MIZZOU STORYLINES

► The No. 19 Mizzou gymnastics team returns home to the Hearnest Center on Friday, Feb. 19 to host No. 2 Florida at 6 p.m. CT. The meet will be televised live on the SEC Network with Melissa Lee and Courtney Kupets Carter on the call.

► The Tigers clock in at No. 19 in this week's national rankings with an average team score of 195.646.

► Freshman Britney Ward leads the Tigers with eight event wins in 2016, including four each on beam and vault. Her wins include vault and beam crowns against both Alabama and Georgia and the vault title at Kentucky.

► Ward has already been recognized twice this season by the SEC. She claimed Freshman of the Week honors on Jan. 26, just one week after she was named the SEC Specialist of the Week.

► So far in 2016, Tiger freshmen have accounted for 62.5 percent of all Mizzou routines, compared to 29.2 percent from sophomores and 8.2 percent from juniors.

► Seven meets into 2016, Mizzou's scoring average stands at 195.646 and its RQS comes in at 195.645. Last season, the Tigers had figures of 194.768 (average) and 194.935 (RQS) through their first seven meets.

► Through seven meets in 2016, the Tigers have notched 76 individual scores of 9.8 or higher, which calculates to 46.5 percent of all routines.

► Freshman Morgan Porter leads the Tigers with 17 scores of 9.8 or higher.

► Mizzou scored a season high 196.625 at the State of Missouri Meet on Feb. 5, a score that stands as the eight-highest in program history and the highest team score since 2010.

► The Tigers also closed the meet with a 49.475 on floor, a season high by 0.4 and the fifth-best event total in program history.

► Mizzou won its first-ever SEC dual meet on Jan. 22 in a 195.800-195.350 win over then-No. 9 Georgia at Mizzou Arena.

► The Tigers opened 2016 with a 195.350-195.075 win over No. 15 Illinois on Jan. 8. The score tied the program record for highest opening meet team total in program history. The 2004 squad also opened its season with the same score.

► Head Coach Shannon Welker is in his third season at the helm of the Tiger program. Welker led Mizzou to the nation's biggest improvement in 2015, as the squad finished 21st in the national rankings after coming in 41st at the end of the 2014 campaign.

► Youth will be served in 2016, as over half (eight) the 15-person roster are freshmen. Additionally, 12 of the team's gymnasts are freshmen or sophomores in 2016.

► The Tigers will face a tough schedule once again, with regular season matchups against seven teams ranked in the preseason coaches poll top 10.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ The Mizzou gymnastics team suffered a 196.050-194.675 loss at Kentucky on Feb. 21
- ▶ During the meet, the Tigers notched a season-high vault total of 49.100, bettering the 49.025 the squad notched against Alabama and at the Metroplex Challenge
- ▶ Freshman Brittany Ward earned her team-leading eighth event crown of the season after notching a 9.875 on vault to take first. She also placed second on beam with a 9.875 as well
- ▶ Freshman Morgan Porter earned scores of 9.850 on vault and bars and 9.800 on floor against the Wildcats, with the vault score standing as a new best
- ▶ Additionally, sophomore Becca Schugel tied her beam career high with a 9.825

LOOKING AT THE OPPONENT...FLORIDA

- ▶ The Gators enter Friday's meet ranked second in the nation with a 197.258 average
- ▶ Last time out, Florida defeated Arkansas, 197.450-195.900
- ▶ The team also ranks second nationally on bars and beam, third on vault and fourth on floor

- ▶ Mizzou travels to Auburn, Ala., to face the No. 8 Auburn Tigers at 7 p.m. CT on Friday, Feb. 26.

TIGERS COME IN AT 19TH IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- ▶ Mizzou is ranked 19th in this week's national rankings.
- ▶ The Tigers jumped dropped four spots after tallying a 194.675 at Kentucky last week.
- ▶ Missouri has now been ranked in the top 20 in each of the five in-season rankings of 2016. Last season, the Tigers did not crack the top 25 until Feb. 23 when in came in at No. 23.

PORTER ROCKING THE BARS

- ▶ A constant in the bars lineup this season, freshman Morgan Porter has not scored lower than a 9.800 in her freshman campaign
- ▶ The Overland, Mo., native leads the Tigers with a 9.854 average on the event, which ties her for 22nd nationally
- ▶ Porter earned a career high 9.900 at the Metroplex Challenge, and also has scores of 9.875 (twice), 8.850 (twice), 9.825 and 9.800.

TIGERS GO BIG AT STATE OF MISSOURI MEET

- ▶ The Tigers notched wins over Lindenwood (194.000) and Southeast Missouri (192.300) at the State of Missouri Meet on Feb. 5 as the squad notched a slew of season highs.
- ▶ Mizzou's team total of 196.625 marked the highest score for the team since 2010 (when it went 196.875 against Illinois State on Feb. 26) and also stands as the eight-highest score in program history.
- ▶ The Tigers closed the meet with a 49.475 on floor thanks to five scores of 9.850 or high and three scores of 9.900 or higher. The tally is the fifth-highest floor total in Mizzou history and the highest since that same meet in 2010 (49.500). The other top three floor scores all came during the 2004 campaign.
- ▶ Mizzou also notched a season best 49.250 on bars, which tied for the seventh-highest score in program history. the total was the highest since the Tigers went 49.300 against George Washington on Feb. 21, 2014.
- ▶ Individually, eight different Tigers set or tied 11 career marks during the meet. Freshman Allison Bower led the way with highs on all three of her events (9.850 on floor and 9.825 on bars and beam), while classmate Madeleine Huber had two (9.875 on bars and 9.775 on vault).
- ▶ Other Tigers who set or tied career highs included freshman Morgan Porter (9.950 on floor), sophomore Kennedy Harris (9.925 on floor), sophomore Becca Schugel (9.900 on bars), freshman Michaellee Turner (9.900 on floor), freshman Britney Ward (9.900 on beam) and freshman Xarria Lewis (9.775 on vault).

MIZZOU CONTINUES TO RISE UNDER WELKER

- ▶ Mizzou's rise under third-year Head Coach Shannon Welker continues seven meets into the 2016 campaign.
- ▶ Last season, the Tigers were the nation's most improved team, jumping a full 20 spots (41 to 21) in the 2014 and 2015 rankings.
- ▶ The improvement didn't stop there, as the 2016 Tigers are improved over even the 2015 squad.
- ▶ So far this season, Mizzou owns a scoring average of 195.646 and an RQS (one of the few teams with an RQS at this point of the season) of 195.645.
- ▶ Seven meets into 2015, the Tigers owned a scoring average of 194.768 and an RQS of 194.935, year-to-year improvements of over a full point.

MIZZOU NOTCHES FIRST-EVER SEC DUAL WIN

- ▶ Mizzou's 195.800-195.350 win over then-No. 9 Georgia on Jan. 22 marked the program's first-ever Southeastern Conference dual win since the Tigers joined the league for the 2013 season.
- ▶ Missouri has twice beaten Kentucky in the SEC Championships (2013 and 2015) but never defeated an SEC foe during the regular season until last Friday.
- ▶ The Tigers were 0-20 before the win over the Gymdogs.
- ▶ The team's narrowest loss in that span was a 194.250-194.125 loss to Arkansas on March 1, 2013.

MIZZOU WITH 76 9.8 SCORES OR HIGHER ON THE SEASON

- ▶ Seven meets into the 2016 season, Mizzou has tallied 76 individual scores of 9.8 or higher so far this year.
- ▶ Those 76 routines mean that 45.2 percent of all Tiger routines have scored a 9.8 or higher in 2016.
- ▶ Freshman Morgan Porter paces the team with 17 scores of 9.8 or higher on the young season, while classmate Brooke Kelly has 11. Sophomore Kennedy Harris and freshman Britney Ward both have 10.
- ▶ Additionally, the Tigers have notched 10 scores of 9.900 or higher, led by four from Ward (three on beam, one on vault) and three from Harris (all on floor).

TIGERS RECORD TOP-10 WIN

- ▶ Mizzou's 195.800-195.350 win over No. 9 Georgia also marked the program's first win over a top-10 opponent since 2012.
- ▶ During that season, the Tigers defeated No. 9 Arkansas, 196.100-195.450, on March 16, 2012 at the Hearn Center.
- ▶ Earlier that season, Missouri also defeated No. 4 Nebraska, 195.725-194.550, on Jan. 28 in Lincoln, Neb.
- ▶ The win was not the first time the Tigers earned an upset over the Gymdogs. In the 2010 NCAA Columbia Regional, Missouri placed first (196.500) while No. 4 Georgia tied for second (196.275).

BRITNEY WARD TWICE RECOGNIZED BY SEC

- ▶ One week after claiming SEC Specialist of the Week honors, freshman Britney Ward was named the Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Week on Jan. 26.
- ▶ Ward claimed two event titles in Mizzou's win over No. 9 Georgia on Jan. 22. The freshman scored a 9.900 on beam to take the win and earned a 9.875 on vault to tie for the title on that event.
- ▶ Her performance came just one week after winning the same events against Alabama on Jan. 15.
- ▶ Ward leads the Tigers with seven event wins in 2015, including four on beam and three on vault. In addition to her wins at Georgia and Alabama, she also won beam in the season opener against Illinois and at the State of Missouri Meet and tied for the vault crown at Lindenwood (9.825).

FRESHMEN MAKING AN IMPACT

- ▶ Through seven meets this season, Mizzou's big freshman class has accounted for 105 of the team's 168 routines, or 62.5 percent.
- ▶ Freshman Morgan Porter leads the way with 26 routines under her belt.
- ▶ Brooke Kelly is close behind with 22 routines.
- ▶ Other freshman contributing routines include Allison Bower (20), Britney Ward (14), Madeleine Huber (12), Michaellee Turner (seven) and Xarria Lewis (four).
- ▶ Sophomores have contributed 29.2 percent (49) of routines, while the juniors 8.3 percent (14) in the five meets.

TIGERS OPEN 2016 WITH WIN OVER NO. 15 ILLINOIS

- ▶ Mizzou opened the 2016 season in style with a 195.350-195.075 win over No. 15 Illinois on Jan. 8 at the Hearn Center.
- ▶ The Tigers' score of 195.350 tied the program's highest opening meet score ever. The team also tallied the same total in the 2004 season opener.
- ▶ Mizzou's meet was highlighted by a 49.175 on bars in the second rotation, a total that was the highest for the team since it scored a 49.200 midway through the 2014 campaign.
- ▶ Sophomores Kennedy Harris and Shauna Miller and freshman Britney Ward all won or tied for event titles against the Fighting Illini. Miller claimed top honors on vault after a 9.850, Ward tied for first on beam after a 9.850 and Harris tied for the floor crown after a score of 9.900.
- ▶ Overall, Mizzou recorded nine individual scores of 9.800 or higher, including two from Miller and freshman Brooke Kelly.

MIZZOU MADE ENORMOUS STRIDES IN 2015

- ▶ The Mizzou Tigers were the nation's most improved team in 2015, finishing the season 21st in the national rankings only a year after finishing 41st in 2013. The 20-spot jump was the largest of any women's gymnastics program in the country.
- ▶ The Tigers scored over 195 in 10 of the team's 13 meets a season ago after reaching the mark only four times combined in the 2013 and 2014 seasons.
- ▶ Additionally, Missouri reached the 196 mark twice in 2015, a feat the squad had not accomplished since 2012.
- ▶ Mizzou also returned to NCAA competition as the team qualified for its first NCAA Regional since 2012. At the Normal Regional, the Tigers took fourth with a score of 196.100, the second-highest NCAA Regional score ever.

TIGERS ON TV

- ▶ Mizzou will have five meets televised on the SEC Network this season.
- ▶ The Tigers make their TV debut on Friday, Jan. 15 in a 6 p.m. CT meet at Alabama.
- ▶ Missouri next appears on the SEC Network on Fri., Feb. 12 as the Tigers travel to Lexington, Ky., to face Kentucky.
- ▶ Additionally, the Tigers' home meet against three-time defending national champions Florida on Feb. 19 will be aired live on the network.
- ▶ For the first time, both sessions of the 2016 SEC Championships will be aired live after the event was streamed a year ago.
- ▶ Additionally, all remaining Tigers' home meets and all SEC away meets will be available on SEC Network + and WatchESPN.

THE 2016 SCHEDULE

- ▶ Mizzou will host five meets in 2016, including Friday's Beauty and the Beast and a clash against Georgia at Mizzou Arena. Other home competitions include the State of Missouri Meet (against Lindenwood and Southeast Missouri State), Florida and Arkansas.
- ▶ Mizzou travels to SEC foes Alabama, Kentucky and Auburn, takes on Oklahoma, LSU, Stanford and Washington in the Metroplex Challenge, and close the year the regular season at Western Michigan.

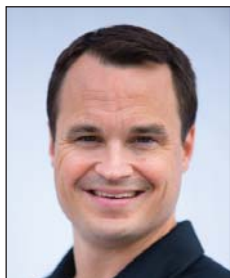
