



- ▶ Mizzou Men's Basketball (8-8, 1-2) hits the road for its second road contest of its Southeastern Conference schedule, visiting No. 19 South Carolina (15-1, 2-1) on Saturday, Jan. 16, with a Noon CT tipoff scheduled on the SEC Network.
- ▶ Head coach Kim Anderson's group has won 3-of-5 games heading into the road trip to South Carolina, seeking its first true road win of the 2015-16 season.
- ▶ Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** finished Mizzou's nonconference schedule averaging 11.8 points per game and has since averaged 13.7 points over the Tigers' three SEC games.
- ▶ Puryear's scoring average ranks fourth in the conference for both overall and league totals. Additionally, his conference free throw percentage of 88.9 (16-of-18) ranks fifth in the SEC.
- ▶ Sophomore forward **Jakeenan Gant** has three blocks in as many league games played, adding to his team-high total of 20 for the season, overall.



KIM ANDERSON



In his second season leading the Mizzou Men's Basketball program, head coach **Kim Anderson** continues to turn the Tigers in the right direction, both on and off the court. With five newcomers on the 2015-16 roster that his staff personally recruited, Anderson hopes a higher comfort level and familiarity amongst his squad will translate into better team basketball. The Tigers already did their part in the offseason, posting the highest summer session grade point average for a Mizzou team in more than five seasons.

The Tiger leader took on the role of architect during the summer of 2014, beginning with establishing an identity for the Mizzou program. It would be built to last, with sturdy roots of character, discipline and competitiveness to reignite the passion of the many Black & Gold fans who clamor into Mizzou Arena. The first step was finding student-athletes, so Anderson and his staff brought in five freshmen and a graduate transfer for a total of six new faces. The following step was to get the newcomers and returning players to work as a team, which is not as simple of a process as it sounds.

Anderson knew sustained success could start with bumps in the road, and as the inexperience and unfamiliarity between his Tigers began to show down the stretch of the 2014-15 season, it became clear that changes would need to be made. Following Mizzou's 9-23 season, Anderson made it known what he and his staff's focuses would be going forward into the offseason. For the offseason, the Tiger coaching staff emphasized academic achievement, staff efficiency, athletic performance, team chemistry and a targeted recruiting focus.

NOTEWORTHY NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

- Mizzou dropped to 8-2 at Mizzou Arena this season with its 94-61 setback vs. Arkansas (Jan. 12).
- Mizzou shot a season-high 87 percent (20-of-23) from the free throw line against Arkansas. It was the team's highest percentage from the charity stripe since they shot 93.9 percent (31-of-33) against Nevada on Nov. 29, 2013.
- Freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** tied his career high with 16 points, the fourth double-digit figure scoring output of his Tiger career. He also tallied 16 against Northwestern on Nov. 24.
- Phillips also set career bests in free throw makes (five) and attempts (six) in the contest.

ASKED TO SHOOT, PHILLIPS DELIVERS

- An emphasis has been placed on Mizzou's quards to be able to make something happen when drawn-up plays break down or the shot clock becomes a factor. Freshman guard Terrence Phillips matched his season-high with 16 points vs. Arkansas (Jan. 12), equaling his effort vs. Northwestern (Nov. 24).
- Phillips got his 16 points taking a season-high 14 field goal attempts. Only junior guard Wes Clark has attempted more field goals in a game this season with 16 vs. Illinois (Dec. 23) and 15 at Georgia (Jan. 5).

ISABELL TRENDING UP

- Sophomore guard Tramaine Isabell shot a career-high eight free throws against Arkansas (Jan .12), making a personal best seven as he scored seven of his nine points from the charity stripe.
- Over his last two games, Isabell has scored 21 points for an average of 10.5 points per game. This comes after a four-game span the sophomore combined to tally 12 points for 3.0 points per game.

CLOSE CALLS WITH SOUTH CAROLINA LAST SEASON

- In head coach Kim Anderson's first season leading Mizzou, the Tigers battled South Carolina twice in tightly contested games, although ultimately yielding the games to the Gamecocks. Mizzou last played at Colonial Life Arena on Feb. 10, 2015, losing by a score of 65-60 after a back-and-forth second half. Anderson's group led by two points at the 16:59 mark after the break. After surrendering the lead, the Tigers closed South Carolina's lead to three points (51-54) with 2:55 left in the game.
- At last season's SEC Tournament in Nashville, Tenn., Mizzou drew South Carolina in its opening game on March 11. 2015. After trailing by six points at the halftime break, Mizzou tightened the game to a two-point USC advantage twice, at both 8:53 (47-49) and 6:42 (50-52). The Gamecocks eventually outlasted the Tigers to take a 63-54 result.

MORE ABOUT SOUTH CAROLINA

- South Carolina (15-1, 2-1) bolted out to a 15-0 start under fourth-year head coach Frank Martin this season before suffering its first loss in its most recent contest, a 73-50 setback at Alabama (Jan. 13). The Gamecocks are balanced in scoring, with five players averaging between 11.9 and 10.5 points per game. Both junior guard Sindarius Thornwell and senior forward Michael Carrera have averaged 11.9 points per game through South Carolina's 16 games.
- Through USC's three SEC contests, Thornwell has led the way with 14.3 points per game and has averaged 3.0 assists per game, as well.
- South Carolina has been widely successful playing at home in Colonial Life Arena, boasting a 9-0 mark thus far. Notable home victories include Memphis (86-76, Jan. 2) and Vanderbilt (69-65, Jan. 9).

BLOCK PARTY

- Mizzou sophomore forward Jakeenan Gant recorded four blocks vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29), a career-high night and the most blocks this season by a Tiger.
- Gant posted his fifth multiple block game of the season with his two swats vs. Auburn (Jan. 6).
- Gant has recorded a block in 13-of-16 games and has a team-leading 20 so far in the 2015-16 campaign.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR PURYEAR AMONG THE LATEST

- Freshman forward Kevin Puryear became the first Mizzou player to record a double-double (14 points, 11 rebounds vs. Auburn on Jan. 9) since March 7, 2015, when sophomore forward Johnathan Williams, III posted 10 points and 12 rebounds on the road at Mississippi State.
- Puryear has scored 195 points through 16 games (12.2) in his first collegiate season, putting him on within reach of Mizzou's all-time freshman scoring leaders. Steve Stipanovich (1979-80) finished his freshman campaign with 445 points and had 256 through 16 games. Derrick Chievous (1984-85) scored 193 points in 16 games before finishing his freshman season with 418 points.
- Nathan Buntin (1986-87) and Kelly Thames (1993-94) scored 228 points and 181 points in 16 games, respectively.
- Puryear's 11 rebounds vs. Auburn also match the team's season-high for an individual. Sophomore **Jakeenan Gant** hauled in 11 boards vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29).

BY THE NUMBERS



▶ Mizzou has the 13th-youngest roster in all of Division I basketball this season, according to Ken Pomeroy (kenpom.com). Head coach Kim Anderson's team ranks 339 out of 351 teams in terms of experience.



▶ Mizzou has five scholarship newcomers, including four talented freshmen and an experienced JUCO transfer. In total, the squad features eight freshmen/sophomores out of its 12 allocated scholarships.

▶ Mizzou outscored its final two nonconference opponents, Savannah State, by a combined 84 points.

PEARL COMES AWAY IMPRESSED WITH MIZZOU

Mizzou came out swinging against Auburn in its Southeastern Conference home opener (Jan. 9), taking a 15-point halftime lead that was the Tigers' largest lead at the break in a league game since the 2013-14 season (38-22 vs. South Carolina, Jan. 25, 2014). Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl had the following to say postgame:



BRUCE PEARL

Auburn Head Coach on Saturday, Jan. 9

On Mizzou's performance...

"I thought Missouri played well, they're a talented team. They have a lot of good young talent, 10 guys who played double digit minutes and five guys in double digit scoring. They have great balance, we got beat 40-5 off the bench. They play better at home because they're a young team and they'll beat people in here."

PURYEAR PUTTING UP POINTS

- Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** leads Mizzou with his 12.2 points per game average, which also **ranks fourth** in the **SEC** among freshmen.
- Puryear's hot free throw shooting clip of 81.4 percent (57-of-70) also ranks seventh overall in the conference.

CLARK CATCHING FIRE

- Junior guard **Wes Clark** set a new career-high with 22 points vs. Savannah State (Jan. 2) on 9-of-10 shooting. He followed that up with 13 points in Mizzou's SEC opener at Georgia (Jan. 6). Clark scored in double-digits in four consecutive games from Dec. 23-Jan. 6.
- Clark did not miss a single shot in the first half vs. Savannah State. Clark was 5-of-5 from the field, including 1-of-1 from beyond the three-point line and 1-of-1 from the free throw line.
- Llark has led Mizzou in scoring three times this season after doing so in five games during the 2014-15 campaign.

GETTING GANT GOING

- After averaging just 2.5 points per game in Mizzou's first six games of the season (15 points), sophomore forward **Jakeenan Gant** has found a rhythm coming off the bench for the Tigers. Gant has averaged 6.7 points per game over the last 10 games (67 points), including two 11-point efforts vs. Northern Illinois (Dec. 4) and Omaha (Dec. 9).
- ▶ Gant has also impacted Mizzou's rebounding, as the forward has pulled down 5.0 boards per game over the last 10 games (50). That more than doubles his six-game average to start the 2015-16 season (1.7).

FRESHMEN CAN FIND THE LINE

- **b** Both **K.J. Walton** and **Kevin Puryear** have posted 9-of-10 games from the free throw line this season, both marks that tie for game highs for Mizzou this season.
- Puryear hit on 9-of-10 from the charity stripe in recent action at Georgia (Jan. 6), while Walton accomplished the feat vs. Maryland-Eastern Shore (Nov. 15).

FINISHED NONCONFERENCE IN STYLE

- Mizzou finished its nonconference schedule the way it should with big victories over visitors to Mizzou Arena, first with the 53-point win (78-25) over Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29). That win was the Tigers largest margin of victory over an opponent since defeating Central Arkansas by the same amount in a 116-63 win in 2010.
- ▶ The 25 points allowed by the Tigers in that victory were the fewest ever allowed by a Mizzou team inside Mizzou Arena and the fewest by a Mizzou team since Jan. 3, 1947, against Iowa State when Mizzou won, 36-25.
- Mizzou also held UAPB to an all-time opponent low 15.4-percent field goal shooting mark. The previous was 18.3-percent by UAPB in 1998.
- ▶ The Tigers defeated Savannah State, 81-50, for a 31-point victory on Jan. 2, bringing Mizzou's two-game stretch to a whopping 84-point differential. That 84-point differential was Mizzou's largest since outscoring its opponents by 99 points in games vs. Texas Pan-American (100-44, Nov. 22, 2009) and Chattanooga (99-56, Nov. 24, 2009).

PSYCHO REBOUNDING

- Mizzou has worked to establish itself on the boards as a noticeably shorter squad. In fact, the Tigers rank 267th in all of Division I basketball in average height with a roster average of 76.2 inches, or 6 feet, 3.5 inches (according to Ken Pomeroy).
- ▶ The Tigers recorded the second +10 rebounding margin game of the Kim Anderson Era against Illinois (Dec. 23), 43-32 (+11).
- Mizzou followed that up with its first 50-rebound game in more than two seasons. The Tigers racked up 56 rebounds against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29). The last time Mizzou grabbed 50 or more rebounds was on Feb. 9, 2013, with 50 vs. Ole Miss.

#RALLYFORRHYAN

- ▶ The Tigers kept the momentum on the boards going in their game vs. Savannah State (Jan. 2). Mizzou outrebounded Savannah State, 40-30, the seventh time this season Mizzou has outrebounded its opponent. The Tigers have outrebounded its opponent in six of their seven wins.
- ▶ The 40-30 rebounding margin was the third time in the **Kim Anderson** era Mizzou has outrebounded its opponent by +10 or more.

ALWAYS BETTER TO GIVE

- Mizzou recorded 19 assists (on 27 field goals) as a team in the 78-25 win vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29), the highest total of assists in the Kim Anderson era.
- Anderson's squad reached 18 assists (on 28 field goals) earlier in the season vs. Northern Illinois (Dec. 4).
- The Tigers had previously posted 18 assists or more with 19 against Mississippi State on March 1, 2014.

PROGRAM MOVING FORWARD

MIZZOU ANNOUNCES DETAILS OF NCAA REVIEW

- It was announced on Jan. 13, that for the past nineteen months, the University of Missouri had worked collaboratively with the NCAA enforcement staff to review potential violations in its men's basketball program. In December 2013, the NCAA enforcement staff received information regarding potential violations involving a then men's basketball student-athlete. A verbal notice of inquiry was provided to the institution on April 14, 2014.
- Mizzou is in agreement with the NCAA that five violations did occur and will work with the NCAA to bring closure to the issue through the NCAA Summary Disposition process.
- ▶ The violations originated under the tenure of the previous men's basketball staff and there is no evidence that any current staff members were aware of the violations. Though self-imposing a postseason ban for this season is difficult for Mizzou's student-athletes, the program's coaches and supporters, it is an appropriate measure in holding the institution accountable and is consistent with the NCAA penalty structure for these levels of violations.
- ▶ Because the NCAA enforcement process is ongoing, the university cannot provide additional details at this time regarding the violations or the sanctions.





HANK FOLEY

"The University of Missouri has high expectations for every member of our community, including our faculty, staff and students, and those same expectations are applied to those who support our endeavors. It is clear from our collaborative investigation with the NCAA that a former member of our athletics staff and members of our donor community violated NCAA bylaws and we take those actions seriously. We have an obligation to adhere to all NCAA and SEC rules as a member institution and we will continue to improve our education and oversight to ensure that we compete with integrity."

@MIZZOUHOOPS DROPS HOME RESULTTO ARKANSAS DESPITE 16 FROM PHILLIPS



COLUMBIA, Mo. - Mizzou Men's Basketball (8-8, 1-2 SEC) fell 94-61 to Arkansas (9-7, 3-1 SEC) on Tuesday evening inside Mizzou Arena. Freshman guard Terrence Phillips (Orange County, Calif.) matched his career-high with 16 points to pace the Tigers' offense, marking his fifth double-digit scoring output of the season.

The visiting Razorbacks shot well throughout the opening half, hitting 20-of-31 (64.5-percent) of its shots from the field. Arkansas held a comfortable lead throughout much of the first 20 minutes, but the Tigers closed the half with a flurry of points to cut into the deficit.

Phillips, playing on his 20th birthday, paced the Tigers' first half scoring with 10 points. Sophomore guard Tramaine Isabell (Seattle, Wash.) and sophomore guard Namon Wright (Los Angeles, Calif.) each added seven points to round out Mizzou's attack. Isabell shot an outstanding 7-of-8 (88 percent) from the free throw line to highlight his scoring effort.

The Tigers opened the second half with a swift scoring run to cut the deficit to seven points. However, Arkansas had an answer as it used a strong stretch to extend its advantage back to double digits. The Razorbacks' effective shooting closed out the remainder of the game as Mizzou was unable to find an answer on defense.

Mizzou collectively shot well from the free throw line despite the loss, knocking down 20-of-23 (87 percent) attempts. Four Tigers produced a perfect 2-for-2 night at the charity stripe to power their productive night at the line. Tuesday's excellent effort at the free throw line was Mizzou's highest single-game free throw percentage since Nov. 29, 2013, at Nevada.
