**Notes:** The Blue Raiders are a perfect 3-0 at home in Sun Belt play ... Middle Tennessee has won 11 of its last 12 games at home ... The Blue Raiders are a perfect 5-0 in Sun Belt play when tailback Dwone Hicks is available the entire game ... MT is 15-0 all-time under Andy McCollum when leading at the half ... ReShard Lee is going for his fourth straight 100-yard rushing game, which would be the first MT back to accomplish that feat since Dwone Hicks in 2000 ... Punter Robert Billings has placed nine of his last 18 punts inside the opponents' 20-yard line ... The Blue Raider defense has allowed an average of only 83.0 passing yards a game over the past two weeks of play.

### SERIES RECORD

■ Saturday's football game between Middle Tennessee and Louisiana-Lafayette will be the fourth meeting between the two schools on the gridiron. The series, which began in 1999, stands in favor of the Blue Raiders, 2-1. The Ragin' Cajuns won the first meeting, 45-31, in Lafayette in 1999 before the Blue Raiders responded with two straight victories. MT defeated ULL in Murfreesboro in 2000, 41-38, in two overtimes, then downed the Ragin' Cajuns, 26-9, last year in Lafayette.

### LAST TIME AT FLOYD

■ Notes from the last meeting between Middle Tennessee and Louisiana-Lafayette at Floyd Stadium:

- The overtime win for MT was its first as a I-A program.

- The average score in the series has been MT 32.7 to ULL's 30.7.

- Following a first quarter injury to Dwone Hicks, Don Calloway came in and had career highs in rushing (108) and receiving yards (136).

- PK Brian Kelly kicked the game-winning field goal (21 yards).

- QB Jason Johnson completed 16 of 24 passes for 226 yards and a TD to ignite the Blue Raiders.

### BLUE RAIDERS AT FLOYD

■ Since Floyd Stadium opened in 1933, the Blue Raiders have compiled an overall mark of 238-87-13 (.723), including a record 31-game win streak from 1987-94. MT is 15-5 at Floyd since the renovation in 1998 and has won 11 of its last 12. Under Andy McCollum, the Blue Raiders are 13-3; 3-0 at home with the only losses coming to Troy State, UCF and SEMO.

### GAME ON TV

■ The Sun Belt Conference television package will get underway with the Middle Tennessee-ULL game on Saturday. The contest will be shown on ESPN Regional Television and will reach nearly six million homes on the SBC Network. Locally, fans can view the game on CSS or Channel 27 on Comcast cable. KLAf-TV in Lafayette will broadcast the game for Ragin' Cajun fans. All three of MT's conference home games will be televised by the SBC Network.

### NO PLACE LIKE HOME

■ The Blue Raiders have found home life enjoyable under Andy McCollum. Middle Tennessee has averaged 2,454 yards per season on the turf at Floyd Stadium since McCollum's arrival. In the team's 16 games at home under Andy Mac, the offense is churning out an average of **477.9** yards per contest. To break it down even further, the Blue Raiders have accumulated 4.2 miles of offense inside Floyd Stadium under McCollum. Of the 7,646 total yards amassed during this two-year plus span, 4,198 yards have come through the air and 3,448 have come on the ground. The Blue Raiders have also turned up the scoring at home, too. The team has rung up 667 points during this stretch for an average of **41.7** points per game. Recent history also favors the Blue Raiders as they have put up 40-plus points in seven of their last 11 games at Floyd Stadium.

### HE'S BACK

■ Middle Tennessee running back **Dwone Hicks** made his surprising return to the football field during last week's game at Vanderbilt. Hicks, who entered the game during the second quarter, had been out of action since mid-way through the third quarter of the Kentucky contest. The preseason SBC Offensive Player of the Year sparked the Blue Raiders to their first win of the year by rushing 10 times for 42 yards and scored the game-winning touchdown with 52 seconds to play.

### RUNNING TO VICTORY

■ The Blue Raiders picked up their first win of the season against Vanderbilt behind a strong running attack. Middle Tennessee had 213 yards on the ground and three touchdowns. The 213 yards rank as the second-best rushing output of the season behind the 220 yards registered at Kentucky. In fact, the Blue Raiders averaged

205.3 yards rushing a game against three of the four SEC schools they have played this year. Tennessee was the lone SEC school to hold the MT ground game in check with only 100 yards.

### THREE IN A ROW FOR LEE

■ Running back **ReShard Lee** rang up his third straight 100-yard rushing game and the fifth of his career by grounding out 144 yards on 20 carries against Vanderbilt. Lee's 144-yard effort was a season-high and ranked as the second-best outing of his career (146 yards vs Arkansas State in 2001). Over the past three games, Lee is averaging 120.3 yards on the ground and 7.2 yards a carry (50 total attempts). The last Blue Raider back to rush for 100 or more yards in four straight games was Dwone Hicks during the 2000 season.

### DEFENSE STEPPING UP

■ After struggling at times during the 2002 season, the Blue Raider defense has shown signs of maturing with back-to-back impressive efforts against Arkansas State and Vanderbilt. At ASU, the Blue Raiders held the Indians to 288 yards of total offense and no touchdowns, then followed that up by allowing only 287 yards of total offense in the win over Vanderbilt. In the two games, MT's defense has given up just 19 total points (not counting seven points from fumbled punt that was recovered at 2-yard line), while allowing an average of 83.0 yards through the air.

Dick Palmer is in his 22nd season as the Blue Raiders' play-by-play announcer, while former MT assistant coach Preston O'Neal is handling the color analysis for the ninth straight year. MT Marketing and Promotions director, Chip Walters, will be handling sideline commentary and locker room interviews. The Blue Raider Network also features five affiliate stations throughout the mid-state area.

## GOOD TIMING

■ **Brandon Lynch**, who has shined the past two games for the Blue Raider defense, picked a great time to record his first career interception. With 52 seconds left in the game at Vanderbilt and Middle Tennessee clinging to a 21-20 lead, Lynch stepped in front of a Benji Walker pass and returned it 37 yards to the VU 3-yard line to seal the Blue Raider victory. Along with his pick, the junior registered five tackles, including two for loss of yards, and a pass breakup. Over the past two games, Lynch has 13 tackles and three TFLs from his outside linebacker spot.

## BILLINGS IS HOT

■ Junior **Robert Billings**, who ranks third all-time at MT in punting average (39.98 yards per punt), continues to prove why he is arguably the league's best. Over his last four games, Billings is averaging 43.5 yards a punt and has placed nine of his 18 punts inside the opponents' 20-yard line. For the season, Billings is averaging 41.7 yards a kick to rank 33rd nationally. The Collierville, TN, native has 114 career punts and 36 of those have been placed inside the opposition's 20-yard line.

## YOUELL EYEING 100

■ Senior **David Youell**, who is having a solid season, needs just nine more receptions to reach 100 for his career. The Sevierville, TN, native has 91 catches all-time to rank seventh on the Blue Raiders receptions list. Youell needs eight more grabs to tie Matt Lowe for sixth place.

## CALICO LEADS RECEIVERS

■ Senior **Tyrone Calico** enters the Louisiana-Lafayette game as the Blue Raiders' top receiver with 26 catches in six games. The Millington, TN, native has reeled in at least six catches in three of the Blue Raiders' six games.

## HINES SPARKS GROUND GAME

■ One of the best weapons for Middle Tennessee's offense this season has been the running ability of quarterback **Andrico Hines**. The junior enters the Louisiana-Lafayette game as the team's second-leading rusher with 294 yards on 79 attempts (3.7). That total ranks as the most rushing yards by a Blue Raider quarterback since Marvin Collier gained 594 yards in 1985. In the conference opener at ASU, Hines had a career-best 76 yards on 18 carries.

## STEADY ELARBEE

■ Senior **Glen Elarbee** has been the Blue Raiders' most consistent lineman in 2002. The starting center has played a team-high 391 plays this season and has earned a combined grade of 78.7 percent, which also paces the Blue Raiders. In fact, Elarbee has graded out at 81 percent or better in six of his last nine games. Elarbee, who is also second on the team in knockdowns with 45, has earned Most Valuable Lineman honors twice.

## WESTBROOK WORTHY

■ Outland Trophy candidate **Brandon Westbrook**, who is coming off a 13-knockdown performance at Vanderbilt, has not let anyone down this season as the junior is off to an excellent start. After five games, the Cumming, GA, native has been in on 293 plays and leads the team in knockdowns with 50. His knockdown total is his highest in five straight games since collecting 47 in the first five outings in 2000.

## HICKS OWNS TD RECORD

■ With two rushing touchdowns against Kentucky, senior **Dwone Hicks** broke out of a tie with former Blue Raider Joe Campbell to take over the school's career rushing touchdown mark. Hicks, who also owns the overall touchdowns scored record at MT with 53, ran his total to 47 career rushing touchdowns with his 2-yard run at Vanderbilt.

## CALICO SIXTH ON TD LIST

■ Senior **Tyrone Calico** enters the Louisiana-Lafayette game ranked sixth on Middle Tennessee's all-time touchdown receptions list. Calico has 14 career scores and stands seven behind record holders Kendall Newson and Herbert Owenby. The Millington, TN, native needs two more scoring grabs to tie George Dykes and G.E. McCormack for fourth place.

■ Defensive lineman **Demetrios Walker** had his leg broken in four places at the age of 14 when he was run over by a car. After learning how to walk all over again, it's amazing the Kansas City, MO, native is even playing football.

■ True freshmen **Sean Waller** and **Pierre Ingram**, both members of the traveling squad, were state champions in track and field last year. Waller was the Tennessee state champion in the 100-, 200-, and 400 meters, while Ingram was the Georgia state winner in the high jump (6-10).

■ On January 29, lineman **Josh Willoughby** saved the life of a gentleman who was choking on some food at a local restaurant. After a lady had tried unsuccessfully to help the man, Willoughby grabbed him out of the booth and attempted the Heimlich maneuver about 10 times before freeing the lodged food from his throat. ■ Middle Tennessee's **Band of Blue** is now the largest college marching band in the state of Tennessee and is tied with Michigan for the sixth largest college marching band in the nation. The Band of Blue's 350 members is larger than the University of Tennessee's Pride of the Southland Band which has 330 members.

■ Sophomore running back **Don Calloway** has 16 brothers and sisters. His brother Selma was a running back at Georgia.

■ Former walk-on **Joey Montalbano**, who was the 2001 and 2002 Lifter of the Year for the Blue Raiders, has his own business called "Campus Times". The company publishes calendars.

■ Starting free safety **Michael Woods**, from Valdosta, GA, is the cousin of current Tennessee Titan linebacker Randall Godfrey.

■ The Blue Raider coaching staff hosts over 500 Boys and Girls Club kids each year for a free clinic at Floyd Stadium. During that same week, Andy McCollum puts on a golf tournament which raised over \$100,000 in 2002 for the club.

## STRONG IN THE RED ZONE

■ Over the past 28 games, the Blue Raider offense has performed admirably in the red zone. During that span, the offense has appeared inside the opponents' 20-yard line 114 times and have come away with points on 92 occasions. That works out to 80.7 percent. Of the 92 scores, 80 have been touchdowns. At Alabama in week one, MT was a perfect 6-for-6 in the red zone with four touchdowns and two field goals. For the season, the Blue Raiders are 14-for-19 inside the redzone.

## BLOCKS UNDER MAC

■ Under **Andy McCollum** the Blue Raiders have blocked five kicks, and all five have come in the last two years. Under McCollum, Middle Tennessee has blocked two punts (Michael Woods vs Louisiana Tech in 2000, Chris Johnson vs ASU in 2001), an extra point (Kareem Bland vs UL-Monroe in 2001), and two field goals (Kareem Bland vs UConn in 2001 and Jerry Vanderpool vs Tennessee in 2002).

## OUTLAND WATCH

■ Middle Tennessee offensive tackle **Brandon Westbrook** was one of 63 players to make the 2002 Outland Trophy Watch List, which was released in August by the *Football Writers Association of America*. The Outland Trophy is awarded each year to the top interior lineman in college football. Westbrook, a freshman all-American in 2000, was a first team all-Sun Belt selection in 2001 and is also a first team all-preseason pick in 2002. The Cumming, GA, native is in his junior season.

## WOODS ON BUTKUS LIST

■ Junior **Michael Woods** is among the 67 players named to the preliminary list for the annual Butkus Award. The award is given each year to the nation's top linebacker.

## BILLINGS ON RAY GUY LIST

■ Junior **Robert Billings** has been named to the 2002 Ray Guy Award watch list as a potential candidate for the top collegiate punter of the year. Billings, one of 34 candidates, led the Sun Belt Conference in punting average in 2001.

## BCS VS NON-BCS

Over the past 26 games, running back Dwone Hicks has proven himself against some of the nation's top teams. During that span, the senior has averaged 94.9 (1,044) yards rushing in 11 games against BCS teams compared to 106.1 (1591) yards in 15 contests versus Non-BCS schools. Hicks' average per carry against BCS members is 5.9 yards (177 att.), while he is gaining 6.3 yards (254 att.) a carry versus the Non-BCS teams. In the 11 games against BCS schools, Hicks has topped the 100-yard mark five times. The only teams to keep him below the century mark were Florida (15-64), Alabama (11-42), Tennessee (17-33), Kentucky (16-97), Vanderbilt (in limited action) and Ole Miss, but against the Rebels he left with a hamstring injury during the first drive of the third quarter and never returned. He finished with 79 yards on nine carries in the loss to the Rebels and an impressive 8.8 yards a carry average.

■ In what was the biggest comeback win in school history, the Blue Raiders came from 24 points down in the fourth quarter to defeat New Mexico State at home in 2001. The Blue Raiders registered 289 total yards of offense in the fourth quarter and scored on four straight possessions (70, 88, 80, and 68 yards). ## 2002 SUN BELT PLAYERS OF THE WEEK Sept. 2: ReShard Lee, Special Teams

Tennessee received a vote in the Preseason Associated Press College Football Top 25 Poll. The Blue Raiders, who have posted back-to-back winning seasons, earned a total of one vote, which ranked them No. 50 overall in the preseason poll, then jumped to No. 49 in the first regular season poll.

## ON CENTER STAGE

■ A three-game record 248,347 (82,782) fans saw the Blue Raiders during the first three weeks of the season. The Blue Raiders played in front of their largest crowd ever when they lined up against Tennessee before 107,672, which came one week after MT opened the season at Alabama before 80,091. The Alabama crowd ranked as the fourth largest crowd the Blue Raiders have played in front of for football. MT played in front of 60,054 at Kentucky.

## QUICK HITTERS

■ At Vanderbilt last week, the Blue Raiders won for the very first time under **Andy McCollum** when totaling less than 300 yards of offense.

■ The Blue Raiders have trailed by a combined 69-14 after the first quarter this season, including 22-0 against Alabama, 14-0 at Tennessee, 17-0 at Kentucky, and 6-0 at Arkansas State. Middle Tennessee has led only one opponent this season after the first quarter (Vanderbilt, 7-3).

■ Senior **Jonathan Proby** has started at three different positions this season. He earned the start at tight end against Kentucky, then started at left tackle versus SEMO and opened at right tackle at Arkansas State.

■ After recording a career-best 83 percent grade in a start against SEMO, senior **Jonathan Proby** followed that effort up with an 82 percent grade at Arkansas State.

■ Middle Tennessee's announced crowd of 27,519 in the home opener against SEMO was the second largest in stadium history. The largest home crowd to ever see the Blue Raiders came in 1998 when 27,568 showed up to see MT defeat Tennessee State.

■ The Blue Raiders came up with a season-high three quarterback sacks against Kentucky.

■ The Blue Raiders gained a season-high 422 yards of total offense against Kentucky last week.

■ In the Sagarin ratings, Middle Tennessee's 2002 schedule is rated the third toughest in the country.

■ True freshman **John Crawford** remains perfect this season on his snaps. The Knoxville,

TN, native is 41-for-41 on all his snaps in 2002.

■ Junior **Wardell Alsup** made his first career catch when he hauled in a 37-yard strike from running back **ReShard Lee** against Alabama. It also was Lee's first career passing attempt.

■ **Tyrone Calico's** 75 receiving yards at Alabama was the senior's most in a game since collecting 160 yards in last year's win over Idaho.

■ As a I-A member (39 games), the Blue Raiders have scored 50 or more points eight times.

■ **Dwone Hicks** has at least one rushing touchdown in 14 of his last 19 outings.

■ The Blue Raiders are **10-0** all-time when **Dwone Hicks** gets at least 18 carries in a game.

■ In his last 26 games, **Dwone Hicks** has tallied 44 rushing touchdowns.

■ The longest consecutive games started streak belongs to **Michael Woods, Tyrone Calico, and Glen Elarbee**. All three players have earned starts in 15 straight games.

■ WR **Tyrone Calico** has caught at least one pass in 38 of 39 career games played. The only game he failed to bring in a reception came last year at UL-Lafayette.

■ The Blue Raiders are **15-0** under Andy McCollum when leading at the half and are 16-0 when leading a game entering the fourth quarter.

■ When trailing at the half, the Blue Raiders are just 3-20 under McCollum and two of those wins came in 2001.

# 2002 SEASON RECAP AND BOXSCORES

## Game 1

Alabama 39, Middle Tennessee 34  
Aug. 31, 2002; Birmingham, AL

**BIRMINGHAM, Ala.** - Middle Tennessee spotted Alabama 22 points in the first quarter and then came storming back to give the Crimson Tide a fight to the finish in the season opener for both teams at Legion Field.

Alabama held off a furious rally that saw the Blue Raiders pull to within five points or less three times in the game's final nine minutes to secure a 39-34 win in front of 80,091 at Legion Field.

No, MTSU didn't get the quality win it sought, but the Blue Raiders showed fight and determination in a remarkable comeback that earned them the respect they were seeking.

"We wanted to get in the fourth quarter with Alabama at Legion Field and have a chance to win the ball game," MTSU coach Andy McCollum said. "We want to find a way to finish this, but Alabama did a good job making sure we didn't. Losing is not OK at Middle Tennessee, though, and never will be."

The game's outcome wasn't decided until Ahmaad Galloway recovered an onside kick at midfield with 2:16 remaining and, even then, the Crimson Tide needed one more first down to run out the clock. MTSU forced a third-and-4 situation with just under two minutes remaining, but Santonio Beard's 4-yard run provided the necessary new set of downs that enabled Alabama to run out the clock and escape with the narrow win.

"We jumped out on them early and really thought we were going to be able to close the deal there, but I tell you what, they kept fighting," Alabama quarterback Tyler Watts said. "They kept coming back. We were unable to put the ball in the end zone (after the first quarter). We kept fighting, and there in the fourth quarter we were able to pull it out."

Funny hearing Watts, who was 16-of-22 for 236 yards and two touchdowns, talk about fighting for a win because there for awhile it appeared the Crimson Tide was on its way to an easy win. Suddenly, everything changed for the Blue Raiders.

The offense started clicking and the defense rose to the occasion. As a result, MTSU outscored Alabama 34-17 after the first quarter to put itself in position for what would have been an incredible comeback.

"You can't be proud of a loss," MTSU line-

backer Michael Woods said. "We knew we could hang with them coming in, and we know if we didn't give up those 22 points in the first quarter we could have won this game. We know we played a good team (Saturday). We came out and played as hard as we could and it just wasn't enough."

Incredibly, MTSU had the ball at its 38 with 3:07 remaining and down 32-27 with an offense that obviously had found its rhythm behind first-year quarterback Andrico Hines, who debuted by going 16-of-24 for 165 yards and rushing for another 47 yards on seven carries.

"When we took over we believed we were going to drive down the field and score," senior receiver David Youell said. "There was never a doubt at any time, even down 22."

Hines' first pass of the series was intercepted when linebacker Freddie Roach cut in front of a pass intended for Youell and took it 41 yards to the end zone to put Alabama on top 39-27 with 2:56 remaining.

"I didn't even see (Roach)," Hines said. "It was a great play on his behalf. I think they started to anticipate what we were doing. That is a time you wish you had a string on the ball to bring it back. I can't take anything from him. You always want to come out with a win. We came out and gave it our all and just came up short."

Even after the only turnover of the game for either team, MTSU came storming back. ReShard Lee almost took the kickoff return the distance before being forced out of bounds after a 58-yard return to the Alabama 42.

Then Lee took the handoff from Hines on the first play of the drive, pulled up, and the former high school quarterback connected with Wardell Alsop for a 37-yard pass play to the Alabama 5.

MTSU tailback Dwone Hicks, being touted as a Heisman Trophy candidate, scored his second touchdown on the following play and Brian Kelly added the extra point to get MTSU within 39-34.

Hicks was held to 42 yards on 11 carries. Lee led a balanced ground game with 56 yards on 11 carries and a touchdown as the Blue Raiders rushed for 183 yards and got all four touchdowns via the rushing attack.

After narrowing the gap to five, MTSU had a chance to recover Paul Wheeler's perfectly placed onside kick when it took a high hop, but Galloway was able to secure it.

"I admire our kids. They hung in there, and they found a way to win," Alabama coach Dennis Franchione said. "Give Middle Tennessee credit, they played hard. We knew they were a good team and they played like it. We tip our hats to

Middle the way they kept fighting. They stayed after it, but we also admire ourselves for hanging in."

# Game 2

#4 Tennessee 26, Middle Tennessee 3  
Sept. 7, 2002; Knoxville, TN

**KNOXVILLE, Tenn.** - Tennessee coach Phillip Fulmer breathed a sigh of relief as the final seconds ticked off the clock and his No. 4-ranked Vols knocked off in-state rival MTSU, 26-3, in the first-ever football meeting between the two schools.

Although Tennessee eventually won by a comfortable margin, there were some anxious moments after the Vols jumped to a 17-0 lead then stalled against a MTSU defense that refused to buckle. It gave the Blue Raiders a chance to make a run in front of 107,672 - the sixth-largest crowd in Neyland Stadium history.

However, Tennessee's defense was up to the task from the outset and never allowed the Blue Raiders to move the ball consistently.

"You have to give Middle Tennessee credit," Fulmer said. "They challenged us. I would like to congratulate Middle Tennessee for the effort they gave. I hope they go the rest of the way and do well.

"They are a well-coached football team, a hard-fighting football team. I'm glad to get the win, glad to get it over. I'm ready to move on."

What began as an apparent Tennessee rout after the Vols (2-0) jumped out to a 17-0 lead early materialized into a competitive, hard-fought game. But the Blue Raiders (0-2) were never able to get into a consistent rhythm offensively and were kept out of the end zone for the first time since a 55-0 loss at Florida, Sept. 9, 2000 - a span of 21 games.

"It's no different than what I told the kids in our locker room," MTSU coach Andy McCollum said. "We took two of the top teams in America to the fourth quarter with a chance to win. Tennessee closed the door and finished the game. These guys didn't come to play close. They came to win.

"There is a pretty good 0-2 football team in that locker room."

Tennessee held MTSU to 209 yards total offense - 100 rushing and 109 through the air - but the Blue Raiders went into halftime knowing the situation could have been much different than the 17-0 deficit they faced at intermission.

The Blue Raiders faced second down at the Vols' 2-yard-line with 4:10 remaining in the half when quarterback Andrico Hines fumbled the football away to end the threat.

"That's my fault," Hines said. "That's all I can really say. There are no do-overs in football. If we execute that, then it's probably a different

ballgame."

Even after the miscue, MTSU's offense had a chance to get on the scoreboard before the half when linebacker Louis Kemp recovered a Casey Clausen fumble near midfield.

Three plays later, receiver Tyrone Calico appeared to haul in a pass at the 1-yard-line, but the play was ruled incomplete. Time ran out on the Blue Raiders before they could attempt a field goal.

MTSU's only points came on Brian Kelly's 45-yard field goal to cut the Tennessee lead to 17-3 with 14:19 remaining.

Hines led MTSU's ground game with 63 yards on 19 carries, while Dwone Hicks was held to 33 yards on 17 attempts.

"Our defense played their heart out," Calico said. "We just never got it done. We needed to capitalize when we got the chance. We got chances, but we didn't capitalize."

MTSU's defense forced two turnovers - a Muhammad Rashada interception on Tennessee's second drive, and the Kemp fumble recovery late in the first half.

UT tailback Cedric Houston started the scoring with a 15-yard run with 10:16 remaining, then Tennessee went up 14-0 when Clausen connected with tight end Jason Whitten for a 10-yard pass play on a fourth-and-1 call.

But MTSU's defense turned the tide with a statement-making stand following the first of three Hines fumbles.

Tennessee recovered the fumble at the MTSU 36-yard-line but had to settle for Phillip Newman's 35-yard field goal. After that, the MTSU defense didn't allow another point and gave its team a chance to rally.

"We really did compete on defense," McCollum said. "And when your defense plays that good, the mistakes really kill you."

Tennessee, which finished with 400 total yards, had difficulty running the ball consistently and finished with 137 rushing yards, led by Houston's 74-yard effort. Clausen finished with 263 yards on 24-of-29 passing.

The Blue Raiders held Tennessee scoreless on seven consecutive possessions, and the Vols scored their last nine points on a safety and a fumble recovery.

"As far as the defense goes, we knew what they were going to do," Rashada said. "We watched enough film, and we came out and played. It wasn't good enough as a whole. As a team, we played pretty good, but we can't be satisfied with two losses."

# Game 3

Kentucky 44, Middle Tennessee 22  
Sept. 21, 2002; Lexington, KY

**LEXINGTON, Kent.** - For the third time in three weeks a familiar script proved detrimental in MTSU's quest to secure its first win of the season.

The Blue Raiders fell behind 17-0 less than eight minutes into the game and, after clawing their way back to within two in the second half, ended up dropping a 44-22 decision in front of 60,584 at Kentucky.

If nothing else, MTSU has been consistent, falling behind a combined 56-0 in the first quarter of its first three games.

"I would like one time for us to get ahead and see how we react to something," MTSU coach Andy McCollum said. "We are constantly playing catch-up, but the offense was a big reason we were in that situation today because they didn't protect the football.

"It's tough right now because we have a good football team, but when you play on the road in the SEC there is no room for error, and we are still not playing well enough to go into these places and win one of those games. As good as (MTSU) has played and as proud as you are of the players, we still are 0-3."

While MTSU is still looking for its first win, Kentucky has started the season 4-0 for the first time since 1984. Senior tailback Artose Pinner was again a big reason Saturday.

He shredded MTSU's defense for 163 yards and three touchdowns on 24 carries and paced an offense that piled up 510 total yards. Quarterback Jared Lorenzen continued his fast start, completing 22-of-31 for 305 yards and three scores. He was intercepted by Aaron Pitts at the end of the first half.

"I knew they had a good back watching (Pinner) on film," MTSU linebacker Randy Arnold said. "We have to be able to step up to the challenge and make plays. We have to get off the field. We have give ourselves a chance, and we didn't do that (Saturday)."

The game included a midfield altercation between both teams at halftime after MTSU defensive lineman Jerry Vanderpool and Lorenzen got into a shoving match.

A melee unfolded at midfield and MTSU had Vanderpool and Devarick Scandrett ejected for the second half. Kentucky lost the services of reserves Sylvester Miller and Michael Aitcheson, but Lorenzen wasn't not ejected although he, along with Vanderpool, were flagged for personal fouls.

"They called two personal fouls, one on Vanderpool and another on Lorenzen,"

McCollum said. "It looked like Lorenzen swung at him, and Vanderpool pushed him back, and they called personal fouls on both of them, but Vanderpool gets thrown out of the game and Lorenzen doesn't. We lost two starters, and they lose two back-ups. (The midfield altercation) was ugly and there's no place for it in the game."

The Blue Raiders ran up 422 yards total offense, including a 220-yard effort on the ground, but moving the ball wasn't the problem as Dwone Hicks rushed for a season-high 97 yards and two touchdowns, and quarterback Andrico Hines was 10-of-19 for 202 yards and a touchdown.

Finishing drives hindered the Blue Raiders in the fourth quarter as three drives stalled in Kentucky territory.

"We got down early and fought like crazy to get back," Hines said. "Things didn't go our way and we have a lot of improving to do. That starts this week in practice. We just have to execute better."

After falling behind 17-0 in the first quarter, MTSU put up 16 points in the second stanza and closed to within 24-16 at the half.

Hicks' 1-yard run got MTSU on the board and Brian Kelly ran in for the 2-point conversion to cut the deficit to 17-8. After Pinner ran for a nine-yard score, Hines connected with Tyrone Calico on a 24-yard scoring pass. Hines ran for the 2-point conversion and MTSU had closed to within 24-16 at the 4:39 mark.

The Blue Raiders opened the second half with a seven-play, 80-yard drive, culminating with Hicks' 16-yard run. Hines hit Youell for the 2-point try to seemingly tie the game, but MTSU was called for pass interference and then Kelly missed the point after, leaving the Blue Raiders trailing 24-22 with 12:16 remaining in the third quarter.

"There was no doubt we were going to come back and finish it," said Calico, who hauled in two catches for 69 yards. "We haven't had a problem catching up in two of the games, but when we catch up then we haven't found a way to get over the hump."

"It's very frustrating because we have worked hard and haven't found a way to get a win."

Kentucky followed MTSU's score with one of its own when Lorenzen flicked the pass to Pinner on third-and-6 from the 13 with Blue Raider Tony Sutton hanging on him. The point after failed, and Kentucky led 30-22.

MTSU was driving for a possible tie when Hines was stopped a half-yard short on fourth-and-5 from the 26.

Then the turning point came when receiver Aaron Boone got behind Will Martin and caught a slant pass that he took 72 yards for the decisive score, with 2:01 remaining in the third quarter.

"That was a big play on the slant because we were back in the game and making a run, and then that happens," MTSU safety Michael Woods said. "Momentum seemed to shift their way, but we still had a quarter to play, and we still believed we had a chance to win."

However, MTSU was shut out in the fourth quarter and never made that final run.

"Once again we just have to come out and play," Youell said. "It's hard to play from behind anywhere. I don't know if it's lack of execution, but we have to find a way to finish drives and come out stronger."

SEMO 24, Middle Tennessee 14  
Sept. 28, 2002; Murfreesboro, TN

**MURFREESBORO, Tenn.** - The stage was set for the type of night MTSU football players had been waiting to realize for such a long time.

Perfect weather and the second-largest crowd in school history greeted the Blue Raiders for their home opener at Floyd Stadium where they would surely taste success for the first time this season against Southeast Missouri - a former OVC foe and I-AA football team.

MTSU had seen this all too often. Go on the road, collect the paycheck and at least head home knowing it had made some money for the trouble.

Too bad Southeast Missouri ruined the party.

The Indians didn't play their role though, ruining MTSU's home opener as they stunned the Blue Raiders 24-14 in front of 27,519 - the second-largest crowd to watch a game at Floyd Stadium. The loss sent MTSU to an 0-4 start, the school's worst such beginning since 1980.

"It starts with me, and we didn't get it done," MTSU coach Andy McCollum said Saturday. "We got beat by a team that played better than us. We didn't execute at times and that starts with me. This will never happen again."

Surely, once was enough.

SEMO (3-2) became the first non Division I-A opponent to beat MTSU since the Blue Raiders made the move into I-A in 1999, and the Indians did it in convincing fashion, trailing only once and successfully controlling the clock and moving the chains from the outset.

"I think Middle Tennessee came in and overlooked us," SEMO quarterback Jack Tomco said. "We earned their respect (Saturday). This win really puts us over the hump as we got to 3-2. I am really flying high."

As a result, MTSU appeared to be at an all-time low.

Players had a difficult time describing how the Indians came into their house and ended an 11-game winning streak.

How the Indians outgained them on offense by more than 100 yards.

How the Indians rushed for 203 yards, including a game-clinching 78-yard run by Keiki Misipeka with 4:26 to play that provided the opposition the final 24-14 margin.

"We just stunk it up," MTSU safety Will Martin said. "We underestimated, well, we have to

find a way to win. We can't take any team lightly and we came out (Saturday) and we lost to a school nowhere close to us. This team has not lost a home game in two years and we come out and play like we played. It's unacceptable."

MTSU, playing without tailback Dwone Hicks and offensive lineman Brandon Westbrook, started slow and really never recovered.

Ironically, the Blue Raiders scored first when Andrico Hines went in from the 1 on the team's first possession to stake MTSU to a 7-0 cushion.

Easy enough.

MTSU had its first lead and first points of the first quarter and the night really started looking good when Tony Sutton hauled in an interception on SEMO's ensuing possession.

However, the Blue Raiders bogged down and didn't score again in the first half, trailing 10-7 at the break.

"I'm really at a loss for words," quarterback Andrico Hines said. "We simply did not come out focused and ready to play. We did not take them seriously and we paid for it. You have to play your top game all the time, no matter who you are playing, and (Saturday) we didn't come out with our best effort."

If the Indians didn't have MTSU's respect before the game, they certainly did at the half.

Surely things would change, and it seemed that way when ReShard Lee scored from the 19 to give MTSU a 14-10 lead with 4:29 remaining in the third quarter.

It was short-lived.

SEMO came back and took a 17-14 lead when Tariq Simpson scored on a 17-yard pass play from Jack Tomco on a third-down play early in the fourth quarter.

After Brian Kelly misfired on a 33-yard field goal attempt that would have tied the game late - his first miss of the season, Keiki Misipeka reeled off a 78-yard run to seal the Blue Raiders' fate.

"Defensively we are going to look at how we hurt ourselves scheme-wise because they should not be able to run the football on us like that," McCollum said. "They shouldn't break a (78-yard) run; that's ridiculous."

Arkansas State 13, Middle Tennessee 7

**JONESBORO, Ark.** - Times have quickly changed for the MTSU football team.

And the same can be said for Arkansas State.

In their last meeting, MTSU dismantled Arkansas State, 54-6, to clinch a share of the Sun Belt Conference championship.

The Blue Raiders (0-5, 0-1), favorites to win the Sun Belt, were trying to explain a 13-7 setback to the Indians that left MTSU winless and put an early dent in their title hopes in front of 16,191 at Indians Stadium.

Meanwhile, Arkansas State (4-3, 2-0) won its third straight and has assumed early control of the league race after being picked to finish at the bottom of the conference race in the pre-season polls.

"In this conference you can lose one game and the bowl hopes and championship can be out the window," MTSU quarterback Andrico Hines said. "It's not over right now. Our goals are still ahead of us, but we have to get things figured out in a hurry. We have to find ways to win these games."

The Blue Raiders were their worst enemy in the loss, turning the ball over a season-high four times.

Three of those miscues led to 10 of Arkansas State's points.

"You've got to give Arkansas State credit," MTSU coach Andy McCollum said. "They did a good job. Finding positives at 0-5 is hard to do. We can't move the ball up and down the field and turn it over. We can't do that especially when you're struggling. When you are struggling and we are in a state where we are a struggling football team, you can't hurt yourself when you're doing that. We've got to make better decisions."

Despite its shortcomings, MTSU still had a chance to win the game on its final drive when Hines marched the Blue Raiders from their 8 to the Indians' 14.

Trailing 13-7, Hines faced a fourth-and-9 and appeared to keep the drive alive when he zipped a pass to receiver Tyrone Calico at the 1. After a delay, Calico was ruled out of bounds, ending the drive.

Calico had a different opinion.

"I am 100 percent sure I caught the ball in bounds," Calico said. "I saw the dirt fly from where my cleat went into the turf. I looked down when I made the catch, and I was inbounds. I'm sticking with that."

Arkansas State (4-3, 2-0) took over on downs and was able to pick up a first down and run out the clock as fans stormed the field.

"It's so hard to put into words," said Indians first-year coach Steve Roberts, who has won more games this season than the program had the two previous two years combined. "It's what we've been preaching about with the attitude, hard work and mental focus. We really played big at critical times, and there were some huge plays."

MTSU failed to get on the scoreboard in the first half as its five possessions resulted in two fumbles - both in ASU territory - a missed field goal and two punts.

Indians kicker Eric Neihouse turned the two turnovers into a pair of field goals, 19 yards and 27 yards, respectively, to stake his team to a 6-0 halftime lead. Neihouse missed an attempt at the half that would have extended the lead more.

"We were just trying to give our offense the best opportunity today and even though we held them to two field goals, that's too much," MTSU linebacker Sheldon Durham said. "Points period are too much. We needed to do better and maybe we would be talking about winning right now, not losing. This team has to find a way to win."

MTSU, which was led by 104 yards rushing from ReShard Lee and another 76 from Hines, dominated the second half and appeared to have things going in its favor.

The Blue Raiders rolled up 217 of their 330 yards total offense in the second half, while limiting the Indians to 55 yards total offense in the final 30 minutes.

Hines' 6-yard run capped a 80-yard drive to open the second half and provided the Blue Raiders with their only lead, a 7-6 edge, with 8:26 remaining in the stanza.

After holding the Indians to three-and-out; however, Indians defensive back Jonathan Burke intercepted a Hines pass and returned it 33 yards for a touchdown to regain the lead, 13-7.

MTSU's offense came storming back and had the ball at the Arkansas State 34 when Hines was intercepted in the end zone, ending another drive.

"Only we stop ourselves and we did that every time at key times," Hines said. "We've always felt only this offense can stop itself and that's exactly what happened in this game. That's just how I feel about it."

Hines was pulled in favor of freshman quarterback Josh Harris following his second interception. Harris, playing for the first time this season, played one series and then Hines returned to lead the final drive.

Tailback Danny Smith led ASU's offense with 154 yards rushing, but 133 of them came in the first half.

The Indians finished with 288 yards total offense.

"I was real proud of the way our kids played on defense," McCollum said. "They didn't allow a touchdown and they were put in some binds. It looked like they got better but we didn't get a win out of it."

# Game 6

Middle Tennessee 21, Vanderbilt 20  
Oct. 12, 2002; Nashville, TN

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** - It may not be given a catchy name or go down in college football lore, but MTSU fans will long remember the Blue Raiders' final drive at Vanderbilt.

The 53-yard effort, capped by a two-yard run from senior tailback Dwone Hicks with 52 seconds remaining, rallied the Blue Raiders to a 21-20 win against Vanderbilt in front of 28,660 at Vanderbilt Stadium.

But it was more than one riveting drive that sent MTSU (1-5) to its first win of the season and second straight against the Commodores in as many years. The encore performance by the Blue Raiders embodied the complete team effort coach Andy McCollum has been seeking all season.

And it was evident in the final minute because offense, defense and special teams alike played a part.

MTSU tied the score, 20-20, on Hicks' run and needed kicker Brian Kelly's extra point to take the lead. He split the uprights, then outside linebacker Brandon Lynch secured the win when he intercepted quarterback Benji Walker at the Vanderbilt 40 and returned the ball to the 3-yard-line, where Hines took a knee on consecutive snaps to complete the triumph.

"This was a complete win, and we came out with the attitude that we were not going to lose, no matter what happened," quarterback Andrico Hines said. "It was a tremendous team effort, and it took all of us to get this win. I'm just happy to have this win and be part of it."

It looked as though MTSU may have been in trouble when Hines was intercepted in the Vanderbilt end zone with less than five minutes remaining, but the Blue Raider defense forced the Commodores to go three and out and provided the offense a final chance at victory.

MTSU took possession at its 47 following a late hit on Vanderbilt and calmly marched 43 yards in six plays for the game-winning score.

"Our kids overcame adversity tonight. They learned how to win," McCollum said. "That Vanderbilt team right there was a very good football team. We throw the interception there at the end, and it looked like it was about to happen again. But our defense holds them, and Andrico leads us right back down. I couldn't be more proud of how he handled it."

The decisive touchdown was MTSU's only score of the second half and enabled the Blue

Raiders to come from behind after squandering a 14-3 halftime lead.

Sophomore tailback ReShard Lee led a ground attack that accounted for 213 of MTSU's 295 yards with a 144-yard effort on 20 carries, and Hicks helped to spark the team with his return to the field.

The senior tailback had missed the previous two games with a knee injury but returned against Vanderbilt and finished with 42 yards on 10 carries.

Hines passed for 82 yards and rushed for another 31, including a pair of first-half touchdowns.

After Greg Johnson led the Commodores (1-5) to an early 3-0 lead with his 18-yard field goal, MTSU scored 14 unanswered points on Hines scoring runs of 5 and 12 yards, respectively. However, the offense tended to bog in the second half, and Vanderbilt scored 17 unanswered points to pull ahead 21-14 on Walker's 3-yard run with 8:30 remaining.

That's when the defense stepped up, and the offense came of age.

"It feels good to win here two years in a row," Hicks said. "Hopefully this will jump start the second half of our year. We won here last year to start the season and had a great year and hopefully this will do the same."

MTSU's defense continued superlative play, limiting the Commodores to 287 yards - the fewest yards allowed this season - and hauled in a pair of interceptions. In addition to Lynch's game-clinching touchdown, junior corner Tony Sutton collected his second interception of the season in the first half to end a Vanderbilt drive at midfield.

"I've never really had a feeling like this," Sutton said. "I would be willing to do anything to keep them coming. We have been looking to put it all together as a team, and tonight we did that. We put forth a complete team effort, and when you do that, it's difficult not to win. We dug deep tonight and made it happen. We didn't give one away. We found a way to win."
