the season and has built a reputation as one of the most accurate shooters on the roster. Her 18 shots on goal rank second on the Michigan State team and place her fifth in the Big Ten Conference in the category.
- The Fenton, Michigan, native averages 1.38 shots on goal per game, the second-highest mark at Michigan State behind Lauren DeBeau (1.75) and top-10 in the Big Ten Conference. Evans stands in a tie for 16th at MSU for career goals scored with 19 through five seasons.

KOHELER'S COURT

- Freshman midfielder Courtney Koehler has stood out as one of the brightest young pieces on the Michigan State roster, currently standing in sixth on the team with six points split between a pair of goals and two assists. Her goal and assist tallies lead all Spartan freshmen.
- Her collegiate debut performance against Central Michigan on Aug. 25 saw the first-year player notch a brace in the seven-goal MSU onslaught.
- In the upset of then-No. 19 Colorado on Sept. 11, Koehler put up a pair of assists on both of
- Camryn Evans' goals in the run of play, helping lead the Spartans to their eventual 4-2 win. Following each breakout performance, Koehler took home Big Ten Conference Freshman of the Week accolades according to the league office on Aug. 30, and Sept. 13, respectively.
- Koehler, a native of The Woodlands, Texas, became the first Spartan player in program history to win Big Ten Freshman of the Week on more than one occasion.

WINNING WITH WHITE

- Graduate defender Samantha White continues her fifth season at Michigan State and stands as
- one of three Spartans who took home All-Big Ten honors a year ago.

 White is Michigan State's all-time program leader in games started, notching 80 over her five years in East Lansing. She set the new program record in MSU's most recent game against Maryland.
- The McKees Rocks, Pennsylvania, native has anchored the Spartan back line through eight shutouts this year and logged an assist in MSU's rout of Central Michigan on Aug. 25
- In the preseason, White was named a Defender to Watch by the United Soccer Coaches, joining fellow defender Kelly Severini.

WHO'S NEW ON THE BANKS -

- The Green & White welcome 17 newcomers to the 2022 roster, split between seven transfers and 10 incoming freshmen.
- Transfers for the Spartans accumulated three All-Conference team selections in 2021, with Kelly Severini, Mia Hansen and Ruby Diodati earning those honors at their previous institutions.
- Severini was named a United Soccer Coaches Defender to Watch after leading the America East's premier defense in terms of goals against average (0.65) at Hartford.
- MSU signed a versatile recruiting class last November, composed of Isa Agrusso, Ella Alati, Maddie Brady, Morgan Gerak, Maggie Illig, Courtney Koehler, Allie Mairn, Ella Ösmussen, Emerson Sargeant and Maia Soulis.

HEAD COACH JEFF HOSLER 17th SEASON, 2ND WITH PROGRAM | ALMA COLLEGE '02

In his first season as head coach for the Green and White, Hosler guided the Spartans to a 10-4-3 record, finishing fourth in the Big Ten regular season with a 5-4-1 mark. The squad made their first Big Ten Tournament appearance since 2011 and were granted the opportunity to host their quarterfinal match, marking the first tournament game in East Lansing since 2002.

After being predicted to finish 13th in the league, the Spartans improved by leaps and bounds to finish within the top five. The Spartans boast the most decorated goalkeeper in the league in Lauren Kozal, and have had a dramatic offensive turnaround compared to last season's 1-10-1 showing. It was the first ten-win season for the team since 2011, the year of their last postseason appearance.

Michigan State received three All-Big Ten selections at the conclusion of the regular season, as Kozal was named to the First Team and Ava Cook and Samantha White garnered Second Team nods. Kozal was also selected as the Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Year, the first-ever Goalkeeper of the Year honor awarded to a member of the Spartans and the first position player of the year award for MSU since 2008.

With Hosler at the helm, Kozal and White also earned recognition on the United Soccer Coaches All-Region team, with Kozal going on to be named a United Soccer Coaches All-American. Kozal held the highest save percentage of any goalkeeper in the Big Ten (.862) during the season. She ranked second in the Big Ten with a goals against average of .0495, allowing just 13 goals to score over 18 games. She also had the second-most saves per game (4.5) and her seven regular-season shutouts were the third-most in the conference.

A total of 18 Spartans earned Academic All-Big Ten honors in Hosler's inaugural year.

Michigan State Vice President and Director of Athletics Bill Beekman announced the hiring of Jeff Hosler as the Spartans' next women's soccer head coach on June 14, 2021.

Hosler succeeds Tom Saxton, who was at the helm of the Spartans for 30 years.

Hosler, who concluded his seventh season as head coach of the Grand Valley State women's soccer team this spring, posted the highest winning percentage of any coach in Laker history, led GVSU to three NCAA Championships, five NCAA title game appearances and reached at least the Elite Eight in six seasons (there was no Division II NCAA Tournament in 2020-21 due to the COVID-19 pandemic). He leaves GVSU with an overall record of 144-12-6, the best winning percentage in all of NCAA Soccer during that span, and a 63-2-2 mark in GLIAC play.

"I'm pleased to welcome Jeff Hosler to the Spartan family as our new women's soccer coach," Beekman said. "He's experienced exceptional success at Grand Valley State, including three national championships, while his student-athletes have been recognized for their performance on the field and in the classroom. Michigan State has a great soccer tradition, and I'm excited to watch Coach Hosler put his own mark on the Spartan program."

"I am so honored and grateful to Athletic Director Bill Beekman, Deputy Athletic Director Jen Smith, head men's soccer coach Damon Rensing and the entire search committee for entrusting me with the opportunity to lead this program," Hosler said. "I also want to thank Tom Saxton, Tammy Farnum and Stacy DeLonge for their dedication, and the incredible example they demonstrated to so many generations of Spartans. The pursuit of excellence for women's soccer in all facets begins now, while competing at the highest level within the Big Ten on and off the field. MSU and this community is a special place with amazing people, and I couldn't be more excited to come home."

With Hosler at the helm, 32 Lakers captured All-America honors and 43 earned All-Region. Twelve different Lakers were honored as CoSIDA Academic All-Americans and 56 Lakers garnered All-GLIAC honors. He also coached three Lakers to National Player of the Year honors, while guiding Marti Corby to the U-23 US Women's National Team camp in 2016.

Under Hosler's leadership, the Lakers dominated GLIAC play, winning six conference regular-season titles and seven GLIAC Tournament championships. The Lakers have also claimed the Midwest Regional title in six seasons and have reached the NCAA Elite Eight in 11 straight seasons.

In 2019, GVSU captured the program's sixth national title, a Division II record. The Lakers went 25-1, matching the single-season wins record, and scored a program-record 117 goals while guiding the nation's top offense.

Prior to GVSU, Hosler spent eight seasons at his alma mater Alma College. During his time, the Scots earned a 91-55-12 overall record, winning their only Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association (MIAA) regular season title in 2010. Alma also claimed the 2011 MIAA Tournament title to make its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance.

As a two-sport student-athlete at Alma, he was a four-time All-MIAA honoree, earning All-Mideast Region and All-NCAA Tournament honors during the Scots' first trip to the Final Four in 1999. Hosler left Alma as the all-time leader in assists and ranked inside the top five in career points.

He also holds a United States Soccer Federation (USSF) National "B" License and USYSA National "Youth" License.

The East Lansing native earned a bachelor of arts in business from Alma College in 2002. He and his wife, Rochelle, are the parents of two daughters, Charlie and Kennedy, and a son, Steven.
