FOR STARTERS

- Missouri will look to build on a promising opening weekend to the 2023 season when they travel to Miami for a four-game series against the FIU Panthers, beginning Thursday (Feb. 23) at FIU Baseball Stadium.
- The Tigers took two of their three games against ranked Big 12 Conference opponents last weekend at the College Baseball Showdown in Arlington, Texas.
- After dropping its opening game against No. 11 Oklahoma State, Mizzou won back-to-back games against Texas and TCU by mounting go-ahead rallies in its final at-bat of each contest.

SERIES BUSINESS

- Mizzou brings an official 5-2 all-time edge against FIU into this weekend's series.
- The Tigers have won six of the seven meetings in the series that dates back to 2007, but had one of those victories vacated (2016).
- Each of the previous seven meetings have taken place in Miami, with the Panthers winning the most recent matchup (11-5) in February 2018, despite the Tigers claiming two of the three games in that series.

- Each of the four games in the series will be broadcast on KTGR (105.1 & 100.5 FM, 1580 AM), with Tex Little and Matt Michaels calling the action.

MEET THE TIGERS

- Mizzou's 2023 roster features a heavy helping of talent from within the state of Missouri's borders, with 16 players from the Show-Me State.
- Additionally, Mizzou head coach Steve Bieser has brought in players from a total of 16 different states, plus the territory of Puerto Rico.
- A host of newcomers should bolster a group of 14 returning letterwinners; 10 freshmen will join 10 transfers to give the Tigers a new look across the diamond in 2023.
- Ty Wilmsmeyer led all Mizzou hitters with a .583 (7-for-12) average last weekend in Arlington.
- As a team, the Tigers hit .325 with an on-base percentage of .398 over the season's opening weekend.
- Grad transfer Zach Franklin made an immediate impact out of the Mizzou bullpen, logging two shutdown performances, including a seven-strikeout effort to earn the win over No. 15 TCU on Sunday.
- Another newcomer, Rorik Maltrud, picked up the win Saturday vs. Texas with 2.2 innings of shutout relief.
- Sophomore lefty Tony Neubeck and freshman right-hander Sam Horn also sparkled out of the pen, combining for 12 strikeouts over 6.2 combined innings.

MEET THE PANTHERS

- Designated hitter Ryne Guida has been the Panthers' top performer at the plate, bringing a .438 batting mark and eight RBIs into the series.
- Outfielder Mike Rosario has accounted for half of the Panthers' four home runs on the season.
- FIU is batting .254 as a club through four games.
- The Panthers have committed just two errors in the field, good for a team .987 fielding percentage.
- On the mound, three of FIU's four starting pitchers to date have yielded one run or fewer.
- As a staff, the Panthers have logged a 3.75 ERA to date.

MANN-ING UP

- Luke Mann continued his climb up the Mizzou home run chart, belting his 29th career round-tripper vs. Texas.
- Mann moved into a tie for 10th on the Tigers' career chart, matching Tom Ciombor and needs three more to catch Chris Wyrick in the No. 9 position on the list.
- The St. Louis native also extended his hit streak to eight games (dating back to May 14, 2022).
- Mann was tabbed for first-team preseason laurels, becoming the first Tiger honoree since Kameron Misner's second-team selection five years ago.
- The fifth-year third baseman from St. Louis belted 15 of his 17 home runs last season in SEC play.
- Mann's 17 homers were the most by a Tiger in the BBCOR era (2011-present), surpassing Trey Harris' 12 long balls in 2017.
- Mann's 17 blasts were the most by a Tiger since Cody Ehlers hit 18 round-trippers in 2004.
- The lefty went long nine times in April 2022, which tied for the most in the SEC.
- His 15 home runs in SEC games ranked second among all league batters.

WHAT A RELIEF

- Mizzou's bullpen turned in a weekend to remember in Arlington, registering 29 strikeouts over the first three games of the season.
- As a group, the seven Tiger relievers who worked at the College Baseball Showdown went 2-0 with a 2.04 ERA, allowing just eight hits over a combined 17.2 innings.
- Sophomore Tony Neubeck established a personal

career high with nine strikeouts in his 3 2/3 innings vs. Oklahoma State.

- Grad transfer Zach Franklin made two appearances out of the MU pen, fanning 10 while allowing just one hit over his 4.2 innings.

BIESER BELIEVER

- Mizzou head coach Steve Bieser is in his seventh year guiding the Tigers, entering the weekend with a 160-132-1 record as MU's bench boss.
- Bieser is just two wins shy of the 300-victory plateau through 10 seasons as an NCAA Division I head coach, bringing a 298-229-1 mark into action Friday.
- The Tigers have finished with an overall record above .500 in five of Bieser's six seasons.
- Bieser's 104 wins from 2017-19 were the most ever by a Mizzou baseball coach in his first three campaigns.
- Additionally, Bieser's win total marked the winningest three-year stretch by the Tigers since 2008-10 (103 victories).
- Mizzou produced 39 wins in Southeastern Conference play from 2017-19 as well, marking its top three-year stretch in league play since joining its new conference in 2013.

TY TAKES TEXAS

- Ty Wilmsmeyer enjoyed the Texas hospitality last weekend in Arlington, recording seven hits over the Tigers three games at the College Baseball Showdown.
- The senior outfielder started his season off with a two-hit performance vs. No. 11 Oklahoma State.
- Wilmsmeyer capped the weekend with a career-high four hits against No. 15 TCU, scoring the go-ahead run in the 10th inning after drawing a one-out walk.
- The Springfield, Mo., native extended his personal hit streak to six games as well.

WELCOME WAGON

- Mizzou's new class of transfers features a number of veterans who have already made their mark in college baseball.
- Zach Franklin (Western Carolina) enters the weekend with 17 mound victories, which ranks atop the SEC leaderboard for active hurlers.
- Jacob Hasty (LSU) has experienced three seasons in the SEC as a highly-productive left-handed specialist.
- Rorik Maltrud (New Mexico State) has the versatility to fill a number of roles for the Tigers after working as both a starter and reliever for New Mexico State.
- The duo of Chandler Murphy and Javyn Pimental comes to Columbia from Arizona, where each gained significant NCAA postseason experience; they will have the opportunity to make an immediate impact as projected starting hurlers for Mizzou this weekend.
- Infielders Cam Chick (Nebraska), Matt Garcia (Bethune-Cookman) and Hank Zeisler (UNLV), as well as Arkansas transfer Dylan Leach behind the plate, give the Tigers a deeper, highly-experienced pool of talent in 2023.

IMMACULATE NEUBECK

- Sophomore left-hander Tony Neubeck returns after a noteworthy rookie campaign in 2022.
- Neubeck delivered an awe-inspiring relief performance Feb. 25 at ULM with an immaculate seventh inning.
- The Tiger lefty torched ULM's batters with nine-straight strikes for the rare feat.
- For the season, Neubeck notched three victories in 15 total appearances, including nine starts, striking out 60 hitters in just 54.1 innings.

AUSTIN LOOKS FOR ENCORE

- Trevor Austin turned in a career-best 15-game hitting streak last spring (April 12-May 7).
- Austin went hitless vs. Ole Miss on May 8, but rebounded to notch hits in his next four games, giving him hits in 19 of 20 contests.
- Over the 15-game hitting streak, Austin batted a blistering .418 with nine RBIs, five doubles and three homers.
- The 15-game hitting stretch raised Austin's average from .237 to .311 on the year, while his OPS went from .736 to .916 over the same span.
- For the season, Austin hit a career-best .297 with six homers, an on-base percentage of .417.
- The Jeff City native ranked 77th nationally and second in the SEC in hit-by-pitches per game (0.31).

SHARING THE LOAD

- Mizzou's breakout 2022 season at the plate featured production from up and down the lineup, with 20 different players recording an RBI.
- Among the Tiger regulars, 11 logged double-digit RBI totals, led by Luke Mann's 10 among the Mizzou returners.
- The Tigers .284 team batting mark represented their best single-season performance since 2010 (.288).
- For the season 13 different Tigers went deep, with six of those launching at least five homers.

LOOKIN' GOOD WITH LOHSE

- Junior lefty Ian Lohse has been a dangerous weapon out of the Tiger bullpen over the last two seasons, posting a 3.55 ERA with five saves in 26 appearances.
- Last season, the St. Louis product limited left-handed batters to a miniscule .071 batting average.
- Lohse fanned 31 hitters in 23.2 innings, collecting three saves and 12 scoreless appearances.
- Notched a team-best 1.40 ERA in 11 SEC outings to lead the Tigers.

LOVE THAT LEATHER

- Mizzou featured one of the SEC's top defenses in 2022, finishing the season with a team .976 fielding percentage.
- The Tigers turned 45 double plays on the season and ranked 24th nationally and second in the SEC in twin killings per outing (0.88).
- Mizzou turned three double plays in their May 14 win over Florida, marking the third time the Tigers recorded three double plays in a game last spring.
- The 45 double plays were the most for a Mizzou team since 2018, when the Tigers turned 46.

MU also rated 32nd nationally in team fielding.

HOMER HISTORY

- The 2022 Tigers set Mizzou's BBCOR-era home run standard with 62 long balls for the season, which represented its top total since the 1998 squad blasted a school-record 110 bombs.
- In records dating to 1950, only 10 Mizzou teams have hit 55 or more homers in a season, and last year's club tied for the seventh-best total in program history.

HIT ME WITH YOUR BEST SHOT

- Mizzou finished 2022 second in the SEC and 33rd nationally with 91 hit-by-pitches.
- Five Tigers were plunked 10 or more times, including Trevor Austin and Luke Mann, who were beamed 13 and 15 times, respectively, as each of Mizzou's top four hitters in its batting order reached double digits in HBP for the season.

DO IT FOR DELUNAS

- Mizzou baseball and the college baseball community suffered a great loss when pitching coach Brian DeLunas passed away on Jan. 16, 2022, after an extended battle with kidney disease.
- DeLunas was set to return for his second stint with the Tigers after serving as a volunteer assistant in the 2007-09 seasons; he called the Mizzou pitching coach spot his "dream job."
- His impact is spread wide across baseball, having spent four seasons in the majors and the better part of two decades mentoring pitchers across all levels of baseball. focused on the person more than the game.

TIGERS ON THE TUBE

- Missouri is slated to appear in at least nine linear broadcasts on the ESPN family of networks over the course of the 2022 season.
- The Tigers will play in eight matchups televised on the SEC Network, along with an ESPNU broadcast at Texas A&M on April 13.
- Additionally, four regular-season dates have been designated as potential wild cards, allowing the league to select additional games for broadcast.
- Along with the nine linear broadcasts, Mizzou's SEC matchups and select non-conference games will stream on SECN+.
- Games 2 (Friday) and 4 (Sunday) of this weekend's series will be streamed live on CUSA.tv.

Mizzou Baseball head coach **Steve Bieser** enters his seventh season at the helm of the program (2017-present). The Tigers have finished with an overall record above .500 in five of his past six seasons. In his first three years in Mid-Missouri (2017-19), Bieser's 104 wins were the most-ever by any Mizzou Baseball coach in his first three campaigns (Gene McArtor: 91 wins (1974-76) // Tim Jamieson: 89 wins (1995-97)). Additionally, his 104 victories marked the winningest three-year stretch by the Tigers since 2008-10 (103 victories). Bieser produced 39 wins in Southeastern Conference play from 2017-19, marking Mizzou's top three-year stretch in league play since joining its new conference in 2013. Additionally, it stands as the Tigers' top three-year conference record since 2007-09.

In six seasons thus far at Mizzou, Bieser has helped guide 23 players to the MLB Draft (five - 2022, one - 2021, one - 2020, five - 2019, six - 2018, five - 2017). The 2022 draft featured five Tigers with RHP Spencer Miles (fourth round - San Francisco Giants) becoming the fifth Tiger pitcher to go in the first four rounds under Bieser. 1B Torin Montgomery (14th round - Miami Marlins) was selected by the Marlins for the second time after a 39th round pick out of high school in 2019. SS Josh Day (Arizona Diamondbacks) and LHP Nathan Landry (Boston Red Sox) each went in the 15th round before Drew Garrett (19th round - Philadelphia Phillies) made it five selections. The five Tigers marked the most in the new, condensed draft era and are tied for ninth all-time in Mizzou draft history. In 2021, pitcher Seth Halvorsen's selection made it 26-straight years with a Tiger selected in the MLB Draft. In 2020, RHP Ian Bedell (fourth round - St. Louis Cardinals) became Mizzou's 11th pitcher to be selected among the opening five rounds of the MLB Draft since 2006. In 2019, OF Kameron Misner (35th overall - Miami Marlins) and LHP TJ Sikkema (38th overall - New York Yankees) became Mizzou's eighth and ninth all-time first-round selections. Misner became only the Tigers' second-ever position player to garner first-round accolades, joining C Steve Patchin in 1971. Sikkema became the first Tiger hurler to be selected in the first round since RHP Tanner Houck did so in 2017. In 2018, LHP Michael Plassmeyer was selected in the fourth round (118th overall - Seattle Mariners), marking the third-highest drafted lefty hurler in program history.

Despite a COVID-19 pandemic shortened 2020 season, Bieser and Mizzou still produced a strong campaign with an 11-5 record. The Tigers ended their brief schedule with seven-straight victories, marking the SEC's second-longest winning streak before the season abruptly ended. Mizzou's impressive streak was highlighted by taking two of three at the premier Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic in Houston, Texas. The Tigers closed their road trip at Minute Maid Park with back to back wins over No. 22 Oklahoma and Texas.

During the 2019 campaign, Mizzou produced five series victories in SEC play, including an impressive 4-1 mark at Taylor Stadium. Two of those series triumphs in Mid-Missouri occurred against nationally ranked foes, highlighted by the program's first-ever series win versus LSU. The five SEC series victories were the most by a Mizzou squad since 2015.

Following a three-game SEC series sweep vs. South Carolina (April 26-28, 2019), Bieser earned his 100th career win at the helm of Mizzou. He produced victory No. 100 in his 161st game in Columbia, becoming the second-fastest head

coach in program history to reach 100 wins. He trailed only John "Hi" Simmons, who produced win No. 100 in his 139th career game at Mizzou.

Bieser was named Mizzou's 14th head coach and just the fourth since 1937 on June 30, 2016. Bieser came to Mizzou after an extremely successful career at Southeast Missouri, where he became the only coach ever to win three consecutive Ohio Valley Conference championships and guided the Redhawks to a 2016 NCAA Regional appearance, their first NCAA bid since 2002.

A two-time OVC Coach of the Year, Bieser won 35 or more games in each of his last three seasons at Southeast Missouri, a feat that had been accomplished just once before he took over the program in 2013. Bieser turned in a .587 winning percentage in his time with the Redhawks, marking the best total among any coach in program history.

Bieser turned in a banner year in 2016, as he earned his 100th career victory and opened OVC play with a perfect 12-0 record, the best start in program history. The season culminated in a regular season OVC championship, an OVC Tournament title and the school's first NCAA Regional since 2002, qualifying for the Starkville Regional at SEC champion Mississippi State.

After a successful playing career at Southeast Missouri, Bieser was drafted in the 32nd round of the 1989 MLB Draft by the Philadelphia Phillies. He played 13 years as a professional with nine of those years coming at Triple-A or higher. He made his Major League debut on April 1, 1997, with the New York Mets and played 60 career MLB games between the Mets and the Pittsburgh Pirates, compiling a .250 career average and a .351 career on-base percentage. Bieser made his Major League debut as a catcher, but his versatility led him to play a variety of positions over his career. He closed out his professional career with the Memphis Redbirds (St. Louis Cardinals Triple-A affiliate), where he guided the team to a Triple-A World Series in 2000. He played every position on the field during his professional career.

Bieser, a native of Saint Genevieve, Missouri, went to Southeast Missouri after a very successful tenure as head coach at St. John Vianney High School in Kirkwood, Missouri. In seven seasons leading the Griffins, his team won two state championships in 2004 and 2006, as he compiled a career record of 137-51 (.729).

Bieser and his wife, Diahann, have a son Cole and three daughters, Whitley, Briley and Carley.
