QUICK HITS

- Mizzou features arguably the nation's deepest and most productive senior class, as OH Kylie Deberg, RS Dariana Hollingsworth-Santana, OH Leketor Member-Meneh and MB Tyanna Omazic enter 2020 with big aspirations. The Tigers' senior quartet is responsible for 89% of the team's returning kills from a season ago, 87% of returning points and 85% of returning aces. Those returning percentages rank highest not only in the Southeastern Conference among 2020 senior classes, but also tops among all Power 5 senior classes.
- Redshirt junior S Andrea Fuentes is back for 2020 and will once again coordinate one of the nation's most powerful offensive attacks. In 2019, Mizzou's team .302 hitting percentage ranked 4th in the NCAA, while its 14.67 kills per set ranked 5th. Individually, Fuentes' 11.77 assists per set last season ranked 5th nationally and her 1,306 total assists placed 18th in the country.
- Coach Taylor brings in a talented trio of newcomers for 2020, as redshirt sophomore DS Erin Williamson (Arizona), sophomore OH *Anna Dixon* (Kansas State) and freshman DS *Emily Brown* join the Tigers. Williamson and Brown will both fight for the libero job, while also adding much needed depth to the defensive back row. Dixon adds yet another talented Tiger attacker to the lineup, as she earned 2019 All-Big 12 Rookie Team honors a season ago in Manhattan, Kansas.

Mizzou Volleyball second-year leader, Joshua Taylor, had the interim tag removed and was named the seventh head coach in the program's 46-year history, announced on Nov. 14, 2019, by Mizzou Director of Athletics Jim Sterk. Taylor was named the Tigers' interim head coach on July 18, 2019, following Wayne and Susan Kreklow's retirement from the program in the summer of 2018 after a highly-successful 19-year run. Taylor agreed to a five-year contract as Mizzou Volleyball head coach, extending him through the 2024 campaign.

In his first year at the helm, Taylor guided Mizzou to a 22-8 (13-5 SEC) record and a trip to the program's 16th all-time NCAA Tournament. He earned his first career postseason win following a dominant sweep over Northern Iowa in the first round. The Tigers featured one of the nation's finest offenses in 2019, evident by their .302 hitting percentage and 14.67 kills per set. Those totals ranked tied for second and fifth in the nation, respectively.

Taylor played a key role into Kylie Deberg's evolution as one of the nation's premier outside hitters, as she earned 2019 AVCA second-team All-American honors. Deberg became only the sixth all-time Tiger to garner multiple All-American accolades.

Taylor has been on the Mizzou Volleyball staff for four years. He served as the Tigers' assistant coach and recruiting coordinator from 2017-18, helping Mizzou to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances and a 46-20 (.697) on-court record.

The Honolulu native specializes in blocking and serve and receive instruction for the Tiger student-athletes. In his first-year coaching campaign, the 2017 Mizzou squad tallied 377.5 total blocks and 547 block assists, marking new program all-time single-season records. Additionally, the Tigers' 2.88 blocks per set (second) and 104 solo blocks (seventh) each cracked the program's all-time single-season Top-10 record book.

In 2018, Taylor played a pivotal role into middle blocker Alyssa Munlyn becoming the program's first-ever four-time AVCA All-American. She concluded her storied fouryear career as the program's leader in hitting percentage, total blocks, block assists and blocks per set.

The Tigers have continued their outstanding success in the classroom under Taylor, recently earning their seventh consecutive AVCA Team Academic Award in July 2020. Mizzou concluded its 2019-20 academic calendar with a program record spring semester 3.74 grade-point average.

Prior to beginning his coaching career at Mizzou, Taylor excelled in the collegiate and professional volleyball ranks as a player. In 2016, he competed with the U.S. National Team at the Pan AM Cup and Olympic Training Team. Before his outstanding collegiate playing career at Pepperdine University, Taylor competed with the U.S. Junior National Team and led the team to first place at the 2010 NORCECA Men's Junior Continental Championship.

Taylor starred collegiately at Pepperdine from 2012-15, earning two AVCA All-American honors and three All-MPSF accolades. During his 2014 junior campaign, Taylor became only the 18th player in program history to surpass 1,000 career kills. He concluded his four-year career in Malibu, California, with 1,433 career kills and 1,630 career points.

SEASON NOTABLES

- MIZZOU RANKED NO. 7 IN FIRST AVCA FALL COACHES POLL: The Tigers placed No. 7 in the first edition of the 2020 AVCA Fall Division I Coaches Poll, announced on Sept. 30 by the organization. This fall's AVCA Coaches Poll will be different than past years, as COVID-19 is still affecting the NCAA Volleyball landscape. The ACC, Big 12, SEC and Sun Belt are the only eligible conferences in voting for the current fall AVCA poll. Mizzou's No. 7 ranking is its highest placement in the first release of an AVCA Coaches Poll in program history. The Tigers have been recognized in an AVCA's initial season poll seven times overall: (2003 - No. 21 // 2005 - No. 21 // 2006 - No. 13 // 2007 - No. 20 // 2014 - No. 15 // 2017 - No. 19 // 2020 - No. 7).
- DEBERG & OMAZIC NAMED 2020 PRESEASON ALL-SEC: Senior OH Kylie Deberg and senior MB Tyanna Omazic were each named to the 2020 Preseason Volleyball All-Southeastern Conference Team, announced Oct. 8 by the league office. It marked Deberg's second consecutive Preseason All-SEC honor, while Omazic received her first career preseason recognition by the league office. Nine total student-athletes across the league were selected to this year's squad. Mizzou has been represented on the annual Preseason All-SEC list in each year since joining the SEC (2012-present). It marked the fifth time there has been multiple Tigers on the preseason list (2012, '13, '14, '17, '20).
- COACH TAYLOR ADDS THREE TALENTED TRANSFERS TO 2020-21 ROSTER: Following the program's 16th all-time NCAA Tournament appearance last December, head coach **Joshua Taylor** guickly got to work on the recruiting trail and added a trio of talented transfers. Sophomore OH Anna Dixon (Kansas State), redshirt junior MB Anna D'Cruz (UAB) and redshirt sophomore DS *Erin Williamson* (Arizona) will all rock Mizzou black and gold beginning this fall. Dixon comes to Mid-Missouri following a sensational freshman campaign at Kansas State. The Louisburg, Kansas, native earned All-Big 12 Rookie Team honors after posting 2.89 kills per set, 292 kills and 326.0 points. Prior to her collegiate career, Dixon was one of 12 members on the 2019 USA Volleyball Women's Junior National Team. D'Cruz enjoyed a breakthrough 2019 redshirt sophomore season at UAB, pacing the Blazers with 11 solo blocks, 79 block assists and 90.0 total blocks. Williamson will make the trek east to Columbia, Missouri, following two years at Arizona. After a redshirt campaign in 2018, she made her debut in 2019 with 14 matches played.
- RUSSELL CORBELLI JOINS TIGERS' COACHING STAFF: 10-year collegiate and club volleyball coach veteran. **Russell Corbelli**, was added to the Tiger coaching staff on Jan. 28, 2020, by Mizzou Volleyball head coach Joshua Taylor. Corbelli will join Molly Taylor on the staff as a full-time assistant coach. Corbelli spent the 2018-19 campaigns as a volunteer assistant coach at Stanford University. As the program's lead scout in opponent attacking, serving and passing; Corbelli played a pivotal role into the Cardinals' back to back NCAA National Championships. In two years on the Stanford coaching staff, Corbelli oversaw 11 AVCA All-Americans, 11 AVCA Pacific North All-Region honorees and 12 All-Pac 12 recipients. The Cardinal also claimed consecutive Pac-12 Conference titles, including an unscathed 20-0 league record in 2018.

- OMAZIC EARNES SPOT ON 2020 U.S. WOMEN'S COLLEGIATE NATIONAL TEAM
- GOLD ROSTER: Junior MB Tyanna Omazic was one of 28 players selected to the U.S. Women's Collegiate National Team - Gold roster, announced in early March by USA Volleyball. It marked Omazic's second consecutive summer with a U.S. Women's Collegiate National Team, as she competed on the 2019 Anaheim roster in June 2019. Unfortunately for Tigers fans, Omazic was ultimately unable to show off her skills with Team USA, as the COVID-19 pandemic hit the nation a week later.
- MIZZOU SET FOR SIX NATIONALLY TELEVISED MATCHES THIS FALL: The SEC Network and ESPNU released its 2020 NCAA Volleyball national television schedule on Monday, Sept. 14, with Mizzou being selected for six national broadcasts this upcoming fall season. Three Tigers matches (Oct. 18 at Alabama // Nov. 5 vs. Arkansas // Nov. 20 at Ole Miss) are scheduled for SEC Network coverage and three additional contests (Oct. 28 vs. Kentucky // Oct. 29 vs. Kentucky // Nov. 4 vs. Arkansas) will broadcast live on ESPNU. Mizzou's remaining two SEC matchups this fall (Oct. 17 at Alabama // Nov. 21 at Ole Miss) will air digitally on SEC Network + via WatchESPN.
- TIGERS PRODUCE SEVENTH CONSECUTIVE AVCA TEAM ACADEMIC AWARD: Mizzou was recognized for its collective success in the classroom with the 2019-20 United States Marine Corps (USMC) / American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Team Academic Award, announced Monday, July 20, by the organizations. Mizzou concluded its 2019-20 academic calendar with a program record spring semester 3.74 grade-point average. The Tigers have surpassed a 3.50 collective GPA in six consecutive spring semesters at the University of Missouri. Historically, Mizzou has exceeded a 3.0 group GPA in 16 of its past 17 spring semesters. Earlier this month, sophomores Claudia Dillon and Kenna Sauer were named to the 2019-20 First-Year Southeastern Conference Academic Honor Roll. The duo joined the six individuals (Kylie Deberg, Leketor Member-Meneh, Tyanna Omazic, Riley Sents, Sun Wenting and Katie Turner) recognized in the 2019 Fall SEC Academic Honor Roll in February. Mizzou has regularly enjoyed high academic success rates in the classroom over the years. Beginning with the 2014-15 academic school year, the Tigers posted four consecutive 1,000 Academic Progress Rate (APR) scores. Historically, Mizzou has surpassed a 3.0 team GPA in 27 of its past 31 combined fall and spring semesters at the University of Missouri
