MIZZOU STORYLINES

▶ The No. 14 Mizzou gymnastics team returns to Mizzou Arena for the second year in a row as the squad hosts No. 9 Georgia on Friday, Jan. 22 at 7 p.m. CT in the annual Pink Out meet. \$1 from every ticket sold will go to the Ellis Fischel Cancer Center.

▶ The first 500 fans in attendance will receive a free pink t-shirt and pink glow necklace, while the first 250 fans will receive the first set of Mizzou gymnastics trading cards. Additionally, there will be a Mizzou gymnastics apparel sale with proceeds going toward the Ellis Fischel Cancer Center.

▶ The competition will be aired live on SEC Network + with Meredith Hoenes and Sasha Sander calling the action.

▶ Freshman Britney Ward earned SEC Specialist of the Week honors after claiming both the vault (9.925) and beam (9.900) titles at Alabama on Jan. 15.

▶ The Tigers remain steady at 14th in the national rankings after a strong showing at Alabama on Jan. 15.

▶ Mizzou notched a season best 196.050 in its SEC opener on Jan. 15. The Tigers also had season highs on two events (49.075 on beam and 49.025 on vault).

▶ In addition to Ward's two event wins, freshman Morgan Porter claimed the all-around victory with a 39.200.

▶ Through three meets in 2016, the Tigers have notched 28 individual scores of 9.8 or higher, compared

to 16 through the first three meets of 2015.

▶ The Tigers opened 2016 with a 195.350-195.075 win over No. 15 Illinois on Jan. 8. The score tied the program record for highest opening meet team total in program history. The 2004 squad also opened its season with the same score.

▶ Against the Illini, Mizzou recorded a 49.175 on bars, the team's highest score on the event since midway through the 2014 season.

▶ Two days later, Mizzou traveled to Lindenwood and notched a 195.200-192.000 win over the Lions.

▶ Head Coach Shannon Welker enters his third season at the helm of the Tiger program. Welker led Mizzou to the nation's biggest improvement in 2015, as the squad finished 21st in the national rankings after coming in 41st at the end of the 2014 campaign.

▶ Youth will be served in 2016, as over half (eight) of the 15-person roster are freshmen. Additionally, 12 of the team's gymnasts are freshmen or sophomores in 2016.

▶ Georgia is ranked ninth in the nation with scores of 196.775, 195.750 and 195.200 on the year. The Gymdogs also rank third in the country on vault with an average score of 49.267 and a high of 49.500.

▶ The Tigers will face a tough schedule once again, with regular season matchups against seven teams ranked in the preseason coaches poll top 10.

LAST TIME OUT

- Mizzou scored a season best 196.050 in a 197.175-196.050 loss at No. 6 Alabama on Jan. 15.
- Freshman Britney Ward (Ozark, Mo.) won both the vault and beam titles with career high scores, while freshman Morgan Porter (Overland, Mo.) took home the all-around crown.
- Ward notched event-winning scores of 9.925 on vault and 9.900 on beam to claim top honors on both apparatus' for the third and fourth event titles of her brief Tiger career. Porter totaled a 39.200 in the all-around, highlighted by a 9.850 on bars and a 9.825 on floor, to take the win.
- Mizzou scored a 49 on three events (vault, bars and beam) and tallied season highs on both vault (49.025) and beam (49.075).
- Overall, Mizzou's freshman contributed 15 of the team's 24 routines in the meet, while the Tigers received eight from the sophomore class and two from the junior class.

LOOKING AT THE OPPONENT...GEORGIA

- Georgia is ranked ninth nationally in the Jan. 18 rankings.
- The Gymdogs are 1-2 on the season. They posted a season best 196.775 to earn a dramatic win at Arkansas (196.700) on Jan. 15, while also posting scores of 195.750 and 195.200 in losses to Stanford and Michigan, respectively.
- As a team, Georgia ranks third nationally on vault (49.267), fourth on bars (49.225) and sixth on floor (49.183).
- Brandie Jay owns a vault average of 9.908 to rank second nationally.
- Additionally, Brittany Rogers is tied for third on bars (9.900) in the country.

UP NEXT

- The Tigers travel to Fort Worth, Texas, to compete at the Metroplex Challenge on Saturday, Jan. 30. Mizzou will face No. 2 Oklahoma, No. 7 LSU, No. 24 Stanford and Washington at the meet, which will be competed on a platform.

TIGERS STAY STEADY AT 14TH IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Mizzou is ranked 14th for the second consecutive week, a jump from the Tigers' preseason ranking of 23rd.
- The ranking is the highest for the program since it was ranked 14th on March 5, 2012.
- The Tigers have steadily climbed in the rankings in Head Coach Shannon Welker's two-plus seasons at Mizzou. Last year in Welker's second year at the helm, the Tigers entered the in-season rankings for the first time since 2012 and ultimately finished 21st in the final team rankings.

BRITNEY WARD NAMED SEC SPECIALIST OF THE WEEK

- ▶ Britney Ward (Ozark, Mo.) was named the Southeastern Conference Specialist of the Week, the league announced on Tuesday (Jan. 19).
- ▶ Ward became the second Tiger gymnast to earn SEC weekly honors since Mizzou joined the conference for the 2013 season, joining current sophomore Shauna Miller, who claimed SEC Freshman of the Week last year
- ▶ Ward claimed two event titles after a pair of career high scores at No. 6 Alabama last Friday. She opened her night with a personal best 9.925 on vault to earn top honors on the event. Then in Mizzou's final routine of the night, she won the beam title with a career high 9.900.
- ▶ Ward's scores helped the Tigers post season best team outputs on both vault (49.025) and beam (49.050), while also notching the team's highest overall score of the young season (196.050).
- ▶ In only three collegiate meets, Ward has two vault and two beam titles to her credit. In addition to her wins at Alabama, she also won beam in the season opener against Illinois (9.850) and tied for the vault crown at Lindenwood (9.825).

MIZZOU POSTS SEASON BEST SCORE AT ALABAMA

- ▶ The Tigers scored a season best 196.050 in the team's SEC opener at Alabama on Jan. 15.
- ▶ The score marked a high for the team in an SEC dual meet since the program joined the league for the 2013 season.
- ▶ Mizzou also had season highs on two events (49.075 on beam and 49.025 on vault).
- ▶ Last season, the Tigers only scored 196 two times and did not accomplish the feat until the regular season finale against North Carolina State (March 13).
- ▶ Ward and freshman Morgan Porter earned wins against the Crimson Tide. Ward took home both the vault and beam titles, while Porter claimed the all-around crown.

MIZZOU WITH 28 9.8 SCORES ON THE YOUNG SEASON

- ▶ Three meets into the 2016 season, Mizzou has tallied 28 individual scores of 9.8 or higher so far this year.
- ▶ Last season, the Tigers accumulated 16 scores of 9.8 or higher in the first three meets of the year.
- ▶ Freshman Morgan Porter paces the team with seven scores of 9.8 or higher on the young season, while classmate Brooke Kelly is second with five.
- ▶ Overall, 38.9 percent of the team's scores this season have been 9.8 or higher.

TIGERS OPEN 2016 WITH WIN OVER NO. 15 ILLINOIS

- ▶ Mizzou opened the 2016 season in style with a 195.350-195.075 win over No. 15 Illinois on Jan. 8 at the Hearn Center.
- ▶ The Tigers' score of 195.350 tied the program's highest opening meet score ever. The team also tallied the same total in the 2004 season opener.
- ▶ Mizzou's meet was highlighted by a 49.175 on bars in the second rotation, a total that was the highest for the team since it scored a 49.200 midway through the 2014 campaign.
- ▶ Sophomores Kennedi Harris and Shauna Miller and freshman Britney Ward all won or tied for event titles

against the Fighting Illini. Miller claimed top honors on vault after a 9.850, Ward tied for first on beam after a 9.850 and Harris tied for the floor crown after a score of 9.900.

► Overall, Mizzou recorded nine individual scores of 9.800 or higher, including two from Miller and freshman Brooke Kelly.

FRESHMEN MAKING AN IMPACT

► Through three meets this season, Mizzou's big freshman class has accounted for 44 of the team's 72 routines, or 61.1 percent.

► Freshman Morgan Porter leads the way with 12 routines under her belt as she has competed the all-around in all three meets.

► Brooke Kelly is close behind with 10 routines.

► Other freshman contributing routines include Allison Bower (eight), Britney Ward (six), Madeleine Huber (five) and Michaellee Turner (three).

► Sophomores have contributed 30.6 percent (22) of routines, while the juniors 8.3 percent (six) in the three meets.

MIZZOU MADE ENORMOUS STRIDES IN 2015

► The Mizzou Tigers were the nation's most improved team in 2015, finishing the season 21st in the national rankings only a year after finishing 41st in 2013. The 20-spot jump was the largest of any women's gymnastics program in the country.

► Mizzou finished the 2015 with a regional qualifying score (RQS) of 195.720, almost a full point better than the team's final 2014 RQS of 194.770.

► The Tigers scored over 195 in 10 of the team's 13 meets a season ago after reaching the mark only four times combined in the 2013 and 2014 seasons.

► Additionally, Missouri reached the 196 mark twice in 2015, a feat the squad had not accomplished since 2012.

► Last season also marked Mizzou's return to NCAA competition as the team qualified for its first NCAA Regional since 2012. At the Normal Regional, the Tigers placed fourth with a score of 196.100, the second-highest NCAA Regional score for the program in history.

GYMNASTICS RETURNS TO MIZZOU ARENA

► Gymnastics returns to Mizzou Arena for the second consecutive season when Missouri hosts Georgia on Friday, Jan. 22 in the annual Pink Out.

► Last season, the Tigers contest their first-ever meet at Mizzou Arena on March 6, 2015 as the squad hosted Alabama.

► The Tigers drew a season-best crowd of 2,822 at the meet.

TIGERS ON TV

► Mizzou will have five meets televised on the SEC Network this season.

► The Tigers make their TV debut on Friday, Jan. 15 in a 6 p.m. CT meet at Alabama.

► Missouri next appears on the SEC Network on Fri., Feb. 12 as the Tigers travel to Lexington, Ky., to face Kentucky.

► Additionally, the Tigers' home meet against three-time defending national champions Florida on Feb. 19 will be aired live on the network.

► For the first time, both sessions of the 2016 SEC Championships will be aired live after the event was streamed a year ago.

► Additionally, all remaining Tigers' home meets and all SEC away meets will be available on SEC Network + and WatchESPN.

THE 2016 SCHEDULE

- ▶ Mizzou will host five meets in 2016, including Friday's Beauty and the Beast and a clash against Georgia at Mizzou Arena. Other home competitions include the State of Missouri Meet (against Lindenwood and Southeast Missouri State), Florida and Arkansas.
- ▶ Mizzou travels to SEC foes Alabama, Kentucky and Auburn, takes on Oklahoma, LSU, Stanford and Washington in the Metroplex Challenge, and close the year the regular season at Western Michigan.
- ▶ Overall, the Tigers face 10 teams ranked in the preseason coaches poll, including seven of the poll's top 10 teams.

TIGERS SIGN THREE FOR 2017

- ▶ Mizzou signed three student-athletes to National Letters of Intent, Head Coach Shannon Welker announced on Thursday, Nov. 12.

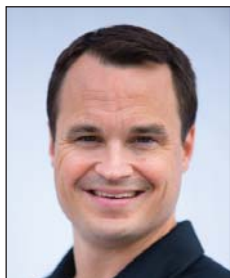
