## KICKIN' IT

- Sixth-ranked and fourth-seeded Michigan State women's soccer prepares for its first NCAA Tournament contest since 2009, and the first NCAA Tournament game at home in program history, as the Spartans welcome the Milwaukee Panthers to DeMartin Stadium for a 6 p.m. kick.
- The Green & White are fresh off the deepest Big Ten Tournament run in school annals, reaching the tournament championship game and coming up just short in a 3-2 contest against nine-time tournament champion Penn State on Sunday, Nov. 6.
- MSU was selected as the No. 4 seed in the South Bend region, marking the first time in program history that the Spartans earned a national seed.
- Michigan State earned 11 Big Ten awards in the postseason, highlighted by Jeff Hosler (B1G Coach of the Year), Lauren DeBeau (B1G Forward of the Year), Ruby Diodati (B1G Defender of the Year) and Lauren Kozal (Unanimous B1G Goalkeeper of the Year).

## CHAMPIONSHIP CALIBER

- For the first time in program history, and in only the second season under head coach Jeff Hosler, Michigan State garnered its first outright regular season Big Ten title.
- The Spartans had previously finished atop the league table in 1994, but the regular season standings were used only for conference tournament seeding. The 1994 B1G Tournament winner, Wisconsin, is the only officially recognized champion from that season.
- Following the Spartans' win over then-No. 14 Rutgers at home in the regular season finale, MSU became only the ninth undefeated Big Ten Champion in league history.
- The women's soccer program took home the first outright Big Ten Championship for any Spartan Athletics program since women's golf earned the 2020-21 league title.
- In the B1G Tournament, the Green & White fell just short of booking the first double conference title in school history. MSU played for the B1G Tournament Title for the first time in 2022.

## PREPPING FOR THE PANTHERS

- One of the most tradition-rich programs in the history of the Horizon League, first-year head coach Kevin Boyd has led the Panthers to a 12-3-3 overall record, bolstered by a fourth-straight conference tournament title and NCAA Tournament appearance.
- Milwaukee reached the NCAA Tournament following wins over IUPUI and Youngstown State in the Horizon League Tournament, garnering the conference's automatic bid.
- Senior forward Haley Johnson and sophomore forward Kayla Rollins pace the team with eight goals apiece, while sophomore forward Lainey Higgins has published eight assists.
- Freshman goalkeeper Kendall Edwards took up the job halfway through the season and leads the Panthers with a .838 save percentage coupled with 31 saves.

## UP NEXT

- The winner of Friday's game between No. 6 Michigan State and Milwaukee will take on the winner of No. 17 TCU and UTSA, with date, time and game location to be determined.

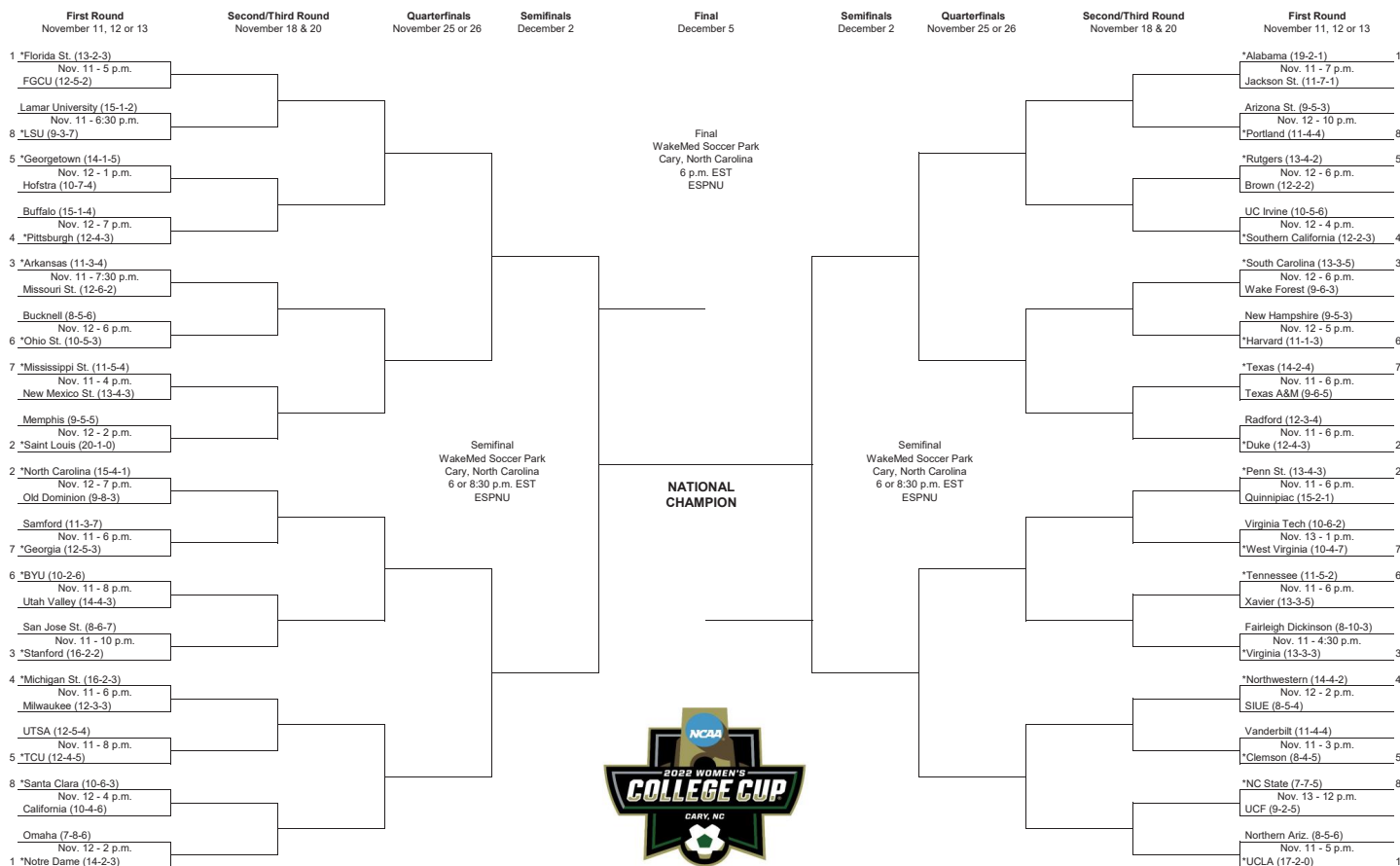

### KEEPING KOZAL

- Senior goalkeeper Lauren Kozal continues the 2022 season as only the second United Soccer Coaches All-American in program history.
- Kozal earned preseason recognition as a MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List member, joining program legend Laura (Heyboer) Heethuis as one of only two Spartans with that accolade.
- The Ada, Michigan, owns the single-season goalkeeper win record at MSU with 16 overall wins. Kozal surpassed the record of 14 set in 1986 by Renee Richert against Minnesota in the B1G Quarterfinals.
- Kozal earned Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Week accolades on Aug. 30, Oct. 4 and Oct. 25, earning winning decisions in all six eligible games as well as five shutouts split among those three weeks.
- One of the most dominant keepers in the history of the Big Ten, Kozal took home her second-straight B1G Goalkeeper of the Year award. She remains the only individual in MSU history to earn the award, and earned the league's highest honor between the posts by unanimous vote in 2022.

### DEBEAU, DA BEAST

- Senior forward Lauren DeBeau leads the Big Ten in game-winning goals (5), is second in the league in total goals (11) and places tied for second in the B1G in points (25).
- The Shelby Township, Michigan, native booked MSU's second consecutive hat trick in the 3-0 rout of Illinois to open Big Ten play. Her three scores came in a span of 11 minutes and two seconds, which stands as the fastest hat trick in Michigan State history.
- DeBeau brought in a pair of Big Ten Offensive Player of the Week Accolades in 2022, winning on Sept. 20 after downing Illinois, and again on Oct. 25 following a pair of goals against Ohio State and Rutgers.
- The veteran attacker became Michigan State's first Big Ten Forward of the Year in the conference's postseason honors, released on Thursday, Oct. 27.

### DEFENDING DIODATI

- Graduate defender Ruby Diodati has made a name for herself in the back line, as well as a featured player in Michigan State's set pieces during the 2022 campaign. She is tied for first in the Big Ten in assists and owns the best mark on the team with eight dishes this year.
- Part of the most dominant defense in the Big Ten Conference, Diodati has led MSU to 12 shutouts.
- After contributing an assist on Jordyn Wickes' game-winning goal against Michigan at home on Oct. 9, Diodati earned a place on the Oct. 10 edition of the College Soccer News National Team of the Week.
- A native of Mendon, Massachusetts, Diodati arrives at Michigan State following a four-year career at Colgate in which she earned All-Patriot League honors in three of her four seasons there.
- In the B1G postseason accolades, released on Oct. 27, Diodati became Michigan State's first Defender of the Year Award recipient.

## 2022 BIG YEARLY AWARD SPOTLIGHT

### COACH OF THE YEAR - JEFF HOSLER



- Hosler led MSU to its best regular-season finish in program history in 2022, booking a 14-1-3 overall record with an unblemished 9-0-1 mark in the Big Ten Conference. Hosler won the third Big Ten Coach of the Year award in program history and first since the 2000 campaign. Previous Spartan skipper Tom Saxton took home both of MSU's prior awards in 1994, the league's first women's soccer season, and 2000.
- "It's great to be recognized for the work that our staff has done," Hosler said. "I'm very, very blessed to have an incredible staff. They work incredibly hard, and they do a good job in all aspects of helping to build this program. They have developed incredibly special relationships with our players, and continue to build on those relationships. This award, to me, really signifies a great team season and the work that this group has put in. To see this award, it's really a reflection of what our players have accomplished this season."

### GOALKEEPER OF THE YEAR - LAUREN KOZAL



- Kozal booked her second-straight Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Year honor and became Michigan State's first unanimous selection for the award, earning a spot as an All-Big Ten First Team representative in the process. Kozal stood watch over the best defensive unit in NCAA Division I during the regular season, allowing a goals-against average of 0.41 while leading the Big Ten in shutouts (10), shutouts per game (0.56) and save percentage (0.877). She became the conference's third two-time recipient of the award, and just the second student-athlete to earn the accolade in consecutive seasons.
- "Obviously it's super exciting to receive this kind of recognition, not only for me, but for the team as well," Kozal said. "I owe it all to the back line, and to the whole team really. We just continue to give our best every single day, and giving our best is what leads to this kind of recognition. It's super exciting for all of our players, but mainly our team as a whole. We are blessed and excited to be having the success that we are this season. Hopefully, we can continue to get the results we work for every day."

### FORWARD OF THE YEAR - LAUREN DEBEAU



- DeBeau became Michigan State's first Forward of the Year since the award's inception in 2011. The only previous Spartan to earn the conference's former Offensive Player of the Year award was MSU Athletics Hall-of-Famer Laura (Heyboer) Heethuis, who earned the accolade by unanimous vote of the league's coaches in 2008. DeBeau finished the regular season tied atop the Big Ten leaderboard in goals scored with 10, ranking second in goals per game (0.59), points (23) and points per game (1.35).
- "This is definitely a confidence boost for me," DeBeau stated. "When I think about all of the situations my teammates have put me in to succeed, I'm extremely grateful to them. Without the success that our team has experienced this season, none of us would be in position to receive any awards or accolades. This 9-0-1 season in the Big Ten is the real reason why I've been given this opportunity. Without my teammates, I would never have been in position to be named Big Ten Forward of the Year, so I truly owe it all to them."

### DEFENDER OF THE YEAR - RUBY DIODATI



- Diodati stood out as one of the most impressive graduate transfers in program history during the 2022 season, becoming the first Spartan to chronicle the Big Ten's highest defensive honor. A four-year standout at Colgate and All-Patriot League player, Diodati helped anchor the best scoring defense in the nation. With Diodati in the back line, MSU allowed just seven goals in 18 regular season games, an average of less than 0.4 goals per game. Michigan State compiled a league-best 12 shutouts, including seven of the 10 B1G battles. Diodati ended regular season play tied for third in the Big Ten with seven assists, garnering an All-Big Ten First Team nod in the process.
- "I think that this is a testament to all of our players, and my teammates," Diodati said. "It's such an honor to be at a school like Michigan State and have an opportunity to play in the Big Ten. I'm so grateful for that opportunity, and the chance to play with such amazing people each and every day. I can't stress enough the fact that this award would not have been possible without the support of my teammates both here and at Colgate. I'm so grateful to this coaching staff. This is an accumulation of all the support I've received over the years."

## STORY OF THE SERIES: MILWAUKEE

- Michigan State and Milwaukee gear up for the 12th meeting in an all-time series that dates to the 1986 campaign, with the Spartans maintaining an 8-3 lead overall.
- In the friendly confines of DeMartin Stadium, Michigan State holds a strong 4-1 advantage over the Panthers. Milwaukee has historically played the Spartans well on their home field, booking a 2-3 mark at their facility.
- The Green & White have faced off against the Panthers in the NCAA Tournament on one prior occasion, as the Spartans defeated Milwaukee by a 2-1 margin in South Bend, Indiana during the 2008 tournament.
- In the most recent contest between the two teams, MSU published a dominant 5-2 victory over Milwaukee in East Lansing on Aug. 25, 2013. The Spartans scored five goals in nine on-target shots.

## MSU IN THE NCAA'S

- For the first time since the 2009 season, Michigan State was selected to take part in the NCAA Women's Soccer Championships. The Spartans will make their fifth all-time NCAA Tournament appearance and first in a span of 13 years.
- The Green & White own a 2-4 overall record in the Big Dance and have published program-best finishes in the second round during the 2005 and 2008 campaigns. MSU's other appearances came in 2002 and 2009.
- MSU will host an NCAA Tournament game for the first time in program history on Friday, having traveled to compete in each of its four prior appearances.
- The Spartans earned their first seeded selection in history, garnering the No. 4 bid in the South Bend region.

## DEMARTIN MAGIC

- In the 11 games Michigan State has played at DeMartin Stadium this year, the Green & White remain unbeaten with a 9-0-2 overall record, the best home mark in the Big Ten.
- Michigan State finished the regular season with the sixth-highest cumulative attendance in the nation and fifth-highest average attendance this season. The Spartans have seen 20,579 fans enter DeMartin Stadium in 2022 with approximately 1,871 fans in attendance each game.
- With Michigan State's 2-0 win over archrival Michigan on Oct. 9, the Spartans shattered the women's soccer program's single-game home attendance record with 3,022 MSU fans in attendance at DeMartin Stadium.
- The previous record of 2,247 was set on Oct. 1, 2017, as Michigan State challenged the Iowa Hawkeyes and published a crucial 3-2 win in the process.

## THE SPARTAN DIFFERENCE

- Through the first 21 contests on the schedule, Michigan State stands alone atop the Big Ten Conference for average scoring margin, publishing a goal differential of 1.53 goals per game.
- MSU boasts the best scoring defense in the Big Ten Conference and the 13th-best in NCAA Division I, allowing only 0.57 goals per game, clearing the next-best defensive B1G side in Northwestern by 0.18 points.
- The Spartans also boast one of the most prolific offenses in the nation's premier soccer conference, amassing 2.10 goals per game. MSU stands in second place in the B1G behind Rutgers, whose offensive attack scores an average of 2.21 goals per contest.
- Additionally, Michigan State leads the Big Ten in total shot attempts with 334, and places second in corner kicks with 121 opportunities thus far in 2022, trailing Minnesota's 137.

## #TITLEIX50

- Throughout the 2022-23 year, Michigan State Athletics will celebrate the 50th anniversary of Title IX. In recognition of the signing of Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 of the Civil Rights Act on June 23, 1972, Spartan Athletics will honor selected individual achievements as well as team milestones from the last half-century.
- Women's Soccer Head Coach Jeff Hosler said, "We are so grateful to all of those that have laid the foundation for equal opportunities throughout athletics and higher education. At the same time, we recognize that there is always work to be done to continue elevating our platform while moving forward collectively."

### BACK LINE? BRICK WALL.

- Michigan State owns the 13th-best scoring defense in NCAA Division I and the best total defense in the Big Ten Conference. MSU has allowed a striking goals-against average of 0.571 in 1890 total team minutes played across 21 games.
- Throughout the 2022 campaign, Michigan State has allowed 12 total scores from an opponent, putting up shutouts against a dozen challengers while allowing a single goal on seven occasions. The Spartans have allowed multiple goals in only two games: against Colorado (Sept. 11) and Penn State (Nov. 6).
- MSU has consistently out-shot its opponents, booking a 334-181 margin, and has only allowed 74 shots on target all season resulting in 60 goalkeeper saves and two team saves.

### BIG TIME ATTACK

- The Green & White boast one of the most high-octane offenses in the Big Ten Conference, leading the league in shots (334) and shots per game (15.90) and placing second in shots on goal (149).
- MSU stands alone atop the Big Ten in terms of goals scored with 44 through this point in the year, surpassing the defending 2021 College Cup participant Rutgers Scarlet Knights by two scores.
- The Spartans have tallied the most points in the league, also ahead of Rutgers. Michigan State has hauled in 128 total points split between its 44 goals and 40 assists. The Spartans average 6.10 points per game, which is the second-highest mark in the B1G behind the Scarlet Knights (6.58).
- Michigan State is tied for the most goals and points in a single game this season among Big Ten teams, scoring seven goals over Central Michigan on Aug. 25, while hauling in 20 total points.

### POSTSEASON PROWESS

- Michigan State completed its best run in the Big Ten Conference Tournament in program history last week, registering a pair of victories in the Quarterfinals and Semifinals before suffering a hard-fought 3-2 defeat at the hands of nine-time tournament champion Penn State.
- The Spartans opened postseason play against Minnesota, which opened the scoring in the fifth minute to take a 1-0 lead. A second-half brace from sophomore forward Jordyn Wickes ensured MSU's advancement to the Semifinals for only the fifth time in program history.
- In the Semifinals against Nebraska at Lower.com Field in Columbus, Ohio, the Spartans were deadlocked with the Cornhuskers 1-1 at the half but overcame their opponent with a second-half dagger from freshman midfielder Courtney Koehler.

### STUCK IN A RUT(GERS)

- Michigan State's historic 2022 regular season effort ended on a high note on Sunday, Oct. 23, as the sixth-ranked Spartans defeated No. 14 Rutgers for the first time in program history. MSU was 0-9 in the previous nine meetings despite falling by only one goal in seven of those games.
- The ranked victory marked MSU's fifth of the season and third consecutive ranked win in Big Ten play. The Spartans had previously beaten No. 5 Northwestern and No. 17 Ohio State to clinch the Big Ten Championship. MSU's win over Rutgers ensured the undefeated title at 9-0-1.
- Senior forward Lauren DeBeau netted one of the most impressive goals of her collegiate career to down the Scarlet Knights late in the second half. Sophomore forward Jordyn Wickes spun off a defender and generated enough space to get the ball to DeBeau, who put a 25-yarder top-shelf in the 86th.

### WINDY CITY WORK

- The Spartans continued their tear through Big Ten Conference play on Sunday, Oct. 16, as MSU recorded its highest ranked win in program history over the fifth-ranked Northwestern Wildcats on the road in Evanston at Lanny and Sharon Martin Stadium.
- MSU improved to 3-1 at the time against opponents nationally ranked in the top 25, the most ranked wins in a single season in program history.
- Michigan State took sole possession of the top spot in the Big Ten Conference standings, as Northwestern was tied with the Green & White for the league lead entering the contest with a 6-0-1 mark in the B1G and 19 points overall with three games left to play on the calendar.
- Graduate defender Samantha White booked the icebreaker in the 13th minute, while Celia Gaynor earned the game-winning goal in the 21st. MSU withstood Northwestern's second-half push and a PK goal to earn the win.

## LION TAMERS

- Michigan State women's soccer recorded its second-highest ranked win in program history on Thursday, Sept. 29, as the Spartans stunned the hometown fans in a 2-1 road win over sixth-ranked Penn State.
- In the 30th all-time meeting between the two schools, MSU registered its first-ever win over the Nittany Lions on the road. The Green & White had previously been 0-11 in games played on the campus of Penn State University.
- The Spartans improved to 2-1 against opponents ranked in the top 25 at the time, and had won each of their last two ranked matchups dating back to a 4-2 win over then-No. 19 Colorado in East Lansing.
- Sophomore forward Jordyn Wickes logged her fourth goal of the season and published what proved to be the game-winner in the 70th minute of action.

## COLORADO ROCKIN'

- Michigan State published a significant program-building result on Sept. 11, as the Spartans stunned the 19th-ranked Colorado Buffaloes by a 4-2 margin on a rainy Old College Field.
- The Spartans concluded non-conference play by earning the first win over a ranked opponent in the Jeff Hosler era. MSU played three ranked opponents during Hosler's first season in 2021 and was within one score of all three challengers when time expired.
- MSU's victory was the first ranked win by any Spartan team since the Green & White defeated then-No. 16 Penn State on Oct. 22, 2016, in a Senior Day showdown at DeMartin Stadium.
- The Green & White's 4-2 victory featured a dominant shot margin of 25-10 in MSU's favor, while the Spartans nearly doubled the Buffaloes' total shots on goal, winning the battle 13-7.

## YOU RANKED?

- Following its most dominant regular season in program history, Michigan State set a new program record with five victories in ranked matchups during the 2022 campaign.
- The Spartans maintain an impressive 5-2 overall record in nationally ranked contests, with the team's only losses coming against No. 11 Arkansas on the road in Fayetteville, and the 2022 Big Ten Women's Soccer Tournament Championship against No. 21 Penn State.
- The Green & White rattled off a quintet of victories against nationally ranked teams between Sept. 11 and Oct. 23. MSU boasts a 3-1 overall record in games when both opponents were ranked.
- Michigan State's five consecutive ranked wins was the best mark in the Big Ten Conference this season, with the Spartans defeating four nationally ranked B1G challengers in that span.

## HOSLER'S HOUSE

- Among active NCAA Division I women's soccer coaches with 17-or-more years of head coaching experience, Jeff Hosler's winning percentage of 0.760 stands as the third-best mark in the nation. He trails North Carolina legend Anson Dorrance (.898), and Stanford skipper Paul Ratcliffe (.781). Hosler is a combined 261-74-24 with stops at Alma, Grand Valley State, and Michigan State.
- In the first year of the Hosler era, Michigan State recorded the largest single-season increase in victories in program history with nine additional wins. MSU turned a one-win 2020-21 slate into 10 victories in the 2021 fall campaign. The Spartans were tabbed to finish 13th in the league in Hosler's first year.
- Despite being picked to finish sixth in the Big Ten in 2022, the Green & White published an unblemished 9-0-1 record in the league and secured the first official Big Ten title in school history.

## REVVIN' EVANS

- Graduate forward Camryn Evans stands tied for second on the team with 16 total points on the season split between seven goals and two assists, including the opening score in MSU's B1G semifinal win over Nebraska.
- After notching her first career hat trick to pave the way for Michigan State's upset of then-No. 19 Colorado, Evans took home Big Ten Co-Offensive Player of the Week accolades on Sept. 13.
- Evans has put up 48 total shots through this point in the season and has built a reputation as one of the most accurate shooters on the roster. Her 27 shots on goal rank second on the Michigan State team and place her seventh in the Big Ten Conference in the category.
- The Fenton, Michigan, native averages 1.29 shots on goal per game, the second-highest mark at Michigan State behind Lauren DeBeau (1.55) and eighth in the Big Ten Conference.
- Evans stands alone in 16th at MSU for career goals scored with 20 through five seasons.

## **WATCHING WICKES**

- In her second season in the Green & White, sophomore forward Jordyn Wickes has more than doubled her scoring output from a season ago.
- Wickes maintained a four-game streak with at least one point per contest from Sept. 25 to Oct. 9. Wickes notched a goal against Purdue before rattling off a goal and assist in MSU's historic win over then-No. 6 Penn State on the road. Against Maryland the following game, she tallied yet another assist before scoring the game-winning goal in the 40th minute against Michigan on Oct. 9.
- In Michigan State's Big Ten Tournament-opening win over the Minnesota Golden Gophers on Oct. 30, Wickes helped guide MSU to just its fifth semifinal appearance in program history. Despite trailing 1-0 at the half, Wickes registered a pair of scores to lead MSU to victory in the second.

## **RAEGAN'S ISLAND**

- One of the most dominant individual defenders in the nation and a crucial piece in the Spartan back line, senior defender Raegan Cox has helped guide the Green & White to the top-15 of the national rankings in scoring defense.
- Tasked with defending the opposing team's best scorer, Cox has held a number of offensive standout players without points. Anna Podojil of Arkansas, Cox's former teammate, was held without a shot in 73 minutes. Kayla Fischer of Ohio State, as well as Riley Tiernan of Rutgers were each held without points with Cox as their primary defender.
- Following her slew of shutdown performances in the 2022 campaign, Cox was honored as a member of the All-Big Ten Second Team, the first All-Big Ten recognition of her career.

## **KOEHLER'S COURT**

- Freshman midfielder Courtney Koehler has stood out as a burgeoning young piece on MSU's roster, highlighted by a brace against Central Michigan on Aug. 25, and a two-assist game against then-No. 19 Colorado on Sept. 11, passing to Camryn Evans for two of her three goals.
- Following each breakout performance, Koehler took home Big Ten Conference Freshman of the Week accolades according to the league office on Aug. 30, and Sept. 13, respectively.
- Koehler, a native of The Woodlands, Texas, became the first Spartan player in program history to win Big Ten Freshman of the Week on more than one occasion.
- In the Big Ten Tournament semifinal win over Nebraska, Koehler assisted Evans yet again for MSU's opening score in the first half, and notched the game-winner herself later in the second.

## **WINNING WITH WHITE**

- Graduate defender Samantha White continues her fifth season at Michigan State and stands as one of three Spartans who took home All-Big Ten honors a year ago.
- White is Michigan State's all-time program leader in games started, notching 88 over her five years in East Lansing. She set the new program record in MSU's game against Maryland on Oct. 2.
- The McKees Rocks, Pennsylvania, native has anchored the Spartan back line through 12 shut-outs this year and has led MSU to the top of the Big Ten in scoring defense.
- In the preseason, White was named a Defender to Watch by the United Soccer Coaches, joining fellow defender Kelly Severini.
- Offensively, White notched an assist against Central Michigan on Aug. 25, and scored her second career goal against No. 5 Northwestern on Oct. 16, warranting B1G Defensive Player of the Week honors.

## **WHO'S NEW ON THE BANKS**

- The Green & White welcomed 17 newcomers to the 2022 roster, split between seven transfers and 10 incoming freshmen.
- Transfers for the Spartans accumulated three All-Conference team selections in 2021, with Kelly Severini, Mia Hansen and Ruby Diodati earning those honors at their previous institutions.
- Severini was named a United Soccer Coaches Defender to Watch after leading the America East's premier defense in terms of goals against average (0.65) at Hartford.
- MSU signed a versatile recruiting class last November, composed of Isa Agrusso, Ella Alati, Madie Brady, Morgan Gerak, Maggie Illig, Courtney Koehler, Allie Mairn, Ella Osmussen, Emerson Sargeant and Maia Soulis.

## HEAD COACH JEFF HOSLER

### 17TH SEASON, 2ND WITH PROGRAM | ALMA COLLEGE '02

In his first season as head coach for the Green and White, Hosler guided the Spartans to a 10-4-3 record, finishing fourth in the Big Ten regular season with a 5-4-1 mark. The squad made their first Big Ten Tournament appearance since 2011 and were granted the opportunity to host their quarterfinal match, marking the first tournament game in East Lansing since 2002.

After being predicted to finish 13th in the league, the Spartans improved by leaps and bounds to finish within the top five. The Spartans boast the most decorated goalkeeper in the league in Lauren Kozal, and have had a dramatic offensive turnaround compared to last season's 1-10-1 showing. It was the first ten-win season for the team since 2011, the year of their last postseason appearance.

Michigan State received three All-Big Ten selections at the conclusion of the regular season, as Kozal was named to the First Team and Ava Cook and Samantha White garnered Second Team nods. Kozal was also selected as the Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Year, the first-ever Goalkeeper of the Year honor awarded to a member of the Spartans and the first position player of the year award for MSU since 2008.

With Hosler at the helm, Kozal and White also earned recognition on the United Soccer Coaches All-Region team, with Kozal going on to be named a United Soccer Coaches All-American. Kozal held the highest save percentage of any goalkeeper in the Big Ten (.862) during the season. She ranked second in the Big Ten with a goals against average of .0495, allowing just 13 goals to score over 18 games. She also had the second-most saves per game (4.5) and her seven regular-season shutouts were the third-most in the conference.

A total of 18 Spartans earned Academic All-Big Ten honors in Hosler's inaugural year.

Michigan State Vice President and Director of Athletics Bill Beekman announced the hiring of Jeff Hosler as the Spartans' next women's soccer head coach on June 14, 2021.

Hosler succeeds Tom Saxton, who was at the helm of the Spartans for 30 years.

Hosler, who concluded his seventh season as head coach of the Grand Valley State women's soccer team this spring, posted the highest winning percentage of any coach in Laker history, led GVSU to three NCAA Championships, five NCAA title game appearances and reached at least the Elite Eight in six seasons (there was no Division II NCAA Tournament in 2020-21 due to the COVID-19 pandemic). He leaves GVSU with an overall record of 144-12-6, the best winning percentage in all of NCAA Soccer during that span, and a 63-2-2 mark in GLIAC play.

"I'm pleased to welcome Jeff Hosler to the Spartan family as our new women's soccer coach," Beekman said. "He's experienced exceptional success at Grand Valley State, including three national championships, while his student-athletes have been recognized for their performance on the field and in the classroom. Michigan State has a great soccer tradition, and I'm excited to watch Coach Hosler put his own mark on the Spartan program."

"I am so honored and grateful to Athletic Director Bill Beekman, Deputy Athletic Director Jen Smith, head men's soccer coach Damon Rensing and the entire search committee for entrusting me with the opportunity to lead this program," Hosler said. "I also want to thank Tom Saxton, Tammy Farnum and Stacy DeLonge for their dedication, and the incredible example they demonstrated to so many generations of Spartans. The pursuit of excellence for women's soccer in all facets begins now, while competing at the highest level within the Big Ten on and off the field. MSU and this community is a special place with amazing people, and I couldn't be more excited to come home."

With Hosler at the helm, 32 Lakers captured All-America honors and 43 earned All-Region. Twelve different Lakers were honored as CoSIDA Academic All-Americans and 56 Lakers garnered All-GLIAC honors. He also coached three Lakers to National Player of the Year honors, while guiding Marti Corby to the U-23 US Women's National Team camp in 2016.

Under Hosler's leadership, the Lakers dominated GLIAC play, winning six conference regular-season titles and seven GLIAC Tournament championships. The Lakers have also claimed the Midwest Regional title in six seasons and have reached the NCAA Elite Eight in 11 straight seasons.

In 2019, GVSU captured the program's sixth national title, a Division II record. The Lakers went 25-1, matching the single-season wins record, and scored a program-record 117 goals while guiding the nation's top offense.

Prior to GVSU, Hosler spent eight seasons at his alma mater Alma College. During his time, the Scots earned a 91-55-12 overall record, winning their only Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association (MIAA) regular season title in 2010. Alma also claimed the 2011 MIAA Tournament title to make its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance.

As a two-sport student-athlete at Alma, he was a four-time All-MIAA honoree, earning All-Mideast Region and All-NCAA Tournament honors during the Scots' first trip to the Final Four in 1999. Hosler left Alma as the all-time leader in assists and ranked inside the top five in career points.

He also holds a United States Soccer Federation (USSF) National "B" License and USYSA National "Youth" License.

The East Lansing native earned a bachelor of arts in business from Alma College in 2002. He and his wife, Rochelle, are the parents of two daughters, Charlie and Kennedy, and a son, Steven.
