NOTABLES

SOPHIE CUNNINGHAM BREAKS SCORING RECORD WITH 42 POINTS

- Freshman guard **Sophie Cunningham** broke the Mizzou single-game scoring record with 42 points in Sunday evening's 94-81 victory over Wake Forest at Mizzou Arena. It was just her fourth game in a Tigers uniform.
- The 42 points are the most scored by any NCAA Division I player this season.
- Cunningham broke the previous record of 41 points held by Renee Kelly in a Jan. 25, 1986 contest vs. Oklahoma at the Hearn Center, a mark that held for nearly 30 years. Kelly ranks second in Mizzou history in scoring with 2,119 career points from 1984-87.
- Cunningham finished 13-for-18 from the field, 6-for-8 from 3-point range and 10-for-12 from the free throw line.
- In the first half alone, Cunningham scored 25 points and was 9-for-10 from the field, 4-for-5 from 3-point range and 3-for-3 from the foul line.
- It was the first 30-plus point performance for Mizzou since Bri Kulas had 30 vs. LSU on Jan. 16, 2014 at Mizzou Arena.
- She also added eight rebounds (seven in the first half), four assists and three steals in the record-breaking performance.
- Cunningham's highest point total during her Rock Bridge High School (Columbia, Mo.) career was 32.
- Through four games, Cunningham leads the SEC in scoring with 21.5 points per contest.

CUNNINGHAM NAMED INITIAL SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

- Freshman guard **Sophie Cunningham** was named SEC Freshman of the Week on Tuesday.
- Cunningham had the most impressive freshman debut of the **Robin Pingeton** era in the season opener at Missouri State on Nov. 13, finishing with a double-double of 23 points and 10 rebounds (five offensive) to go along with a game-high five assists (tied with older sister, Lindsey), three steals and one block.
- Cunningham is the first McDonald's High School All-American to join Mizzou Women's Basketball.
- During her prep career at Rock Bridge High School in Columbia, Missouri, Cunningham and fellow freshman **Cierra Porter** led their team to four consecutive Missouri Class 5 state championships.
- Cunningham was invited to play in the 2015 Jordan Brand Classic in New York, New York.
- She was the 2015 Co-Miss Show-Me Basketball.
- Cunningham was the 2014 and 2015 Missouri Class 5 Player of the Year.
- In 2014, she was named the *USA Today* Gatorade Missouri Player of the Year.

FAMILY MATTERS

- Mizzou features the only NCAA Division I Women's Basketball team in the country with three sets of sisters on the roster in senior twins **Maddie** and **Morgan Stock**, redshirt junior **Lindsey Cunningham** and freshman **Sophie Cunningham** and sophomore forward **Bri Porter** and freshman forward **Cierra Porter**.
- Assistant coach **Michael Porter** is the father of both **Bri** and **Cierra Porter**. Porter is also the brother-in-law of head coach **Robin Pingeton**.
- The Cunninghams come from a long line of Mizzou athletes, including both parents (football and track and field), a grandfather (football), aunt (women's basketball) and uncle (football).

TIGERS ALLOW LEAST POINTS SINCE 2010 AGAINST UAPB

- In the 85-34 victory over Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Nov. 16, Mizzou allowed limited its opponent to the lowest point total since a 53-30 victory over UT Martin on Dec. 7, 2010.
- Mizzou has now held it last two opponents under 40 points for the first time since Dec. 10 and Dec. 13, 2009 when Mizzou achieved the feat vs. Texas-Pan American and Murray State.
- The Tigers outscored UAPB 69-23 over the final three quarters on Monday.
- Mizzou outscored UAPB 31-10 in the second quarter, 19-4 in the third quarter and 19-9 in the final period.
- The Tigers outscored UAPB 44-10 in points in the paint, 21-2 in points off of turnovers, 17-0 in second-chance points, 12-2 in fast break points and 56-4 in bench points.
- For the game, Mizzou held UAPB to a 29 percent (15-for-52) field goal percentage and a 20 percent (3-for-15) shooting percentage from beyond the 3-point arc.
- The 51-point margin of victory was the largest for Mizzou since defeating Bradley by 71 points in a record-setting 126-55 victory at Mizzou Arena on Dec. 8, 2013.

TIGERS SNAP WICHITA STATE'S 17-GAME HOME WINNING STREAK; HOLD SHOCKERS TO FEWEST POINTS AT HOME IN NEARLY 26 YEARS

- In the 57-37 victory at Wichita State on Nov. 18, Mizzou snapped the Shockers' 17-game home winning streak in record fashion.
- The 37 points are the fewest WSU has scored in a home game since Dec. 18, 1989 vs. Missouri-Kansas City.
- Mizzou outscored Wichita State in all four quarters, including 16-10 in both the second and fourth periods.
- The Tigers outscored the Shockers 24-8 in the paint, 7-0 in second-chance points and 22-11 in bench scoring.
- **Sierra Michaelis** had a game-high 13 points on 4-for-7 shooting, including a 3-for-5 mark from beyond the 3-point arc. She also added four rebounds, two assists and two steals.
- **Jordan Frericks** added 12 points, six rebounds, two assists and a block.
- **Sophie Cunningham** scored 10 points with five boards, two assists, two steals and a block.

ABOUT SIU EDWARDSVILLE...

- The Cougars are 1-2 overall following a victory vs. Northern Illinois (11/13) and losses at Western Illinois (11/15) and Oklahoma State (11/20).
- SIUE is the Ohio Valley Conference preseason favorite.
- **Shronda Butts** leads the OVC in scoring with 24.7 points per game. She scored 23 at Oklahoma State on Friday.
- Butts was named the OVC Preseason Player of the Year.
- She averaged 15.6 points and 3.5 rebounds per game last season.

NOTABLES

FRERICKS' SOPHOMORE SEASON MAKES MARK ON RECORD BOOK

- Junior forward **Jordan Frericks** had an outstanding sophomore season last year when she was the team's leader in scoring, rebounds and blocks with 13.2 points, 9.9 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per game, respectively. Her rebounding total led the SEC and ranked 36th in the country.
- Frericks was named second-team All-SEC by the league's coaches and earned honorable mention All-SEC honors from the *Associated Press*.
- In 2014-15, Frericks registered 12 double-doubles, including a string of five straight games from Jan. 25 - Feb. 8.
- On five occasions, Frericks scored 20 or more points.
- Frericks was named the SEC Player of the Week on March 1 after averaging 12.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game for the week in leading the team to victories at No. 12 Texas A&M and vs. Arkansas to close the regular season.
- Frericks scored in double figures 23 times last year and reached double digits on the boards in 15 contests.

- Senior guard **Maddie Stock** move into sole possession for seventh in program history with 114 career 3-pointers on Nov. 16 vs. UAPB. She also ranks fourth in career history with 375 attempted 3-pointers.
- In 14 contests last season, Stock drained multiple shots from beyond the arc, including a career-best four on five separate occasions.
- Stock drained a career-high 54 triples last season, including a dramatic buzzer beater to defeat No. 12 Texas A&M in College Station on Feb. 26, 2015 to snap the Aggies' 17-game home winning streak.

BRI PORTER RECOVERS NICELY FROM 4TH TORN ACL

- Sophomore forward **Bri Porter** has bounced back from a season-ending torn anterior cruciate ligament in her left knee during the 12th game of last season.
- The torn ACL was the fourth of Porter's high school and college basketball career, but the first to her left knee.
- Porter recorded season-highs with 16 points and eight rebounds (five offensive) vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Nov. 16.
- Through four games, Porter is averaging 5.3 points, 2.5 rebounds, 1.3 steals and 11.0 minutes per game.

FAST BREAK FACTS...

LINDSEY CUNNINGHAM FROM LONG RANGE

- ▶ Redshirt junior guard **Lindsey Cunningham** was a perfect 3-for-3 from beyond the arc in Friday's season-opening win.
- ▶ She drained a crucial triple with 2:41 remaining to increase the lead to 58-52 following a beautiful pass from junior guard **Sierra Michaelis**.
- ▶ It marked the first time in Cunningham's career that she has connected on three 3-pointers in a single contest.
- ▶ Cunningham sank two of her triples during the second half and hit the Tigers' lone 3-pointer during the first half.

CUNNINGHAMS DROPPING DIMES

- ▶ Sisters **Sophie Cunningham** and **Lindsey Cunningham** lead the team in assists with 14 and 13, respectively.
- ▶ They each tied for a game-high with five assists each on Nov. 13 at Missouri State.
- ▶ Sophie dished out five assists in the second half while Lindsey recorded three assists over the game's final 20 minutes.
- ▶ Last season, Lindsey led the Tigers with 91 total assists, good for an average of 2.8 per contest.
- ▶ Lindsey had a game-high six assists in Sunday's victory over Wake Forest.

TIGERS DOMINATE 4TH QUARTER AT MISSOURI STATE

- ▶ Mizzou outscored Missouri State 27-8 in the 71-55 victory at the JQH Arena in Springfield on Nov. 13.
- ▶ The Tigers held a 10-4 advantage in points in the paint and a 6-0 margin in second-chance opportunities during the final 10 minutes.
- ▶ Over the game's final 1:14, Mizzou went on an 8-0 run, including four free throws from Cunningham and two from **Jordan Frericks**.

MISSOURI CRASHES THE BOARDS IN OPENER

- ▶ The Tigers recorded a 53-27 rebounding average against Missouri State on Nov. 13.
- ▶ In the first quarter alone, Mizzou outrebounded the Bears 19-8.
- ▶ Three Mizzou players - **Michelle Hudyn** (13), **Sophie Cunningham** (10) and **Jordan Frericks** - notched double-digit totals on the boards.
- ▶ Hudyn set a career-high with 13 rebounds (three offensive) in the game, besting her previous high of nine at LSU on Feb. 2, 2015. Five of Cunningham's 10 rebounds were on the offensive end.
- ▶ "We felt like the team that won the rebounding battle would win the game," head coach **Robin Pingeton** said during the postgame press conference.
- ▶ Last season's team rebounding high was 55 boards vs. UNLV in a 79-60 victory on Nov. 21, 2014 during the Wahine Classic in Honolulu, Hawai'i.
- ▶ Mizzou recorded 50 or more rebounds in four games last year - vs. UNLV (11/21/14), vs. Milwaukee (11/30/14), vs. Florida (1/11/15) and at Kansas State (3/22/15) in the second round of the WNIT.

MICHAELIS HEATING UP FROM BEYOND THE ARC

- ▶ Junior guard **Sierra Michaelis** has drained seven 3-pointers over the last two games, including four on Sunday vs. Wake Forest.
- ▶ She is shooting 8-for-21 (38.1 percent) overall from beyond the arc and was 3-for-5 from long range at Wichita State on Nov. 18.
- ▶ Michaelis scored 13 points - including three treys - in the first quarter on Sunday against Wake.
- ▶ She finished the game with a season-high 18 points, including four triples.

THREE STRAIGHT WINNING SEASONS FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 1987-90

- ▶ Mizzou Women's Basketball has recorded three consecutive winning seasons for the first time since 1987-90.
- ▶ The Tigers finished 19-14 last season, 17-14 in 2013-14 and 17-15 in 2012-13 as **Robin Pingeton's** squads have continually improved each year.
- ▶ All three seasons have included postseason trips to the WNIT.
- ▶ Last year, the Tigers advanced to the quarterfinals of the WNIT after winning 69-61 in the first round at Northern Iowa on March 19, 2015 and a 67-48 win at Kansas State on March 22, 2015 during a record-setting performance that included nine 3-pointers from guard **Morgan Eye** (now a graduate student manager with the program) to tie for the most in a single game in WNIT history. Mizzou was 16-for-37 from beyond the arc during the second-round victory that also featured a program postseason-record 50 rebounds.

PINGETON RECORDS 80TH WIN ON MISSOURI SIDELINE

- ▶ Friday's win at Missouri State was the 80th for head coach **Robin Pingeton** at Mizzou.
- ▶ She is 83-79 (.512) since joining Mizzou prior to the 2010-11 campaign.
- ▶ Over the last three-plus years, the Tigers have gone 57-43.
- ▶ The 19 victories in 2014-15 were the most since the 2005-06 campaign.
- ▶ With two postseason victories last season, the program advanced to the quarterfinals of the WNIT for the first time since the 2002-03 season.
- ▶ Throughout her career, Pingeton has coached 31 all-conference players, seven Academic All-Americans, six All-Americans, four conference players of the year and has led her teams to three regular season conference championships, two postseason conference titles and 13 postseason tournament appearances.
- ▶ She has been named a conference coach of the year twice.

MISSOURI RECEIVES VOTES IN AP TOP 25 POLLS

- ▶ Mizzou received five votes in the *Associated Press* Top 25 poll released on Monday.
- The Tigers received three votes in the first two *AP* Top 25 polls.

MICHAELIS & SOPHIE SCORE GAME'S FIRST 30

- ▶ On Sunday against Wake Forest, **Sierra Michaelis** and **Sophie Cunningham** scored the first 30 points for the Tigers over the game's first 13:27.
- ▶ Michaelis (13) and Cunningham (11) scored all 24 of Mizzou's points in the first quarter.
- ▶ In the first quarter alone, the duo was 9-for-14 from the floor and 4-for-8 from beyond the 3-point arc.
- ▶ Sophie Cunningham had six rebounds in the first quarter while her sister, Lindsey, added five.
- ▶ Cunningham scored Mizzou's first six points of the second quarter on two 3-pointers before Lindsey made two free throws with 6:33 remaining before halftime.

TIGERS RECEIVE PROGRAM'S HIGHEST PICK IN SEC PRESEASON POLLS

- ▶ Mizzou was picked sixth in the SEC Coaches Preseason Poll and seventh in the poll of the league's media members.
- ▶ The Tigers received 94 points in the coaches poll released on Nov. 10 and 165 points in the media poll that was released on Oct. 20.

MISSOURI RANKED 20TH NATIONALLY IN REBOUNDING MARGIN

- ▶ The Tigers are ranked 20th in the country with a +15.3 rebounding margin.
- ▶ Mizzou had a season-high 53 rebounds in the opener at Missouri State, followed by 49 vs. UAPB. Following a 33-board effort at Wichita State, the Tigers responded with a 42-rebound effort in Sunday evening's win over Wake Forest.
- ▶ Against both Wake Forest and UAPB, Mizzou has grabbed a season-best 16 offensive boards.

MISSOURI SIGNS THREE PREP STANDOUT GUARDS

- ▶ On National Signing Day, Wednesday, Nov. 11, Mizzou inked guards **Jordan Chavis** (Lexington, N.C./Central Davidson), **Jordan Roundtree** (St. Louis, Mo./Kirkwood) and **Amber Smith** (Shreveport, La./Loyola College Prep).
- ▶ Chavis drained a team-best 45 shots from beyond the arc for a New Hope squad that went 29-2, won the National Independent School Athletic Association National Championship and finished last season ranked No. 24 nationally by *USA Today*.
- ▶ Roundtree is ranked the No. 148 recruit nationally by *Blue Star Report*.
- ▶ Smith is a three-year all-state honoree and set a school record with 41 points in a single game last year.
- ▶ "We feel honored and blessed to have them join our basketball family," head coach **Robin Pingeton** said. "They are winners on and off the court and will be great additions to our program. They all possess a great understanding of the game with a high basketball IQ and will fit very well with our style of play. It is very transparent in all three of them that they are passionate about the game, they understand the importance of team and they are self-motivated."
- ▶ On Chavis, "Jordan has great court vision and a very high basketball IQ," Pingeton said. "She has great handles and can score in a variety of ways."
- ▶ On Roundtree, "Jordan is an incredible athlete. I don't think she has even come close to reaching her potential," Pingeton said. "She also can score in a variety of ways and can create havoc on the defensive end."
- ▶ On Smith, "Amber is a very versatile and explosive athlete," Pingeton said. "She has a scorer's mentality. She has the ability to take over games on both the offensive and defensive end."

FAST BREAK FACTS...

#OURTOWNOURTEAM

► Mizzou Women's Basketball has established a hashtag motto for the 2015-16 season. #OurTownOurTeam honors the incredibly loyal supporters in the region that inspire our team and create a homecourt advantage at Mizzou Arena.

► Nine of the players on the Tigers' 2015-16 roster hail from the state of Missouri, including four from right in the backyard in Columbia.

► Mizzou Women's Basketball puts a heavy emphasis on being active in the community and the Tigers completed over 325 hours of community service last academic year to earn the Mizzou Athletics Community Service Award for the second time in five years.

► Since **Robin Pingeton** took over as head coach prior to the 2010-11 season, the team has completed over 1,567 hours of community service. Director of Basketball Operations **Heather Buechter** is instrumental in establishing relationships and scheduling many of the activities within the Columbia and surrounding communities in mid-Missouri. Redshirt junior point guard **Lianna Doty** was named to the SEC Community Service Team in 2014.

DOTY, McDOWELL, PORTER RETURN FROM INJURIES

► Last season, three impact players suffered season-ending injuries for the Tigers. Guard **Lianna Doty** and forwards **Kayla McDowell** and **Bri Porter** all went down for the year within the season's first 12 games.

► All three players have worked relentlessly throughout rehabilitation programs and returned to the court in time for the season opener.

► Doty suffered a Lisfranc fracture in her foot while McDowell and Porter both tore the ACL in their knees. For Porter, it was the fourth ACL tear she has suffered throughout her high school and collegiate playing career.

DOTY CONTINUES PURSUIT OF ASSISTS RECORD

► Point guard **Lianna Doty** missed last season but still ranks fifth in Mizzou career history with 329 assists. She is eight assists away from tying current Tigers assistant coach **RaeShara Brown** for No. 4 on the all-time list.

► Doty recorded the third-highest single-season assist total in 2013-14 with 175 and the fifth-best mark by a Mizzou passer with 151 as a freshman in 2012-13.

FRESHMEN CLASS HIGHEST-RANKED IN TEAM HISTORY

► This season's freshmen class including guard **Sophie Cunningham** and forwards **Cierra Porter** and **Hannah Schuchts** was ranked the No. 14 recruiting class nationally by *Blue Star Report*.

► Cunningham and Porter lead Rock Bridge High School in Columbia to four consecutive Missouri Class 5 state titles.

► Cunningham was ranked the No. 14 recruit in the country by *Blue Star Report* while Porter was listed as the No. 37 high school player nationally by *All Star Girls Report*. Schuchts ranked the No. 59 forward in the country by *ESPN HoopGurlz* and was the Big Bend Conference Defensive Player of the Year in 2014-15 after averaging 10.0 rebounds and 3.0 blocks per game.

FIRST McDONALD'S ALL-AMERICAN JOINS PROGRAM

► Freshman guard **Sophie Cunningham** is the first McDonald's All-American to join the Mizzou Women's Basketball program. Cunningham was a four-time Class 5 state champion at Rock Bridge High School in Columbia and was ranked the No. 14 prospect in the country by *Blue Star Report* and No. 20 recruit by *ESPN HoopGurlz*. She played in the 2015 Jordan Brand Classic in New York. She was invited to the USA Basketball U19 World Championships Team Trials in May, the USA Basketball U18 National Team Trials in 2014 and also played in the 2013 USA Basketball 3-on-3 National Tournament.

► Cunningham was the 2014 *USA Today* Gatorade Missouri Girls Basketball Player of the Year and Missouri Class 5 Player of the Year as a junior and senior.

► She was named 2015 Co-Miss Show Me Basketball and was also the Missouri Basketball Coaches Association Player of the Year in 2014-15.

► In June, Cunningham became the first high school player to earn the Kiwanis Club Don Faurot Sportsman of the Year Award in Columbia. The honor - named after Mizzou's legendary former head football coach and director of athletics - was established in 1991 to honor an outstanding candidate who contributes to the local sports community as an athlete, coach, administrator or official.

► Cunningham set a school record with 1,983 points during her prep career and had her No. 3 jersey retired following her senior season in which she averaged 21.1 points, 7.3 rebounds, 4.3 assists and 2.9 steals per game.

► She was a three-time recipient of the *Columbia Daily Tribune* Player of the Year award.

► Cunningham verbally committed to Mizzou following her eighth grade year.

► She was also a standout in volleyball, track and field and even joined the Rock Bridge football team as a kicker during the fall of her senior year, becoming the first female in school history to score a point on the gridiron.

FORMER STANDOUT BROWN JOINS COACHING STAFF

► **RaeShara Brown** transitioned into an assistant coaching role after spending the last year as Director of Recruiting & Player Development.

► She has been a member of the coaching staff since 2012-13, joining first as a graduate student manager.

► Brown and fellow assistant **Michael Porter** share responsibilities in helping develop the Tiger guards.

► A mainstay in the backcourt from 2007-11, Brown's natural leadership and hard-nosed style of play endeared her to Mizzou fans.

► Brown is the program's all-time leader with 273 career steals, including 88 in 2010-11, which ranks third in single-season history.

► The native of Little Rock, Arkansas, earned a bachelor's degree in Nutritional Sciences from Mizzou in 2011 and a master's in Educational Psychology in 2014.

COX TAKES OVER DIRECTOR OF RECRUITING ROLE

► **Willie Cox** transitioned from assistant coach and has now taken over recruiting operations for the program.

► Cox works with the rest of the staff to maintain successful recruiting efforts and works diligently to provide the best experience for potential players visiting campus.

► He has been a member of **Robin Pingeton's** staff since the 2003-04 season at Illinois State.

EYE REMAINS WITH PROGRAM, JOINS STAFF

► Mizzou's all-time 3-point champion **Morgan Eye** completed her eligibility following last season and has remained with the program as a graduate student manager.

► Eye finished her Tigers career with 367 baskets from 3-point range, which is 141 more than Alyssa Hollins (2006-09) in second place.

► She ranks 12th in program history with 1,374 career points.

► With a 38.9 percent career shooting marking from long range, Eye closed her Mizzou career by ranking 43rd nationally in 2014-15 with 2.6 triples per game.

► She is pursuing a master's degree in Educational, School & Counseling Psychology with an emphasis in Positive Coaching.

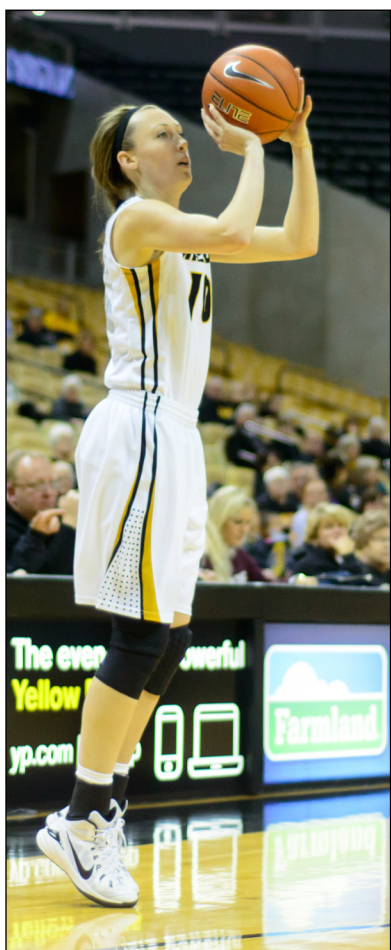
