



### LEADING OFF WITH MIZZOU

- Mizzou extended its season-high winning streak to eight games as it shutout Northern Iowa (6-0) on Wednesday, March 23. Freshman **Danielle Baumgartner** earned her second consecutive win while sophomore Amanda Sanchez led the Tigers' offense with three RBI.
- Wednesday's effort marked Mizzou's third straight 6-0 shutout victory to open its 2016 home schedule. In the three wins at University Field, the Tigers pitching staff has allowed zero runs in 21.0 innings pitched.
- Sophomore Paige Lowary was sensational against New Mexico State, earning all three of Mizzou's wins while posting a sparkling 0.48 ERA in 14.2 innings pitched. Lowary limited the Aggies to a .207 average while striking out 20 batters. For her outstanding efforts, Lowary was honored with the SEC Pitcher of the Week, marking her second career accolade from the SEC office.
- Mizzou hit .330 (33-for-100) as a team with 28 runs scored, three doubles and seven home runs in its threegame set at New Mexico State (March 19-20). Senior Emily Crane led the team with seven hits (.583 AVG) while adding two home runs and five RBI. Her solo home run on Sunday, March 20, was her 5th blast of the year and gave her a new single-season career high in home runs.
- Redshirt senior Sami Fagan was also a force at the plate, hitting .556 (5-for-9) with two home runs and seven RBI against the Aggies. In five games this past week, Fagan was simply outstanding at the plate. She finished with a .600 AVG (9-for-15) with seven runs scored, one double, two home runs, nine RBI, 16 total bases, 1.067 SLG%, .700 OBP and four stolen bases.

### **2016 SEASON HEADLINES**

- Sophomore LHP **Paige Lowary** was named SEC Pitcher of the Week (March 14-20) for her outstanding performances against Western Illinois and New Mexico State. Lowary played a key role into the Tigers' 5-0 record that week as she went 4-0 with a microscopic 0.36 ERA. The hard throwing lefty allowed only one earned run in 19.2 innings pitched while striking out over a batter an inning (22 K). It marked Lowary's second career honor from the SEC office as she also garnered Pitcher of the Week accolades in 2015 (Week 3).
- The Tigers earned its third winning streak of five game or more on Sunday, March 20, with a series sweep at New Mexico State. Mizzou extended its winning streak to seven games (second time this season) after a doubleheader sweep at UTEP on March 21.
- Mizzou earned its first two ranked wins of the season at the Judi Garman Tournament in Fullerton, Calif. (March 3-5), defeating #17 Arizona State (8-0) and #22 Baylor (10-4) in back to back games.
- The Tigers opened their 2016 campaign with six consecutive convincing wins at the Citrus Classic in Kissimmee, Fla. Overall, Mizzou outscored its opponents 55-10 en route to a perfect start to the season.
- Freshman 1B **Rylee Pierce** was one of many Tiger hitters to shine at the Citrus Classic and earned SEC Player of the Week (Feb. 15-21) honors. Pierce hit .476 with 10 R, 10 H, 2 2B, 3 HR, 8 RBI and 2 SB in her first six career games.
- Mizzou begins the season ranked 15th in the preseason USA Today / NFCA Division I coaches poll and 12th in the preseason ESPN.com / USA Softball poll.
- Over the past seven seasons (final 2008 polls through current polls), Mizzou has been ranked inside each of the major Top-25 polls (119 consecutive polls to be exact).

### **FAGAN AMONG THE SEC AND NATION'S BEST**



#### **SAMI FAGAN**

- ▶ Redshirt senior **Sami Fagan** is in her third year in Mizzou black and gold. The sweet-swinging lefty has once again upped her game in 2016 and is producing astounding numbers at the plate and on the basepaths.
- Currently, Fagan is the lone player in the SEC to rank Top-10 in AVG (.481), HR (9) and SB (18).
- Additionally, the Dunnellon, Fla., native's .899 SLG% ranks 2nd in SEC, .607 OBP ranks 2nd in SEC, 35 runs scored ranks 6th in SEC, 38 hits ranks 6th in SEC and 71 total bases ranks 2nd in SEC.
- Nationally, Fagan's .607 OBP ranks Top-10 and 1.30 runs scored per game ranks Top-10 in the country.
- ▶ The Tiger senior leader has powered one of the nation's top offenses since game one this year. Fagan possesses a team-leading 12 multi-hit games this season (50 in her career), including three 3-hit games and two 4-hit games. Also, she holds a team-leading 10 multi-RBI games in 2016 (40 in her career), including four 3-RBI games and two 4-RBI efforts.

### **TAYLOR GADBOIS: #SECSPEED**



#### **TAYLOR GADBOIS**

- Redshirt senior Taylor Gadbois has been a menace on the basepaths throughout her Tiger career and she has continued to wreak havoc in 2016.
- ▶ In the Tigers' 2016 SEC opening series at Ole Miss (March 11-13), Gadbois added six stolen bases to her season total. On Friday, March 11, in the series opener, Gadbois went 4-for-4 at the plate with an incredible four stolen bases.
- The four stolen bases tied the Mizzou Softball single-game SB record. Gadbois now owns two of the five all-time single game four stolen base outputs in program history (joining Rhea Taylor 2008, 2011 and Julie Silver 2008).
- ▶ The four swipes against the Rebels also marked the most single-game stolen bases by an SEC player so far this season.
- Two days later (March 13) during game one of a doubleheader, Gadbois picked up two more stolen bases, marking her 110th and 111th career SB. Gadbois now sits alone in 2nd place in all-time career SB in program history.
- Gadbois' 30 stolen bases this year currently ranks 2nd in the SEC and 5th in the NCAA. Additionally, her 1.11 SB per game ranks 3rd-best in the NCAA.

### TIGERS RUNNING WILD THIS SEASON

- So far this season, Mizzou has swiped 91 stolen bases in 96 attempts (94.8% success rate). Redshirt senior Taylor Gadbois (30), redshirt senior Sami Fagan (18) and freshman Regan Nash (14) lead the Tigers' attack on the base paths with double-digit SB already.
- Freshman Rylee Pierce (8), senior Emily Crane (7), junior Kirsten Mack (2), junior Chloe Rathburn (3), freshman Raime Cohen (3) and junior Natalie Fleming (2) have also been active in the running game for the Tigers.
- Mizzou's running threat has struck fear in opponents all season long. In fact, the Tigers' 3.37 stolen bases per game ranks 1st in the SEC and 2nd in the NCAA. Additionally, its 91 total stolen bases ranks 2nd-most in the SEC, trailing Ole' Miss 99 swipes (in five more games played than Mizzou).
- The Tigers' single-game high in stolen bases was seven at Ole Miss (March 11). Overall, Mizzou has produced at least one stolen base in 26-of-27 games, multiple stolen base nights in 22-of-27 games, have swiped fourplus stolen bases in 11 games and tallied five-plus stolen bases in eight games.

### TIGER TRIO LEADS OFFENSE AT MARY NUTTER

- For the second straight weekend, Mizzou's offense put together an impressive display at the plate. Over five games at the Mary Nutter Classic in Cathedral City, Calif., (Feb. 25-27), the Tigers hit .425 (62-for-146) with 52 runs scored, eight doubles, two triples, eight home runs and 47 RBI.
- Leading the way for Mizzou was sophomore **Amanda Sanchez**, redshirt senior **Sami Fagan** and junior **Chloe Rathburn**. Sanchez paced the Tigers with a ridiculous .688 average (11-for-16) with seven runs, one double, one triple and four RBI. Sanchez hit safely in each Mary Nutter game, including four multi-hit efforts. The West Covina, Calif., native now has eight multi-hit games to her resume this season and has amassed a 10-game hitting streak.
- Fagan was an absolute monster, hitting .650 (13-for-20) with team-leading nine runs, two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and team-leading 24 total bases. Fagan opened her weekend with a four-hit performance vs. NC State and closed her set with another four-hit outing against BYU. On the year, Fagan has five multi-hit efforts and is in midst of a six-game hitting streak.
- ▶ Rathburn had a day to remember in the Tigers' Mary Nutter opener vs. NC State, going 2-for-3 with two home runs and seven RBI. The two long balls, including a grand slam, occurred in the same inning as Rathburn piled onto her team-lead in home runs. The Mission Viejo, Calif., native has five multi-RBI games to her name, including single-game totals of four, five and seven.

### PIERCE OPENS CAREER WITH SEC POW HONORS

- ► Freshman 1B **Rylee Pierce** (Visalia, Calif.) was named Southeastern Conference Softball Player of the Week, as announced Monday, Feb. 22, by the SEC office. The award marked Pierce's first career honor from the SEC office.
- ▶ Pierce tallied a .476 average with 10 runs scored, 10 hits, two doubles, two stolen bases, three home runs and eight RBI in her NCAA debut as a Tiger. Her outstanding weekend at the plate paced Mizzou hitters in runs, home runs and total bases (21).
- ▶ The hard-hitting freshman was a force in the middle of the Mizzou lineup in her first six games. Pierce posted an astounding 1.522 OPS (1.000 SLG%, .522 OBP) and was a model of consistency throughout the weekend, recording at least one run, hit and RBI in each game.
- In a three game stretch, Pierce recorded multi-hit games each time out and finished with four total multi-hit efforts at the Citrus Classic.






### **DANIELLE BAUMGARTNER**

- A huge part into Mizzou's opening weekend success was because of its outstanding contributions from its freshmen class. In the circle, freshman RHP **Danielle Baumgartner** was outstanding in her three appearances (two starts), posting a 3-0 record in 18.0 IP with a miniscule 0.39 ERA.
- In her two starts (Feb. 19 vs. Elon and Feb. 20 vs. College of Charleston), Baumgartner tossed two complete game victories, while allowing only two runs (one earned). After giving up two runs in the first inning against Elon, the Mexico, Mo., native reeled off 17.0 consecutive scoreless innings to wrap up her outstanding Citrus Classic.
- Throughout her 17.0 straight scoreless IP, Baumgartner was virtually unhittable, allowing only 11 hits and four walks (0.88 WHIP).







PAIGE LOWARY REGAN NASH

- The Tigers were impressive in their opening weekend, producing six wins in three days at the Citrus Classic (Feb. 19-21). Mizzou outscored its opponents to the tune of 55-10, including scoring eight or more runs in five of its games.

Mizzou Softball has become one of the top programs in the nation, and is a perennial contender to reach the Women's College World Series under the direction of Head Coach Ehren Earleywine, a mid-Missouri native who enters his 10th year leading the charge for the Tigers. With a career winning percentage of .745 (575-197 over 13 seasons), Earleywine is truly among the top coaches in the nation. He is the 13th-winningest coach in NCAA Division I history entering this season, according to winning percentage.

Mizzou enjoyed a proud softball tradition before Earleywine took over in 2007, but he's clearly since taken the Tigers to the next level. In the seven seasons before Earleywine's arrival, Mizzou averaged 32.0 wins per season (2000-06). The Tigers have averaged 45.7 wins per season in Earleywine's nine seasons in the dugout.

Earleywine has built the Tigers by striving for excellence in all phases of the game. Shut-down pitching, consistent fielding and explosive offense have been constants during his tenure in Columbia. In his nine seasons at the helm of the Missouri softball program, the Tigers have made three Women's College World Series appearances, recorded the first three 50-win seasons in school history and have advanced to seven NCAA Super Regionals. These accomplishments have come while building an incredible .749 winning percentage to rank as one of the winningest programs in the nation since 2007.

Mizzou Softball has competed at the highest level during Earleywine's time leading the Tigers, including the capture of two of the programs' seven all-time conference championships. As part of a stellar 50-12 overall record in 2009, Mizzou won the 2009 Big 12 Conference Tournament. The Tigers followed that up with a Big 12 Regular Season Championship in 2011, posting a stout 53-10 overall record. In Mizzou's first season of Southeastern Conference action in 2013, Earleywine's squad left an immediate impression. The Tigers placed third in the league's regular season standings before finishing as runners-up at the SEC Tournament.

Earleywine's teams have been ranked in the top-10 for seven straight seasons, including as high as No. 3 in the nation during a three-week run in 2010. Mizzou has finished as a top-10 team in the polls three times under Earleywine's leadership.

Named Missouri's head coach in August of 2006, Earleywine's model for winning was rewarded with a seven-year contract extension on Aug. 31, 2011, making him the first Olympic coach in Missouri history to receive an extension greater than five years. In his nine seasons at Missouri, Earleywine has managed a record of 411-138 and became the fastest Missouri softball coach to reach 300 victories. Since beginning his head coaching career in 2003 at Georgia Tech, Earleywine has turned in a .743 winning percentage, the 13th-best amongst active Division I coaches. He was the fifth fastest coach to reach 100 wins in NCAA Division I softball history.

Since Earleywine took the reins, Missouri's batting averages have been on the rise, which includes a .313 mark in 2009, a .304 mark in 2013, .310 rate in 2014 and .320 posting in 2015. Additionally, the team ERA has steadily been on the decline, highlighted by 2011's 1.40 mark, the Tiger's best end of the year ERA since 1998.

Mizzou's entire softball staff has received deserved recognition while helping the program ascend to the upper echelon of college softball. Earleywine and crew were named NFCA Midwest Region Staff of the Year three times in a four-year span (2009, 2010, & 2012).
