BLUE RAIDER BREAKDOWN »

- Middle Tennessee and Ole Miss are meeting for the 11th time, with the Blue Raiders winning both matchups in the current four-game series and six of the last seven overall
- Senior forward Karl Gamble became a steady presence off the bench for the Blue Raiders to earn a starting role the last three games, grabbing five or more rebounds in 10 of 11 games and scoring at least eight points in seven of 11 games this season, and ranks 68th nationally and third in C-USA in offensive rebounds per game (2.91)
- Junior guard Antonio Green and senior forward James Hawthorne rank third and fourth in C-USA in free throw percentage - 90.3 and 88.0 percent, respectively - while the latter is also sixth in C-USA in blocks
- Green, whose 90.3 percent conversion rate from the charity stripe also ranks 25th nationally, joined the 1,000-point club (823 points at UTRGV) Dec. 8 against Murray State and ranks third in C-USA in total points (185) and sixth in points per game (18.5) so far this season
- The Blue Raiders continue to face the toughest non-conference schedule of any team in Conference USA, ranking sixth toughest nationally in the most recent NET ratings with eight contests in quadrants 1 & 2
- Middle Tennessee entered the 2018-19 season in the bottom 10 nationally in returning minutes played, returning starts and returning points (see pg. 4)



Steals 26 201 12.9% • Entering the 2018-19 season, Middle Tennessee returns only 15.2% of their minutes played from a season ago, the fifth least in the nation behind only Mount St. Mary's (7.0%), UNC Asheville (7.9%), Idaho (10.6%) and Wichita State (11.2%)

- The Blue Raiders also ranke seventh nationally in least returning starts (13), percent of starts returning (7.9%) and least returning points (252) and sixth in percent of points returning (10.2%)
- The 329 career points by Middle Tennessee players in a Blue Raider uniform is tied with Idaho for the fith least nationally behind Mount St. Mary's (103), UT Arlington (130), UNC Asheville (141) and Chattanooga (241)

PUT ME IN, COACH »

- With just three scholarship players returning to Middle Tennessee in 2018-19 season in seniors Karl Gamble and James Hawthorne and sophomore Donovan Sims, the trio were forced to pick up much larger roles
- After combining for just 7.8 points and 5.6 rebounds in 31.8 minutes per game last season, the returners have seen major upticks in production in their increased roles

- After spending the last 21 college basketball seasons with his hometown UNC Asheville Bulldogs, the first four of which came as a player while the last five were as head coach, Nick McDevitt begins a new journey as he takes over the Middle Tennessee men's basketball program in 2018-19
- McDevitt helped the Bulldogs to a 40-26 record during his two seasons as an associate head coach in Asheville, helping cement him as the successor to former head coach Eddie Biedenbach
- After being named head coach in 2013, McDevitt led the Bulldogs to a 98-66 record over five seasons, including three consecutive 20-win seasons and postseason appearances to close out his time in Asheville

Toledo Shoots Past Blue Raiders »

- Middle Tennessee's offense saw solid improvement at Toledo from it's last time out, upping its assists by 10 and logging a season low in turnovers, but fell to a sweet-shooting, 10-1 Toledo squad in Ohio
- While the Raiders' 42.6 percent shooting performance was a step in the right direction, the Rockets' 45.9 percent clip from the field and 42.3 percent showing from beyond the arc was too much for MT to overcome

RAIDERS DROP SIXTH STRAIGHT »

- In the midst of the fourth-toughest non-conference strength of schedule in the nation, Middle Tennessee fell to 3-7 on the season against long-time rival Murray State on Dec. 8
- Murray State moved into a tie with Tennessee Tech as Middle Tennessee's most frequently faced opponent in program history in the contest when the teams met for the 141st time
- Junior guard Antonio Green hit a major milestone in the loss, collecting his 1,000th career point on a free throw in the first half and finished the night at 1,008, 823 of which came at UTRGV

MT SUFFERS LOSS AT SEC FOE VANDY >

- Middle Tennessee fell by a wide margin to a talented Vanderbilt squad in Memorial Gymnasium on Dec. 5, snapping a three-game winning streak for the Blue Raiders in the series with their nearby SEC foe
- Junior Reggie Scurry was the top producer in the first half with 11 of his 14 points coming before halftime and finished the game with seven boards while junior Antonio Green notched 16 of his 18 points after the break in an attempt to spark MT and run his career scoring tally to 997 points

IMPROVING RAIDERS FALL TO LIPSCOMB »

- For the first time in 57 years the Blue Raiders fell to local foe Lipscomb, as a talented and veteran Bisons squad escaped Murphy Center with an 84-74 win
- Junior Antonio Green poured in a career-high 30 points on 10 field goals and connected on 7 of 13 3-pointers while freshman Jayce Johnson added a career-high 16 in the loss
- While showing improvement, the Blue Raiders continue to battle offensive inneficiency particularly late in games due to a short bench netting just 8 assists to 17 turnovers on the evening

INEFFICIENCY DOOMS MT IN ATLANTIS »

- The Blue Raiders battled Stanford all night long in their Battle 4 Atlantis finale, but thanks only to a strong defensive effort as MT shot just 35.6 percent from the floor and was 0-for-7 from three while collecting just three assists on the night
- Middle Tennessee was able to collect six blocks and 10 steals on the defensive end and held the Cardinal to just 38.2 percent shooting from the floor
- Junior Antonio Green led the way offensively with 21 points despite not hitting a triple while senior James Hwthorne collected team highs in rebounds (8) and blocks (4) to go along with his eight points.
- Freshman Jayce Johnson logged a career-high 14 points on the evening, 11 of which came in the final 16 minutes of action, and added five rebounds, two blocks and two steals

BULLDOGS SHOOT PAST RAIDERS »

- Butler hit a tournament record 16 3-pointers led by Sean McDermott's seven, also a tournament record, and shot 52 percent from the field and 46 percent from beyond the arc to defeat the Blue Raiders
- Senior James Hawthorne pased MT with 11 points while Donovan Sims added nine points and Reggie Scurry pitched in seven points and seven rebounds
- Freshman Junior Farquhar tallied a career-high eight points to go along with four boards and three assists while classmate Jayce Johnson added six points and five boards

No. 4 Virginia Outlasts MT »

- Middle Tennessee battled throughout the evening in their Battle 4 Atlantis opener, staying in striking distance of the highly-ranked Cavaliers a majority of the contest before falling by a score of 74-52
- Antonio Green and Reggie Scurry led the way offensively with 11 and 10 points, respectively, while Karl Gamble pitched in with nine and Donovan Sims and Jayce Johnson added seven apiece
- Despite facing perhaps the best defense in college basketball, the Blue Raiders kept their composure throughout the night with a season low 15 turnovers against UVA

BLUE RAIDERS IN PARADISE »

- Middle Tennessee makes its first ever trip to the Battle 4 Atlantis during Thanksgiving week, but aren't far removed from their last trip to the Bahamas where the team spent its preseason tour prior to the 2015-16 season
- Middle Tennessee's football team recently spent time in the Bahamas as well, competing in the Bahamas Bowl in 2015 against Western Michigan
- The Blue Raiders will be facing opening round foe Virginia for just the second time in the history of the program and of their six other potential opponents have only previously faced Butler, Dayton and Florida

MT Fights Off Late CSU Charge »

- Middle Tennessee made it across the finish line just in time against Charleston Southern, watching a Buccaneer 3-pointer sail off the mark at the buzzer to preserve a 3-point win in Murphy Center
- The Blue Raiders led 45-25 at halftime and remained up by 20 nine minutes into the second half before the Buccaneers made their gradual climb back into the contest
 Junior Antonio Green led MT offensively and on the glass with a 22-point, 6-rebound outing, but the Raiders would struggle in the second half as Green scored just six of his 22 on 1-for-9 shooting after the break

RAIDERS COLLECT THREE NLIS »

- Head Coach Nick McDevitt announced the addition of three incoming Blue Raiders in the early signing period in forward Tyson Jackson and guards Eli Lawrence and Jo'Vontae Millner
- Jackson, a 6-foot-9 forward and native of Fairburn, Georgia, averaged just shy of 30 points and more than 13 rebounds per outing as a senior at Creekside High School to earn First Team All-State honors before moving on to Hargrave Military Academy for the 2018-19 season
- Lawrence, a 6-foot-5 guard and native of Atlanta, Georgia, boasted 21.3 points and 9.1 rebounds as a senior at Tri-Cities High School to join his childhood friend Jackson as a First Team All-State honoree before moving on to Washington Academy for the 2018-19 season
- Jo'Vontae Millner, 6-foot-6 guard from Burlington, North Carolina, recently started his sophomore campaign at Cape Fear Community College after competing at Presbyterian as a freshman where he led the team in scoring (10.8) and rebounding (5.6) in his rookie campaign

RAIDERS SUFFER FIRST LOSS »

- Middle Tennessee opened with an impressive 54-point first half at in-state foe Belmont to take an 8-point lead into the half, but second half struggles saw the Bruins protect their homecourt with 92-73 win in Nashville
- Senior Karl Gamble had another career night with 20 points and eight rebounds while Antonio Green added 19 and Donovan Sims pitched in 13
- Belmont's always efficient offense shot 53.6 percent on the night with a lofty 56 points in the paint, much of which came as a result of 21 Blue Raider trunovers

MT, McDevitt Hit Century Mark »

- Head Coach Nick McDevitt ran his career win total to 100 in game two of his tenure at Middle Tennessee as the Blue Raiders hit the century mark themselves with a 102-70 win against Milligan
- Junior guard Antonio Green once again provided the spark offensively with his second consecutive 24-point outing
- Junior Reggie Scurry logged his second double-double in as many games with the Blue Raiders with 13 points and 12 boards while senior Karl Gamble's career highs in points (16) and rebounds (12) gave him his first career double-double

McDevitt Era Opens with Win »

- Head Coach Nick McDevitt started things off on the right foot with a win against Division II Lees-McRae in his Murphy Center debut on Nov. 6, 2018
- Junior guard Antonio Green led the way offensively with 24 points on 8-of-14 shooting while adding seven rebounds
- MT's starting post duo of Reggie Scurry and James Hawthorne showed out as well, each collecting 19 points while Scurry's 11 rebounds gave him a debut double-double
- Sophomore Murfreesboro native Donovan Sims also poured in a career-high 16 points for the Blue Raiders in the season-opening win

HIT THE RECRUITING ROAD RUNNING *

- Head Coach Nick McDevitt and his new staff faced a tough task already knowing that they had to replace 2018 graduates Nick King, Giddy Potts, Ed Simpson and Brandon Walters, but five more departures in the offseason left the roster short and the list of needs long to force them onto the recruiting trail early and often in their first summer in Murfreesboro
- It didn't take long for the first piece to fall into place for McDevitt and his staff as they landed high level Missouri State transfer Reggie Scurry on April 23, 2018 in hopes of appealing for immediate eligibility for the Georgia native after suffering a season-ending foot injury during a cryotherapy treatment while with the Bears
- The Blue Raiders soon added fellow Division I transfers C.J. Jones (Arkansas) and DeAndre Dishman (Eastern Kentucky), both of whom must sit out the 2018-19 season, and junior college transfer Darnell Butler (Seminole State College)
- McDevitt's first recruiting class was rounded out with a trio of freshman in Michigan prep standout Anthony Crump, Canadian point guard Junior Farquhar and Buffalo, N.Y., native and former Wagner football signee Jayce Johnson


MEET THE STAFF »




