- Missouri is 8-17 during the 2023-24 season with a 0-12 record in SEC action.
- The Tigers lost a close contest in their last game, falling at Ole Miss, 79-76.
- After missing the previous two contests with an injury, Sean East II returned at Ole Miss – tallying 25 points and six assists.
- Overall, East leads the Tigers with 16.0 points and 4.2 assists per game.
- Four Tigers score in double figures with Tamar Bates (14.0), Noah Carter (11.5) and Nick Honor (10.8) following East's lead.
- Carter also leads all active Mizzou players with 5.0 rebounds per game.
- The Tigers are scoring 72.2 points per game, while allowing 74.5.

ABOUT THE VOLUNTEERS

- Tennessee enters Tuesday's contest with a No. 5 nationally ranking in the AP and coaches polls.

INJURY UPDATE

- The Tigers have dealt with a number of injuries throughout the 2023-24 campaign.
- Eight Mizzou players have missed at least two games this season due to injury or illness.
- Tigers that missed the team's most recent game include Kaleb Brown (stress reaction, out for season), Caleb Grill (wrist), Trent Pierce (illness), Danny Stephens (foot, out for season) and John Tonje (foot, out for season).
- The Tigers owned a 7-2 record with Grill in the lineup but are 1-15 without him.

BENCH DEPTH

- Because of its injuries, the MU's depth and bench has been the biggest reason for its recent slide.
- In their 12 SEC games, the Tigers starters have played their opponents nearly even – being outscored by less than two points, 57.5 to 55.8.
- However, the team's bench has been outscored in 11-of-12 league contests and by a 245-140 total (average of 20.4 to 11.7).

- Junior **Tamar Bates** has increased his output the second half of the season.
- Bates has scored in double digits in the last 15 games, tallying 18.5 points during the stretch – an increase of 11.4 from the year's first 10 contests.
- The junior guard's 15-straight games of at least 10 points is the longest streak by a Tiger since Jabari Brown had a 31-game run in 2013-14.

- Shooting efficiency is the key to success for junior **Tamar Bates** in 2023-24.
- Bates owns career-best marks with a 52.1 field goal percentage, 41.5 3-point percentage and 92.3 free-throw percentage.
- In fact, Bates is one of only two players in the country shooting 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from three and 90 percent from the free-throw line in 2023-24 (Princeton's Matt Allocco is the other).
- Bates is also on target to become the first Tiger in school history to join the 50-40-90 club.

THREE POINTS OF DIFFERENCE

- The deep looks have not gone in for the Tigers as of late, leading to their 0-11 conference start.
- In the last 14 games, Mizzou has made just 29.1 percent of its 3-point shots a decrease of more than seven percent from the first 11 games.

TOP 3-POINT THREATS

- While MU has struggled as a team from the 3-point line, the Tigers still feature a strong collective of shooters from beyond the arc.
- **Sean East II** leads MU at 46.7 percent, followed by **Tamar Bates** (41.5) and **Nick Honor** (40.6).
- It marks the first time in its history that Mizzou has three players shooting 40-plus percent from three-point range (minimum 1.0 make per game).

HONOR LEADS 3-POINT CHARGE

- Graduate Nick Honor has led the charge for the Tigers from beyond the 3-point arc this season, making 58 triples with his 40.6 percent clip.
- Honor has started to click as of late in SEC play, making 24-of-55 during the last nine games – 2.67 per game and 43.6 percent.
- Honor has made multiple triples in each of the last nine games, the second-longest streak by a Tiger in SEC play – topped only by Kassius Robertson (12 in 2017-18).
- Overall, Honor ranks sixth in the SEC and 139th nationally with 2.32 triples per game, while placing fourth on Mizzou with 10.8 points.

A TURN IN TURNOVERS

- One stat MU could always rely on was winning the turnover battle but that tide has turned recently.
- In the first 53 games under Coach Gates, Mizzou committed fewer turnovers than its foe in 47-of-53 games (more five times and tying once).
- However, MU has committed more turnovers in five of the last seven games, being outscored 110-76 in points off turnovers.

- Bates currently ranks first in the SEC and sixth in the nation by making 92.3 percent from the freethrow line (72-78).
- Additionally, Bates' mark is the top in school history, ahead of the current school record of 90.5, held by Brian Grawer (1999-00).

EAST ALSO SHINES FROM THE LINE

- Graduate guard Sean East II has also excelled from the charity stripe this season, coming off the best game from a Tiger in years.
- East went a perfect 12-for-12 from the freethrow line at Ole Miss on Saturday – the most makes without a miss by any player in an SEC game since 2020 (Arkansas' Joe Isaiah) and the most by a Tiger since Linas Klieza in 2005 (13-13).
- Overall, East ranks first in the conference in SEC play by making 95.0 percent from the free-throw line (38-40).

MABOR MAGIC

- Senior **Mabor Majak** has seen an increase in minutes as of late, contributing on the boards.
- In the last five games, Majak has totaled four points, 14 rebounds and two blocks in 65 minutes of action.
- In his first 20 games as a Tiger over the last season and a half, he had one point and five rebounds.

CHARITY STRIPE DIFFERENTIAL

- One area that has hurt the Tigers this season is at the free-throw line.
- Mizzou ranks last in the SEC in both free throws per game (16.96) and free throws allowed (22.60).
- In fact, MU places 294th nationally (of 362 teams) in free throws and 322nd in free throws allowed.
- Overall, the Tigers are 349th nationally and last among Power 6 schools with 5.64 fewer free throws per game than its opponent.
- On 11 occasions this year, MU's opponent

- has made more free throws than the Tigers attempted.
- Mizzou has not attempted more free throws in a game since Dec. 30 versus Central Arkansas.

STRONG DEFENSIVE SHOWING

- On Jan. 23 at Texas A&M, MU put together one of its top defensive games since joining the SEC.
- For just the sixth time in SEC regular-season play, the Tigers held a team to under 30 percent shooting as the 28.8 percent clip is the fifth-best mark in its SEC history.

BLOCK PARTY

- The Tigers are one of the nation's top teams in rejections this season.
- MU ranks 23rd nationally with 5.0 blocks per game.
- It is one of the team's biggest improvements from last year as Mizzou averaged just 2.7 in 2022-23.
- On Nov. 22, the Tigers set a new school record with 12 blocks against South Carolina State, topping the previous school standard of 11 that was set three times and most recently in 2015.
- Aidan Shaw leads MU and ranks 162nd nationally (10th in the SEC) with 1.20 per game.

MOST IMPROVED AWARD

- Two Tigers rank among the most improved in the SEC this season.
- Sean East II has increased his scoring by 8.7 points this season the most in the SEC while Tamar Bates is third by increasing his average by 7.9 points.

- The key behind the strong campaign from **Sean East II** is his shooting touch.
- East has made 51.6 percent of his attempts this year, including 46.7 percent from beyond the 3-point arc (28-60).
- Last season, East connected on 22.1 percent of his 3-point attempts and it took to his 11th game to surpass his total of 15 made triples from 35 games last season.
- East is 83rd in the nation and fifth in the SEC with his 52.1 field goal percentage.

LEADING FROM THE START

- The signs were there from the beginning that Sean East II would have a strong season.
- East led MU in scoring in each of the first three games – the first Tiger to do so since 2013-14 – and capped his early-season run with the gamewinner with 9.9 seconds left at Minnesota.
- Overall, East has led Mizzou in scoring 12 times this year – he did so twice in 35 games in his first year at Mizzou.

DOUBLE-DIGIT OPTIONS

- With **Tamar Bates**' hot stretch of late, MU now features four players averaging at least 10 points.
- Joining Bates (14.0 ppg) is **Sean East II** (16.0), **Noah Cater** (11.5) and **Nick Honor** (10.8).
- Mizzou has not finished a season with four players averaging in double figures since five did so during the 2012-13 campaign.
- Overall, 11 different Tigers have scored at least 10 points in a game this season – most by MU since the 2017-18 team also had 11.

RECORD-SETTING PERFORMANCE

- On Jan. 20, **Tamar Bates** had one of the best performances by a Tiger in an SEC game.
- Bates set two MU records in SEC play with his 36 points and 13 made field goals versus Florida.

- Overall, Bates' 36 points are the most by a Tiger in a regulation game since Arthur Johnson tallied 37 versus Kansas in 2004.
- Bates is also the first Tiger to score more than half of the team's points in a game since Derrick Chievous had 33 in a 64-63 setback at Cal in 1986.

STAT FILLER

- Senior Jesus Carralero Martin is capable of doing it all with the Tigers.
- On Jan. 16, he scored in double figures for the first time at MU with 10 points at Alabama.
- Additionally, Carralero Martin has also posted highs of seven boards, six assists, four steals and three blocks this season – the only Tiger to reach all of those marks.

EARLY STEALS LEADER

- Anthony Robinson II continues to make a strong first impression as a rookie.
- Robinson leads MU with 32 steals and adds 3.8 points, 1.9 boards and 24 total assists.
- He is aiming to be the first freshman to lead MU in steals since Terrence Phillips in 2015-16.
- The rookie also scored in double figures in backto-back games on Nov. 22 and Nov. 25 – the first MU rookie to do so since Kobe Brown in 2019-20.

EARLY-SEASON GAINS

- The Tigers put together some resume bullet points early in the season before their injuries.
- Missouri is the only SEC school with two road victories over power-conference schools after wins at Minnesota and Pittsburgh.
- In fact, it marks the first time since 2003-04 that Missouri has two road wins in non-conference play and first time since 1991-92 with two over power-conference foes.

NEW FACES

- One challenge the Tigers face in the 2023-24 season is introducing a number of new faces.
- The Tigers welcomed 11 newcomers to the roster this season.
- The nine newcomers that have played so far are currently combining to average 31.2 points, 14.4 rebounds, 5.1 assists, 4.4 steals and 2.6 blocks.

- Mizzou made a splash on Nov. 8 by signing the nation's fourth-ranked freshman class.
- MU officially welcomed Marcus Allen, T.O.
 Barrett, Annor Boateng, Trent Burns and Peyton
 Marshall to the program all top-100 commits.
- The No. 4 class matches the highest in school history, tying the mark of No. 4 in 2017.

BATES SHINES IN MIZZOU DEBUT

- Tamar Bates made a strong first impression.
- A transfer from Indiana, Bates scored 18 points in his first game with the Tigers, including a run of 10-straight for MU which turned a nine-point lead to a 17-point halftime advantage.
- Bates' 18 points are the most by a Tiger in his Mizzou debut since Mark Smith tallied 19 to open the 2018-19 campaign.

MIZZOU RALLIES FOR VICTORY

- Dennis Gates has built a staff that includes multiple years of head-coaching experience.
- Three assistants have enjoyed time leading a college program: Charlton "C.Y." Young (Georgia Southern, 2009-13), David "Dickey" Nutt (Arkansas State, 1995-08; Southeast Missouri, 2009-15) and Kyle Smithpeters (John A. Logan CC, 2012-22).
- Additionally, special assistant to the head coach
 Matt Lottich joins the roster after spending the last seven years leading Valparaiso.

CAN'T TEACH HEIGHT

- The Tigers feature a lot of height in 2023-24.
- With Connor Vanover (7-5), Mabor Majak (7-2) and Jordan Butler (7-0), Mizzou is one of just five schools in the nation to feature three seven-footers on its roster joining Arizona (4), Duke (3), Oregon State (3) and Santa Clara (3).
- Additionally, Vanover is the tallest player in school history and tied with Ole Miss' Jamarion Sharp for the tallest in the NCAA this season.
- Last year, Vanover had more blocks individually (110) than Mizzou did as a team (95).

INTERNATIONAL DUTY

- Graduate guard John Tonje spent his summer helping the Cameroon National Team advance in the Olympic Qualifying Tournament.
- In the final of the Pre-Qualifying Tournament in Nigeria, Tonje and Cameroon defeated Senegal, 80-74, to advance to final rounds of qualifying.
- Four of the 24 teams left in qualifying advance to Paris 2024 with the tournament set for July 2024.

WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

- A number of 2022-23 Tigers have continued their basketball career at the professional level.
- Kobe Brown was a first-round draft pick of the Clippers, while D'Moi Hodge signed as a rookie free agent with the Lakers and is now playing for Rip City in the G-League.

- In addition, Isiaih Mosley was selected eighth overall in the G-League Draft and is playing for the Wisconsin Herd.
- DeAndre Gholston is also playing in Hungary.
