A win Saturday would give the Racers their fourth consecutive win over Eastern Illinois and would be the second-longest such streak in series history. MSU's longest winstreak in series history against the Panthers is five games and took place from 1994 to 1999 with the two teams not meeting in 1995.

With five rushing touchdowns already this season, including a record-tying four against Mississippi Valley, Preston Rice is on the precipice of becoming the first Racer quarterback to crack the top 10 in career rushing touchdowns. Rice currently has 14 career rushing touchdowns and needs just three to join the top 10 and tie with Derrick Cullors and Danny Lee Johnson with 17.

A NON-CONFERENCE AFFAIR

Due to late schedules caused by recent conference shuffle Murray State's contest against EIU will be a non-conference game. The last time the two teams met in a non-OVC contest was nearly 30 years ago in 1994. This year's OVC contest between the two teams will take place in Charleston Nov. 20 in the regular-season finale for both teams.

GAME 3 NOTES - BOWLING GREEN

A WIN SATURDAY WOULD...

A win Saturday would give the Racers their first victory over an FBS team since defeating Louisville in 1984.

STRIKING FIRST

Murray State's 7-0 lead last Saturday at Cincinnati was its first lead over an FBS team since the Racers held a 7-6 first quarter lead over Northern Illinois in 2015. It was also the first time since 2014 that the Racers scored first against an FBS team, when they did so against Missouri.

HOLDING THEIR OWN

The 45 points scored by the Bearcats are fewest by a Murray State FBS opponent since Louisville scored 22 in 2011.

GAME 2 NOTES - #7 CINCINNATI

A SIGNIFICANT SHUTOUT

The Racers notched their first shutout since 2011 when they beat Mississippi Valley, 39-0, in Itta Benna. In two games against the Delta Devils, 10 years apart, the Racers have outscored MVSU, 79-0.

THE 11TH MAN

Preston Rice tied a school record by scoring four touchdowns to become just the 11th Racer to accomplish the feat and the first quarterback. The other 10 Racers to score four rushing touchdowns in the same game are: Danny Lee Johnson ('78), Lindsey Hudspeth ('80), Rodney Payne ('85), Derrick Cullors ('95), David McCann ('95), Anthony Downs ('97), Billy Blanchard ('02), Stevie Chaney ('05), Mike Harris ('11) and Duane Brady ('13)

WHAAAT AAA RUSHHHHH!

- The Racer rushing attack netted 307 yards against MVSU, marking the first 300-plus yard game for MSU since 2018 and only the second against a Division I opponent since 2011.
- Thursday marked just the second time since 2012 that Murray State has scored five rushing touchdowns against a Division I opponent.
- Cortezz Jones ruled the rushing attack for Murray State with 107 yards, including a long of 69, and a touchdown.

LOCKDOWN D

Mississippi Valley's 162 total offensive yards Thursday is the least allowed by a Racer defense against a Division I opponent since 2004.

THE HOTTEST TICKET IN TOWN

The 6,874 fans attendance at The Track Thursday was the most for a Racer home opener since 2012.

AGAINST THE FBS

The Racers are 1-29-1 all-time against FBS opponents and 0-4 against Top 25 FBS opponents. Saturday's contest will mark the fourth time MSU has faced a top 10 opponent and the third time since 2012. The only time the Racers have defeated an FBS opponent was in 1984 when they beat Louisville, 24-23. One year later, the Racers traveled to Memphis where they battled the Tigers to a 10-10 tie.

GAME 1 NOTES - MISS. VALLEY

CLEAR THE TRACK

One of the greatest traditions in college football returns this season, as Racer 1 will once again make its way around the track following Murray State touchdowns. This year the horse, whose real name is Vegas, will be mounted for the second-consecutive season by senior Emily Helmick of St. Charles, Mo.

OVC ACCOLADES

For the first time since 1996, Murray State has been picked to win the OVC by a vote of the league's sports information directors and head coaches. In addition, the Racers led all OVC schools with 10 players named to the Preseason All-OVC Team.

THE INSIDE TRACK

PRETTY BOY FLOYD

Like the legendary bank robber, Marcis Floyd had his share of thefts last season, finishing the year with three interceptions and six pass breakups. His performance last season turned heads as has already been named to the Preseason All-OVC team, the preseason Stats Perform All-American team and initial watchlist for the Buck Buchanan award, given to the nation's top FCS defensive player.

RACER RETURNS

Coming off their first winning season in 10 years, the Racers will bring back all 22 starters and all 13 2020 OVC All-Conference selections.
