
#### #ZOUNOTES

- ▶ Mizzou Men's Basketball (10-17, 3-11) continues on the road at Ole Miss (17-10, 7-7) on Tuesday, Feb. 23, with tipoff scheduled for 8 p.m. on the SEC Network.
- ▶ The Tigers won back-to-back Southeastern Conference games for the first time in the Kim Anderson era with wins over Tennessee (75-64, Feb. 13) and South Carolina (72-67, Feb. 16).
- ▶ The first-ever #RallyForRhyan Game (Feb. 13, vs. Tennessee) raised more than \$50,000 dollars for pediatric cancer research in honor of assistant coach **Brad Loos**' 5-year old daughter, Rhyan, who continues her fight against neuroblastoma.
- ▶ Freshman forward Kevin Puryear scored a season-high 23 points at Arkansas (Feb. 20), the 3rd 20-point game of his debut season. He became the 8th freshman in program history to eclipse 300 points.
- ▶ Senior forward Ryan Rosburg has put together the greatest five-game stretch of his career, averaging 18.2 points per game and scoring the first two 20-point games of his career.

Freshman forward Kevin Puryear ranks fourth in the SEC for his free throw percentage in conference games, hitting on 85.5 percent of his attempts (47-of-55). Additionally, sophomore guard Namon Wright is seventh with his 82.1-percent success rate (46-of-56)

#### KIM ANDERSON



In his second season leading the Mizzou Men's Basketball program, head coach Kim Anderson continues to turn the Tigers in the right direction, both on and off the court. With five newcomers on the 2015-16 roster that his staff personally recruited, Anderson hopes a higher comfort level and familiarity amongst his squad will translate into better team basketball. The Tigers already did their part in the offseason, posting the highest summer session grade point average for a Mizzou team in more than five seasons.

The Tiger leader took on the role of architect during the summer of 2014, beginning with establishing an identity for the Mizzou program. It would be built to last, with sturdy roots of character, discipline and competitiveness to reignite the passion of the many Black & Gold fans who clamor into Mizzou Arena. The first step was finding student-athletes, so Anderson and his staff brought in five freshmen and a graduate transfer for a total of six new faces. The following step was to get the newcomers and returning players to work as a team, which is not as simple of a process as it sounds.

Anderson knew sustained success could start with bumps in the road, and as the inexperience and unfamiliarity between his Tigers began to show down the stretch of the 2014-15 season, it became clear that changes would need to be made. Following Mizzou's 9-23 season, Anderson made it known what he and his staff's focuses would be going forward into the offseason. For the offseason, the Tiger coaching staff emphasized academic achievement, staff efficiency, athletic performance, team chemistry and a targeted recruiting focus.

#### NOTEWORTHY NOTES

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- ▶ Mizzou (10-17, 3-11) dropped an 84-72 result at Arkansas (13-14, 6-8) on Saturday, Feb. 20, at Bud Walton Arena.
- Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** became the eighth freshman in Mizzou Men's Basketball history to eclipse the 300-point mark with his season-best 23-point effort. It was his third game with 20+ points in his debut Tiger campaign.
- **>** Sophomore guard **Namon Wright** earned his first career double-double (12 points, 12 rebounds). The 12 boards were a career-high and also his first game rebounding in double figures.
- Senior forward **Ryan Rosburg** scored 11 points in limited minutes due to foul trouble. It was the fifth-straight game of 10+ points for Rosburg, who is now averaging 18.2 points in his last five games.
- Freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** led the Tigers in assists with seven his highest total in SEC play. The mark tied the career-high he set against Arkansas State (Dec. 1, 2015).

#### **PURYEAR JOINS FRESHMAN 300-POINT CLUB**

- Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** used his third 20-point game of his first season in the Black & Gold to reach a significant mile marker. With a season-high 23 points (6-of-14 FG, 1-of-3 3PT, 10-of-11 FT) at Arkansas (Feb. 20), Puryear became the eighth freshman in program history to reach the 300-point mark in a season.
- Puryear's scoring ability has seen an uptick in recent games due to his ability to stretch the floor. In Mizzou's first 15 games of the season, he made 4-of-21 (.190) from three-point range. In the Tigers' last five games, Puryear has sank 5-of-11 (.455) from deep.
- Finding scoring chances for Puryear has also become a focus for Mizzou. In four of the last six games, Puryear has attempted 10 or more field goals. Prior to that stretch, he had yet to attempt more than nine field goals in a Southeastern Conference game.

#### WRIGHT WENT TO BOARDING SCHOOL

- No Tiger has improved on the glass like sophomore guard **Namon Wright**, who pulled down a career-best 12 rebounds at Arkansas (Feb. 20) to help power his way to his first career double-double. Wright scored 12 points against the Razorbacks for his fourth-straight game reaching double figures.
- ▶ Wright's 12 rebounds at Arkansas are a season individual high for the Tigers, with three prior instances of 11 rebounds recorded by sophomore forward **Jakeenan Gant** (Arkansas-Pine Bluff, Dec. 29), freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** (Auburn, Jan. 9) and senior forward **Ryan Rosburg** (at Vanderbilt, Feb. 10).
- Wright narrowly missed his first career double-double with 16 points and nine rebounds against Mississippi State (Jan. 30). The nine boards were then a career-high.
- Wright, averaging 5.1 rebounds per game this season, has more than doubled his rebounds-per-game average from his freshman campaign (2.3). The Tiger has 137 rebounds through 27 games after securing 69 in 30 games last season.
  Wright is one rebound away from completely doubling his rebound total from his freshman campaign.

#### ROSBURG NOT GOING QUIETLY INTO THE NIGHT

- Mizzou senior forward **Ryan Rosburg** has not been fazed as the end of his Black & Gold career draws nearer. In fact, Rosburg has responded by playing the best basketball of his career.
- Rosburg has scored 129 points in the 11 games since Mizzou Athletics announced it would self-impose a postseason ban for the 2015-16 season (11.7 points per game), more than the 99 points he scored in his entire junior campaign (30 games, 3.3 points per game).
- ▶ In his latest five-game stretch of scoring 17, 24, 21, 18 and 11 points, Rosburg has transformed his conference scoring average from 5.6 points per game to 10.1.
- Rosburg has scored in double digits on seven different occasions since Jan. 13, including a career-high 24 points with a season-best 11 rebounds at Vanderbilt (Feb. 10) for his first career double-double.
- Over the last 11 games, Rosburg has averaged 11.7 points and 4.0 rebounds per game. Rosburg held a season scoring average of 3.6 points per game prior to the game at South Carolina (Jan. 16).

#### **BIG REBOUNDING EFFORTS VS. SOUTH CAROLINA AND TENNESSEE**

- Mizzou became just the fourth team to outrebound South Carolina with its 46-39 advantage on the boards in the 72-67 win on Tuesday, Feb. 16. The Gamecocks entered the contest as the SEC's No. 2 team in rebounding margin (+5.8) in conference games, also ranking third in total rebounds (40.0).
- ▶ The Tigers punched above their weight class with a tenacious rebounding effort against South Carolina, pulling down a total of 46. Mizzou entered the game averaging 34.2 per game in league play.
- ▶ The 46 rebounds were the second-highest total of the season for Mizzou, only falling short of the Tigers' 56-board effort vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29, 2015).
- Mizzou's double-digit rebounding margin against Tennessee (41-26, +15) was its first in conference play since the 2013-14 season when the Tigers posted a 39-24 advantage against Texas A&M (March 5, 2014). Mizzou additionally posted a +20 margin (48-28) against the Aggies in the SEC Tournament on March 13, 2014.
- ▶ Head coach **Kim Anderson**'s squad has outrebounded its opponent in consecutive conference games for the first time since the close of the 2014-15 season. Mizzou recorded advantages on the boards vs. Auburn (34-25; March 3, 2015), at Mississippi State (37-32; March 7, 2015) and vs. South Carolina in the SEC Tournament (35-26, March 11, 2015).

#### #RALLYFORRHYAN



Mizzou Athletics was pleased to announce that more than \$50,000 was raised for pediatric cancer research from Mizzou Men's Basketball's #RallyForRhyan Game vs. Tennessee on Saturday, Feb. 13.

The combined amount of t-shirt sale proceeds and cash donations at the door was raised in honor of assistant coach **Brad Loos**' 5-year-old daughter, **Rhyan**, who continues her fight against neuroblastoma. Rhyan was diagnosed with the rare form of pediatric cancer in October.

"I am so thankful for everything that everybody's done," Brad Loos said. "Thank you doesn't do it justice. I'm happy for the way the day went. I'm happy for the win. I am thrilled by the amount of money we raised. I am really happy for our guys. They have been working really hard and deserved a win."



A season-high 10,536 fans came to Mizzou Arena to see the Tigers win 75-64, predominantly clad in Gold in support of pediatric cancer awareness, as well as in conjunction with Mizzou's Gold Rush Game. Fans were granted free general admission at the gate with a cash donation of any amount, which led to \$35,726 in monetary donations on Saturday.

In cooperation with the Tiger Team Store, more than 1,300 #RallyForRhyan t-shirts were sold for more than \$15,000 in proceeds.

Additionally, Mizzou Athletics and the University of Missouri's Greek Community partnered to provide contests to chapters for both best attendance and best fundraising efforts. Chapters recognized for best attendance marks were: Pi Beta Phi, Beta Theta Pi and Alpha Kappa Lambda. Chapters honored for best fundraising efforts were: Zeta Tau Alpha, Delta Tau Delta and ACACIA.

The Tiger Team Store will continue selling #RallyForRhyan t-shirts, with proceeds donated towards pediatric cancer awareness, throughout the month of February in-store and online.

#### NOTEWORTHY NOTES (CONT.)

#### TERRENCE TURNING HEADS

- Mizzou freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** put on one of his best performances of the season in Mizzou's 72-67 victory over South Carolina (Feb. 16), scoring 15 points (4-of-9 FG), dishing out four assists and matching his season-high with seven rebounds. Phillips made 5-of-6 at the free throw line and hit on 2-of-5 from beyond the arc.
- Phillips twice completed three-point plays inside the final nine minutes of the game, first at the 8:56 mark to put Mizzou up eight points, and again with 1:58 left in the game to help the Tigers regain the lead, 67-65.
- As part of his season-high seven rebounds, Phillips grabbed two rebounds following South Carolina misses inside the final 15 seconds of the game.
- South Carolina head coach Frank Martin noticed Phillips' efforts, offering his analysis after the game:

#### **PURYEAR STANDING TALL WITH FELLOW SEC FRESHMEN**

- Mizzou freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** has averaged 11.4 points per game during the Tigers' conference schedule the highest mark on head coach **Kim Anderson**'s squad.
- Puryear is one of eight freshmen in the conference to average double digit scoring in SEC action thus far.
- Puryear ranks sixth in the SEC for freshman scoring average in overall games with his 11.6 points per game.

#### LAST TIME AGAINST OLE MISS

- Mizzou dropped a hard-fought game to Ole Miss on Feb. 3, falling by a score of 76-73 at Mizzou Arena. The Tigers led by four points with 1:05 left, but ultimately fell.
- ▶ The Tigers connected on a season-high 10 three-pointers in the game, led by three from both freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** and sophomore guard **Namon Wright**.
- Wright led the Tigers in rebounding for the second-straight game with eight boards, while Phillips recorded a season-high five steals. Freshman guard **Cullen VanLeer** also chipped in 10 points off the bench, hitting on 2-of-6 three-pointers.
- As a team, Mizzou snagged 12 steals in the game, matching a season-high which was previously set on Dec. 29, 2015, against Arkansas Pine-Bluff. Individually, Phillips had a season-high five steals in the game.

#### **MORE ABOUT OLE MISS**

- Ole Miss (17-10, 7-7) has split its last four games, three of which were road contests for the Rebels. Head coach **Andy Kennedy'**s group rebounded from a 71-56 setback at Texas A&M (Feb. 16) to win at Auburn (Feb. 20). 69-59.
- ▶ Senior guard **Stefan Moody** continues to top the SEC in scoring, averaging 22.9 points per conference game. Moody scored 23 points (6-of-18 FG, 5-of-12 3PT, 6-of-7 FT) in Ole Miss' 76-73 escape in Columbia, Mo., on Feb. 3.

#### PURYEAR STANDING OUT AMONG MIZZOU FRESHMEN, ALL-TIME

- Mizzou freshman forward **Kevin Puryear**'s scored 22 points, a previous season-high, and grabbed six rebounds at Alabama (Feb. 6), becoming the 12th freshman in program history to record a 200-point, 100-rebound debut season.
- Puryear is just the second Mizzou freshman in 12 seasons to accomplish the feat. As a freshman in 2013-14, forward Johnathan Williams III recorded 204 points and 227 rebounds.
- Since the 1993-94 season, only five Mizzou freshmen have posted at least 200 points and 100 rebounds in a season.

#### STEAL OUR HEARTS, TERRENCE

- There is a lot to love about freshman guard **Terrence Phillips**' aggressive style of play, especially on the defensive end. His 38 steals over Mizzou's 27 games leads the squad.
- Phillips put forth a defensive gem vs. Ole Miss (Feb. 3), recording a season-high five steals.
- ▶ Phillips has recorded multiple steals in nine games this season.

#### **DIGGING IN AT THE LINE**

- Mizzou has seen improvement at the free throw line this season, shooting 71.1 percent (443-of-623) thus far in the 2015-16 campaign. Three Tigers are currently shooting better than 75.0-percent from the line.
- Three of Mizzou's top four overall scorers are the squad's top marksmen at the free throw line. Freshman forward

#### NOTEWORTHY NOTES (CONT.)

Kevin Puryear is shooting 82.2 percent (88-of-107), sophomore guard Namon Wright is shooting 79.0 percent (83-of-105) and freshman guard Terrence Phillips is hitting on 75.8 percent (47-of-62).

Last season, Mizzou finished with a 66.0-percent FT mark, with only two Tigers shooting above the 75.0-percent mark.

#### **PSYCHO REBOUNDING**

- Mizzou has worked to establish itself on the boards as a noticeably shorter squad. In fact, **the Tigers rank 267th in all of Division I basketball in average height** with a roster average of 76.2 inches, or 6 feet, 3.5 inches (according to Ken Pomeroy).
- ▶ The Tigers recorded the second +10 rebounding margin game of the Kim Anderson Era against Illinois (Dec. 23), 43-32 (+11).
- Mizzou followed that up with its first 50-rebound game in more than two seasons. The Tigers racked up 56 rebounds against Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29). The last time Mizzou grabbed 50 or more rebounds was on Feb. 9, 2013, with 50 vs. Ole Miss.
- Anderson's group recorded the fourth +10 rebounding margin game of his tenure with a 41-26 edge (+15) over Tennessee en route to the 75-64 win on Feb. 13.

#### **WELCOME HOME, JORDAN BARNETT**

- ▶ Head coach **Kim Anderson** announced on Jan. 19, that former Texas forward **Jordan Barnett**, a St. Louis, Mo., native and former standout at Christian Brothers College High School, had transferred to Missouri and joined the program.
- ▶ In his last game inside Mizzou Arena, Barnett scored 43 points, grabbed 20 rebounds and blocked three shots to lead CBC to an 86-77 overtime win over Hickman to claim the 2014 Missouri Class 5 State Championship. He averaged 20.8 points and 8.2 rebounds per game as a senior.
- Barnett (6-7, 215 pounds) will sit out as part of his transfer requirements for a year-long period and be eligible to play in the second half of the 2016-17 season as a junior.
- ▶ Barnett was widely considered one of the country's Top 100 players coming out of high school, as he was ranked 70th overall by *Rivals.com* and 86th by *ESPN.com*. He was named the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch*'s All-Metro Player of the Year at the conclusion of his final prep campaign.

#### PEARL COMES AWAY IMPRESSED WITH MIZZOU

Mizzou came out swinging against Auburn in its Southeastern Conference home opener (Jan. 9), taking a 15-point halftime lead that was the Tigers' largest lead at the break in a league game since the 2013-14 season (38-22 vs. South Carolina, Jan. 25, 2014). Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl had the following to say postgame:

"I thought Missouri played well, they're a talented team. They have a lot of good young talent, 10 guys who played double digit minutes and five guys in double digit scoring. They have great balance, we got beat 40-5 off the bench. They play better at home because they're a young team and they'll beat people in here."

#### FINISHED NONCONFERENCE IN STYLE

- Mizzou finished its nonconference schedule the way it should with big victories over visitors to Mizzou Arena, first with the 53-point win (78-25) over Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29). That win was the Tigers largest margin of victory over an opponent since defeating Central Arkansas by the same amount in a 116-63 win in 2010.
- ► The 25 points allowed by the Tigers in that victory were the fewest ever allowed by a Mizzou team inside Mizzou Arena and the fewest by a Mizzou team since Jan. 3, 1947, against lowa State when Mizzou won, 36-25.
- Mizzou also held UAPB to an all-time opponent low 15.4-percent field goal shooting mark. The previous was 18.3-percent by UAPB in 1998.
- The Tigers defeated Savannah State, 81-50, for a 31-point victory on Jan. 2, bringing Mizzou's two-game stretch to a whopping 84-point differential. That 84-point differential was Mizzou's largest since outscoring its opponents by 99 points in games vs. Texas Pan-American (100-44, Nov. 22, 2009) and Chattanooga (99-56, Nov. 24, 2009).

#### THREE 2016 SIGNEES SECURED FOR ANDERSON'S SQUAD

- A 6-6 small forward, **Willie Jackson** (Cleveland, Ohio) has been electric for Garfield Heights High School, averaging 18.0 points, 14.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game and helping head coach Sonny Johnson's group to a 24-4 record as a junior in 2014-15.
- Standing 6-9, **Reed Nikko** (Maple Grove, Minn.) powered Maple Grove High School to a 23-4 record last season while averaging 9.6 points, 6.5 rebounds and 2.4 blocks per game for head coach Nick Schroeder.
- A 6-9 forward, Mitchell Smith (Van Buren, Ark.) scored in bunches for Van Buren head coach Randy Loyd, averaging 18.1 points and 7.6 rebounds per game as a junior.

#### **OFFSEASON FOCUSED ON BUILDING TEAM CHEMISTRY**

- Head coach **Kim Anderson** knew the 2015 offseason was an important one in regards to fostering a stronger bond amongst his squad. Team activities that the Tigers participated in during the spring and summer included: hospital visits, bowling, flag football, Saturday tailgates before Mizzou Football games and team picnics.
- Anderson also commissioned Missouri National Guard's Camp Clark to teach leadership and communication skills to the Tigers in late September.
- Mizzou spent the weekend (Sept. 26-27) at Camp Clark (near Nevada, Mo.) learning from Captain Travis Miller's specialized crew of instructors, all active National Guardsmen.
- Activities included obstacle course and communication challenges, proper tactical and weapon operation, Humvee rollover training and paintball.

#### **OUTSTANDING SUMMER IN THE CLASSROOM**

- ▶ Head coach **Kim Anderson**'s 2015-16 squad posted one of the program's highest summer session grade point averages in recent history.
- This season's Tigers group was the first to record a summer session GPA above the 3.0 mark in more than five years.

#### PROGRAM MOVING FORWARD

#### **MIZZOU ANNOUNCES DETAILS OF NCAA REVIEW**

- It was announced on Jan. 13, that for the past nineteen months, the University of Missouri had worked collaboratively with the NCAA enforcement staff to review potential violations in its men's basketball program. In December 2013, the NCAA enforcement staff received information regarding potential violations involving a then men's basketball student-athlete. A verbal notice of inquiry was provided to the institution on April 14, 2014.
- Mizzou is in agreement with the NCAA that five violations did occur and will work with the NCAA to bring closure to the issue through the NCAA Summary Disposition process.
- ▶ The violations originated under the tenure of the previous men's basketball staff and there is no evidence that any current staff members were aware of the violations. Though self-imposing a postseason ban for this season is difficult for Mizzou's student-athletes, the program's coaches and supporters, it is an appropriate measure in holding the institution accountable and is consistent with the NCAA penalty structure for these levels of violations.
- ▶ Because the NCAA enforcement process is ongoing, the university cannot provide additional details at this time regarding the violations or the sanctions.





## **HANK FOLEY**

Statement from the University of Missouri's Chancellor on Wednesday, Jan. 13

"The University of Missouri has high expectations for every member of our community, including our faculty, staff and students, and those same expectations are applied to those who support our endeavors. It is clear from our collaborative investigation with the NCAA that a former member of our athletics staff and members of our donor community violated NCAA bylaws and we take those actions seriously. We have an obligation to adhere to all NCAA and SEC rules as a member institution and we will continue to improve our education and oversight to ensure that we compete with integrity."



## **MACK RHOADES**

"We have already taken many proactive steps to address concerns, including appropriate self-imposed sanctions. We will win at Mizzou and do so with integrity and class. Our working relationship with the current men's basketball staff is strong and I am confident in their commitment to upholding our standards and values for Mizzou Athletics."

#### PURYEAR SCORES 23, WRIGHT GOES FOR DOUBLE-DOUBLE, BUT @MIZZOUHOOPS FALLS AT ARKANSAS



FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. - Freshman forward Kevin Puryear (Blue Springs, Mo.) became the eighth freshman in Mizzou Men's Basketball history to eclipse the 300-point mark and sophomore guard Namon Wright (Los Angeles, Calif.) earned his first career double-double (12 points, 12 rebounds) as Mizzou (10-17, 3-11) dropped an 84-72 result at Arkansas (13-14, 6-8) Saturday at Bud Walton Arena.

Puryear led the Tigers in scoring with a season-high 23, giving him 313 total points this season. It was his third game with 20+ points in his debut Tiger campaign. He was active down low, setting a new career-high in free throws made and attempted, going 10-11 from the charity stripe.

Wright led the team in rebounds with 12. He also splashed home three long-range shots late in the game to help obtain the first double-double of his career.

Freshman guard Terrence Phillips (Orange County, Calif.) led the Tigers in assists with seven - his highest total in SEC play. The mark tied the career-high he set against Arkansas State (Dec. 1, 2015).

Senior forward Ryan Rosburg (Chesterfield, Mo.) scored 11 points in limited minutes due to foul trouble. It was the fifth-straight game of 10+ points for Rosburg, who is now averaging 18.2 points in his last five games. Foul trouble did not keep the big senior from doing work on the defensive end. Rosburg finished the night with two blocks for the third time this season, and the second time in the past three games.

The Tigers showed offensive flow in the first half, going on a 7-0 run at one point. Sophomore forward Jakeenan Gant (Springfield, Ga.) provided the spark that led to the run by swatting a layup attempt by Arkansas. The subsequent scoring spree cut Arkansas' lead to four points, 22-18, with 8:42 seconds left in the first half.

Mizzou outscored Arkansas in the second half, 42-41, in large part due to the return of Rosburg, who only played four first-half minutes. The team also passed the ball very well in the second period, recording 10 assists on 13 field goals made while only committing four turnovers.


