LEADING OFF

LIFTING THE LID

- Missouri will lift the lid on its 131st season of varsity baseball Friday (Feb. 16) when the Tigers open a four-game series with Cal Poly at Baggett Stadium in San Luis Obispo, Calif.
- New Tiger head coach **Kerrick Jackson** will be leading Mizzou into action for the first time Friday. The St. Louis native returned to Columbia last June as the 15th head coach in MU history.
- The Tigers' series with Cal Poly opens a West Coast road swing that will see MU play a total of eight games in nine days to open the season.
- Following the conclusion of its series in SLQ, Mizzou will relocate to San Diego, where it will play four more games in the Tony Gwynn Legacy event, Thursday, Feb. 22 through Saturday, Feb. 24.
- Mizzou is 80-43-1 all-time in season openers and 6-4 in its last 10 debut contests (since 2014)
- MU will making its first season-opening trip to the state of California since 2011, when it topped Cal Poly (10-9) on a neutral field in Los Angeles.

- Each of the Tigers' four games with Cal Poly will be streamed live through **ESPN+**.
- Each game this week will also be streamed live on the **Tiger Radio Network** via the **Varsity Network** app, with Tex Little and Matt Michaels describing the action.

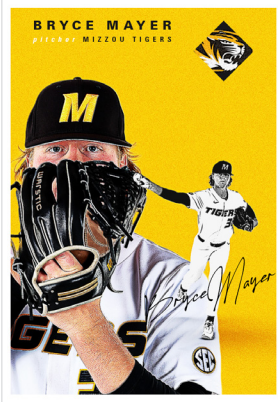

Rustad was limited to one mound appearance in 2023 due to injury ... allowed one unearned run on one hit in his only appearance of the season vs. No. 15 TCU (Feb. 19) at the College Baseball Showdown ... worked 51.1 innings with a 4.73 ERA in 2022, his first season with the Tigers ... dominant workhorse out of the bullpen, posting a 2.77 ERA and a 3-1 mark in 13 appearances and 39.0 IP ... spent two seasons at the University of San Diego to start his career ... went 5-1 with a 4.70 ERA while making 15 appearances in 2021 ... recorded 46 strikeouts in 53.2 innings pitched... received Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American honors in 2020.

SERIES HISTORY

- Mizzou and Cal Poly will meet for the fourth time when the two clubs open the 2024 season Friday evening.
- MU holds a 2-1 overall series edge after claiming each of the last two meetings with the Mustangs; Mizzou edged Cal Poly, 10-9, in the most recent matchup in Los Angeles on Feb. 18, 2011.
- The Tigers also claimed a 6-3 victory on March 2, 2008 in San Diego, after Cal Poly notched a 4-2 win on Feb. 15, 2003 in Phoenix.

SCOUTING MISSOURI

- Missouri posted a 30-24 regular-season finish last spring, including a 10-20 SEC mark.
- Kerrick Jackson** was named the 15th head coach in Mizzou history in June, returning to Columbia to lead a program for which he served as an assistant coach from 2011-15 under Mizzou Hall of Fame head coach (and current pitching coach) **Tim Jamieson**.
- The Tigers return three regular starters from last season, led by senior INF/OF **Trevor Austin**, who batted .311 with eight homers and 10 steals to help bolster the MU offense.
- Senior INF **Matt Garcia** turned in a solid debut season with the Tigers, providing clutch hitting and lock-down defense on the MU infield.
- Additionally, junior INF **Justin Colon** returns for Mizzou and earning significant playing time at shortstop over each of his first two seasons in Columbia.
- MU should also receive a lift from sophomore INF **Jackson Lovich** and junior OF **Juju Stevens**, who each made key contributions in limited duty in 2023.
- Several newcomers could also make early contributions, including junior INF **Danny Corona**, who helped Wake Forest to a 2023 College World Series berth, C **Jedier Hernandez**, a standout behind the plate for Seton Hall the last two seasons, and sophomore OF **Jeric Curtis**, a Texas Tech transfer who brings significant speed to the Tiger outfield and batting order.
- On the mound, sophomore RHP **Logan Lunceford** is back to help anchor Mizzou's weekend rotation after posting 68 strikeouts to lead all SEC freshman hurlers last spring.
- Junior LHP **Javyn Pimental** also contributed mightily to the Tigers' mound efforts in 2023, making eight starts for the Tigers.
- Mizzou should also benefit from the potential return of a trio veterans who missed significant time last spring; left-handers **Ian Lohse** and **Tony Neubeck** and RHP **Carter Rustad** missed significant portions of 2023 due to injury following promising starts to the campaign.
- New arms like RHP **Xavier Lovett** and RHP **Bryce Mayer** could compete for starting rotation spots, while RHP **Jacob Peaden** may give the back end of the Tigers' bullpen a strong presence.

MIZZOU BY THE NUMBERS

- Missouri is coming off a 30-win campaign last spring, which marked the 20th time the Tigers reached the 30-win plateau in the last 30 seasons, as well as the 35th time overall in program history.
- Mizzou finished its 2023 home slate with a 19-7 mark at Taylor Stadium — its top home win total since 2019.
- The Tigers also shattered the program's single-season attendance record, drawing at total of 37,133 fans over 23 home dates to eclipse the previous mark of 31,450 spectators (2008).
- Mizzou homered 79 times as a team in 2023, which

represented the fifth-best season total in program history.

- The Tigers' 2023 pitching staff ranked 37th nationally in strikeouts per nine innings (9.7).
- Trevor Austin** enters his fourth season as a Tiger with a career .294 batting mark. The Jefferson City, Mo., product has hit .282 in SEC play with 10 of his 16 career home runs coming in league action.
- Matt Garcia** enters the campaign as the Tigers' active career leader in hits (121), runs (70), doubles (21) and triples (8).
- Ian Lohse** has limited opposing hitters to a minuscule .178 batting mark in his 32 career outings spanning 58.0 innings.
- Carter Rustad** brings 12 career victories into the 2023 season. The Kansas City native also leads all active Mizzou pitchers with 113 career strikeouts.

SCOUTING CAL POLY

- Under the direction of 22nd year head coach **Larry Lee**, Cal Poly is looking to bounce back from an uncharacteristic 21-35 season last spring.
- The Mustangs return were picked to finish seventh in the Big West Preseason Coaches' Poll.
- C **Ryan Stafford** returns to lead Cal Poly after hitting .313 with a team-leading 20 doubles, seven home runs and 44 RBIs in 2023.
- Stafford, who earned a roster spot on USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team last summer, also threw out 11 would-be base stealers for the second straight year and picked off three other runners.
- INF **Aaron Casillas** is also back for the Mustangs following a year in which he hit .329 with 40 RBIs, while fellow returner and INF Ryan Fenn led all Cal Poly hitters with his .344 average.
- In the outfield, **Jake Steels** swiped a team-high 13 bases in 2023 to go along with a .318 showing.
- On the mound, the right-handed duo of **Ryan Baum** and **Steven Brooks** returns after sharing the team lead with four wins apiece last spring.
- As a team, Cal Poly hit .278, while fielding at a .974 clip a year ago.

FAB FROSH FIND SUCCESS

- Mizzou's 2023 pitching staff received a needed boost from its talented freshman class, which featured five hurlers—**Sam Horn**, **Brock Lucas**, **Logan Lunceford**, **Nic Smith** and **Daniel Wissler**—who combined to log 135.0 innings while posting a 10-6 mound mark.
- Lunceford, who fanned six or more batters in seven of his 13 appearances, led all SEC freshman pitchers in strikeouts (68).
- The group finished the season with a combined 135 strikeouts in 135.0 innings.
- Smith has been dominant out of the bullpen, logging a 2.84 ERA while holding the opposition to a .208 batting average in his five relief outings.

MIZZOU MOMENT

February 18, 2011...The Tigers rallied for six runs in the home half of the sixth inning vs. Cal Poly to claim a 10-9 opening-day victory in Los Angeles. The Mustangs snapped a 4-4 tie by scoring five times in the top of the sixth, before RBI singles from **Conner Mach**, **Blake Brown** and **Brannon Champagne** keyed the Tigers' decisive rally. That trio finished the day a combined 6-for-10 with six RBIs for Mizzou, which went on to post 27

- Mizzou reached the 75-home run plateau on just four previous occasions--1998, 1988, 1986 and 1985.
- Last year's total marked the Tigers' first 75-HR season during the BBCOR era (2011 to present)

TIGERS AT THE TURNSTILES

- Mizzou shattered its program record for total home attendance this season, drawing 37,133 fans over 23 home dates to eclipse the previous mark of 31,450 fans (2008).
- MU finished its 2023 home campaign with its 20th crowd of 1,000 or more fans—and its 17th in a row.
- In its 23 home dates at Taylor Stadium, the Tigers drew five crowds of at least 2,000 fans, as well as an average of 1,614 spectators per date, both of which represent high-water marks for the program.
- This season's attendance growth marks a 43-percent increase in average home attendance from last spring, when MU drew 1,127 fans per home date (and 28,181 for the entire season).

THROWING SMOKE

- Mizzou's 2023 pitching staff left its mark, posting 23 double-digit strikeout totals in 54 games.
- With 484 K's, the Tigers' staff total ranked seventh on the program's single-season strikeout chart.
- The Tigers ranked 37th nationally as a staff in strikeouts per nine innings (9.7).
- Mizzou's 8.9 hits allowed per game ranked 56th in the nation.
- As a staff, the Tigers limited the opposition to a collective .254 batting average, with nine different pitchers logging averages against below that figure.

A HUB FOR MID-MISSOURI

- The University of Missouri generates \$5 billion in economic impact for the state of Missouri.
- The larger University of Missouri System, comprised of four universities, generated \$6.5 billion in economic impact on the Show Me State.
- The University of Missouri supports nearly 50,000 direct and indirect jobs, both full and part time, in the state.
- Mizzou Athletics generated \$319.1 million in economic impact over the last fiscal year.
- The Tigers support and sustain 3,591 jobs annually.
- Mizzou Athletics has generated \$15.9 million in state and local taxes.

NON-CON DOMINATION

- Mizzou logged a 20-3 mark against non-SEC foes last spring, continuing a string of recent dominance in nonconference play.
- The Tigers went 18-3 in nonconference play in 2022, giving them an overall mark of 38-6 in non-SEC competition since the start of the 2022 season.
- Mizzou hit .300 against non-league foes and averaged nearly 10 hits per outing, while also posting a 3.95 team ERA.
- Over the last decade, the Tigers' dominance has been equally as pronounced, with MU winning nearly 100 more nonconference games than it has lost (165-66), good for a .747 winning percentage.

IN THE 'NOW'

- New Tiger bench boss **Kerrick Jackson** has undertaken the challenge of revitalizing Missouri's tradition-rich program, part of which has included a re-branding of sorts.
- Casual observers of any number of Mizzou's fall or preseason workouts will undoubtedly have taken note of a new and unique slogan around Taylor Stadium. Jackson and his staff introduced the **#MizzouNOW** branding—an acronym for No Opportunity Wasted—providing his student-athletes an entirely new way of approaching the game and the way they go about working to achieve their common goal of returning Mizzou to national prominence.
- #MizzouNOW** was developed with a focus on appreciating the present and working toward taking advantage the opportunities immediately in front of the Tigers.

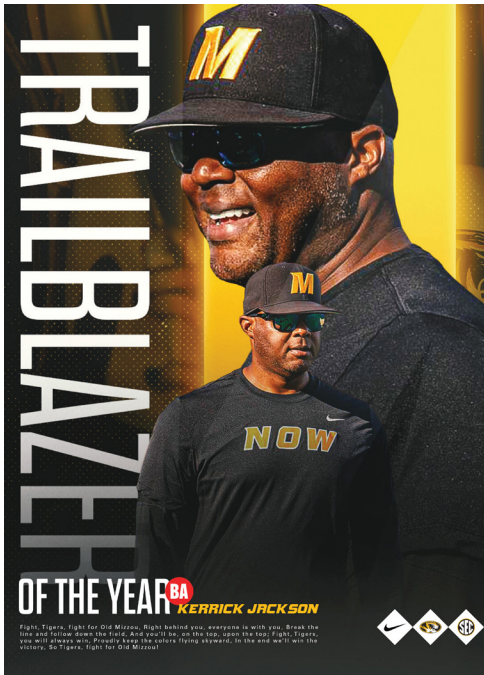

TIGER TRAILBLAZER

- **Kerrick Jackson** has already enjoyed a personal moment of 'NOW' as the St. Louis product became the first Black head coach in SEC history with his appointment to the Tigers' top job.
- Jackson also picked up a significant honor from Baseball America in December, earning the publication's 2023 Trailblazer of the Year honor.
- Jackson has left his mark in just four seasons as a Division I head coach, including leading Southern to the 2019 Southwestern Athletic Conference crown and an NCAA Regional berth, as well as guiding Memphis to its first winning season in six years last spring.
- Additionally, Jackson has impacted the college baseball landscape through his work on the American Baseball Coaches Association's Diversity in Baseball Committee, a body for which he has served as chairman since its creation in 2018. The council works to improve diversity in the coaching ranks through a professional development program and an increased focus on youth baseball



CALIFORNIA DREAMING

- Mizzou will be making its first season-opening trip to California since 2011, when it topped Cal Poly (10-9) on a neutral field in Los Angeles (Feb. 18).
- Most recently, the Tigers traveled to San Francisco for a three-game nonconference set against the Dons in February 2012.
- The Tigers dropped all three of those contests to USF, as well as the final two games of their 2011 trip to Los Angeles, meaning they enter Friday's season opener looking to right a five-game slide in the Golden State.
- Overall, MU brings a 22-32 overall record against schools from California into the 2024 season.
- The Tigers did log arguably the biggest four wins of the 2000s in California when Mizzou posted victories over UC Irvine, UCLA and Pepperdine (twice) to claim the 2006 Malibu Regional title, advancing to their first NCAA Super Regional appearance.

COMING HOME

- Head coach **Kerrick Jackson** did not have to look far when adding the initial pieces of his Mizzou coaching staff. He selected former Tiger head coach **Tim Jamieson** for his pitching coach, completing a homecoming for the Mizzou Athletics Hall of Famer.
- Jamieson brings 28 years of coaching experience on the Missouri campus into his new role as the Tigers pitching coach.

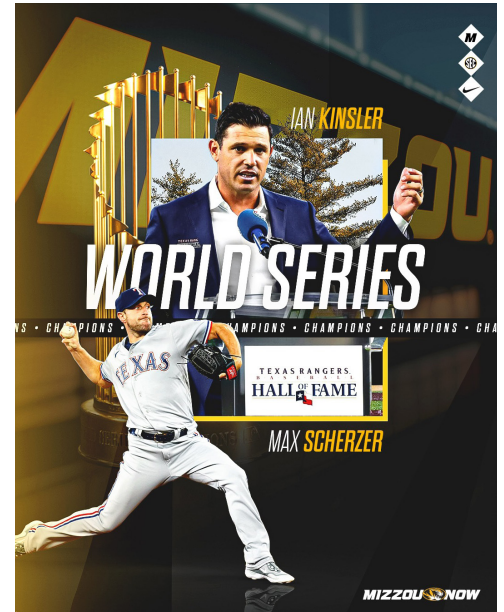
- In 22 seasons as Mizzou's head baseball coach, Jamieson led the Tigers to 698 wins, trailing only **Gene McArtor** (733) on the Tigers' all-time coaching victories chart.
- He coached eight All-Americans at Mizzou and saw 75 of his players drafted, including 19 Major Leaguers.
- Jamieson returns to his hometown of Columbia after serving as pitching coach under Jackson in his lone season at Memphis, where the duo helped lead the Tigers to their first winning season since 2017.
- Prior to his stop at UM, Jamieson spent three seasons (2020-22) as pitching coach at Southern Illinois, helping the Salukis compile a 96-42 record that included a pair of 40-win seasons.
- Jamieson garnered 1996 Big 8 Coach of the Year and 2007 Big 12 Co-Coach of the Year honors, as his Missouri teams won 35 games or more nine times during his head coaching career.
- He led Mizzou to seven consecutive NCAA postseason appearances from 2003 to 2009, including the program's first Super Regional berth in 2006. He was also selected to lead USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team as head coach in 2011.
- Jamieson, a graduate of Columbia Rock Bridge High School, is married to a Mizzou graduate, the former Cindy Thornton.

SPEAKING OF HOMECOMINGS...

- Another new Mizzou assistant coach (and former Tiger) will be making a return to his old stomping grounds, both this week and for the foreseeable future. **Bryson LeBlanc** joined Jamieson on Kerrick Jackson's first MU staff after spending five seasons on the coaching staff at UC San Diego, whom Mizzou will face two times at next weekend's Tony Gwynn Legacy in San Diego.
- LeBlanc, who was named one of D1Baseball.com's picks for its '100 Assistant Coaches Athletic Directors Should Know' list this past fall, patrolled the MU outfield for Jamieson on the previously mentioned 2006 Regional-winning club.
- He helped guide UC San Diego through its transition to the NCAA Division I level, including a 34-18 campaign last spring that culminated in the program's first Big West Conference title.
- In all, 46 of LeBlanc's former players have been selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 who have been taken in the top 10 rounds. Six of those have advanced to the big leagues.

HALL WORTHY

- Even before his return as a member of the Tigers' new coaching staff, **Tim Jamieson** knew he'd be making a trip to Columbia in 2023 after his selection for induction to the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletics Hall of Fame in late May.
- Jamieson became the fourth former Tiger head baseball coach to be tabbed for Mizzou's highest athletic honor, joining **Don Faurot**, **John 'Hi' Simmons** and **Gene McArtor**.
- He began his MU career with six years as top assistant coach to McArtor (1989-94), then succeeded his boss in 1995.
- For the next 22 years, Jamieson developed some of the nation's best pitchers, most notably future MLB Hall of Famer **Max Scherzer** (2004-06).
- His career record of 698-565-2 is second only to McArtor's 733-430-3 mark in school history.
- Jamieson took the Tigers to a Big Eight Conference championship in 1996, completing a worst-to-first turnaround – the first in Big Eight history – and in 2012 the Tigers won the Big 12 Conference Tournament title.
- Overall, he took nine teams to the NCAA Tournament, including seven straight appearances from 2003-09 and a Super Regional trip in 2006.



SHOW-ME STATE TO THE SHOW

- Tiger great P **Max Scherzer** claimed his second World Series title with the Texas Rangers' first world championship in a five-game series with Arizona.
- Scherzer became the fourth Tiger to earn multiple World Series championships, adding to his 2019 title with Washington.
- Another former Mizzou stalwart, Rangers special assistant to the G.M. **Ian Kinsler** (2003), also claimed his second World Series ring with the victory, following his first title as an active player with Boston in 2018.
- In all, eight Mizzou baseball alums have won World Series titles as players: in addition to Kinsler (2018) and Scherzer (2019 and 2023), **Homer Summa** (1929 and 1930), **Darold Knowles** (1973 and 1974), **Mike Shannon** (1964 and 1967), **Glenn Wright** (1925), **Charlie James** (1964) and **Tim Laudner** (1987) also claimed Fall Classics.

TIGERS IN THE MLB DRAFT

- Four 2023 Missouri baseball standouts continued the Tigers' tradition of professional talent production with their selections in the Major League Baseball Draft in July.
- P **Chandler Murphy** was taken by Tampa Bay in the 12th round (363rd overall), before 3B **Luke Mann** was picked by Oakland in the 14th round (406th overall) on the final day of the draft.
- The two selections doubled Mizzou's 2023 crop of draftees to a total of four, joining fourth-round selection P **Austin Troesser** (New York Mets) and P **Zach Franklin** (Chicago White Sox), who were picked on day two of the draft.
- With their four selections last summer, the Tigers have seen nine players drafted over the last two seasons, as well as a total of 37 picks in the last 10 drafts.

TIGERS ON THE TUBE

- Missouri was slated to appear in eight linear broadcasts on the ESPN family of networks over the course of the 2024 season.
- The Tigers will play in eight matchups televised on the SEC Network, starting with MU's March 24 league game vs. Kentucky in Columbia.
- Additionally, four regular-season dates have been designated as potential wild cards, allowing the league to select additional games for broadcast.
- Mizzou's SEC matchups and select non-conference games will stream on SEC Network+.

KERRICK JACKSON

FIRST YEAR • NEBRASKA '99

A veteran coach with experience at all levels of baseball, **Kerrick Jackson** was tabbed as Missouri's 15th head coach in June 2023.

Since that time, Jackson has undertaken the challenge of revitalizing the Tigers' tradition-rich program. These efforts have included hiring a diverse staff, recruiting a new-look roster and providing his pupils an entirely new way of approaching the game—and the way they go about working to achieve their common goal of returning Mizzou to national prominence.

While the work is well underway, Jackson will officially become the first Black Southeastern Conference head baseball coach to lead his team into action when the Tigers open their 2024 campaign in February. Furthermore, he will be just the fourth Black collegiate coach to guide a Power Five baseball program and the first to do so since the 2021 season.

In recognition of these efforts, *Baseball America* named Jackson its 2023 Trailblazer of the Year in December, capping an already historic year for the new Mizzou coach.

In addition to his success on the diamond as a collegiate coach, including leading Southern University to the 2019 Southwestern Athletic Conference crown and an NCAA Regional berth and guiding the University of Memphis to its first winning season in six years last spring, Jackson continues to serve as a relentless advocate for minorities in college baseball, especially in the coaching ranks. He helped form the American Baseball Coaches Association's Diversity in Baseball Committee and has served as its chairman since its creation in 2018. That body works to improve diversity in the coaching ranks through a professional development program and an increased focus on youth baseball.

Jackson returned to Columbia after having served as a Mizzou assistant from 2011-15. Known as a developer of players, a tireless recruiter, and a strong talent evaluator, Jackson is a well-respected leader in baseball circles, serving on the American Baseball Coaches Association Board of Directors and as chair of their Diversity in Baseball committee.

Prior to his season at Memphis, Jackson was the President of the MLB Draft League from 2020-22, a six-team summer baseball league sponsored by Major League Baseball and featuring a split-season amateur-professional format.

Jackson served as the head coach at Southern University from 2018-20, where he took a nine-win team in 2018 to 32 wins, a conference championship, and the NCAA Tournament the following season, earning SWAC and Louisiana Sports Writers Association Coach of the Year accolades. His 2018 Jaguar team boasted the athletic department's highest men's team GPA and received national recognition for its community service efforts.

Jackson worked for the Boras Corporation as a certified player agent for two years from 2016-17, where he identified prep and college players with the best chance to develop into Major League talent.

He served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Mizzou from 2011-15, working with the Tigers' hitters, outfielders, and infielders. Mizzou made back-to-back trips to the Big 12 Conference Tournament Championship in 2011-12, culminating with the program's first Big 12 title in 2012. The Tigers had multiple nationally-ranked recruiting classes, including 24th in 2012, 12th in 2014 and a consensus Top-30 class in 2015.

Before heading to Missouri, Jackson served as the Midwest Area Scouting Supervisor for the Washington Nationals from 2008-10, overseeing Missouri, Kansas, Arkansas, Iowa, Nebraska and the Dakotas.

His other collegiate coaching stops include assistant stints at St. Louis Community College-Meramec (2008), Nicholls State (2006-07), Jefferson (Mo.) College (2004-05), Coffeyville (Kan.) Community College (2003),



Emporia State (2002) and Fairfield (2001). Jackson also has extensive experience in the summer collegiate leagues, as he has coached in the Cape Cod League and New England Collegiate Baseball League.

Jackson spent two years at St. Louis Community College-Meramec as a student-athlete, where the team finished third at the JUCO World Series in 1995. Following that, he played at Bethune-Cookman University in 1996, leading the squad to its first-ever conference championship and regional appearance. Jackson concluded his playing career at Nebraska in 1997, graduating in 1999 with a bachelor's degree in sociology.

Jackson and his wife, Talia, have two sons, Zion and Lazarus.
