

#### First At-Bat, First Home Run

In his collegiate debut, redshirt-freshman hit a three-run home run against Oral Roberts. The home run came in his first at-bat on just the second pitch.

#### **New Faces**

#### **Tournament Trip**



#### **Scouting Memphis**

The Tigers went 1-2 in their opening weekend against Indiana, picking up a 6-3 win in game two of a doubleheader, Saturday.

After finishing last in the American Athletic Conference a season ago, the Tigers were once picked to be a the bottom of the standings again. ECU is the top dog in the AAC, sitting at #11 in the country.

Memphis returns four of its top five hitters by average, led by Cale Hennemann, who led the squad with a .299 average last season and hit .377 during league play. Junior Alec Trela seeks to build upon a successful 2018 at the plate after leading the team in RBI (39) and home runs (7).

While the Tigers have not hit any home runs so far this year, they do lead the AAC in doubles, led by Hunter Goodman with three.
