QUICK HITS

- Following big performances in Mizzou's wins at LSU (Oct. 2) and versus Texas A&M (Oct. 6) this past week, junior **Kylie Deberg** was named the Southeastern Conference Week Six Volleyball Overall and Offensive Player of the Week.
- It marked Deberg's fifth career honor by the SEC office. She was also tabbed the SEC Overall and Offensive Player of the Week earlier this season (Sept. 9) and was recognized as the SEC Offensive Player of the Week three times in her 2018 sophomore campaign.
- This past week against the Tigers and Aggies, Deberg produced her fourth and fifth consecutive matches with 20-plus kills. The Hudson, Iowa, native owns six 20-plus kill matches overall this year, marking the most 20-plus kill outings by a Tiger in a single-season since 2016.
- The NCAA revealed its first RPI rankings of the 2019 campaign Monday (Oct. 7) morning, as Mizzou checked-in with an outstanding No. 10 mark.
- The Tigers have faced one of the nation's toughest schedules thus far, highlighted by three matchups versus Top 25 RPI foes, six contests against Top 50 opponents and nine matchups versus Top 75 programs.
- Mizzou's top RPI wins this season have occurred vs. No. 28 Texas A&M (Oct. 6), vs. No. 36 Michigan (Sept. 6) and at No. 49 Miami (Fla.) (Aug. 30).

Mizzou Volleyball assistant coach Joshua Taylor was promoted to interim head coach for the 2019 season, announced July 18 by Mizzou Director of Athletics Jim Sterk. Taylor takes over the reins of the Tiger program, following the retirement announcement by Wayne Kreklow and Susan Kreklow.

"Joshua Taylor enjoys tremendous respect among our student-athletes and staff, and is most-deserving of this opportunity to serve as Mizzou's Interim Head Volleyball Coach for the 2019 season," Sterk said. "He has played a critical role in Mizzou's academic, on-court and recruiting success over the last three years, and I look forward to watching his team compete this fall. I believe that Joshua and Molly (Taylor) are an excellent husband-wife coaching duo, and that they will build upon our program's proud tradition and successes."

"We're excited for the upcoming season and know this group is going to be great!" the Kreklows said. "We know that Joshua and his staff are going to do a great job with the program and we couldn't be more excited for everyone!"

Taylor enters his third overall season on the Mizzou Volleyball coaching staff in 2019. Prior to his newly appointed role as interim head coach, Taylor served as the Tigers' lead assistant coach and recruiting coordinator.

"I'm extremely humbled to be named the interim head coach for the 2019 season," Taylor said. "I want to thank Athletic Director Jim Sterk for having faith in my ability to lead this year's squad. I also want to thank Senior Deputy Athletics Director Sarah Reesman and Executive Associate Athletics Director Andy Humes for their support."

I want to thank Wayne and Susan for the amazing things they've done for this program and the example they've set for me over the years I've worked with them. I'm grateful for their guidance and support during this transition. This program and university means a great deal to me and I'm extremely grateful for this opportunity and I can't wait for the season ahead!"

The Honolulu native specializes in blocking and serve and receive instruction for the Tiger student-athletes. In his first-year coaching campaign, the 2017 Mizzou squad tallied 377.5 total blocks and 547 block assists, marking new program all-time single-season records. Additionally, the Tigers' 2.88 blocks per set (second) and 104 solo blocks (seventh) each cracked the program's all-time single-season top-10 record book.

This past season, Taylor played a pivotal role into middle blocker Alyssa Munlyn becoming the program's first-ever four-time AVCA All-American. She concluded her storied four-year career as the program's leader in hitting percentage, total blocks, block assists and blocks per set.

Prior to his coaching career at Mizzou, Taylor excelled in the collegiate and professional volleyball ranks as a player. In 2016, he competed with the U.S. National Team at the Pan AM Cup and Olympic Training Team. Before his outstanding collegiate playing career at Pepperdine University, Taylor competed with the U.S. Junior National Team and led the team to first place at the 2010 NORCECA Men's Junior Continental Championship.

Taylor starred collegiately at Pepperdine from 2012-15, earning two AVCA All-American honors and three All-MPSF accolades. During his 2014 junior campaign, Taylor became only the 18th player in program history to surpass 1,000 career kills. He concluded his four-year career in Malibu, California, with 1,433 career kills and 1,630 career points.

SEASON NOTABLES

- ▼ **MIZZOU CHECKS-IN AT NO. 10 IN FIRST NCAA RPI RANKINGS:** On Monday (Oct. 7) morning, the NCAA revealed its first edition of this year's RPI rankings and Mizzou clocked-in with an impressive No. 10 ranking. The Tigers have faced one of the nation's toughest schedules thus far, highlighted by three matchups versus Top 25 RPI foes, six contests against Top 50 opponents and nine matchups versus Top 75 programs. Mizzou's top RPI wins this season have occurred vs. No. 28 Texas A&M (Oct. 6), vs. No. 36 Michigan (Sept. 6) and at No. 49 Miami (Fla.) (Aug. 30). Despite dropping the matches, the Tigers also have contests against current No. 1 RPI Baylor, No. 8 Kentucky and No. 14 Hawaii on their season resume.
- ▼ **TIGERS FEATURE ONE OF NATION'S MOST EFFICIENT OFFENSES:** Mizzou's offense stole the show over its 10-match non-conference schedule, producing 502 kills (13.94 per set) on .348 hitting, 13.03 assists per set and 74 total aces (2.06 per set). With Southeastern Conference play now in full swing (as of Monday, Oct. 6), the Tigers rank Top 2 in the league in all four major offensive categories, including leading the conference in hitting percentage (.316) and aces per set (1.90). Mizzou also ranks very favorably in the national rankings, highlighted by third in hitting percentage, eighth in aces per set, 15th in kills per set and 20th in assists per set. Individually, junior OH **Kylie Deberg** is off to another All-American caliber start, pacing the SEC in total kills (243), kills per set (5.06), total aces (28), aces per set (0.58), total points (285.0) and points per set (5.94). Redshirt sophomore S **Andrea Fuentes** has managed the Tiger offense beautifully, ranking second in the SEC in assists per set (11.31). As a team, Mizzou owns the four-highest single-match hitting percentages by an SEC squad this season, highlighted by three .500-plus hitting performances.
- ▼ **MIZZOU CLAIMS TIGER INVITATIONAL CROWN, CLIMBS FOUR SPOTS IN AVCA POLL:** Mizzou continued its then-undefeated start to the 2019 campaign with a four-match sweep at the Tiger Invitational (Sept. 13-15). The Tigers jumped off to an 8-0 start for the sixth time since 2000. It was the program's third time they've accomplished the feat since joining the Southeastern Conference (2013, '15, '19). With its hot start and catching national attention, Mizzou climbed four spots in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) poll to No. 17 overall on Sept. 16. It was the Tigers' highest ranking in an AVCA poll since they finished No. 16 in the last edition of the 2016 campaign poll.
- ▼ **FUENTES EARNS BACK TO BACK SEC SETTER OF THE WEEK:** Redshirt sophomore S **Andrea Fuentes** was recognized as the Southeastern Conference Week Three Volleyball Overall Player and Setter of the Week, announced Monday (Sept. 16) by the league office. It marked Fuentes' sixth career honor by the SEC office. She was also tabbed the SEC Setter of the Week on Sept. 9 and once in her 2018 redshirt freshman campaign. Fuentes was named the SEC Freshman of the Week on three occurrences a season ago as well. At setter, Fuentes orchestrated an incredibly highly efficient Mizzou offense for the second consecutive weekend at the Tiger Invitational (Sept. 13-15). The Tigers collectively produced 187 kills (14.38 per set) on a standout .396 hitting percentage. Mizzou's offense hit a phenomenal .500-plus in two of four matches played. Mizzou's incredible .526 hitting percentage in its victory over Kansas City ranked tied for sixth in single-match program history.
- ▼ **MIZZOU MAKES SEASON DEBUT IN AVCA POLL:** Mizzou placed No. 21 in the Monday, Sept. 9, edition of the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Division I Coaches Top 25 poll. It marked the Tigers' first appearance in the national poll this season. Mizzou has appeared in the AVCA poll 31 total times since joining the Southeastern Conference in 2012. The Tigers gained national attention following an impressive sweep over No. 14 Michigan (Sept. 6) at the Dayton Invitational. It stood as Mizzou's 16th, Top 25 nationally ranked victory since joining the SEC.
- ▼ **DEBERG & FUENTES PICK UP SEC WEEKLY AWARDS:** Junior OH **Kylie Deberg** and redshirt sophomore S **Andrea Fuentes** were each recognized Monday, Sept. 9, in the Southeastern Conference Week Two Volleyball Players of the Week. Deberg was named the Overall and Offensive Player of the Week, while Fuentes garnered Setter of the Week honors. It marked both Deberg and Fuentes' fourth career honor by the SEC office. Deberg was named the SEC Offensive Player of the Week three times in her 2018 sophomore campaign, while Fuentes was tabbed the SEC Freshman of the Week on three occurrences a season ago. Deberg produced 59 kills (5.36 per set) on an incredible .510 hitting percentage, leading to Dayton Invitational All-Tournament Team accolades. She also added seven aces, two solo blocks and five total blocks en route to an amazing 6.32 points per set. She capped her weekend with a career-high 25 kills on .575 hitting versus Northern Illinois. At setter, Fuentes orchestrated an incredibly highly efficient Mizzou offense, as it produced 158 kills on a standout .434 hitting percentage. Across the weekend, Mizzou hit .370-plus in 10 of 11 sets played, highlighted by eight sets over .400 hitting and five sets exceeding .500 hitting. Against Northern Illinois, Fuentes recorded a season-high 55 assists, marking the fourth, 50-plus assist match of her career.
- ▼ **MIZZOU SWEEPS NO. 14 MICHIGAN, HIGHLIGHTING DAYTON INVITATIONAL CROWN:** The Tigers produced a flawless road trip at the Dayton Invitational (Sept. 6-7), highlighted by an impressive sweep over No. 14 Michigan. Against the Wolverines, Mizzou collectively hit an eye-popping .507, standing as the 10th-highest single-match team hitting percentage in program history. The Tigers opened the match with 14 kills on .591 hitting in set one, followed by 13 kills on .600 hitting in set two. Mizzou capped off day one's doubleheader with a 3-1 victory over host Dayton. The Tigers concluded their road trip with another dominating offensive performance against Northern Illinois, recording 65 kills on .461 hitting in a four-set win. Against the Huskies, Mizzou never hit below .380 in a set, highlighted by 15 kills on .520 hitting in set one and 18 kills on .556 hitting in set four.

SEASON NOTABLES

- ▼ **THE JOSHUA TAYLOR MIZZOU VOLLEYBALL ERA BEGINS:** In mid-July, Mizzou Volleyball legendary coaching duo **Wayne and Susan Kreklow** announced their retirement following a historical 19-year tenure at the helm. Shortly after the Kreklow's retirement news, Mizzou Director of Athletics Jim Sterk promoted **Joshua Taylor** from assistant coach to interim head coach. Taylor becomes the Tigers' seventh all-time head coach, as they enter year No. 45 of the program's existence (1974-present). Set for his fourth overall season on the Mizzou coaching staff (2016: graduate assistant // 2017-18: assistant coach), Taylor has already made a profound impact on the program. As the program's lead recruiter, Taylor has continually brought in top-tier talent to Mid-Missouri. Additionally, as the staff's lead blocking and serve and receive instructor, Taylor oversaw four-time AVCA All-American **Alyssa Munlyn's** peak performance at Mizzou. In Munlyn's 2017 junior campaign, the Suwanee, Georgia, native set single-season records in total blocks (189), block assists (159) and blocks per set (1.44). Collectively, the Tigers' 377.5 total blocks and 547 block assists also set new program benchmarks. Prior to beginning his coaching career, Taylor starred at the professional and collegiate level with Team USA and Pepperdine University. In 2016, he competed with the U.S. National Team at the Pan AM Cup and Olympic Training Team. From 2012-15 at Pepperdine, Taylor was a two-time AVCA All-American and finished with 1,433 career kills and 1,630 career points.
- ▼ **ASSISTANT COACH AND FORMER ALL-AMERICAN MOLLY TAYLOR NAMED TO MIZZOU HALL OF FAME:** Interim Head Coach **Joshua Taylor's** wife and former Tiger legend, **Molly Taylor (Kreklow)** was named one of six honorees to the Class of 2019 Mizzou Athletics Hall of Fame, announced in late July. Molly, the 2013 SEC Player of the Year and 2013 AVCA first team All-American, finished her four-year career in Mizzou black and gold with 5,366 career assists, ranking second all-time in program history. Following her standout collegiate career, Molly would go on to compete for the U.S. National Team at the 2013 Pan-American Games and NORCECA Championships. Heading into the 2019 Mizzou Volleyball campaign, Molly is set for her third year on the coaching staff and first as an assistant coach.
- ▼ **KYLIE DEBERG NAMED 2019 PRESEASON ALL-SEC:** Mizzou junior OH **Kylie Deberg** was named to the 2019 Preseason Volleyball All-SEC Team, announced in early July by the league office. It marked Deberg's first career Preseason All-SEC honor. The Tigers have been recognized on the annual preseason list in each year since joining the SEC (2012-present). After a one-year stint at Illinois (2017), Deberg joined Mizzou last season and turned into one of the SEC's premier offensive talents. The Hudson, Iowa, native ranked Top 10 in the conference in kills, kills per set, points, points per set, aces and aces per set. Deberg wowed Tiger fans from the service line, as her 59 aces ranked third all-time in Mizzou single-season history. It was the most single-season aces by a Tiger since 2002. Overall, Deberg was an incredible model of consistency on offense, producing 10-plus kills in 28 of 32 matches played. Arguably her top moment occurred at No. 11 Florida (Oct. 21, 2018), as she posted 21 kills and a career-high 26 points in Mizzou's upset victory in Gainesville. Postseason accolades were aplenty following the season, highlighted by AVCA All-America Honorable Mention honors. Deberg is one of 13 all-time Tigers to garner an All-America award.
- ▼ **TYANNA OMAZIC & KYLIE DEBERG COMPETE FOR TEAM USA:** Junior MB **Tyanna Omazic** and junior OH **Kylie Deberg** each competed for outlets of Team USA this summer. Omazic was a member of the U.S. Women's Collegiate National Team - Anaheim Roster, while Deberg was named to the U.S. Collegiate National Team World University Games roster. In early July, Omazic starred for her respective squad, posting seven kills on .462 hitting in a scrimmage matchup. Deberg also fared well against top-flight competition, highlighted by a team-best 14 points and six aces against Team Switzerland in early July.
- ▼ **MIZZOU FINISHES NO. 23 IN FINAL 2018 AVCA COACHES POLL:** Fresh off a 24-win campaign and a trip to the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament, Mizzou placed No. 23 in the final American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Division I Coaches Poll. The Tigers ranked Top 25 in the AVCA poll for seven consecutive weeks to close out their 2018 campaign. It stood as their most single-season appearances in the AVCA poll since 2013 and second-most since 2006. Since the AVCA's Coaches Poll inception in 1982, Mizzou has cracked the final poll nine times. The Tigers' top ranking to conclude a season occurred in 2005, as that year's team advanced to the NCAA Tournament Regional Final (Elite Eight).
