
#ZOUNOTES

- ▶ Mizzou Men's Basketball (7-7) hosts its first Southeastern Conference game of 2016 vs. Auburn (7-6) on Saturday, Jan. 9, with an 8 p.m. tipoff televised nationally on ESPN2 from Mizzou Arena.
- ▶ Head coach **Kim Anderson**'s squad dropped its SEC opener on the road at Georgia (Jan. 6), yielding a 77-59 result to the Bulldogs.
- ▶ Mizzou was powered by freshman forward **Kevin Puryear**'s 19 points in the setback, his 10th game in double figures this season.
- ▶ Sophomore guard Namon Wright leads Mizzou with his 4.9 rebounds per game, while freshman Terrence Phillips leads the Tigers with his 3.4 assists per game.
- ▶ The Tigers rolled to a +84 point differential to close out its nonconference schedule, defeating Arkansas-Pine Bluff, 78-25, on Dec. 29 before beating Savannah State, 81-50, on Jan. 2.
- ▶ Mizzou is 2-1 in SEC home openers over the last three seasons, including the 2014-15 defeat of LSU (74-67 OT, Jan. 8, 2015).

KIM ANDERSON



In his second season leading the Mizzou Men's Basketball program, head coach **Kim Anderson** continues to turn the Tigers in the right direction, both on and off the court. With five newcomers on the 2015-16 roster that his staff personally recruited, Anderson hopes a higher comfort level and familiarity amongst his squad will translate into better team basketball. The Tigers already did their part in the offseason, posting the highest summer session grade point average for a Mizzou team in more than five seasons.

The Tiger leader took on the role of architect during the summer of 2014, beginning with establishing an identity for the Mizzou program. It would be built to last, with sturdy roots of character, discipline and competitiveness to reignite the passion of the many Black & Gold fans who clamor into Mizzou Arena. The first step was finding student-athletes, so Anderson and his staff brought in five freshmen and a graduate transfer for a total of six new faces. The following step was to get the newcomers and returning players to work as a team, which is not as simple of a process as it sounds.

Anderson knew sustained success could start with bumps in the road, and as the inexperience and unfamiliarity between his Tigers began to show down the stretch of the 2014-15 season, it became clear that changes would need to be made. Following Mizzou's 9-23 season, Anderson made it known what he and his staff's focuses would be going forward into the offseason. For the offseason, the Tiger coaching staff emphasized academic achievement, staff efficiency, athletic performance, team chemistry and a targeted recruiting focus.

NOTEWORTHY NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

- Freshman forward Kevin Puryear led the Tigers in scoring with 19 points, but Mizzou Men's Basketball (7-7) dropped its Southeastern Conference opener at Georgia (8-4) on Wednesday, Jan. 6. It was the 10th time in 14 games Puryear has scored in double digits.
- Junior guard Wes Clark had 13 points for the fourth consecutive game he has scored in double-digits.
- For the third-straight game, Mizzou shot better than 75 percent from the free throw line, connecting on 18-of-23 attempts for 78.3 percent.
- Puryear was aggressive in drawing fouls throughout the game, setting season highs with his nine free throw makes and 10 free throw attempts.

HOT DISHES SERVED BY PHILLIPS

- Freshman guard Terrence Phillips became the first Tiger since the 2013-14 season to have five or more assists in three-straight games. He joined current Los Angeles Lakers guard Jordan Clarkson with that distinction with his fiveassist game at Georgia (Jan. 6).
- Phillips, who has started every game of his first collegiate season, leads the Tigers with his 47 assists.

FRESHMEN CAN FIND THE LINE

- Both K.J. Walton and Kevin Puryear have posted 9-of-10 games from the free throw line this season, both marks that tie for game highs for Mizzou this season.
- Puryear hit on 9-of-10 from the charity stripe in recent action at Georgia (Jan. 6), while Walton accomplished the feat vs. Maryland-Eastern Shore (Nov. 15).

PURYEAR PUTTING UP POINTS

- Freshman forward Kevin Puryear leads Mizzou with his 12.4 points per game average, which also ranks fourth in the SEC among freshmen.
- Puryear's hot free throw shooting clip of 80.6 percent (50-of-62) also ranks ninth overall in the conference.

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP-CALIBER COACHING

- Mizzou head coach Kim Anderson led Central Missouri to the 2014 NCAA Division II National Championship two seasons ago in his final campaign in Warrensburg, Mo., ending an impressive run of success with the Mules. Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl, before head coaching stints at UW-Milwaukee, Tennessee and Auburn, was the head coach at Division II Southern Indiana and won the 1995 Division II title.
- Both coaches have NABC (National Association of Basketball Coaches) recognition in their pasts. Anderson and Pearl earned Division II National Coach of the Year honors after their respective national title runs at both Central Missouri and Southern Indiana.

LAST TIME VS. AUBURN

- It was Senior Night for Mizzou vs. Auburn on March 3, 2015, and senior guard Keith Shamburger hit the go-ahead jumper with 10.9 seconds remaining to lift head coach Kim Anderson's squad to a 63-61 win. Shamburger finished with a team-best 21 points to lead the Tigers.
- Mizzou was dominant on the boards, outrebounding Auburn 34-25. Senior forward Keanau Post was big in the defensive effort, recording two blocks and one steal.
- Then-freshman guard Namon Wright scored 10 points on 4-of-10 field goal shooting and pulled down five rebounds.

MORE ABOUT AUBURN

- Auburn (7-6) opened Southeastern Conference action with an 83-77 win at home vs. Tennessee (Jan. 2) before falling to No. 22 South Carolina by a score of 81-69 at home (Jan. 5).
- Both Mizzou and Auburn played road contests at Xavier which ended in defeats. Mizzou dropped a 78-66 result on Nov. 17, while Auburn fell by a score of 85-61 on Dec. 19.
- Head coach Bruce Pearl's group is led in scoring by transfer guard Kareem Canty (formerly of Marshall), who averages 19.5 points per game. Canty also averages 5.9 assists per game.

CLARK CATCHING FIRE

Junior guard Wes Clark set a new career-high with 22 points vs. Savannah State (Jan. 2) on 9-of-10 shooting. He followed that up with 13 points in Mizzou's SEC opener at Georgia (Jan. 6). Clark has scored in double-digits in four consecutive games, six times this season and 19 times in his career.

NOTEWORTHY NOTES (CONT.)

- ▶ Clark did not miss a single shot in the first half vs. Savannah State. Clark was 5-of-5 from the field, including 1-of-1 from beyond the three-point line and 1-of-1 from the free throw line.
- Clark has led Mizzou in scoring three times this season after doing so in five games during the 2014-15 campaign.

FINISHED NONCONFERENCE IN STYLE

- Mizzou finished its nonconference schedule the way it should with big victories over visitors to Mizzou Arena, first with the 53-point win (78-25) over Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29). That win was the Tigers largest margin of victory over an opponent since defeating Central Arkansas by the same amount in a 116-63 win in 2010.
- ▶ The 25 points allowed by the Tigers in that victory were the fewest ever allowed by a Mizzou team inside Mizzou Arena and the fewest by a Mizzou team since Jan. 3, 1947, against lowa State when Mizzou won, 36-25.
- Mizzou also held UAPB to an all-time opponent low 15.4-percent field goal shooting mark. The previous was 18.3-percent by UAPB in 1998.
- ▶ The Tigers defeated Savannah State, 81-50, for a 31-point victory on Jan. 2, bringing Mizzou's two-game stretch to a whopping 84-point differential. That 84-point differential was Mizzou's largest since outscoring its opponents by 99 points in games vs. Texas Pan-American (100-44, Nov. 22, 2009) and Chattanooga (99-56, Nov. 24, 2009).

PSYCHO REBOUNDING

- Mizzou has worked to establish itself on the boards as a noticeably shorter squad. In fact, the Tigers rank 267th in all of Division I basketball in average height with a roster average of 76.2 inches, or 6 feet, 3.5 inches (according to Ken Pomeroy).
- ▶ The Tigers recorded the second +10 rebounding margin game of the Kim Anderson Era against Illinois (Dec. 23), 43-32 (+11).
- Mizzou followed that up with its first 50-rebound game in more than two seasons. The Tigers racked up 56 rebounds against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29). The last time Mizzou grabbed 50 or more rebounds was on Feb. 9, 2013, with 50 vs. Ole Miss.
- ▶ The Tigers kept the momentum on the boards going in their game vs. Savannah State (Jan. 2). Mizzou outrebounded Savannah State, 40-30, the seventh time this season Mizzou has outrebounded its opponent. The Tigers have outrebounded its opponent in six of their seven wins.
- ▶ The 40-30 rebounding margin was the third time in the **Kim Anderson** era Mizzou has outrebounded its opponent by +10 or more.

BLOCK PARTY

- Mizzou sophomore forward Jakeenan Gant recorded four blocks vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29), a career-high night and the most blocks this season by a Tiger.
- ▶ Gant has recorded a block in 11-of-14 games and has a team-leading 17 so far in the 2015-16 campaign.

GETTING GANT GOING

- After averaging just 2.5 points per game in Mizzou's first six games of the season (15 points), sophomore forward **Jakeenan Gant** has found a rhythm coming off the bench for the Tigers. Gant has averaged 7.3 points per game over the last eight games (58 points), including two 11-point efforts vs. Northern Illinois (Dec. 4) and Omaha (Dec. 9).
- Gant has also impacted Mizzou's rebounding, as the forward has pulled down 5.5 boards per game over the last eight games (44). That more than doubles his six-game average to start the 2015-16 season (1.7).

ALWAYS BETTER TO GIVE

- Mizzou recorded 19 assists (on 27 field goals) as a team in the 78-25 win vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29), the highest total of assists in the Kim Anderson era.




OFFSEASON FOCUSED ON BUILDING TEAM CHEMISTRY

@MIZZOUHOOPS FALLS IN SEC OPENER AT GEORGIA, 77-59



ATHENS, Ga. - Mizzou Men's Basketball (7-7) dropped its Southeastern Conference opener Wednesday night, 77-59, at Georgia (8-4). Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** (Blue Springs, Mo.) led the Tigers in scoring with 19 points, the 10th time in 14 games Puryear has scored in double digits.

Joining Puryear in double-digit scoring was junior guard **Wes Clark** (Detroit, Mich.), who had 13 points, the fourth consecutive game he has scored in double-digits. Sophomore forward **Jakeenan Gant** (Springfield, Ga.) led the team in rebounds with six while freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** (Orange County, Calif.) led the team in assists with five.

For the third-straight game, Mizzou shot better than 75 percent from the free throw line, connecting on 18-of-23 attempts for 78.3 percent.

The Tigers got behind early in the first half, falling behind 8-0. From there, the Tigers went on to score 10 of the next 17 points to cut the lead to five after a jumper from sophomore guard **Tramaine Isabell** (Seattle, Wash.) made the score 15-10. With under five minutes left in the half, the Tigers began feeding their freshman big man, Puryear. The Blue Springs native scored eight consecutive points for Mizzou, but the Tigers trailed by 12 at the half, 45-32.

The Bulldogs opened the second half on a 12-3 run to open a 57-35 lead. Throughout the remainder of the half, the Tigers could not cut the deficit to under 15, falling 77-59 at the final buzzer.


