STORY LINES

- ▶ **THE MATCHUP:** Mizzou Women's Basketball returns home for a two-game home stand, beginning with a Saturday afternoon tilt with South Dakota, who enters the game with an impressive 9-1 mark on the season. Among the Coyotes impressive start is a 64-59 win over No. 22-ranked Iowa on Nov. 28. Tipoff between the Tigers and Coyotes is scheduled for 3:00 p.m. (CT) on SEC Network +. A radio broadcast of the game will be available on KTGR with Brad Tregnago and Kathy Wiesen on the call. Mizzou enters the contest on a five-game winning streak after defeating Saint Louis, 74-62 on the road on Sunday, Dec. 9. Junior guard **Amber Smith** has led the way for Mizzou during the win streak, as she has posted double-doubles in four of the last five games, including a 15-point and 13-rebound performance against the Billikens on Sunday. Saturday's game will be the second meeting between Mizzou and South Dakota, with the Tigers winning the only other contest, 96-64 on March 9, 1979 in the AIAW Region VI Championships.
- ▶ **DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE:** Junior guard **Amber Smith** has become a double-double machine this season, as she has turned in six double-double in 10 games, a mark which marks second in the SEC and tied-for-10th in the NCAA. During Mizzou's five-game winning streak, Smith is averaging 17.4 points and 10.2 rebounds per game with four double-doubles. In Mizzou's most recent outing, Smith scored 15 points and matched a career-high with 13 rebounds at Saint Louis. Against UMKC, Smith scored 19 points on 8-for-15 shooting from the field and corralled 10 rebounds to lead Mizzou to victory. In addition to UMKC, Smith recorded double-doubles against Quinnipiac on Nov. 24 (17 points, 10 rebounds) and West Virginia on Dec. 2 (28 points, 13 rebounds). Smith's set career-highs in points and rebounds against the Mountaineers.
- ▶ **FIVE-GAME WINNING STREAK:** Mizzou enters Saturday's game on a five-game winning streak after winning its final two games at the Gulf Coast Showcase against Quinnipiac (Nov. 24, 65-51) and Duke (Nov. 25, 62-54), road games at West Virginia (Dec. 2, 68-51) and Saint Louis (Dec. 9, 74-62), and a home game against UMKC (Dec. 6, 66-59). A win against South Dakota would match Mizzou's longest win streak since winning six straight between Dec. 5 and Feb. 22 last season. Defense has been a key part of Mizzou's win streak, as the Tigers have held their opponents to 55.4 points per game, 33.5 percent shooting from the field and 29.0 percent shooting from three in the five victories.

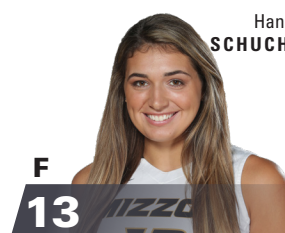

- All eyes will be on senior guard **Sophie Cunningham's** senior season as she looks to lead Mizzou to a fourth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance.
- A returning two-time AP All-America Honorable Mention selection and two-time First Team All-SEC honoree, Cunningham has named to the Wooden Award Preseason Watch List (Nov. 7), the Naismith Trophy Award Preseason Watch List (Nov. 12), and WBCA Cheryl Miller Small Forward of the Year Watch List (Oct. 24). The Cheryl Miller award is an award in its second year, and is given out to the top small forward in the country. Cunningham was a one of five finalists for the award in 2017-18, and is the only returning finalist from a season ago. Cunningham was also named Preseason All-SEC First Team by both the media and coaches.
- Cunningham continues to climb up the Mizzou record book, as she currently ranks **No. 5 in all-time scoring** (1,717 points), No. 4 in career 3-pointers made (168), No. 5 in PPG (16.5), No. 4 in free throws made (423), No. 5 in three-point percentage (.391), No. 3 in free throw percentage (.828) and No. 8 in field goal percentage (.502), No. 8 in assists (317) and No. 10 in career field goals made (563).
- With 1,717 career points, Cunningham is the active career scoring leader in the SEC. She holds a slim lead on Florida's Funda Nakkasoglu by 11 points (1,706 points). Her career-point total ranks 19th among active players in the NCAA D-I. Among SEC career active leaders, Cunningham also ranks fifth in career rebounds (555) and seventh in career assists (317). Cunningham's career 82.7 percent success rate from the free throw line ranks ninth among active NCAA D-I players.
- Cunningham will need to score 410 points and connect on 59 free throws to become the most prolific player in those categories.

- In 2017-18, Cunningham was the **only player in the nation to shoot better than 54 percent from the field** (54.2 percent, 186-for-343), **45 percent from three** (45.7 percent, 69-for 151) and **83 percent from the free throw line** (83.6 percent, 133-for-159). Her three-point percentage ranked fourth in the NCAA.
- Cunningham returns for her senior season after earning AP All-America Honorable Mention honors and All-SEC First Team Honors each of the last two seasons (2016-17, 2017-18), as well as being named the 2016 SEC Freshman of the Year and earning All-SEC Second Team honors in her freshman campaign (2015-16).
- Cunningham was Mizzou's leading scorer for the third consecutive season in her junior campaign, scoring 18.5 points per game while grabbing 4.7 rebounds per game and recording 93 assists, the second-most on the team. She reached double figures scoring marks in 28 of 31 games she played in, and scored 20+ points 13 times during the season.
- **30-POINT PERFORMANCES FROM SOPH:** Senior guard **Sophie Cunningham's** 31 points in Mizzou's season-opening victory over Western Illinois (Nov. 6) was her eighth career game with 30+ points, and her second consecutive game after scoring 35 points against Florida Gulf Coast in last year's NCAA Tournament game.
- Cunningham's eighth 30-point contest ranks third in Mizzou history, trailing only Renee Kelly's 16 and Joni Davis' 13. Davis is Mizzou's all-time leading scorer with 2,126 points, while Kelly ranks second with 2,119 points.
- Mizzou is an all-time 6-2 in games where Cunningham scores 30+ points.

STORY LINES

- **IN PURSUIT OF WIN NO. 500:** Mizzou Head Coach **Robin Pingeton** will be chasing down a major coaching milestone this season, as she currently stands 10 wins away from 500 career victories (490-267, .647). Earlier this season, Pingeton registered win No. 150 as Mizzou's head coach in a 59-36 win over SIU Edwardsville on Nov. 19. In her ninth season, Pingeton ranks second in winning percentage (.585) in program history, trailing only coach Mizzou Hall of Famer Joann Rutherford (.617, 422-262). Among active coaches, Pingeton's 488 career wins ranks second in the Southeastern Conference behind only Texas A&M's Gary Blair (769 wins) and 33rd overall among D-I head coaches. After an outstanding 2017-18 season, Pingeton was a top-10 finalist for both the Naismith National Coach of the Year Award and the WBCA National Coach of the Year Award.
- In 2017-18, Pingeton led Mizzou to the NCAA Tournament for the third straight season for the first time since 1984-86. Mizzou earned a No. 5-seed in the NCAA Tournament, its highest seed in a 64-team tournament in program history and its highest seed overall since grabbing a 4-seed in the 32 team 1984 NCAA Tournament.
- Pingeton steered Mizzou to 24 wins for the first time since 1983-84. That marked the fifth-most wins in a campaign in program history. The Tigers now have at least 22 wins in three straight seasons under Pingeton for the first time since 1982-85.
- With Pingeton at the helm, Mizzou is one of just 15 Power 5 programs with at least 22 wins and an NCAA Tournament appearance in each of the last three seasons.
- In 2017-18, Mizzou spent the entire campaign ranked in the Top 25, climbing as high as No. 11 in the AP Poll, their highest ranking since 1984, and No. 9 in the Coaches' Poll, their highest ranking in that poll in program history.
- In SEC play, Pingeton's squad racked up 11 victories, giving them at least 11 wins in league play in back to back seasons for the first time since 1983-84 and 1984-85.
- **PINGETON RECEIVES CONTRACT EXTENSION:** On Nov. 21, Mizzou Athletics extended the contract of Head Women's Basketball Coach **Robin Pingeton** four years, ensuring she will be on the Mizzou sideline through the 2024-25 season. In her ninth season, Pingeton has built Mizzou into a consistent Top-25 team program, leading the Tigers to three consecutive NCAA Tournaments for the first time since 1984-86.
- "It has been exciting to watch Robin and her staff restore Mizzou's proud women's basketball tradition while making a positive impact in the lives of our student-athletes, and a difference within the Columbia community," said Mizzou Director of Athletics **Jim Sterk**. "She is a leader of impeccable integrity, who has re-built this program from the ground up, and I believe this new contract demonstrates Mizzou's commitment to Robin and rewards her for the success she has enjoyed over the last eight seasons. Robin is a tremendous fit at Mizzou, and I look forward to watching her program continue to graduate its student-athletes at a high level while competing for championships."
- "I am extremely grateful, and appreciative to the University of Missouri for their faith and commitment to myself and my staff," said Pingeton. "It is an honor to be associated with a great university and community. My family and I are so thankful to have the opportunity to work with great leaders, administrators and student-athletes. I am looking forward to continuing to grow this program and pursuing excellence both on and off the court."
- In her time at Mizzou, Pingeton has coached two All-Americans, 12 all-conference players and two conference freshmen of the year. She was named the Southeastern Conference Coach of the Year following the 2016-17 season and was a top-10 finalist for both the Naismith National Coach of the Year award and the WBCA National Coach of the Year award after an outstanding 2017-18 campaign.

- **A DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE:** With Mizzou losing much of its rebounding contributions from last season, junior guard **Amber Smith** has stepped up for the Tigers on the glass, leading the way with 8.3 rebounds per game while recording six double-doubles in Mizzou's first 10 games.
- Smith's six double-doubles rank second in the SEC this season and tied-for-10th in the NCAA. In her freshman and sophomore campaigns, Smith had just two double-doubles to her stat line.
- Smith had her third consecutive double-double and sixth of the season in Mizzou's 72-64 road win over Saint Louis on Dec. 9. The Tiger junior scored 15 points and matched a career-high with 13 rebounds.
- The Tiger junior posted her fifth double-double of the season and her third in four games in a 66-59 win over UMKC on Dec. 6. Smith had 19 points and 8-for-15 shooting from the field while corraling 10 rebounds.
- Smith posted career highs in points (28) and rebounds (13) in Mizzou's road win over West Virginia (Dec. 2). The 28-point performance was Smith's fifth 20-point game of her career, as she shot 10-for-15 from the field, 4-for-6 from three and 4-for-5 from the free throw line. With the win, Mizzou improved to 19-3 all-time in games in which Smith scores in double figures.
- The Tiger junior had 17 points and 10 rebounds for her fifth career double-double in a win over Quinnipiac (Nov. 24). Smith scored 11 of her 17 points in the second half.
- Smith posted her fourth career game 20-point game and fourth career double-double with 23 points and 10 rebounds against Green Bay (11/16). Smith got the scoring early, as she scored Mizzou's first nine points of the game, and was successful on a career-high 8-of-10 trips to the free throw line in the game.
- Smith led Mizzou on the glass in Mizzou's season-opening win over Western Illinois (11/6), snagging 12 rebounds while scoring 14 points to record her third career double-double.
- Through 10 games, Smith has also recorded 13 blocks, including a career-high four against Missouri State (11/16). Smith recorded eight blocks as a freshman in 2016-17 and 25 as a sophomore in 2017-18. Smith's 46 career blocks ranks second among all Mizzou players, and ranks 10th in the SEC among active leaders.
- Smith was named the co-SEC Freshman of the Year in 2016-17 after averaging 5.9 points and 2.8 rebounds per game. She saw her contributions nearly double last season, as she averaged 9.3 points and 5.3 rebounds per game while shooting 43.5 percent (113-for-260) from the field, 36.4 percent from three (39-for-107) and 81.0 percent (34-for-42) from the free throw line.
- **LETHAL FROM THREE:** Mizzou has began to heat up from deep lately, as the Tiger have made seven or more three-pointers in five of its last six contests. As a team, Mizzou ranks third in the SEC in three-pointers made per game, as the Tigers average 7.8 threes per game (78 total).
- Mizzou sank 11 threes and shot 39.3 percent from deep in a 68-51 road win over West Virginia (Dec. 2). Junior guard **Amber Smith** led the way with four triples, while redshirt freshman guard **Haley Troup** and junior guard **Jordan Chavis** each drained three. Redshirt senior guard **Lauren Aldridge** also drained a triple.
- Mizzou's three-point shooting led the Tigers to its win over Duke (Nov. 25) in the consolation finals of the Gulf Coast Showcase, as Mizzou made a season-high 16 three-pointers. Mizzou's 16 triples were the most made in a game as a team since Dec. 20, 2015 when Mizzou also made 16 against Lamar. Five Tigers made threes against Duke, led by junior forward **Hannah Schuchts** with six. Aldridge drained four triples, while senior guard **Sophie Cunningham**, Smith and Troup each made two.
- Two Tigers are shooting better than 40 percent from deep on the season, led by Aldridge's 43.6 percent (10-for-24). Close behind is Schuchts at 42.9 percent (12-for-28), while Troup is shooting 34.8 percent from beyond the three-point arc (8-for-23).

STORY LINES

- **SCHUCHTS' CAREER NIGHT:** Redshirt junior forward **Hannah Schuchts'** 6-for-6 performance from deep vs. Duke (Nov. 25) set a Mizzou single game record for most threes made without a miss, surpassing the previous record of 5-for-5, which was set numerous times, most recently by Lindsey Cunningham against Arkansas on Feb. 12, 2017. Between the Quinnipiac (Nov. 24) and Duke games, Schuchts made seven consecutive three-pointers, the most since junior guard **Jordan Chavis** made nine straight in a four-game stretch between Nov. 22-29, 2016. Chavis made 4-for-4 from three in the second half against Indiana State (Nov. 22, 2016), then did not shoot a three vs. Creighton (Nov. 26, 2016), then went 3-for-3 vs. Georgia Tech (Nov. 26, 2016) and finally made her first two against Western Illinois (Nov. 29, 2016).
- Schuchts finished with 25 points in the game, and was a perfect 8-for-8 from the field and 6-for-6 from three, all career highs.
- The Tiger junior ranks second on the team in shooting from deep, as she has sank 42.9 percent (12-for-28) from three. Her 6.7 points per game is a significant jump from her production of 1.9 points per game as a freshman in 2016-17 and 2.4 points per game in 2017-18.
- **DOUBLE-DOUBLE DUO:** Senior guard **Sophie Cunningham** and junior guard **Amber Smith** led Mizzou to victory over Quinnipiac on Nov. 23, as each recorded a double-double, becoming the first Tiger duo to record double-doubles in the same game since Cunningham and Cierra Porter did so against Saint Louis on Dec. 8, 2017. Cunningham scored 15 points and had 10 rebounds in that game, while Porter had 23 points and 18 rebounds.
- Cunningham had 26 points and 10 rebounds in the game to record her 10th career double-double, while Smith had 17 points and 10 rebounds for her fifth career double-double.
- Cunningham's 26 points moved her to fifth all-time in Mizzou history as she surpassed Nancy Rutter (1974-78), who scored 1,641 career points.
- **LAWYER LAUREN:** Senior guard **Lauren Aldridge** is helping lead the Mizzou offense once again this season after setting a season-season program record in assist-to-turnover ratio in 2017-18. Aldridge posted an outstanding 2.22 mark (113 assists, 51 turnovers), as she averaged 6.7 points and 3.0 assist per game.
- With 368 career assists, Aldridge is the team leader in career assists, ranks second among active SEC leaders and 28th among active NCAA D-I players. Aldridge recorded 228 assists in her first two seasons at Kansas.
- Through nine games in 2018-19, Aldridge's three-point percentage as made significant leaps, as she is currently shooting 44.4 percent (16-for-36) from deep. That mark is up from her previous best of 36.6 percent (45-for-123) from deep in 2017-18, and currently ranks fourth in the SEC this season.
- Off the court, Aldridge is in her second year as a law student after graduating with a Political Science degree in May 2017. Aldridge is the one of two players in Division-I NCAA Basketball who is currently in law school, as she is joined by Arizona State's Courtney Ekmark.



- **STIFLING DEFENSE:** A trademark of head coach Robin Pingeton-led team's, Mizzou has been suffocating on the defensive end this season, as it has held its opponents to 54.8 points in its eight victories. Mizzou has held its opponent to 65 points or less in nine of 10 games this season.
- Mizzou ranks third in the SEC in field goal percentage defense at 34.3 percent, and ranks sixth in scoring defense at 56.4 points per game. The Tigers have forced 10 or more turnovers in eight of 10 games this season, and have forced their opponents to 40 percent or under from the field in eight games.
- In Mizzou's 68-51 road win over No. 21 West Virginia, Mizzou's defense held the Mountaineers to 34.8 points below its season average as the Mountaineers scored 51 points on Sunday. West Virginia entered the game averaging 85.8 points. The Tigers were also able to hold West Virginia to season lows in field goal percentage (27.9 percent), three-point percentage (27.8 percent), field goals (17) and three-pointers (five). Junior guard **Amber Smith**, redshirt junior forward **Hannah Schuchts** and redshirt freshman guard **Haley Troup** all set career highs in rebounds with 13, nine and six, respectively, as Mizzou outrebounded West Virginia, 42-34. Smith also contributed a team-high three blocks in the game.
- Mizzou held SIU Edwardsville to 36 points on Nov. 19, the lowest point total Mizzou has given up since allowing 35 points to Nebraska on Nov. 14, 2016. The Tigers held the Cougars to 27.8 percent shooting from the field (15-for-54), the lowest field goal percentage Mizzou has allowed since last season when SIUE shot 25.8 percent (16-for-52) on Dec. 10, 2017.
- Freshman forward **Grace Berg** recorded a team-high four steals against SIUE, becoming the first freshman to record four steals in a game since **Jordan Chavis** did so against Indiana State on Nov. 22, 2016. As a team, Mizzou recorded nine steals in the game, the most since having nine steals against Indiana (Dec. 17, 2017).
- Mizzou held Quinnipiac (Nov. 24) to a season-low 21.4 percent shooting from the field as the Bobcats were only successful on 15-for-70 shooting from the field.
- **HOME SUCCESS:** Mizzou has enjoyed much success at Mizzou Arena over the last four seasons, as they have posted a record of 43-7 overall and 18-6 in SEC play in front of the Black & Gold faithful.
- Some of Mizzou's highest-ranked wins in program history have come at home, including wins over No. 4 South Carolina (83-74, 1-7-18) and No. 11 Tennessee (77-73, 2-18-18) last season. Mizzou's win over the previously NCAA Champion Gamecocks was Mizzou's highest win over a ranked opponent since defeating No. 4 Baylor on Jan. 4, 2006.
- Mizzou set a Mizzou Arena home attendance record in its win over the Volunteers, as 11,092 fans showed up to cheer on the Black & Gold.
- Prior to last season, Mizzou also recorded wins over No. 6 South Carolina (62-60, 2-19-18) in 2016-17 and No. 6 Mississippi State (66-54, 1-14-16) in 2015-16.
- Overall, Mizzou is 7-2 overall on its own home floor against ranked opponents since the start of the 2015-16 season, including a 3-0 mark in the 2016-17 season.

STORY LINES

- **BUILDING OFF ANOTHER HISTORIC CAMPAIGN:** Mizzou reached the NCAA Tournament for the third straight season in 2017-18, marking the first time since 1984-86 the Tigers have reached the Big Dance. Mizzou was a five-seed in the Tournament, the highest seed Mizzou has been ranked since the tournament moved to 64 teams. Mizzou went 24-8 in 2017-18, its most wins as a program since 1983-84 and its third straight season with 22+ wins (first time with three consecutive seasons with 22+ wins since 1982-85).
- **FRESHMEN OFF TO A QUICK START:** Mizzou's current freshman class features three top-70 ranked recruits who will have an instant impact in a Mizzou uniform.
- Forward **Grace Berg** and guard **Akira Levy** gave the home Tiger crowd a glimpse of the next four years in their Mizzou Arena debuts, as the duo combined to score 23 points in Mizzou's 65-61 win over Missouri State (11/13). Berg was a perfect 6-for-6 from the free throw line in the game, and snagged four rebounds, while Levy had five rebounds and a team-high three assists in the game.
- Berg, from Indianola, Iowa joined the Black & Gold as the No. 36-ranked recruit in ESPNW's HoopsGurlz Recruiting Rankings and the No. 2-ranked recruit from Iowa. Berg was a three-time Class 5A Iowa Girls Coaches Association First Team All-State Honoree and the all-time leading scorer at Indianola High School. In her senior season, she averaged 20.3 points, 9.3 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game.
- Levy, from Baxter, Tenn., is a dynamic point guard who won three state titles and was the No. 67-ranked recruit in ESPNW's HoopsGurlz Recruiting Rankings. She was a two-time Tennessee Class AA Miss Basketball, and a 2018 All-USA Tennessee First Team Honoree. She finished her career with 2,761 points, 921 assists, 591 rebounds and 504 steals. In her senior campaign, she averaged 25.3 points, 9.4 assists and 4.8 steals per game.
- Yet to make her Mizzou debut, forward **Brittany Garner** was a late signee for Mizzou who will add size to the Tigers. The 6-foot-4 big was the No. 69-ranked recruit in Prospect Nation's Class of 2018 Rankings and was a 2018 First Team All-Conference Honoree. In her senior season, she averaged 17.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game.
- **PRESEASON ALL-SEC RECOGNITION:** Mizzou was picked to finish fifth in the Southeastern Conference in the SEC Preseason Coaches' Poll. Mizzou was picked to finish behind Mississippi State, South Carolina, Georgia and Tennessee. Each team picked ahead of the Tigers advanced to the NCAA Tournament last season, with South Carolina making the Elite Eight and Mississippi State ending the season as the national runner-up. Mizzou was also tabbed to finish fifth in the SEC in the preseason media poll.
- Senior guard **Sophie Cunningham** was named Preseason All-SEC First Team for the third consecutive season. In 2017-18, Cunningham averaged 18.5 points and 4.7 rebounds per game as she earned AP All-America Honorable Mention honors for the second consecutive season. She was the only player in the nation to shoot better than 54 percent from the field (54.2 percent, 186-for-343), 45 percent from three (45.7 percent, 69-for-151) and 83 percent from the free throw line (83.6 percent, 133-for-159).
- Just like in the preseason media poll, Cunningham was one of three players to receive votes for the Preseason SEC Women's Basketball Player of the Year award, which ended up going to Mississippi State's Teaira McCowan.
- Junior guard **Amber Smith**, the 2016-17 SEC Co-Freshman of the Year, was named to the Preseason All-SEC Second Team. Smith started all 32 games for Mizzou as a sophomore in 2017-18, averaging 9.3 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. Smith scored a career-high 27 points vs. LSU (Jan. 4) on 11-for-18 shooting from the field while grabbing seven rebounds.

- **A TOP-15 SIGNING CLASS:** Mizzou signed a pair of five-star recruits on Nov. 14, as No. 8 Aijha Blackwell and No. 29 Hayley Frank each inked National Letters of Intent to continue their academic and athletic careers at the University of Missouri. Mizzou then added Micah Lintahcum, a 6-foot-3 post player from Jefferson City on Nov. 20. Lintahcum is the No. 18-ranked post player by ESPNW. The trio helped Mizzou bring in the No. 12-ranked recruiting class in the nation according to ESPNW.
- Blackwell, from Whitfield School in Berkeley, Mo., who was recruited by just about every Division-I program in the country, is ranked No. 8 in the nation and No. 1 in the state of Missouri in ESPNW's 2019 HoopsGurlz Recruiting Rankings. She is a three-time Missouri Basketball Coaches Association (MBCA) Class 3 All-State selection (2016-18), and a USA Today first team Missouri selection in 2018. As a junior, Blackwell led Whitfield to the Class 3A state semifinals and a 22-7 record, as she averaged 24.2 points, 8.3 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 2.0 steals per game. Entering her senior season, Blackwell is one of 50 high school seniors named to the watch list for the 2019 Naismith High School Trophy.
- Blackwell was selected to play for the USA U18 National Team this past summer, where she helped lead Team USA to a gold medal in Mexico City at the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship. She averaged 9.3 points, 3.7 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game over six games during USA's championship run, including eight points, four rebounds and three steals in the gold medal game win over Canada.
- Blackwell's father, Ernest, was a four-year letterwinner for Mizzou Football who played running back from 1994-97 and was drafted by the Kansas City Chiefs in 1998.
- Frank, from Strafford, Mo., is the No. 29-ranked player in the nation and the No. 2-ranked player in the state of Missouri. Coached by her dad, Steve, Frank has helped lead Strafford High School to three consecutive Missouri Class 3 state championships and 82 consecutive wins. She has been named to the MBCA Class 3A All-State team each of the last three seasons (2016-18), the MBCA Class 3 Player of the Year in 2016-17 and 2017-18, the 2017-18 Gatorade Missouri Girls Basketball Player of the Year and the 2018 Missouri Wendy's High Heisman state winner. Entering her senior campaign, Frank has already racked up 2,293 points and 1,213 rebounds.
- As a junior, the 6-foot-2 guard led the Indians to a 33-0 record and third straight state title after averaging 24.9 points, 12.7 rebounds, 7.1 assists, 3.3 steals and 3.0 blocks per game. Frank led Strafford to a second consecutive state title as a sophomore in 2016-17, averaging 24.0 points, 13.0 rebounds, 6.5 assists, 3.0 steals and 2.2 blocks per game en route to a 33-0 season. She was named the Class 3 Player of the Year in both seasons.
- Frank is an all-state infielder on the Strafford softball team and a state qualifier for the golf team. Away from the court, Frank has maintained a 4.05 GPA, is the vice president of the student body, and is a part of the National Honor Society.
- A 6-foot-3 post player from Jefferson City High School, Lintahcum will add size to the Mizzou women's squad. Lintahcum helped lead the Lady Jays to a Class 5 District 7 title as a junior in 2017-18, and is the No. 18-ranked player in the nation at her position, according to ESPNW.

CAREER HEAD COACHING RECORD

24 Seasons **490-267 (.647)**

Since stepping foot on Mizzou's campus in 2010, head coach Robin Pingeton has led the Mizzou Women's Basketball program to greater heights each and every season. Pingeton is entering her ninth season at the helm after Mizzou completed its third consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance in 2017-18, the first time in program history since 1984-86 Mizzou has earned a berth to the Big Dance in three consecutive seasons. For Pingeton's success in leading Mizzou during the 2017-18 season, she was named a Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year National Semifinalist and a WBCA National Coach of the Year finalist.

Pingeton has restored a proud Missouri women's basketball tradition and has recorded a 147-108 (.576) record over her eight seasons with her teams averaging 21 wins per year over the last four seasons. In 23 years overall as a head coach, Pingeton's teams have gone 482-265 (.652). She has led her squads to postseason play 16 times and has mentored 37 all-conference honorees, eight All-Americans, seven Academic All-Americans and five conference Players of the Year. She has won three regular season conference titles, two postseason conference tournaments and has three times been named the conference Coach of the Year.

In 2017-18, Pingeton led Mizzou to its third straight NCAA Tournament and a 24-8 record, the Tigers' most wins since 1983-84. The 24 victories marked Mizzou's third consecutive campaign with at least 22 wins, a feat which had not been accomplished since 1982-85. In SEC play, Mizzou won 11 games for the second straight season and finished tied-for-fourth in the SEC. Mizzou's 22 wins in conference play in the 2016-17 and 2017-18 seasons are the most in a two year span since Mizzou won 24 over the 1983-84 and 1984-85 seasons. Mizzou reached as high as No. 11 in the Associated Press Top-25 during the 2017-18 season, its highest ranking since 1984.

Mizzou had many memorable moments in 2017-18, but two of the more notable Tiger victories came in home wins against South Carolina and Tennessee. First, Mizzou knocked off the defending National Champion No. 4 South Carolina Gamecocks, 83-74, on Jan. 7. The win was Mizzou's fourth win in program history against an AP top-four opponent, and the first such victory since a 64-60 win over No. 4 Baylor on Jan. 4, 2006. Next, in front of a program record 11,092 fans and behind 32 points from Sophie Cunningham, Mizzou downed No. 11 Tennessee, 77-73, on Feb. 18. The win marked the first time since 1993-94 Mizzou has defeated two top-11 AP opponents in the same season.

Mizzou closed the 2017-18 season with its third consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, as the Tigers entered the Big Dance as the No. 5 seed in the Lexington Region, its highest ever in a 64-team NCAA Tournament. Cunningham and Frericks each received All-SEC honors for their performance on the court in 2017-18. Cunningham earned First Team honors for the second time in her career as she scored a career-high 18.5 points per game while also

averaging 4.7 rebounds and 3.0 rebounds per game. Cunningham became the 35th member of Mizzou 1,000-point win club during the season, and currently ranks eighth in overall scoring (1,563 points) with one season remaining. Cunningham also received AP All-America Honorable Mention honors for the performance in her junior campaign. Frericks earned All-SEC Second Team recognition for the third time in her career after averaging 11.8 points and 7.6 rebounds per game in her senior campaign. Frericks became just the third player in Mizzou history to join the 1,000-point and 1,000-rebound club, as she ended her career with 1,032 rebounds, the second-most in program history. Mizzou was highly successful in the classroom as well in '17-18, as the team put together its best two semesters in program history, recording a 3.3 and 3.4 in the fall and spring semesters, respectively.

Pingeton was named the Southeastern Conference Coach of the Year in 2016-17 after being selected by both the Associated Press and the league's coaches for the honor. She steered Mizzou to its second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance and a third-place finish in the SEC. It marked the Tigers' highest finish in league play since joining the SEC and the highest since 1990. Pingeton's squad piled up 11 SEC wins, the most since 1990, putting together two separate win streaks of five or more in league action in the same campaign for the first time in program history.

Mizzou capped off the special 2016-17 season with a trip to the Big Dance, advancing to the second round with a win over South Florida in the tournament opener. It gave Pingeton and company wins in back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in program history. Pingeton and the Tigers completed the incredible campaign despite losing All-SEC forward Jordan Frericks to a preseason knee injury. Mizzou was picked to finish seventh in the SEC, but the Tigers completed their fifth consecutive winning season for the first time since 1985-90 and a campaign for the record books. As a result, Pingeton was named a Naismith Coach of the Year National Semifinalist, along with nine other coaches. During the 2016-17 season, Mizzou beat eventual national champion No. 6 South Carolina, No. 25 Kentucky and No. 25 Texas A&M at Mizzou Arena, extending the Tigers' home win streak against ranked opponents to five.

In 2015-16, under Pingeton's guidance, the program's success on and off the court helped produce the nation's largest attendance increase as Mizzou fans came out in droves to support the team last season. Mizzou Arena welcomed an average of 3,990 fans per game, including a facility-record 7,989 fans for a showdown with Tennessee.

Mizzou faithful were rewarded for their support as Mizzou spent eight weeks in the AP Top 25 poll and finished with eight conference victories for the first time in more than a decade, highlighted by victories over No. 6 Mississippi State and No. 22 Florida. Pingeton's squad capped the season with the program's 10th NCAA Tournament appearance. Mizzou entered the Big Dance as a No. 10 seed and knocked off seventh-seeded BYU, 78-69, in the opening round to seal its first NCAA Tournament victory since 2001.

A 1990 graduate of St. Ambrose, Pingeton stands as the school's all-time scoring leader with 2,502 points and earned All-American honors in basketball and softball. She also played three seasons of professional basketball in the Women's Basketball Association. Pingeton and her husband, Rich, are the proud parents of two sons, Blake, born June 9, 2006, and Zach, born July 5, 2011. In her limited spare time, Pingeton enjoys spending time with her family on their boat and playing golf.
