### QUICK HITTERS

► Dating back to last year, MT has outscored its last two opponents at home by a combined score of 71-13.

► MT has been bowl eligible nine times in the last 12 years and has reached a bowl game a school-record three straight years.

► The 2018 season will be the **104th** for Blue Raider football and the **20th** at the FBS level.

► **WR Ty Lee** has hauled in at least one reception in **27** straight games which ranks as the 7th longest streak in MT history and is tied for the 8th longest current streak in the country.

► MT had 3 blocked kicks in 2017 to rank 3rd nationally

► In MT's last **20 wins**, it has averaged 539.2 yards of total offense and allowed 368.4.

► **QB Brent Stockstill** has thrown at least one TD pass in **24** straight games, which ranks as the second longest streak nationally behind Penn State's Trace McSorley (26).

► **LB Khalil Brooks** ranked 21st nationally last year in TFLs with 17.0 and has 1.0 so far this season.

► **WR Ty Lee** ranked 19th nationally last year in receptions per game with 6.1

► **Tavares Thomas** has rushed for 436 yards the last five games he has played combined and averaged 5.7 yards a touch (76).

► MT is 26-14 all-time in C-USA play and is averaging 202.5 yards rushing per game.

► Middle Tennessee is 24-7 in its last 31 home games.

► In their last 48 conference games, the Blue Raiders have a mark of 32-16.

► Over the last 70 games, the Blue Raiders have come up with 70 interceptions. The team had 15 picks in 2013 by eight different players, 13 in 2014, 17 in 2015, 11 in 2016 but just five in 2017.

► Consecutive Start Leaders: **Ty Lee** (17), **Carlos Johnson** (15), **Reed Blankenship** (13).

► Under **Rick Stockstill**, the Blue Raiders have been involved in 20 games that were decided in the final minute of regulation or overtime. The team is 12-9 in those games and have won eight of the last 11.

► **Rick Stockstill** is third on the school's all-time wins list with 79 victories.

### Press Conference

On Mondays at 10:30 AM, in the Kennon Sports Hall of Fame building, following players and Coach Stockstill meet with the media individually for a press conference. The weekly conferences will be held every Monday before a game. Media can park in the area located between the practice field and the weight room on campus. The Athletic Communications Office will transcribe quotes that will be put on GoBlueRaiders.com and also emailed to the Blue Raiders' primary and football lists. A video feed of Stockstill, along with the players, will be available on Youtube.com/GoBlueRaiders.tv. The Press Conference will be shown live on Facebook Live.

### Practice

Members of the media can interview coaches and players on Tuesday and Wednesday of game-week after practice. All practices are closed. Following Wednesday's practice, student-athletes will not be available for interviews until the conclusion of the game on Friday/Saturday.

### Postgame Interviews

Middle Tennessee's locker room is closed. Media will be asked to submit a list of player requests to Mark Owens at the start of the 4th quarter. During home games, players will be available to the media first in the Murphy Center Green Room (lower level) followed by Head Coach Rick Stockstill.

## A LOOK AT THE SERIES

- The Blue Raiders and Skyhawks have met 28 times with the majority of those coming during their days together in the OVC. MT owns a 20-7-1 advantage, including six straight wins.
- This is the first meeting between the two schools since 1999 when the Raiders won, 70-14 inside Floyd Stadium.
- The first meeting was in 1931.

## RAIDERS AT FLOYD STADIUM

- Since Floyd Stadium opened in 1933, the Blue Raiders have compiled an overall mark of 291-120-13 (.701), including a record 31-game win streak from 1987-94.
- Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders are 43-23 overall at Floyd Stadium and 29-15 in conference games (16-4 vs C-USA). MT has a 24-7 record at home in its last 31 games.
- Since 2007, MT has had home games against Virginia, Maryland, Mississippi State, Minnesota, Georgia Tech, BYU and Vandy. MT hosts Duke in 2019 and Missouri in 2022.

## RAIDERS VS IN-STATE FOES

- Since joining the FBS in 1999, the Blue Raiders have enjoyed success against in-state foes. During that span, MT has a mark of 12-8 against teams from the state of Tennessee with three wins coming on the road against Vanderbilt. The Blue Raiders fell to No. 4 Tennessee in Knoxville, 26-3, in 2002, lost at Memphis in 2010 and 2014, dropped one to UT in 2011 and lost to Vandy in 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018. Head Coach Rick Stockstill is 7-6 against in-state competition.

## 9 TIMES IN 12 YEARS

- In 12 years under Rick Stockstill, Middle Tennessee has reached bowl eligibility nine times and eight times in the last nine years. The Blue Raiders have been bowl eligible under Rick Stockstill in 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017. The nine bowl eligible years during the 12-year span is more than any FBS team in Tennessee and equals the most of any program in C-USA.

### AT HOME UNDER SHAFER

▶ The Blue Raiders have played six home games under second year defensive coordinator Scott Shafer and the unit has been impressive. The defense has allowed an average of just 294.2 (1,765) total yards a game, held the opponents to 32 of 90 (.355) on third down conversions and has allowed just 21 total fourth quarter points. However, the unit has forced just two turnovers in the six games and both came against FIU.

### STOCKSTILL IS MT CAREER LEADER

▶ QB Brent Stockstill enters his senior season owning virtually ever career passing mark at Middle Tennessee. The left-hander is the record holder in passing attempts, completions, yards, touchdowns, passing efficiency, passing yards per game, consecutive completions, 300-yard passing games and 400-yard passing games. Stockstill is also the all-time leader in total offense.

### CHASING 10,000 AND 100

▶ QB Brent Stockstill owns 9,129 career passing yards and 78 touchdown passes. He is trying to become just the 11th player in C-USA history to reach the 10,000 passing yard mark and only the third to top at least 100 TD passes. Only 109 players have reached 10,000 yards all-time in NCAA FBS history.

### LEE HOPES TO BUILD ON CAREER YEAR

▶ Quietly, wide receiver Ty Lee turned in a career-best season for the Blue Raiders in 2017. The sophomore finished with 79 receptions, which was the fourth most in school history, and 955 receiving yards (seventh most in MT history). Lee now enters the UTM game with 147 career catches (fifth most at MT) and 1,679 yards (seventh most). He also has 14

career TD grabs to tie for 10th in Raider history.

### HARRIS READY TO SHINE

▶ Linebacker Darius Harris (6-2, 238) is coming off a career year that saw him come into his own down the stretch. Harris, the MVP of the Camellia Bowl, had 64 tackles to go with 7.5 TFLs, 4.5 sacks and six pass breakups. He picked up where he left off in the opener with a team-high eight tackles including a sack.

### BROOKS IS DISRUPTOR ON DEFENSE

▶ Junior Khalil Brooks had a breakout year at linebacker for the Blue Raiders last year by leading the team in tackles for loss (17.0) and sacks (7.5). The all-conference player had a strong camp and looks to build on his 2017 success.

### RAIDERS HAVE DEPTH IN BACKFIELD

▶ Middle Tennessee likes its depth and experience in the backfield for 2018. Tavares Thomas, Terelle West and Brad Anderson are the frontliners who all recorded a 100-yard rushing game in 2017. Thomas adds tremendous size and is a Doak Walker candidate while West can run inside or outside. Anderson is shifty and provides a threat in the passing game. The Blue Raiders also have Maurice Gordon, who missed last year with an injury, to go with another big bruiser in Chaton Mobley. The group has a goal of 3,000 rushing yards which would go down as just the second time in MT history a team has gained that much on the ground.

### GIANT KILLERS

▶ Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have a knack of knocking off Power 5 opponents. With the win at Syracuse last season, MT now has five wins over Power 5 foes in the Rick Stockstill era. MT has wins over Maryland (2008, 2009), Georgia Tech (2012), Missouri (2016) and Syracuse (2017) with six others being decided by a touchdown or less. The Raiders will have plenty chances in the future with games against Vandy,

► Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders are 62-7 when scoring 30 points or more. **OFFENSIVE NOTES****THIS 'N THAT**

► In the season opener last week at Vandy, MT had 10 different receivers catch passes which was the most in a game by the Raiders since having 11 against Minnesota in game three of 2017.

► When Brent Stockstill does not start, the Blue Raiders have a 4-5 record during his career.

► Despite playing without starting QB Brent Stockstill for six games in 2017, the Blue Raiders still threw for 3,264 yards. That total went

down as the third most in school history.

► MT has registered over 5,000 yards of total offense in a season eight times in its history, and six of those have come under Rick Stockstill, including the last three years in a row.

► MT has topped the 200-yard rushing mark four times in each of the last two years under Franklin, including three games over 300 yards.

► MT turned in its best rushing game of the year and fifth highest under Rick Stockstill when it had 320 yards against ODU.

► MT has gone over the 500-yard mark of total offense in a game 11 times under Tony Franklin. The Blue Raiders did it twice in 2017 with the most recent coming against ODU (586).

## PLAYER NOTES

### Brent Stockstill

► Has **78** career TD passes, owning the Blue Raider all-time mark and ranking 2nd among active NCAA players. He became the all-time leader in just 22 games played.

► Ranks 14th on the C-USA all-time list for touchdown passes with 78. Needs one more to take over 13th place.

► Has six career games with four or more touchdown passes.

► With **9,129** career passing yards, the senior ended 2017 ranked 15th nationally among active career leaders in the NCAA. He started 2018 ranked third. He was also 6th in passing yards per game at 288.7.

► Had a career-high 434 passing yards against WKU in 2016 which ranks as the third most in school history for a single game.

► With 432 passing yards against Hawai'i in 2016, Stockstill became the first multiple 400-yard passer in school history.

► Set a new school record when he connected on his first 22 passes in the win over AAMU in 2016. Stockstill broke the previous mark of 19 set by Logan Kilgore in 2011.

► His 4,005 passing yards in 2015 was tops in the country among freshmen and was a new MT single-season and C-USA freshman record. He also led all freshmen in touchdown passes with 30.

► Stockstill set the new NCAA freshman completions record with 327 (Kentucky's Jared Lorenzen had 321 in 2000) and fell just 53 yards shy of breaking Jameis Winston's NCAA freshman passing record of 4,057 yards.

► Set a new school record with four straight 300-yard passing games in 2015.

► His 31 touchdown passes in 2016 was a new school record and broke the previous mark of 30 set by Stockstill himself in 2015.

### Ty Lee

► Ranks 7th all-time in receiving yards at MT and needs just 79 more to surpass Herbert Owenby for 6th place.

► Ranks 10th at MT with 14 career touchdown receptions. He needs two more to tie Ed Batties, George Dykes and G.E. McCormack for 7th place.

were 96th in total defense in 2016.

### DEFENSIVE SCORES

► Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raider defense has scored 27 defensive touchdowns, and 22 have come since 2009. Of the 27 scores, 17 have been interceptions and 10 have come by way of fumble returns. The Raiders had just two defensive scores in 2016 and only two in 2017.

### 10 TIMES FOR DEFENSE

► Middle Tennessee's defense has held the opposition to under 400 yards of total offense in 10 of 14 games under Scott Shafer. MT did it nine times in 2017 and once so far in 2018. The Raiders only had four games in 2016 prior to Shafer's arrival. FAU, UAB, WKU and Ark. St. are the only teams to go over 400 yards.

### MORE DEFENSIVE TIDBITS

► MT had 32 sacks in 2017 and 25 came in the seven wins. That total went down as the fourth

most in school history.

► MT held six opponents in 2017 to under 100 yards rushing, including three of the last five. The Raiders only held two opponents below 100 yards in 2016.

► 20 different players recorded at last one TFL in 2017, led by Khalil Brooks' 17.0.

► MT held Bowling Green in 2017 to just 1 total rushing yard in week 4 which went down as the third fewest ever allowed in a single game by the Blue Raiders. It was also the fewest since giving up just five yards against North Texas in 2016.

► The Blue Raiders recorded six sacks against Syracuse which was their most in a game since registering six in a win over UAB in 2014 - a span of 32 games. It was also the most ever against a Power 5 team under Rick Stockstill. MT also later had six sacks in 2017 bowl win over A-State.

► MT owns two shutouts since entering C-USA play in 2013. MT defeated FIU 48-0 in 2013



► Has hauled in at least one reception in 27 straight games which ranks 5th longest all-time at MT. The all-time record is 43.

## RAIDER ROUNDUP

► The top-scoring quarter in the Rick Stockstill era is the second quarter. Here is a combined total for each quarter: 1st - 1073 points; 2nd - 1,251 points; 3rd - 800 points; 4th - 1,080 points; and 70 in overtime.

► When both teams are held under 20 points, the Blue Raiders are 3-1 under Rick Stockstill.

► As a FBS (I-A) member (231 games), the Raiders have scored 50 or more points 20 times.

► The Blue Raiders are 86-14 in the FBS era when leading at the half and are 93-11 when leading a game entering the 4th quarter.

► When trailing at the half, the Blue Raiders are just 20-95 in the FBS (I-A) era.

► The Blue Raiders have scored in 255 of their last 261 games and broke a string of scoring in 55 straight when they were shut out at Tennessee in 2011. MT, which has a current streak of 61 games, has been shut out five other times during the FBS era. The Blue Raiders were shut out 10-0 on the road against UL-Monroe in 1999, 55-0 in 2000 at Florida, 59-0 at Oklahoma in 2006, 44-0 at LSU in 2007, and 45-0 at Arkansas State in 2012. MT has scored in 116 straight home games (last shutout was 9/23/1995 vs Murray State).

► Largest margin of victory in the I-A era: 59 points vs Charlotte 9/19/15 (73-14) ... Largest margin of defeat in the I-A era: 59 points vs Oklahoma 9/23/06 (59-0).

► MT currently has six players on NFL rosters.

Erik Walden (Seahawks), Benny Cunningham (Bears), Kevin Byard (Titans), Josh Walker (Jaguars), Richie James (49ers) and Charvarius Ward (Chiefs).

## ACADEMICS ARE A TOP PRIORITY

► Academic success at MT has been a high priority for 13th-year coach Rick Stockstill. Under his reign, the Blue Raiders have seen 96 percentage of student-athletes earn their degree entering the 2018 season. MT, who has also been impressive with APR scores under Stockstill, has been publicly recognized by the NCAA for APR success twice in the last eight years. Also under Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have taken home six Academic All-District honors and produced an Academic All-American.

► Middle Tennessee has eight student-athletes entering the 2018 season already with a degree in hand. The graduates are Gatlin Casey, Cordell Hudson, Brent Stockstill, Darrius Liggins, Angelo Owens, Jahmal Jones, Darius Harris and Carlos Johnson.

► On Dec. 7, 2017, Middle Tennessee was one of just seven programs nationally to earn the AFCA's 2017 Academic Achievement Award. The Blue Raiders recorded a perfect 100 percent graduation rate for freshmen football student-athletes class of 2010.

## RICK STOCKSTILL

Head Coach

13th Year - Florida State '82

2-Time Coach of the Year

Winning on the field, off the field and having a first-class football program from top to bottom is the goal of any university at the highest level of intercollegiate athletics. That is exactly what Middle Tennessee has as a result of the leadership of head coach Rick Stockstill.

In his 13th season at the helm of the Blue Raiders, Stockstill is the sixth-longest tenured coach in the country and third-longest in MT history. With his long tenure have come numerous achievements and accolades, including:

- 2006 Sun Belt co-champions
- 2009 New Orleans Bowl and 2017 Raycom Media Camellia Bowl champions
- 79 wins, third all-time in program history
- 7 bowl appearances and bowl eligible 9 times
- 2 NCAA awards for APR success (2011, 2012)
- American Football Coaches Association's 2017 Academic Achievement Award
- Back-to-back eight-win seasons in 2012-13 for first time in 21 years
- Six of the top eight crowds in Floyd Stadium history, including top three
- 8 All-Americans (1 Academic All-American)
- Three conference defensive players of the year
- Produced 36 First Team All-Conference honors
- Four bowl game MVPs
- Six NFL Draft picks and a pro bowler
- Produced the school's all-time leader in passing yards, receptions, sacks and interceptions
- 2018 recipient of the Grant Teaff "Breaking the Silence" Award

Stockstill and the Raiders advanced to their third bowl game in as many seasons in 2017 when they went to Montgomery, Alabama and took down Arkansas State for the Raycom Media Camellia Bowl championship, the first time in program history they played in bowl games in three successive seasons. It was also the seventh bowl game for MT under Stockstill's guidance and second win, joining the 2009 New Orleans Bowl title.

The first of the three-year bowl streak came in 2015, when MT held a 7-6 record and Popeyes Bahamas Bowl berth. The Blue Raiders had to show a tremendous amount of grit to become bowl eligible, winning all four games in November.

Prior to the three years finishing in bowl games, Stockstill led Middle Tennessee to three straight second-place finishes in Conference USA's East Division from 2012-14, including a berth in the Bell Helicopter Armed Forces Bowl in 2013 against Navy.

Some regard the 2012 season as his best coaching job after leading the Blue Raiders to the nation's biggest win improvement from the previous year. They won just two games in 2011, but Stockstill turned the 2012 MT squad around, finishing with an 8-4 record that included an FBS school record five road wins. They also received votes in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll three straight weeks, another school record, and upset ACC Coastal Division Champion Georgia Tech. Along the way, he produced a Freshman All-American, eight all-conference players and a national offensive player of the week.

Throughout his 13-season tenure, Stockstill has also shown a commitment to academics. The Blue Raiders have gone from an APR score of 892 to a very impressive 992, the biggest increase of any program in the country.

Born Dec. 23, 1957 in Sidney, Ohio, Stockstill grew up in Georgetown, Kentucky, and then moved to Fernandina Beach, Florida, where he was inducted into the Fernandina Beach Hall of Fame in 2006. He was a three-year letterman at Florida State as a quarterback, where he was team captain and earned Honorable Mention All-American honors in 1981 under Coach Bobby Bowden. During his career at FSU, the Seminoles had two top-10 final Associated Press rankings and had wins over powers Notre Dame, Pittsburgh, Ohio State and Nebraska. Stockstill, who received his bachelor's degree from FSU in 1982, made three bowl trips with the Seminoles.

## RAIDERS FALL IN OPENER

**NASHVILLE** - Troubles offensively cost Middle Tennessee, as the Blue Raiders traveled to Vanderbilt and were defeated 35-7 in their season opener.

It was the fourth loss in a row for the Raiders in the series, which is in its final year in the current contract.

"I told them [after the game], I like this team and I'm not down on this team one bit," head coach Rick Stockstill said. "I'm sick to my stomach that we lost, and they're sick to their stomachs because they lost. We're still going to be a dang good football team."

"I feel a lot better about this team than I did at this point last year."

Middle Tennessee (0-1) looked to have control of the Commodore (1-0) defense in the first quarter, as a 4-yard pass from redshirt senior Brent Stockstill to junior CJ Windham ended a 93-yard drive with a touchdown. It knotted things at seven with two minutes left in the opening frame, and momentum had been snatched.

From there, though, the Blue Raider attack turned inconsistent.

It started with a bad lateral pass from Brent Stockstill to sophomore Brad Anderson that was dropped and returned 3 yards by Vanderbilt's Dayo Odeyingbo for what proved to be the game-winning score with 14 minutes left in the first half.

Middle Tennessee's defense did all it could to hold things close, holding Vanderbilt to just 89 total yards in the first half. But, the costly mistakes and inconsistencies on offense voided the good effort.

The Blue Raiders moved the ball effectively, getting to the Vanderbilt side of the field five times after their scoring drive in the first quarter. However, all five drives ended without points (three punts, an interception and a missed field goal).

Brent Stockstill finished the game 24 of 36 for 178 yards, one touchdown and an interception, and he added 10 yards rushing. He was sacked six times.

Ten Blue Raiders caught at least one pass, led by Anderson and junior Ty Lee with five catches apiece, Anderson for 37 yards and Lee for 25.

Defensively, redshirt senior linebacker Darius Harris led the way with eight tackles, a sack and tackle for loss. Khalil Brooks added five tackles and a tackle for loss, and Chris Melton and Kylan Stribling also had five tackles apiece.
