GAME NOTES

MIDWEEK ACTION VS. MISSOURI

Illinois baseball heads to Sauget, Ill., to take on Missouri in Braggins' Rights at Grizzlies Ballpark.

The game will be streamed on SEC Network.

Mike Reis will call the action for the Illini on the Busey Bank Illini Sports Network (1400 AM/93.9FM). Streaming, audio, and stats links are also available at FightingIllini.com.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

Missouri enters the weekend 10-14, coming off of a series defeat to No. 25 Kentucky. The Tigers have gone 1-1 in neutral site contests this season.

INF Jackson Lovich leads Missouri, among qualifiers, at the plate with a .322 average to go along with six home runs and 20 RBI. Among starters, LHP Javyn Pimental leads on the mound, going 1-0 with a 1.90 ERA (5 ER/23.2 IP) to go along with 26 strikeouts.

The Tigers are led by first-year head coach Kerrick Jackson, the first Black head coach in SEC baseball history and just one of four Black collegiate coaches ever to lead a Power Five baseball program.

Missouri went 30-24 last season, including a 10-20 record in SEC play.

ALL-TIME SERIES INFO

Illinois trails in the all-time series 14-16-1 and have gone 4-10 in neutral site contests against Missouri. The teams have gone 3-3 in the last six matchups, all played at neutral sites.

This will be the fourth-straight contest in this series that will be played in Sauget, Ill., and the seventh such game overall at this facility. Illinois has gone 3-3 in those ballgames.

BIG WEEKEND IN BLOOMINGTON

Illinois began Big Ten play in winning fashion, taking two of three over Indiana in Bloomington for its first series win over the Hoosiers on the road since 2005.

The Illini batted .303 as a team, tallying seven doubles and three home runs over the series. Drake Westcott led the way at the plate, slashing .400/.600/.800 with a double, home run and six RBI.

Illinois starting pitching went 2-1 with a 2.40 ERA (4 ER/15.0 IP) to go along with 13 strikeouts. All three starters (Jack Crowder, Cooper Omans, Jake Swartz) worked 5.0 innings in their outings and all yielded three earned runs or fewer.

In Sunday's series finale, the Illini put together their best day at the plate this season, setting season-high marks in runs (15), hits (20) and extra-base hits (7). The 15 runs scored are the most in a Big Ten game by Illinois since scoring 18 at Penn State on May 19, 2022. It also was the first time since May 10, 2015, vs. Rutgers that the Illini had at least 20 hits in a game.

BIG PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Redshirt junior infielder Drake Westcott has been named Big Ten Player of the Week, the conference announced Monday.

Westcott went 6-for-15 (.400) with five runs scored, a double, a home run, six RBI and five walks over four games, posting a .550 on-base percentage while slugging .667.

The Edwardsville, Ill., started the week by going 2-for-5 with two runs vs. Bradley on March 19 before going 4-for-10 (.400) with three runs, a double, a home run, six RBI and five walks over the three-game set at Indiana.

In Sunday's series finale, Westcott reached safely in all six of his plate appearances (2 H, 4 BB), homered and drove in four runs.

Westcott has walked 23 times on the season, which is second-most among Big Ten hitters and his 1.045 OPS ranks 12th among conference batters. He also ranks among Big Ten leaders in home runs (6, T-3rd) and slugging (.592, 11th).

This marks the second time this season, and the third time in his Illini career, that Westcott has earned conference weekly honors. He is the first Illinois player since Bren Spillane in 2018 to earn multiple Big Ten Weekly Awards in a single season.

JANIK JAMS

After being held hitless during the Southern Indiana series, Camden Janik responded in a big way last week, going 8-for-18 (.444) with six runs, a double, triple, home run and five RBI, reaching base at a .500 clip and slugging .778.

Janik went 3-for-5 vs. Bradley on March 19, falling just a double shy of hitting for the cycle. Over the weekend at Indiana, the junior slashed .385/.467/.462, posting a season-high four-hits in Sunday's series finale.

The Wauconda, Ill., native, leads the Illini with nine multi-hit performances this season and also leads the squad in average (.341), hits (29) and doubles (6).

Janik is also one of the toughest outs in the country, striking out just five times in 85 at-bats. His K AVG. of 17.0 ranks 12th in the nation. His five strikeouts are also the third-fewest among batters that have taken at least 85 at-bats this season.

CROWDER SHINES

Jack Crowder was one against sharp on the mound, earning the win in Friday's series opener vs. Indiana by allowing just one run on two hits over 5.0 innings of work, striking out six.

In his last two starts, Crowder has gone 1-0 with a 1.50 ERA (2 ER/12.0 IP) to go along with 11 strikeouts and four walks. The senior has also allowed just six hits during that span.

Crowder leads the Orange and Blue pitching staff with 33 strikeouts this season, which also ranks T-11th among Big Ten arms.

MO TO THE MOON

Ryan Moerman showcased his power on Sunday at Indiana, homering twice and driving in five runs. It was his first multi-home run game of the season and the second such performance in his career.

Moerman is now up to six home runs on the season, which ties him with Drake Westcott for the team lead and also ranks tied-for-third among Big Ten batters.

MARK ALLEN TAKING HEALTH-RELATED LEAVE

It was announced on Friday that pitching coach Mark Allen would be taking a temporary health-related leave from coaching.

"I will be taking a temporary leave from coaching to focus on my health," Allen said. "Earlier this month, I was diagnosed with cancer and have begun treatments that will keep me away from baseball. It will be extremely difficult to be away from the team right now, but it will be important to stay focused on my health. I will remain in communication with our coaching staff and pitchers as much as possible while away. Thank you to my wife Angela, my daughters Skylar and Avery, Coach Hartleb, and our entire staff for their support."



GAME NOTES

Allen is in his fifth season as Illinois' pitching coach in 2024. He joined the Fighting Illini in October 2019 after nine seasons in professional baseball, including serving as the San Francisco Giants' pitching coordinator during the 2019 season.

Allen has totaled over 25 years of coaching and scouting experience in collegiate and professional baseball.

UN-HUTCH-ABLE

Peyton Hutchings was nearly untouchable in his relief outing on March 19 vs. Bradley, striking out six of the seven batters he faced, allowing just one hit. The junior struck out the first four batters he faced before allowing the hit.

The 2.1 innings is a season-high mark for Hutchings, while the six strikeouts set a career high.

CLOSE CALLS

The Illini won by two runs on March 19, improving to 3-0 in two-run games this season. Illinois also won a pair of one-run games over Southern Indiana from March 15-17 and are now 2-2 in one-run contests. The Orange and Blue are 5-2 in games decided by two runs or fewer this season.

WALK IT OFF

The Fighting Illini earned their first walk-off win of the season on March 15, scoring twice with two outs in the ninth to take the series opener vs. Southern Indiana. Ryan Moerman tied the game on a passed ball and Cameron Chee-Aloy plated Christian Smith with a single to win it.

Illinois had two walk-off victories last season, the most recent being May 5, 2023, vs. Michigan State.

QUICK START

Illinois scored four times in the first inning on Sunday at Indiana, the third time in the last six games that the Illini have put runs on the board their first time up to bat and the ninth time overall this season.

The first inning is Illinois joint-highest scoring frame, where the offense has scored 24 of its 131 runs this season.

GOOD OMANS

Cooper Omans turned in the first quality start of his Illinois career on March 12, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one run, unearned, on three hits to go along with a career-high 10 strikeouts.

Omans became the third Illini pitcher to record a quality start this season. In his four starts this season, the Oviedo, Fla., native, has gone 2-1 with a 2.70 ERA (6 ER, 20.0 IP) and has amassed 21 strikeouts.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Fighting Illini won their home opener 12-2 over Eastern Illinois at Illinois Field on Feb. 27. Illinois is now 8-3 in its last 11 home openers and the 12 runs scored are the most since also scoring 12 in the 2021 home opener vs. Northwestern.

BACKSIDE DIESEL

INF Drake Westcott homered twice on Feb. 27 vs. Eastern Illinois, his first multi-homer game of the season.

Westcott had three such performances in 2023, including back-to-back multi-home run games against Michigan State on May 6 (3) and May 7 (2).

Two of the Edwardsville, Ill., native's big flies this season have gone to the opposite field. Westcott hit eight of his 18 dingers last season the opposite way.

FOUR IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

Illinois slugged four home runs on Feb. 27 vs. Eastern Illinois, a season-high mark. The Illini had eight such games last season, going 7-1 in those contests. Since 2018, Illinois is 12-2 when they hit at least four homers in a single game.

BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK

In the first inning of the game at No. 25 Coastal Carolina on Feb. 23, INF Coltin Quagliano, INF Drake Westcott and OF Ryan Moerman all homered in consecutive at-bats. They became the first set of Illini to slug back-to-back-to-back home runs since April 24, 1998.

FEELING THE CHEE-SIEST

OF Cameron Chee-Aloy had a big first weekend in the Orange and Blue, going 4-for-13 (.308) with six runs scored, three home runs, six RBI and two walks from Feb. 16-18.

» Had a pair of go-ahead two-run homers during the doubleheader against Akron on Feb. 16...the first of his career in the opener proved to be the game winner.

While Chee-Aloy's eight-game hitting streak came to an end on March 2 vs. Western Michigan, the freshman reached safely four times in the ballgame (2 BB, 2 HBP) and has reached base safely in 19 of 20 games this season.

The Toronto native also put together a big series in his Big Ten debut this past weekend, going 5-for-13 with five runs, a double and three walks. He reached base at a .500 clip and slugged .462. He set a new career high with three walks on Friday and matched a career high with three hits on Sunday.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

Illinois got two quality starts during the opening weekend, with RHP Jack Crowder picking up the first of his season in game one of the doubleheader vs. Akron on Feb. 16 and LHP Regan Hall recording the first one of his career on Feb. 18 vs. Fordham.

Crowder did not factor into the decision but went on to strikeout nine over 6.0 innings, allowing one run on three hits in the Illini's season-opening victory.

Hall turned in a stellar collegiate debut, as the freshman earned the first win of his career by holding the Rams to just one run on the three hits in 6.0 innings, punching out nine along the way. Hall retired 14 of the final 16 batters he faced.

OPENING DAY HISTORY

After defeat Akron to opening the campaign, Illinois is now 6-2 in their last eight season openers...the Illini snapped a brief two-game losing streak in curtain raisers in their 9-6 victory over Youngstown State in 2023.

DAN HARTLEB, THE WINNINGEST COACH AT ILLINOIS

Illinois head coach Dan Hartleb earned win No. 519 on April 2, 2023, against Michigan, passing Lee Eilbracht for the most in program history...currently has 541 career wins.

THEY HAVE THE POWER

Illinois batters slugged a total of 89 home runs last season, falling just two dingers shy of matching the program record of 91, set in 1998.

» The Illini return 72 percent (64/89) of their home run production to the team this year.

» Slugged a program-record 46 home runs during Big Ten play last season.

» INF Drake Westcott crushed a team-leading 18 home runs in 2023, becoming the first Illini to hit at least 18 in single season since Bren Spillane in 2018.
