- Four Tigers scored in double figures in Mizzou's frenetic comeback attempt at LSU (March 1), with both senior forward **Ryan Rosburg** and freshman guard **K.J. Walton** scoring 11 second half points in the eventual 80-71 setback.
- Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** leads Mizzou with his 11.5 and 11.2 respective scoring averages in overall and conference games.
- Senior forward **Ryan Rosburg** has put together the greatest eight-game stretch of his career, averaging 15.5 points per game and scoring the first two 20-point games of his career.
- The first-ever #RallyForRhyann Game (Feb. 13, vs. Tennessee) raised more than \$50,000 dollars for pediatric cancer research in honor of assistant coach **Brad Loos'** 5-year old daughter, Rhyann, who continues her fight against neuroblastoma.

In his second season leading the Mizzou Men's Basketball program, head coach **Kim Anderson** continues to turn the Tigers in the right direction, both on and off the court. With five newcomers on the 2015-16 roster that his staff personally recruited, Anderson hopes a higher comfort level and familiarity amongst his squad will translate into better team basketball. The Tigers already did their part in the offseason, posting the highest summer session grade point average for a Mizzou team in more than five seasons.

The Tiger leader took on the role of architect during the summer of 2014, beginning with establishing an identity for the Mizzou program. It would be built to last, with sturdy roots of character, discipline and competitiveness to reignite the passion of the many Black & Gold fans who clamor into Mizzou Arena. The first step was finding student-athletes, so Anderson and his staff brought in five freshmen and a graduate transfer for a total of six new faces. The following step was to get the newcomers and returning players to work as a team, which is not as simple of a process as it sounds.

Anderson knew sustained success could start with bumps in the road, and as the inexperience and unfamiliarity between his Tigers began to show down the stretch of the 2014-15 season, it became clear that changes would need to be made. Following Mizzou's 9-23 season, Anderson made it known what he and his staff's focuses would be going forward into the offseason. For the offseason, the Tiger coaching staff emphasized academic achievement, staff efficiency, athletic performance, team chemistry and a targeted recruiting focus.

## NOTEWORTHY NOTES

### LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Mizzou (10-20, 3-14) clawed its way back, cutting a 22-point halftime deficit down to three points, but ultimately fell, 80-71, to LSU (18-12, 11-6) on Tuesday, March 1. The Tigers outscored LSU, 47-34, in the second half, utilizing a 26-11 run to make the score 65-62 with 4:48 remaining in the game.
- ▶ Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** shot 3-of-5 from beyond the three-point line in the game, a season-high for three-pointers made. After connecting on only 4-of-21 (19 percent) from deep in his first 22 games, Puryear has shot 9-of-20 (45 percent) from beyond the arc in his last eight games.
- ▶ Puryear scored 13 points on the night, his 20th double-digit performance of the season. Puryear now sits in sixth place on the freshman class all-time scoring leaders list with 344 points, surpassing Doug Smith, who scored 338 points in the 1987-88 season.
- ▶ Freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** dished out four assists in the game to reach 100 assists on the season. Phillips is the eighth freshman in Mizzou history to reach 100 assists.

### ROSBURG GOING OUT AS GO-TO BIG

- ▶ Mizzou senior forward **Ryan Rosburg** has become a consistent scoring threat for the Tigers down the stretch of his final season wearing the Black & Gold. Forget that the Chesterfield, Missouri, native has a career 4.1-points-per-game scoring average - Rosburg has averaged an outstanding **15.5 points per game over his last eight games** and has posted a **10.2 scoring average in conference play** this season.
- ▶ Always an efficient shooter (60.6 career FG%), Rosburg has successfully converted 67.7 percent (67-of-99) of his field goal attempts in his senior league campaign. If not for averaging 3.9 field goal makes per conference game, his shooting percentage would rank No. 1 in the SEC (5.0-makes-per-game minimum).
- ▶ Rosburg scored 13 points on 5-of-7 shooting from the field in the comeback attempt at LSU (March 1). **Rosburg has scored in double digits in seven of his last eight games.**
- ▶ Rosburg has scored 162 points in the 14 games since Mizzou Athletics announced it would self-impose a postseason ban for the 2015-16 season (11.6 points per game), more than the 99 points he scored in his entire junior campaign (30 games, 3.3 points per game). That total of 162 points in the span of 14 games also nearly matches his entire sophomore season (169 points, 35 games, 4.8 points per game).
- ▶ In his latest eight-game stretch, Rosburg has transformed his conference scoring average from 5.6 points per game to 10.2 points per game.
- ▶ Rosburg has scored in double digits on nine different occasions since Jan. 13, including a career-high 24 points with a season-best 11 rebounds at Vanderbilt (Feb. 10) for his first career double-double.
- ▶ **Rosburg plays the final game of his collegiate career on Senior Night vs. Florida on Saturday, March 5.**

### WALTON STARTS CONNECTING

- ▶ Freshman guard **K.J. Walton** showed a glimpse of what Mizzou fans would like to see on a more consistent basis from the wing player who hails from Indianapolis. Walton poured in three three-pointers (3-of-3 3PT), shooting 4-of-6 from the field overall en route to 11 points at LSU (March 1).
- ▶ The effort marked a season-high in triples for the freshman, surpassing the two (2-of-2 3PT) he hit vs. Savannah State (Jan. 2). Walton had not attempted three shots from beyond the arc in a game prior to the game at LSU.
- ▶ Walton has scored in double figures in three of the last five games, twice matching his season-best of 11 points in that span. He recorded 11 points in Mizzou's second game of the season (Maryland-Eastern Shore, Nov. 15, 2015), and has since reached that total at Ole Miss (Feb. 23) and at LSU (March 1).

### PHILLIPS JOINS CENTURY CLUB FOR DIMES

- ▶ Freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** became the eighth freshman in school history to record 100 assists in a season with his four dimes at LSU (March 1).
- ▶ Phillips is the first Tiger freshman to accomplish the feat since Phil Pressey in 2010-11 (117).

### PURYEAR JOINS FRESHMAN 300-POINT CLUB

- ▶ Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** used the third 20-point game of his first season in the Black & Gold to reach a significant mile marker. With a season-high 23 points (6-of-14 FG, 1-of-3 3PT, 10-of-11 FT) at Arkansas (Feb. 20), Puryear became the eighth freshman in program history to reach the 300-point mark in a season.
- ▶ Puryear moved into sixth all-time on Mizzou's freshman scoring chart with his 13 points at LSU (March 1). The current Tiger jumped past Doug Smith's 338 points from the 1987-88 season.
- ▶ Puryear's scoring ability has seen an uptick in recent games due to his ability to stretch the floor. In Mizzou's first 22 games of the season, he made 4-of-21 (.190) from three-point range. In the Tigers' last eight games, Puryear has sank 9-of-20 (.450) from deep.

### LAST TIME AGAINST FLORIDA

- ▶ Then-freshman guard **Namon Wright** scored a career-high 28 points off 10-of-13 shooting to lead Mizzou to a 64-52 win over Florida on Feb. 24, 2015 at Mizzou Arena.
- ▶ Mizzou held Florida to 52 points in the contest, the second fewest points the Tigers allowed all season. The season low point total for an opponent was Valparaiso's 41 on Nov. 16, 2014.
- ▶ Florida's 52 points tied for its second lowest scoring output of the season.

- Prior to this run of scoring success, Rosburg had scored 10+ points in four games over his entire career.

- A career rebounder of 3.0 boards per game, Rosburg has grabbed **five or more rebounds in seven of the last eight games**.
- That stretch includes his 11-rebound game at Vanderbilt (Feb. 10) which helped him tally his first career double-double.
- Rosburg's career high in boards (12) came as a sophomore.

- In conference play alone this season (17 games), Rosburg has compiled 174 points, which is more than he scored in either his entire sophomore (169 points) or junior (99 points) campaigns.

Ryan Rosburg is the first Mizzou senior on the team's roster to have spent his entire eligibility in the program since the 2012-13 season. Laurence Bowers was a redshirt senior that season, in which Rosburg was a true freshman.

Mizzou Athletics was pleased to announce that more than \$50,000 was raised for pediatric cancer research from Mizzou Men's Basketball's #RallyForRhyan Game vs. Tennessee on Saturday, Feb. 13.

The combined amount of t-shirt sale proceeds and cash donations at the door was raised in honor of assistant coach **Brad Loos'** 5-year-old daughter, **Rhyan**, who continues her fight against neuroblastoma. Rhyan was diagnosed with the rare form of pediatric cancer in October.

"I am so thankful for everything that everybody's done," Brad Loos said. "Thank you doesn't do it justice. I'm happy for the way the day went. I'm happy for the win. I am thrilled by the amount of money we raised. I am really happy for our guys. They have been working really hard and deserved a win."

A season-high 10,536 fans came to Mizzou Arena to see the Tigers win 75-64, predominantly clad in Gold in support of pediatric cancer awareness, as well as in conjunction with Mizzou's Gold Rush Game. Fans were granted free general admission at the gate with a cash donation of any amount, which led to \$35,726 in monetary donations on Saturday.

In cooperation with the Tiger Team Store, more than 1,300 #RallyForRhyan t-shirts were sold for more than \$15,000 in proceeds.

Additionally, Mizzou Athletics and the University of Missouri's Greek Community partnered to provide contests to chapters for both best attendance and best fundraising efforts. Chapters recognized for best attendance marks were: Pi Beta Phi, Beta Theta Pi and Alpha Kappa Lambda. Chapters honored for best fundraising efforts were: Zeta Tau Alpha, Delta Tau Delta and ACACIA.

### DIGGING IN AT THE LINE

► Mizzou has seen improvement at the free throw line this season, shooting 71.3 percent (476-of-688) over the course of the 2015-16 campaign. In conference play, the Tigers have been especially stout, **shooting 73.0 percent (273-of-374) to rank second in the league.**

► Mizzou's top three scorers all also the squad's top marksmen from the charity stripe. Freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** is shooting 83.2 percent (99-of-119), sophomore guard **Namon Wright** is shooting 78.0 percent (85-of-109) and freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** is hitting on 74.6 percent (50-of-67).

► Last season, Mizzou finished with a 66.0-percent FT mark, with two Tigers shooting above the 75.0-percent mark.

### WRIGHT WENT TO BOARDING SCHOOL

► No Tiger has improved on the glass like sophomore guard **Namon Wright**, who pulled down a career-best 12 rebounds at Arkansas (Feb. 20) to help power his way to his first career double-double. Wright scored 12 points against the Razorbacks for his fourth-straight game reaching double figures.

► Wright's 12 rebounds at Arkansas are a season individual high for the Tigers, with three prior instances of 11 rebounds recorded by sophomore forward **Jakeenan Gant** (Arkansas-Pine Bluff, Dec. 29), freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** (Auburn, Jan. 9) and senior forward **Ryan Rosburg** (at Vanderbilt, Feb. 10).

► Wright narrowly missed his first career double-double with 16 points and nine rebounds against Mississippi State (Jan. 30). The nine boards were then a career-high.

► Wright, averaging 5.1 rebounds per game this season, has more than doubled his rebounds-per-game average from his freshman campaign (2.3). The Tiger has 153 rebounds through 30 games after securing 69 in 30 games last season. **Wright has completely doubled his rebounding effort from his freshman season.**

### BIG REBOUNDING EFFORTS VS. SOUTH CAROLINA AND TENNESSEE

► Mizzou became just the fourth team to outrebound South Carolina with its 46-39 advantage on the boards in the 72-67 win on Tuesday, Feb. 16. The Gamecocks entered the contest as the SEC's No. 2 team in rebounding margin (+5.8) in conference games, also ranking third in total rebounds (40.0).

► The Tigers punched above their weight class with a tenacious rebounding effort against South Carolina, pulling down a total of 46. Mizzou entered the game averaging 34.2 per game in league play.

► The 46 rebounds were the second-highest total of the season for Mizzou, only falling short of the Tigers' 56-board effort vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (Dec. 29, 2015).

► Mizzou's double-digit rebounding margin against Tennessee (41-26, +15) was its first in conference play since the 2013-14 season when the Tigers posted a 39-24 advantage against Texas A&M (March 5, 2014). Mizzou additionally posted a +20 margin (48-28) against the Aggies in the SEC Tournament on March 13, 2014.

► Head coach **Kim Anderson's** squad outrebounded its opponent in consecutive conference games for the first time since the close of the 2014-15 season. Mizzou recorded advantages on the boards vs. Auburn (34-25; March 3, 2015), at Mississippi State (37-32; March 7, 2015) and vs. South Carolina in the SEC Tournament (35-26, March 11, 2015).

### TERRENCE TURNING HEADS

► Mizzou freshman guard **Terrence Phillips** put on one of his best performances of the season in Mizzou's 72-67 victory over South Carolina (Feb. 16), scoring 15 points (4-of-9 FG), dishing out four assists and matching his season-high with seven rebounds. Phillips made 5-of-6 at the free throw line and hit on 2-of-5 from beyond the arc.

► Phillips twice completed three-point plays inside the final nine minutes of the game, first at the 8:56 mark to put Mizzou up eight points, and again with 1:58 left in the game to help the Tigers regain the lead, 67-65.

► As part of his season-high seven rebounds, Phillips grabbed two rebounds following South Carolina misses inside the final 15 seconds of the game.

### PURYEAR STANDING TALL WITH FELLOW SEC FRESHMEN

- ▶ Mizzou freshman forward **Kevin Puryear** has averaged 11.2 points per game during the Tigers' conference schedule - the highest mark on head coach **Kim Anderson's** squad. He is joined by two others' in double-figure conference scoring: senior forward **Ryan Rosburg** (10.2) and sophomore guard **Namon Wright** (10.0).
- ▶ Puryear is one of seven freshmen in the conference to average double digit scoring in SEC action thus far.

### WELCOME HOME, JORDAN BARNETT

- ▶ Head coach **Kim Anderson** announced on Jan. 19, that former Texas forward **Jordan Barnett**, a St. Louis, Mo., native and former standout at Christian Brothers College High School, had transferred to Missouri and joined the program.
- ▶ In his last game inside Mizzou Arena, Barnett scored 43 points, grabbed 20 rebounds and blocked three shots to lead CBC to an 86-77 overtime win over Hickman to claim the 2014 Missouri Class 5 State Championship. He averaged 20.8 points and 8.2 rebounds per game as a senior.
- ▶ Barnett (6-7, 215 pounds) will sit out as part of his transfer requirements for a year-long period and be eligible to play in the second half of the 2016-17 season as a junior.
- ▶ Barnett was widely considered one of the country's Top 100 players coming out of high school, as he was ranked 70th overall by *Rivals.com* and 86th by *ESPN.com*. He was named the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch's* All-Metro Player of the Year at the conclusion of his final prep campaign.

### THREE 2016 SIGNEES SECURED FOR ANDERSON'S SQUAD

- ▶ A 6-6 small forward, **Willie Jackson** (Cleveland, Ohio) has been electric for Garfield Heights High School, averaging 18.0 points, 14.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game and helping head coach Sonny Johnson's group to a 24-4 record as a junior in 2014-15.
- ▶ Standing 6-9, **Reed Nikko** (Maple Grove, Minn.) powered Maple Grove High School to a 23-4 record last season while averaging 9.6 points, 6.5 rebounds and 2.4 blocks per game for head coach Nick Schroeder.
- ▶ A 6-9 forward, **Mitchell Smith** (Van Buren, Ark.) scored in bunches for Van Buren head coach Randy Loyd, averaging 18.1 points and 7.6 rebounds per game as a junior.

### OFFSEASON FOCUSED ON BUILDING TEAM CHEMISTRY

- ▶ Head coach **Kim Anderson** knew the 2015 offseason was an important one in regards to fostering a stronger bond amongst his squad. Team activities that the Tigers participated in during the spring and summer included: hospital visits, bowling, flag football, Saturday tailgates before Mizzou Football games and team picnics.
- ▶ Anderson also commissioned Missouri National Guard's Camp Clark to teach leadership and communication skills to the Tigers in late September.
- ▶ Mizzou spent the weekend (Sept. 26-27) at Camp Clark (near Nevada, Mo.) learning from Captain Travis Miller's specialized crew of instructors, all active National Guardsmen.
- ▶ Activities included obstacle course and communication challenges, proper tactical and weapon operation, Humvee rollover training and paintball.

### OUTSTANDING SUMMER IN THE CLASSROOM

- ▶ Head coach **Kim Anderson's** 2015-16 squad posted one of the program's highest summer session grade point averages in recent history.
- ▶ This season's Tigers group was the first to record a summer session GPA above the 3.0 mark in more than five years.

## PROGRAM MOVING FORWARD

### MISSOURI ANNOUNCES DETAILS OF NCAA REVIEW

- It was announced on Jan. 13, that for the past nineteen months, the University of Missouri had worked collaboratively with the NCAA enforcement staff to review potential violations in its men's basketball program. In December 2013, the NCAA enforcement staff received information regarding potential violations involving a then men's basketball student-athlete. A verbal notice of inquiry was provided to the institution on April 14, 2014.
- Mizzou is in agreement with the NCAA that five violations did occur and will work with the NCAA to bring closure to the issue through the NCAA Summary Disposition process.
- The violations originated under the tenure of the previous men's basketball staff and there is no evidence that any current staff members were aware of the violations.** Though self-imposing a postseason ban for this season is difficult for Missouri's student-athletes, the program's coaches and supporters, it is an appropriate measure in holding the institution accountable and is consistent with the NCAA penalty structure for these levels of violations.
- Because the NCAA enforcement process is ongoing, the university cannot provide additional details at this time regarding the violations or the sanctions.



### HANK FOLEY

Statement from the University of Missouri's Chancellor on Wednesday, Jan. 13

"The University of Missouri has high expectations for every member of our community, including our faculty, staff and students, and those same expectations are applied to those who support our endeavors. It is clear from our collaborative investigation with the NCAA that a former member of our athletics staff and members of our donor community violated NCAA bylaws and we take those actions seriously. We have an obligation to adhere to all NCAA and SEC rules as a member institution and we will continue to improve our education and oversight to ensure that we compete with integrity."



### MACK RHOADES

Statement from Missouri's Director of Athletics on Wednesday, Jan. 13

"We have already taken many proactive steps to address concerns, including appropriate self-imposed sanctions. We will win at Missouri and do so with integrity and class. I am satisfied the University fully cooperated with the NCAA and will continue to do so. We must do better and we will. Our working relationship with the current men's basketball staff is strong and I am confident in their commitment to upholding our standards and values for Missouri Athletics."

However, I am appreciative to Mack Rhoades and our staff for their guidance and support throughout this process. We are committed to representing this great university and state with honor and integrity and that's what we are going to do."

## SECOND HALF COMEBACK EFFORT NOT QUITE ENOUGH FOR @MIZZOUHOOPS AT LSU



**BATON ROUGE, La.** - Mizzou Men's Basketball (10-20, 3-14) clawed its way back, cutting a 22-point halftime deficit down to three points, but ultimately fell, 80-71, to LSU (18-12, 11-6) on Tuesday. The Tigers outscored LSU, 47-34, in the second half, utilizing a 26-11 run to make the score 65-62 with 4:48 remaining in the game following a three-pointer from freshman guard K.J. Walton (Indianapolis, Ind.).

Three Tigers, freshman guard Terrence Phillips (Orange County, Calif.), freshman forward Kevin Puryear (Blue Springs, Mo.), and senior forward Ryan Rosburg (Chesterfield, Mo.), scored 13 points to lead the way for Mizzou. Walton chipped in 11 points in the game, matching his season-high. Puryear and Walton each connected on three shots from beyond the arc to set season highs, while Phillips led the team with four assists and sophomore guard Namon Wright (Los Angeles, Calif.) led with eight rebounds.

Phillips powered the Tigers in the first half, scoring seven points on 2-of-4 shooting from the field and 2-of-2 marksmanship from the free throw line. Mizzou held close to LSU over the game's first five minutes, but a 16-4 run from LSU put the Tigers down 14 with 9:17 left in the half. LSU's lead was up to 22, 46-42 at the halftime break.

Mizzou showed resiliency in the second half, opening up the half on a 12-4 run. Puryear had five points in the stretch, while Rosburg added four. A layup following a drop-step on a post-up move from Rosburg closed the deficit to under 10 points for the first time since early in the first half at 63-54 with 7:48 left in the game. The Tigers finished off a 26-11 run after Walton connected on his third three-pointer of the game, to cut the lead to three at 65-62. It would be the closest Mizzou could get, as LSU finished the game on a 15-9 run to close out the score at 80-71.
