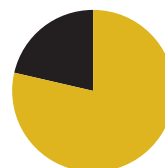

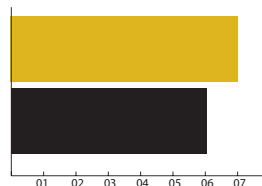

- ▶ Mizzou Men's Basketball (8-7, 1-1) hosts Arkansas (8-7, 2-1) for more Southeastern Conference action at Mizzou Arena on Tuesday, Jan. 12 with an 8 p.m. tipoff on the SEC Network.
- ▶ Head coach **Kim Anderson's** squad fired back with a 76-61 win over Auburn (Jan. 9) to level its record in SEC play after an opening setback at Georgia (Jan. 6). The Tigers outrebounded Auburn, 41-34, and sank 25 free throws while Auburn only attempted 24.
- ▶ A big part of Mizzou's win over Auburn was the play of freshman forward **Kevin Puryear**, who recorded his first career double-double with 14 points and a season-high 11 rebounds.
- ▶ Puryear also dropped in 19 points in the game at Georgia (Jan. 6).
- ▶ Puryear now leads Mizzou in rebounding with his 4.9-per-game average. Sophomore guard **Namon Wright** just trails him with his 4.8 boards per game, while freshman **Terrence Phillips** leads the Tigers in assists, averaging 3.4 per game.

Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** ranks seventh in the Southeastern Conference with his 80.9-percent free throw shooting mark. Puryear has connected on 55-of-68 foul shots.



The Tigers are averaging 69.7 points per game through 15 games this season, bettering its 60.5 average from a season ago.

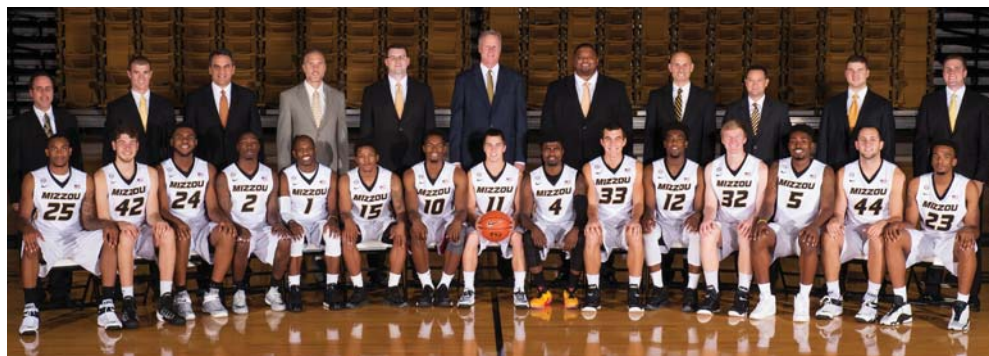
In his second season leading the Mizzou Men's Basketball program, head coach **Kim Anderson** continues to turn the Tigers in the right direction, both on and off the court. With five newcomers on the 2015-16 roster that his staff personally recruited, Anderson hopes a higher comfort level and familiarity amongst his squad will translate into better team basketball. The Tigers already did their part in the offseason, posting the highest summer session grade point average for a Mizzou team in more than five seasons.

The Tiger leader took on the role of architect during the summer of 2014, beginning with establishing an identity for the Mizzou program. It would be built to last, with sturdy roots of character, discipline and competitiveness to reignite the passion of the many Black & Gold fans who clamor into Mizzou Arena. The first step was finding student-athletes, so Anderson and his staff brought in five freshmen and a graduate transfer for a total of six new faces. The following step was to get the newcomers and returning players to work as a team, which is not as simple of a process as it sounds.

Anderson knew sustained success could start with bumps in the road, and as the inexperience and unfamiliarity between his Tigers began to show down the stretch of the 2014-15 season, it became clear that changes would need to be made. Following Mizzou's 9-23 season, Anderson made it known what he and his staff's focuses would be going forward into the offseason. For the offseason, the Tiger coaching staff emphasized academic achievement, staff efficiency, athletic performance, team chemistry and a targeted recruiting focus.

NOTEWORTHY NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

- Mizzou improved to 8-1 at Mizzou Arena this season with the 76-61 win over Auburn (Jan. 9).
- The Tigers' 15-point win was the largest over a Southeastern Conference opponent since Mizzou defeated Mississippi State, 85-66, on March 1, 2014.
- Mizzou's 15-point halftime advantage (39-24) was the largest over an SEC foe since a 16-point lead (38-22) over South Carolina on Jan. 25, 2014.
- The Tigers received 40 points from the bench in the win, compared to only five bench points for Auburn.
- Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** notched his first career double-double with 14 points and a career-high 11 rebounds vs. Auburn.
- Sophomore guard **Tramaine Isabell** tallied a season-best 12 points, only two off his career high.
- Sophomore guard **Namon Wright** reached double figures after a 10-point night to mark his fifth double-digit scoring output of the season and the 12th of his Tiger career.
- Freshman guard **K.J. Walton** was Mizzou's fourth player to reach double figures in scoring, with 10 points against Auburn. His total was only one point off his career best of 11 (vs. Maryland-Eastern Shore) and marked the fifth double digit output of his career. Walton also had three steals in the contest, which is a season-best.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR PURYEAR AMONG THE LATEST

- Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** became the first Mizzou player to record a double-double (14 points, 11 rebounds vs. Auburn on Jan. 9) since March 7, 2015, when sophomore forward Johnathan Williams, III posted 10 points and 12 rebounds on the road at Mississippi State.
- Puryear has scored 187 points through 15 games (12.5) in his first collegiate season, putting him on within reach of Mizzou's all-time freshman scoring leaders. **Steve Stipanovich** (1979-80) finished his freshman campaign with 445 points and had 241 through 15 games. **Derrick Chievous** (1984-85) scored 177 points in 15 games before finishing his freshman season with 418 points.
- **Nathan Buntin** (1986-87) and **Kelly Thames** (1993-94) scored 212 points and 177 points in 15 games, respectively.
- Puryear's 11 rebounds also match the Mizzou team's season-high mark for an individual. Sophomore **Jakeenan Gant** hauled in 11 boards vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29).

PEARL COMES AWAY IMPRESSED WITH MIZZOU

- Mizzou came out swinging against Auburn in its Southeastern Conference home opener (Jan. 9), taking a 15-point halftime lead that was the Tigers' largest lead at the break in a league game since the 2013-14 season (38-22 vs. South Carolina, Jan. 25, 2014). Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl had the following to say postgame:

"I thought Missouri played well, they're a talented team. They have a lot of good young talent, 10 guys who played double digit minutes and five guys in double digit scoring. They have great balance, we got beat 40-5 off the bench. They play better at home because they're a young team and they'll beat people in here."

MORE ABOUT ARKANSAS

- Arkansas (8-7, 2-1) opened Southeastern Conference action with a road loss at Texas A&M (Jan. 2), but has since rebounded with wins over Vanderbilt (90-85 OT, Jan. 5) and Mississippi State (82-68, Jan. 9). In true road games this season, head coach **Mike Anderson's** Razorbacks are 0-3.
- Senior guard **Anthlon Bell** leads the Razorbacks with his 17.3 scoring average, with junior forward **Moses Kingsley** and junior guard **Dusty Hannahs** not far behind with averages of 16.8 and 16.3 points per game, respectively.
- Arkansas has shot 51.9 percent from three-point range in its three SEC games, a mark that leads the league.

LAST TIME VS. ARKANSAS

- Mizzou shot 50.0 percent from the field for just the third time that season, but it was not enough to slow Arkansas as the Tigers dropped an 84-69 result in Bud Walton Arena on Feb. 18, 2015.
- Four Tigers scored in double figures, with three of them coming from Mizzou's then-freshman class. **Tramaine Isabell**, scored 13, while **Jakeenan Gant** had 11.

PURYEAR PUTTING UP POINTS

- ▶ Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** leads Mizzou with his 12.5 points per game average, which also **ranks fourth in the SEC among freshmen**.
- ▶ Puryear's hot free throw shooting clip of 80.9 percent (55-of-68) also ranks seventh overall in the conference.

BLOCK PARTY

- ▶ Mizzou sophomore forward **Jakeenan Gant** recorded four blocks vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29), a career-high night and the most blocks this season by a Tiger.
- ▶ Gant posted his fifth multiple block game of the season with his two swats vs. Auburn (Jan. 6).
- ▶ Gant has recorded a block in 12-of-15 games and has a team-leading 19 so far in the 2015-16 campaign.

CLARK CATCHING FIRE

- ▶ Junior guard **Wes Clark** set a new career-high with 22 points vs. Savannah State (Jan. 2) on 9-of-10 shooting. He followed that up with 13 points in Mizzou's SEC opener at Georgia (Jan. 6). Clark scored in double-digits in four consecutive games from Dec. 23-Jan. 6.
- ▶ Clark did not miss a single shot in the first half vs. Savannah State. Clark was 5-of-5 from the field, including 1-of-1 from beyond the three-point line and 1-of-1 from the free throw line.
- ▶ Clark has led Mizzou in scoring three times this season after doing so in five games during the 2014-15 campaign.

GETTING GANT GOING

- ▶ After averaging just 2.5 points per game in Mizzou's first six games of the season (15 points), sophomore forward **Jakeenan Gant** has found a rhythm coming off the bench for the Tigers. Gant has averaged 7.0 points per game over the last nine games (63 points), including two 11-point efforts vs. Northern Illinois (Dec. 4) and Omaha (Dec. 9).
- ▶ Gant has also impacted Mizzou's rebounding, as the forward has pulled down 5.2 boards per game over the last nine games (47). That more than doubles his six-game average to start the 2015-16 season (1.7).

FRESHMEN CAN FIND THE LINE

- ▶ Both **K.J. Walton** and **Kevin Puryear** have posted 9-of-10 games from the free throw line this season, both marks that tie for game highs for Mizzou this season.
- ▶ Puryear hit on 9-of-10 from the charity stripe in recent action at Georgia (Jan. 6), while Walton accomplished the feat vs. Maryland-Eastern Shore (Nov. 15).

FINISHED NONCONFERENCE IN STYLE

- ▶ Mizzou finished its nonconference schedule the way it should with big victories over visitors to Mizzou Arena, first with the 53-point win (78-25) over Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29). That win was the Tigers largest margin of victory over an opponent since defeating Central Arkansas by the same amount in a 116-63 win in 2010.
- ▶ The 25 points allowed by the Tigers in that victory were the fewest ever allowed by a Mizzou team inside Mizzou Arena and the fewest by a Mizzou team since Jan. 3, 1947, against Iowa State when Mizzou won, 36-25.
- ▶ Mizzou also held UAPB to an all-time opponent low 15.4-percent field goal shooting mark. The previous was 18.3-percent by UAPB in 1998.
- ▶ The Tigers defeated Savannah State, 81-50, for a 31-point victory on Jan. 2, bringing Mizzou's two-game stretch to a whopping 84-point differential. That 84-point differential was Mizzou's largest since outscoring its opponents by 99 points in games vs. Texas Pan-American (100-44, Nov. 22, 2009) and Chattanooga (99-56, Nov. 24, 2009).

PSYCHO REBOUNDING

- ▶ Mizzou has worked to establish itself on the boards as a noticeably shorter squad. In fact, the Tigers rank 267th in all of Division I basketball in average height with a roster average of 76.2 inches, or 6 feet, 3.5 inches (according to Ken Pomeroy).
- ▶ The Tigers recorded the second +10 rebounding margin game of the Kim Anderson Era against Illinois (Dec. 23), 43-32 (+11).
- ▶ Mizzou followed that up with its first 50-rebound game in more than two seasons. The Tigers racked up 56 rebounds against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29). The last time Mizzou grabbed 50 or more rebounds was on Feb. 9, 2013, with 50 vs. Ole Miss.
- ▶ The Tigers kept the momentum on the boards going in their game vs. Savannah State (Jan. 2). Mizzou outrebounded Savannah State, 40-30, the seventh time this season Mizzou has outrebounded its opponent. The Tigers have outrebounded its opponent in six of their seven wins.
- ▶ The 40-30 rebounding margin was the third time in the **Kim Anderson** era Mizzou has outrebounded its opponent by +10 or more.

ALWAYS BETTER TO GIVE

- ▶ Mizzou recorded 19 assists (on 27 field goals) as a team in the 78-25 win vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29), the highest total of assists in the Kim Anderson era.

#RALLYFORRHAN

Rhyan Loos, the 5-year-old daughter of assistant Mizzou coach Brad Loos and his wife, Jen, has been diagnosed with neuroblastoma, a type of pediatric cancer. The Mizzou Men's Basketball program will be supporting Rhyan and the Loos Family throughout the season.

- ▶ A 6-6 small forward, **Willie Jackson** (Cleveland, Ohio) has been electric for Garfield Heights High School, averaging 18.0 points, 14.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game and helping head coach Sonny Johnson's group to a 24-4 record as a junior in 2014-15.
- ▶ Standing 6-9, **Reed Nikko** (Maple Grove, Minn.) powered Maple Grove High School to a 23-4 record last season while averaging 9.6 points, 6.5 rebounds and 2.4 blocks per game for head coach Nick Schroeder.

@MIZZOUHOOPS PICKS UP FIRST SEC WIN IN BIG WAY VS. AUBURN, 76-61



COLUMBIA, Mo. - Mizzou Men's Basketball (8-7, 1-1) utilized the free throw line and got a huge boost from its bench in a 76-61 victory over Auburn (7-7, 1-2) Saturday for its Southeastern Conference home opener at Mizzou Arena. Head coach Kim Anderson improved to 2-0 in SEC home openers (74-67 vs. LSU on Jan. 8, 2015) with the largest margin of victory against an SEC opponent during his tenure.

Freshman forward Kevin Puryear (Blue Springs, Mo.) led all Mizzou players in points and rebounds, notching his first double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds. The freshman also went 5-6 from the free throw line. As a team, the Tigers were successful on 25-of-33 free throw attempts.

Three other Mizzou players scored in double digits. Freshman guard K.J. Walton (Indianapolis, Ind.) scored 10 points after shooting 4-of-5 from the line, while sophomore guard Tramaine Isabell (Seattle, Wash.) scored 12 points, sinking two three-pointers and converting 4-of-6 free throw attempts. Sophomore guard Namon Wright (Los Angeles, Calif.) scored 10 points and shot 7-of-10 from the charity stripe. Freshman guard Terrence Phillips (Orange County, Calif.) led the team in assists with four, while Walton snagged three steals, a season-high.

Contributions came from all over Mizzou's roster as all 11 players that saw the floor scored points. The Tigers' bench outscored Auburn, 40-5.

Mizzou used a 21-3 run in the first half to grab a 39-24 lead at half time. The 15-point lead was the largest halftime lead against any SEC opponent in the Anderson era. After scoring only 11 points in the first 10:37 of the game, the Tigers offense exploded with three-pointers. Sophomore forward D'Angelo Allen (Dallas, Texas) and sophomore forward Jakeenan Gant (Springfield, Ga.) each connected from beyond the three-point line for the first time this season.

Allen provided a huge spark off of the bench in the first half, scoring five points, grabbing three rebounds, and posting a block in eight minutes of first-half action. He finished the night with seven points and four rebounds in 12 minutes.

Auburn was unable to cut the deficit to less than 12 points in the second half. Mizzou lead by as many as 26 points with just 4:36 remaining in the game. The Tigers converted 14-of-16 (87.5 percent) attempts from the free throw line during the second half to seal a 76-61 win.
