

#### ■ FAST FACTS

- >> Despite trailing by just six at the end of the third quarter, the Murray State Racers simply ran out of gas in the fourth and fell to 21st-ranked Southeast Louisiana, 48-14, in Hammond.
- » Saturday will be the 62nd all-time meeting between the Racers and the Skyhawks with Murray State leading the way in the all-time series, 38-22-1.
- » After starting the season 0-2 with a pair of FBS losses, Southeastern has now won two in a row including an upset of then No. 4 Incarnate Word, Saturday, 41-35.
- » Fourteenth-ranked UT Martin enters Saturday's contest at 3-2 overall and 2-0 in the OVC after defeating Tennessee Tech last week, 45-28.
- » UT Martin is currently averaging 36.0 points on 444.4 yards per game, while its opponents average 28.8 points on 398.2 yards per game. Offensively, the Skyhawks are more pass-focused averaging 264.0 yards in the air compared to 180.4 on the ground.
- » In their two OVC games, the Skyhawks have scored an average of 50.5 points by game and have defeated opponents by an average of 23.5 points.

**SCOUTING THE SKYHAWKS:** Fourteenth-ranked UT Martin enters Saturday's contest at 3-2 overall and 2-0 in the OVC after defeating Tennessee Tech last week, 45-28. In their two OVC games, the Skyhawks have scored an average of 50.5 points by game and have defeated opponents by an average of 23.5 points.

UT Martin is currently averaging 36.0 points on 444.4 yards per game, while its opponents average 28.8 points on 398.2 yards per game. Offensively, the Skyhawks are more passfocused averaging 264.0 yards in the air compared to 180.4 on the ground.

Dresser Winn has been one of the most accurate quarterbacks in the nation this season for UTM, completing 64.6 of his passes and tossing just one interception compared to 11 touchdowns. On the ground, Zak Wallace has been an absolute workhorse for the Skyhawks, averaging 100.2 yards per game and scoring the fourth-most rushing touchdowns in the nation at eight.

Defensively, UT Martin averages the 13th most sacks in the nation (3.2), 16th in tackles-for-loss (7.8) and sixth in defensive touchdowns (2). Individually, John Ford and Daylan Dotson currently lead the OVC in tackles-for-loss per game at 1.2 and 1.0, respectively, while Ford also leads the league in tackles per game at 9.6 and Dotson leads in sacks per game at 0.9.

**SERIES AT A GLANCE:** Saturday will be the 62nd all-time meeting between the Racers and the Skyhawks with Murray State leading the way in the all-time series, 38-22-1. The Racers also lead the series in Murray at 21-8-1 and have won each of the last two meetings at Roy Stewart Stadium. Despite a loss last year at UT Martin, the Racers have still won three of the last five meetings between the teams.

#### **FALL DOWN IN THE BAYOU**

Saturday should be a picture-perfect in Hammond with a high during the day of 84°F that will fall during gametime to an overnight low of 57°F. The is just a four-percent chance of rain Saturday evening with winds relatively low out of the northwest at 4-7 mph.

#### A QUICK STUDY

In his first football game since 2019 and his first collegiate start, redshirt sophomore quarterback made an immediate impact Saturday, taking just 10 plays to score his first touchdown.

#### **GAINS**

The Racers put up a season-high 407 yards against Eastern Illinois Saturday, marking the seventh time in the 22-game tenure of head coach Dean Hood that the MSU offense has put up 400 or more yards of offense.

#### **FINALLY FALL?**

After temps in the high 90's earlier this week, temperature at kickoff Saturday is predicted to be just 82° F. Saturday is expected to be slightly humid, around 40-percent, with just a six-percent chance of rain and winds out of the south-southwest at 8-14 mph.

#### STANDING THEIR GROUND

The Racer defense has been perfect on fourth down this season. Currently, MSU is just one of 17 teams nationally that have yet to allow an opponent to convert a fourth down in 2022.

#### **GRAB & GO**

Through three games this season, the Racers have picked off their opponents four times. The four interceptions currently leads the OVC and ranks the Racers 13th in all of the FCS.

#### FIRST TIME IN MUNCIE

Murray State makes the 294-mile trip to Scheumann Stadium for the first time in 2022. The matchup between the Cardinals and Racers is a first for the two sides.

#### **TURNER THE TURNOVER MAN**

Racers redshirt senior defensive back Quinaz Turner grabbed two interceptions against Jacksonville State in week two. Turner has nine career interceptions while totaling over 100 return yards on the plays.

#### **SHARING THE WEALTH**

Five Racers totaled at least four carries each in the MSU game against Jacksonville State. The Racers rushed for over 170 yards in the contest with Jawaun Northington leading the charge with 10 carries for 56 yards.

#### **ERIC THE GREAT**

Inside Linebacker Eric Samuta continues to lead the MSU defense with 13 tackles against JSU and 16 total for the season. Samuta now has 184 career tackles in 43 games played with 10 tackles-for-loss.

Murray State is 67-24-2 all-time in home openers and is 35-14 in home openers at Roy Stewart Stadium.

#### **CLEAR THE TRACK!**

One of the greatest traditions in college football returns this season, as Racer 1 will once again make its way around the track following Murray State touchdowns. This year the horse, whose real name is Vegas, will be mounted for by Madison Kirby of Louisville, Kentucky. Kirby is the 39th jockey in the history of the Racer I tradition.

#### ONE OF OUR OWN

After playing quarterback for the Racers from 2007 to 2009, Nico Yankto returned to Murray State earlier this month as the 10th director of athletics in Murray State history.

#### **AMONGST THE GREATS**

With a 51-yard catch Saturday against Texas Tech, LaMartez Brooks moved into the career top 10 in receiving yards for Murray State with 1,855, ranking him ninth all-time in the pantheon of great Racer receivers.

#### THE CENTURY CLUB

Aaron Baum was 1-for-1 on both field goals and PATs Saturday at Texas Tech giving him 100 career points and moving him to 11th all-time in career field goals with 20. Baum is now 20-for-29 on field goals in his career as a Racer.

The Neslers are not the only biological brothers on the team, as identical twins Jared and Jarad McCray also return to Racers for their fourth season.

#### HEAD WEST TO THE LONE STAR STATE

There are 948 miles between Roy Stewart Stadium in Murray and Jones AT&T Stadium in Lubbock, thus making Saturday's fame the farthest the Racers have played from Murray since 2004 when they travelled 1,096 miles to UConn.
