LEADING OFF

- University of Missouri baseball concludes a four-game road trip Tuesday (April 16) with a 6:30 p.m. nonconference matchup against in-state rival **Missouri State** at Hammons Field in Springfield.
- Tuesday's contest will be the first of two meetings for Mizzou and MO State, with the two clubs squaring off again next Tuesday (April 23) at Taylor Stadium in Columbia.
- Mizzou brings a narrow 32-31 series edge over the Bears into Tuesday's matchup; MSU holds a 17-12 advantage in games played on its home field, however.
- The Tigers are coming off a weekend trip to Athens, where they rallied from early deficits in all three contests against Georgia, claiming a 6-5 victory in 10 innings Friday for their lone win of the series.
- Matt Garcia** led the Tigers in nearly every offensive category last week, including hitting (.471), slugging (.824) and OBP (.526); he also posted a Mizzou career best with four hits in MU's series opener at Georgia (April 11).
- Missouri State dropped two of three Missouri Valley Conference games to UIC in Springfield over the weekend; the Bears put up 17 runs in a series-opening victory, before the Flames rallied for wins in the final two contests of the series.

MIZZOU MOMENT

April 16, 2019...Mizzou opened a four-game road trip with a convincing 14-6 victory over Missouri State in Springfield, running their series win streak to three in a row versus the Bears.

Mizzou continued a dominant midweek performance in 2019, improving to 8-0 in Tuesday contests. The Tigers were clicking on all cylinders against MSU, posting double-digit runs for the 16th time in 2019 and recording 10-plus strikeouts on the mound for the 26th time.

The Tigers, who led by as many as 12 runs, homered three times, using long balls from **Cameron Swanger**, **Clayton Peterson** and **Connor Brumfield** to improve to 12-1 overall in midweek competition.

SERIES HISTORY

- Missouri brings a 32-31 all-time series edge over Missouri State into Tuesday's game.
- The Tigers claimed both meetings with the Bears last spring, including a 10-1 rout of MSU at Hammons Field (April 11) and a 7-6 walk-off victory in Columbia (April 18).
- The Bears hold a 17-12 home-field advantage in the series, despite the Tigers taking three of the last four contests played in Springfield.
- Mizzou has won seven of the last nine meetings overall since 2018.

- Every Missouri baseball game in 2024 will be produced by the **Tiger Radio Network** and broadcast live via the **Varsity Network** app.
- Tuesday's game will be streamed live on **ESPN+**, with Don West and Mike McClure calling the action.

SCOUTING MISSOURI

- Missouri posted a 30-24 regular-season finish last spring, including a 10-20 SEC mark.
- Kerrick Jackson** was named the 15th head coach in Mizzou history in June, returning to Columbia to lead a program for which he served as an assistant coach from 2011-15 under Mizzou Hall of Fame head coach (and current pitching coach) **Tim Jamieson**.
- The Tigers return three regular starters from last season, led by senior INF **Trevor Austin**, who batted .311 with eight homers and 10 steals to help bolster the MU offense.
- Senior INF **Matt Garcia** turned in a solid debut season with the Tigers, providing clutch hitting and lock-down defense on the MU infield.
- Additionally, junior INF **Justin Colon** returns for Mizzou and earning significant playing time on the Tigers' infield over the last two seasons.
- MU should also receive a lift from sophomore INF **Jackson Lovich** and junior OF **Juju Stevens**, who each made key contributions in limited duty in 2023.
- Several newcomers could also make early contributions, including junior INF **Danny Corona**, who helped Wake Forest to a 2023 College World Series berth, C **Jedier Hernandez**, a standout behind the plate for Seton Hall the last two seasons, and sophomore OF **Jerik Curtis**, a Texas Tech transfer who brings significant speed to the Tiger outfield.
- On the mound, sophomore RHP **Logan Lunceford** is back to help anchor Mizzou's weekend rotation after posting 68 strikeouts to lead all SEC freshman hurlers last spring.
- Junior LHP **Javyn Pimental** also contributed mightily to the Tigers' mound efforts in 2023, making eight starts for the Tigers.
- Mizzou should also benefit from the potential return of a pair of veterans who missed significant time last spring; LHP **Ian Lohse** and RHP **Carter Rustad** missed significant portions of 2023 due to injury following promising starts to the campaign.
- New arms like RHP **Josh McDevitt** and RHP **Bryce Mayer** could compete for starting rotation spots, while RHP **Jacob Peaden** may give the back end of the Tigers' bullpen a strong presence.

MIZZOU BY THE NUMBERS

- 1B **Jackson Lovich** leads the Tigers with a .377 batting average in nonconference play.
- The sophomore recorded a career-best 13-game hit streak, February 24-March 15, batting .388 (19-for-49).
- Lovich leads the SEC and ranks 41st nationally with three triples.
- OF **Jackson Beaman** has been the Tigers' biggest threat at the plate in nonconference play, batting .412 and slugging .912 to pace the offense.
- C **Jedier Hernandez** paces the Missouri offense with a .293 overall batting average; the junior catcher also leads the club with a .288 mark in SEC play.
- Hernandez played a pivotal role in MU's series sweep of No. 6 Florida (April 5-7), hitting a club-best .417 with key RBIs in each of the three games.
- Hernandez drove in the game-winning run in the 11th inning of game one vs. UF, then brought home the tying run in the sixth inning of MU's 4-3 win in game two.
- As a team, the Tigers are hitting .288 and averaging 8.1 runs per contest in nonconference action.
- INF **Brock Daniels** has been Mizzou's hottest hitter in the month of April, batting .429 (15-of-35) with 17 RBIs and five steals in nine games this month.
- Daniels went a combined 5-for-7 (.714) with two homers and nine RBIs, nearly tripling his career RBI total, in the Tigers' two-game sweep of UT Martin (April 2-3).
- Daniels also owns the Tigers' best road batting mark this spring, bringing a .308 average — as well as a team-best .462 slugging percentage — in eight road contests into play Tuesday.
- INF **Matt Garcia** turned in his best weekend of SEC play to date at Georgia (April 11-13), leading the Tigers with a .500 batting average, including a career-best four-hit performance Thursday night in the series opener.
- Garcia drove in a pair of runs in that contest, then went 2-for-5 with three RBIs in the finale on Saturday, belting his first home run of the season as well.
- For the week, Garcia went 8-of-17 (.474) with a .824 slugging percentage.
- OF **Jerik Curtis** also turned in a big weekend in Athens, hitting .333 for the series, with a career-best three hits in Saturday's finale.
- Curtis swiped two bases to run his season total to 14 bags, which ranks sixth overall in the SEC.
- As a team, Mizzou stole five bases in back-to-back games vs. UT Martin (April 2-3), achieving the feat for the first time since April 11, 2023 vs. Missouri State.
- The Tigers rank fourth in the conference in stolen bases (51).
- INF **Trevor Austin** leads the club with nine home runs, topping his previous season high (2023) with a three-run blast in Friday's 6-5 win over Georgia while hiking his career total to 25 round-trippers.
- LHP **Ryan Magdic** has proven to be a valuable weapon out of the bullpen, including a dominant 3.1 inning stint to lift Mizzou to a 6-5 win over Georgia in 10 innings on Friday.
- Magdic fanned a career-best eight hitters and struck out the side in two different innings late in the game.
- The graduate transfer picked up his first save as a Tiger in MU's 4-3 win over No. 6 Florida on April 6.
- As a team, Mizzou ranks sixth in the SEC in fielding double plays (20).
- Mizzou is hitting .294 as a team with two outs, logging 91 of its 203 RBIs on the year after the second out in an inning has been recorded.

SCOUTING MISSOURI STATE

- Led by 42nd-year head coach **Keith Guttin**, the Bears enter the week 15-19 overall after dropping two of three Missouri Valley Conference contests to UIC over the weekend.
- The Bears are hitting .273 as a team, led by former Tiger C **Dylan Leach's** .333 average.
- Sophomore OF **Zack Stewart** paces the offense with 14 home runs and 33 RBIs. OF **Caden Bogenpohl** has added 13 round-trippers for the Bears, who have clubbed 61 homers through just 34 contests.
- On the mound, RHP **Brandt Thompson** heads the weekend rotation with his 5-0 season mark and 2.35 ERA. RHP **Kaleb Thomas** and RHP **Hunter Day** have been MSU's most consistent weapons out of the bullpen, logging a combined 27 appearances and 52.2 total innings.

HOW SWEEP IT IS

- Mizzou completed its second SEC series sweep of a top 10 conference foe in as many seasons, securing its first-ever sweep of No. 6 Florida (April 5-7).
- The Tigers, who also swept Georgia (May 12-14) and No. 4 Tennessee at Taylor Stadium (March 17-19) last spring, logged three consecutive one-run victories over the Gators.
- Mizzou pitching limited a potent UF lineup to a .196 batting mark for the series.
- RHP **Logan Lunceford** turned in 6.0 shutout innings in the opener, holding the Gators to a single hit, while combining with RHP **Carter Rustad** on a two-hit, 2-1 victory in 11 innings.
- The Tigers fanned a season-high 14 hitters in the series finale and averaged 12.0 strikeouts per game for the series.
- At the plate, C **Jedier Hernandez** turned in a series to remember, hitting a club-best .417 while driving in key runs in each victory. He plated the game-winning run on an 11th inning single in the opener, brought home the tying run in the sixth inning of game two, then drove home two more runs in the finale.

NON-CON DOMINATION

- Mizzou has claimed 11 nonconference victories over the first nine weeks of the season, continuing a string of recent dominance in nonconference play.
- MU logged a 20-3 mark against non-SEC foes last spring, after going 18-3 in nonconference in 2022.
- MU has an overall mark of 49-16 in non-SEC competition since the start of the 2022 season.
- Over the last decade, the Tigers' dominance has been equally impressive, with MU winning 100 more nonconference games than it has lost (176-76).

RANK AND FILE

- With their three wins over sixth-ranked Florida, the Tigers can now boast of four total SEC wins over ranked opponents this season.
- Mizzou notched its first win over a top 25 foe March 23 with a 2-1 victory over No. 21 Kentucky.
- The victory over UK also marked head coach **Kerrick Jackson's** first conference win — as well as the first SEC win for a Black head coach in the circuit's history.
- Mizzou recorded seven wins over ranked opponents last season, but suffered 18 of its 24 overall losses against ranked clubs.
- This year, the Tigers could face as many as nine ranked SEC foes in weekend series, as each of their scheduled league opponents have spent time in at least one top 25 poll this spring.

TERRIFIC WITH TWO

- The Tigers have been clutch this season with two out, both at the plate and on the mound.
- Mizzou's offense has recorded 91 two-out RBIs in just 37 games, while hitting .294 (129-for-439) after the second out has been recorded in an inning.
- This past weekend at Georgia, the Tigers hit .325 (13-for-40) with two out, producing 11 RBIs.
- Against vs. No. 6 Florida, Mizzou recorded eight two-out RBIs, including all four of its runs in its game two victory (April 6).
- Brock Daniels** and **Jackson Beaman** have been MU's most consistent two-out threats, hitting .556 (10-for-18) and .409 (9-for-22) in such situations, respectively.
- Mizzou pitchers have been equally dominant, holding the opposition to a collective .211 (85-for-403) two-out batting average.
- Brock Lucas** has allowed just one two-out hit in 28 official at-bats. **Ryan Magdic** has been nearly flawless as well, limiting MU's opponents to just three hits in 23 two-out at-bats (.130).

CAN'T SLOW OUR ROLL

- In the Tigers' 16 wins this season, MU baserunners have been successful on 30-of-33 steal attempts.
- Mizzou posted five stolen bases each of its two wins over UT Martin (April 2-3), going 10-for-10 in steal attempts against the Skyhawks.
- The Tigers' last five-steal performance came on April 11, 2023 at Missouri State.
- INF **Brock Daniels** was a perfect 5-of-5 in steal attempts the week of April 2-7, including the first three-steal effort by a Tiger since 2022.
- For the season, Mizzou ranks fourth in the SEC with 51 steals (in 61 attempts) this season.
- OF **Jeric Curtis** leads the Tigers with 14 steals, which is good for sixth overall in the SEC.

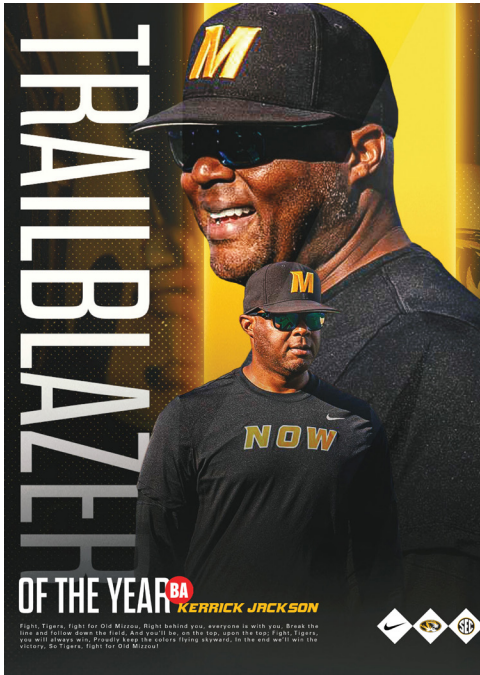

A HUB FOR MID-MISSOURI

- The University of Missouri generates \$5 billion in economic impact for the state of Missouri.
- The larger University of Missouri System, comprised of four universities, generated \$6.5 billion in economic impact on the Show Me State.
- The University of Missouri supports nearly 50,000 direct and indirect jobs, both full and part time, in the state.
- Mizzou Athletics generated \$319.1 million in economic impact over the last fiscal year.
- The Tigers support and sustain 3,591 jobs annually.
- Mizzou Athletics has generated \$15.9 million in state and local taxes.



TIGER TRAILBLAZER

- **Kerrick Jackson** has already enjoyed a personal moment of 'NOW' as the St. Louis product became the first Black head coach in SEC history with his appointment to the Tigers' top job.
- Jackson, who recorded the first SEC victory for a Black head coach with MU's March 23 win over No. 21 Kentucky, also picked up a significant honor from *Baseball America* in December, earning the publication's 2023 Trailblazer of the Year honor.
- Jackson has left his mark in just four seasons as a Division I head coach, including leading Southern to the 2019 Southwestern Athletic Conference crown and an NCAA Regional berth, as well as guiding Memphis to its first winning season in six years last spring.
- Additionally, Jackson has impacted the college baseball landscape through his work on the American Baseball Coaches Association's Diversity in Baseball Committee, a body for which he has served as chairman since its creation in 2018. The council works to improve diversity in the coaching ranks through a professional development program and an increased focus on youth baseball.

GOING STREAKING

- Mizzou ran its win streak to five straight games with its third consecutive win over Florida on April 7.
- In going 5-0 the week of April 2-7, the Tigers put together their longest win streak since claiming six in a row, March 12-22, 2023.
- INF **Brock Daniels** was MU's top offensive threat during the five-game stretch, batting .474 with 10 RBIs and five steals.
- INF **Trevor Austin** was a thorn in the opposition's side as well, scoring 10 times after posting a .600 on-base percentage and recording at least one hit in each game.
- The Tigers were lethal on the basepaths, going 14-for-14 in steal attempts.
- On the mound, MU fanned 59 batters in five games, reaching double-figure strikeout totals in four of those, including a season-best 14 K's April 7 vs. Florida.
- Like Austin, OF **Jeric Curtis** logged a hit in all five games last week, including three consecutive two-hit performances (April 2-5). The sophomore went 4-for-9 with two steals and four runs scored in MU's two-game sweep of UT Martin (April 2-3).

IN THE 'NOW'

- New Tiger bench boss **Kerrick Jackson** has undertaken the challenge of revitalizing Missouri's tradition-rich program, part of which has included a re-branding of sorts.
- Casual observers of any number of Mizzou's fall or preseason workouts will undoubtedly have taken note of a new and unique slogan around Taylor Stadium. Jackson and his staff introduced the **#MizzouNOW** branding — an acronym for No Opportunity Wasted — providing his student-athletes an entirely new way of approaching the game and the way they go about working to achieve their common goal of returning Mizzou to national prominence.
- **#MizzouNOW** was developed with a focus on appreciating the present and working toward taking advantage the opportunities immediately in front of the Tigers.

TAYLOR TOMFOOLERY

- Mizzou has found the friendly confines of Taylor Stadium to its liking over a recent surge spanning the last seven home games of 2023 and its first 18 home contests of the new season.
- Over the 25-game stretch, Mizzou has scored in double-digits 12 times and registered at least 10 hits 14 times in going 16-9 at Taylor.
- The Tigers' three-game sweep of No. 6 Florida marked the most recent chapter in the Taylor Stadium lore. Mizzou also knocked off No. 21 Kentucky on March 23, which still represents UK's lone SEC loss of 2024.
- Additionally, MU swept Georgia (May 12-14, 2023) and took two of three conference games from Ole Miss (May 6-8, 2023), giving the Tigers a 9-3 SEC home record in their last four league series at Taylor.
- 2B **Trevor Austin** has been the key linchpin in the Tigers' power surge at Taylor, clubbing eight of MU's 48 home runs over the 25-game span.

LIGHTS-OUT LUCAS

- Sophomore RHP **Brock Lucas** saw his string of 11 1/3 consecutive scoreless innings come to an end April 6 vs. Florida.
- Lucas turned in four straight scoreless relief outings from March 17-April 2.
- The St. Elizabeth, Mo., product most recently logged a pair of 4.0-plus inning efforts out of the MU bullpen, including a 4 1/3 inning hitless stint vs. Kansas (March 19), and four additional scoreless frames, allowing just one hit, against Kentucky (March 24).
- For the season, Lucas has compiled a club-best 2.45 ERA, while holding the opposition to a .194 average.
- In his 10 games, Lucas has logged six scoreless outings, including three extending at least 4.0 frames.

SEC MOUND MASTERY

- The Mizzou pitching staff has met the challenge of SEC play, logging a team ERA of 3.84 over a nine-game stretch, March 22-April 7.
- Against three ranked opponents (Kentucky, Vanderbilt and Florida), the Tigers have limited the opposition to .223 hitting and an average of just 4.6 runs per game over the nine-game stretch.
- Mizzou's three weekend starting pitchers — RHP **Logan Luncford**, LHP **Javy Pimental** and RHP **Carter Rustad** — combined to hold the opposition to 20 earned runs over their 48.0 total innings, while striking out 42 hitters.
- Additionally, the MU bullpen was equally as effective, holding the Wildcats and Commodores to a .211 average.
- RHP **Bryce Mayer** has turned in 5.1 scoreless innings, combining with LHP **Daniel Wissler**, LHP **Ryan Magdic** and RHP **Victor Quinn** for 12.0 scoreless frames of relief work.

TARGET: TREVOR

- INF **Trevor Austin** has made a habit of reaching base throughout his four-year career with the Tigers, particularly when it comes to serving as a target, logging 42 free bases due to hit by pitches.
- Austin, the SEC's active leader in HBPs, was hit by a pitch three times during Mizzou's most recent home stand, running his 2024 total to 13 HBPs, which ranks second in the SEC.
- As a result, the Jefferson City native has climbed to fourth on Mizzou's career HBP chart, passing **Brock Bond** and **Dane Opel** on March 5.
- Austin is one HBP away from matching **Jacob Priday's** career total of 43 in the No. 3 position.
- **John McKee** (2004-07) owns the Tigers' all-time mark of 70 HBPs, and **John Hay** (1989-93) ranks second with 51 HBPs.

PRIMETIME PIMENTAL

- Junior LHP **Javy Pimental** has been one of the Tigers' key linchpins on the mound through the first nine weeks of the season as well, bringing a .219 batting average against into the week.
- Pimental registered dominant starts against top 25 teams in three straight weekend starts to open SEC play; the lefty notched his first victory of the season with 6.0 strong innings vs. No. 21 Kentucky (March 23), allowing just one run on four hits while fanning five; the previous week, he held No. 1 Arkansas hitless through four innings and posted 5.0 scoreless frames overall before yielding to his bullpen.
- For the season, the Hawaii native has fanned 39 batters — a single-season best for the junior — in 36.0 innings spanning eight total appearances.

LOVIN' LOVICH

- 1B **Jackson Lovich** returned from a two-week absence due to injury April 5 vs. Florida.
- Lovich went 2-for-4 in his first game back, doubling in the 11th inning to spark the Tigers' game-winning rally.
- The sophomore saw his career-best 13-game hit come to an end March 16 at No. 1 Arkansas.
- The Overland Park, Kan., product batted .388 (19-for-49) with four of his five home runs on the season and 15 RBIs during his streak, which ran from February 24 through March 15.
- Lovich has slugged .556 for the season and reached base safely via a hit or walk in the Tigers' first 18 contests (also through March 15).
- He currently owns the top spot on the SEC leaderboard for triples (3), despite missing eight contests due to injury.

SHOW-ME STATE TO THE SHOW

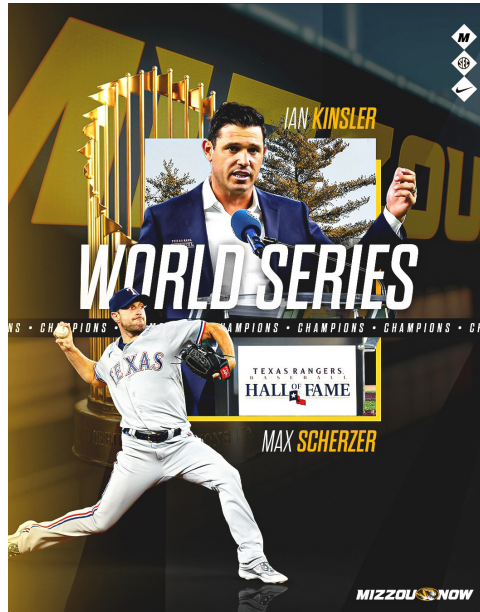
- Major League Baseball's 2024 Opening Day saw four former Missouri baseball standouts on 40-man big league rosters earlier this month.
- Tiger legend RHP **Max Scherzer** begins his 17th Major League season on the Texas Rangers' 15-day IL due to offseason surgery, but could return to the reigning World Series champs earlier than originally expected.
- Scherzer claimed his second World Series title last fall, helping the Rangers to their first world championship in a five-game series with Arizona.
- Mizzou Athletics Hall of Famer RHP **Kyle Gibson** begins his first season with the St. Louis Cardinals after helping his former club, Baltimore, capture an AL East Division title last season.
- Gibson, a 2009 first-round MLB Draft selection, brought a 104-100 career big league mound mark into the 2024 season. The right-hander is also a three-time MLB Roberto Clemente Award nominee.
- RHP **Tanner Houck** was named to the Boston Red Sox Opening Day roster, marking the beginning of the former Tiger hurler's fourth season in The Show.
- Houck, a 2017 first-round pick of the Red Sox, won a career-high six games last season, one year after logging eight saves and a 3.15 ERA for Boston.
- RHP **Pete Fairbanks** also earned an Opening Day roster spot and will once again help anchor the Tampa Bay Rays bullpen.
- Fairbanks, a ninth-round choice of the Rangers in 2015, logged a career-best 49 relief appearances in 2023, posting a 2.58 ERA and 25 saves — the most MLB saves in a season by a Mizzou alum.
- The right-hander's 43 career saves also mark an all-time MLB high for a Missouri baseball product.

TIGER KINGS

- Speaking of **Max Scherzer**, the three-time Cy Young Award winner became the fourth Tiger to earn multiple World Series championships as an active player last fall, adding to his 2019 title with Washington.
- Another former Mizzou stalwart, Rangers special assistant to the G.M. **Ian Kinsler** (2003), also claimed his second World Series ring with the victory, following his first title as an active player with Boston in 2018.
- In all, eight Mizzou baseball alums have won World Series titles as players: in addition to Kinsler (2018) and Scherzer (2019 and 2023), **Homer Summa** (1929 and 1930), **Darold Knowles** (1973 and 1974), **Mike Shannon** (1964 and 1967), **Glenn Wright** (1925), **Charlie James** (1964) and **Tim Laudner** (1987) also claimed Fall Classics during their respective big league careers.

WELCOME WAGON

- Twenty different players have made their Mizzou debuts over the first nine weeks of the season.
- In the Tigers season opener at Cal Poly, seven newcomers found their names in the lineup: RHP **Bryce Mayer**, 3B **Danny Corona**, C **Jedier Hernandez**, DH **Thomas Curry**, CF **Jeric Curtis**, SS **Drew Culbertson** and LF **Tucker Moore**.
- On the mound, several new faces contributed to the Tigers' series win, with LHP **Ryan Magdic** and RHP **Jacob Peaden** combining for 4.0 hitless innings of relief in a 3-1 victory, while RHP **Charlie Miller** and C **Mateo Serna** also saw action in game three.
- The followin week, OF **Kaden Peer** made a pair of starts in the outfield, while RHP **Kaden Jacobi**, RHP **Victor Quinn** and RHP **Josh McDevitt** all made their first appearances for the Tigers in San Diego.
- On MU's initial home stand, four more newcomers have introduced themselves to the Mizzou faithful: RHP **Miles Garrett** made his debut vs. SEMO, before RHP **Xavier Lovett** and OF **RJ Jimerson** made their first appearances vs. NKU (March 2) and RHP **Ben Smith** worked an inning in the series finale with PFW.
- Finally, INF **Jack Holubowski** made his Mizzou debut March 26 against Illinois, starting at first base for the Tigers.

**FRESH LOOK**

- Mizzou has received contributions from up and down its roster, but the Tigers' talented crop of freshmen have been perhaps their most consistent performers.
- MU's four primary freshman position players — SS **Drew Culbertson**, DH **Thomas Curry**, OF **Tucker Moore** and OF **Kaden Peer** — each rank among the Tigers' top offensive contributors.
- Culbertson has logged six multi-hit outings to date, swiping nine bases (in 10 attempts), while making 27 starts for the Tigers.
- Moore has spent time in the leadoff spot in the MU batting order, recording four multi-hit performances and reaching base safely in 19 of his 26 games.
- Curry has hit four homers and notched five multi-RBI efforts, while drawing 16 walks.
- Peer has heated up as well, registering hits in 10 of his last 16 games, including a pair of home runs over the last two weeks.
- Additionally, C **Mateo Serna** has contributed at the plate, driving in three runs in MU's March 5 victory over Lindenwood.

MIZZOU MILESTONES

- Several Tigers have reached or are approaching significant career milestones this season.
- Mizzou's April 2 contest with UT Martin marked **Kerrick Jackson's** 200th career game as a Division I head coach.
- INF **Danny Corona** recorded the 100th hit of his collegiate career March 19 vs. Kansas at Kauffman Stadium.
- INF **Trevor Austin** sits atop the Tigers' leaderboard for career hits among active players with 144.
- Austin, who played in his 150th career game April 7 vs. Florida, ranks fourth all-time at Mizzou in HBP (42) to go along with his 25 career homers, the latter of which is just seven shy of cracking the Tigers' all-time top 10 list.
- RHP **Logan Lunceford** surpassed the 100-strikeout milestone for his career this past weekend at Georgia; the sophomore enters the week with 103 punchouts to his credit.
- LHP **Ian Lohse** enters the week within striking distance of the 100-K plateau as well with 93 K's on his resume.
- C **Jedier Hernandez's** game-winning hit vs. Florida on April 5 marked the 100th hit of his collegiate career.

NOW THAT'S A RALLY

- Mizzou utilized a first-inning rally of historic proportions to log its first home victory of 2024 — a 28-10 rout of Northern Kentucky (March 2).

- The Tigers sent 17 batters to the plate in scoring 14 runs in the first inning, marking their biggest inning since a 17-run rally vs. Texas Tech on April 1, 2005.
- In that 25-0 win over Texas Tech, current Tiger assistant coach **Bryson LeBlanc** factored prominently in the Tigers' key rally, walking twice and scoring before grounding out in a second inning that saw 23 MU hitters come to the plate.

COMING HOME

- Head coach **Kerrick Jackson** did not have to look far when adding the initial pieces of his Mizzou coaching staff. He selected former Tiger head coach **Tim Jamieson** for his pitching coach, completing a homecoming for the Mizzou Athletics Hall of Famer.
- Jamieson brings 28 years of experience on the MU campus into his new role as the Tigers pitching coach.
- In 22 seasons as Mizzou's head baseball coach, Jamieson led the Tigers to 698 wins, trailing only **Gene McArtor** (733) on MU's coaching wins list.
- He coached eight All-Americans at Mizzou and saw 75 of his players drafted, including 19 Major Leaguers.
- Jamieson returns to his hometown of Columbia after serving as pitching coach under Jackson in his lone season at Memphis, where the duo helped lead the Tigers to their first winning season since 2017.
- Prior to his stop at UM, Jamieson spent three seasons (2020-22) as pitching coach at Southern Illinois, helping the Salukis compile a 96-42 record.
- Jamieson garnered 1996 Big 8 Coach of the Year and 2007 Big 12 Co-Coach of the Year honors, as his Missouri teams won 35 games or more nine times during his head coaching career.
- He led Mizzou to seven consecutive NCAA postseason appearances from 2003 to 2009, including the program's first Super Regional berth in 2006. He was also selected to lead USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team as head coach in 2011.
- Jamieson, a graduate of Columbia Rock Bridge High School, is married to a Mizzou graduate, the former Cindy Thornton.

SPEAKING OF HOMECOMINGS...

- Another new Mizzou assistant coach (and former Tiger) is making a return to his old stomping grounds. **Bryson LeBlanc** joined Jamieson on **Kerrick Jackson's** first MU staff after spending five seasons on the coaching staff at UC San Diego.
- LeBlanc, who was named one of D1Baseball.com's picks for its '100 Assistant Coaches Athletic Directors Should Know' list this past fall, patrolled the MU outfield for Jamieson on the previously mentioned 2006 Regional-winning club.
- He helped guide UC San Diego through its transition to the NCAA Division I level, including a 34-18 campaign last spring that culminated in the program's first Big West Conference title.
- In all, 46 of LeBlanc's former players have been selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 who have been taken in the top 10 rounds. Six of those have advanced to the big leagues.

HALL WORTHY

- Even before his return as a member of the Tigers' new coaching staff, **Tim Jamieson** knew he'd be making a trip to Columbia in 2023 after his selection for induction to the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletics Hall of Fame in late May.
- Jamieson became the fourth former Tiger head baseball coach to be tabbed for Mizzou's highest athletic honor, joining **Don Faurot**, **John 'Hi' Simmons** and **Gene McArtor**.
- Jamieson took the Tigers to a Big Eight Conference championship in 1996, completing a worst-to-first turnaround — the first in Big Eight history — and in 2012 the Tigers won the Big 12 Conference Tournament title.
- Overall, he took nine teams to the NCAA Tournament, including seven straight appearances from 2003-09 and a Super Regional trip in 2006.

KERRICK JACKSON

FIRST YEAR • NEBRASKA '99

A veteran coach with experience at all levels of baseball, **Kerrick Jackson** was tabbed as Missouri's 15th head coach in June 2023.

Since that time, Jackson has undertaken the challenge of revitalizing the Tigers' tradition-rich program. These efforts have included hiring a diverse staff, recruiting a new-look roster and providing his pupils an entirely new way of approaching the game—and the way they go about working to achieve their common goal of returning Mizzou to national prominence.

While the work is well underway, Jackson will officially become the first Black Southeastern Conference head baseball coach to lead his team into action when the Tigers open their 2024 campaign in February. Furthermore, he will be just the fourth Black collegiate coach to guide a Power Five baseball program and the first to do so since the 2021 season.

In recognition of these efforts, *Baseball America* named Jackson its 2023 Trailblazer of the Year in December, capping an already historic year for the new Mizzou coach.

In addition to his success on the diamond as a collegiate coach, including leading Southern University to the 2019 Southwestern Athletic Conference crown and an NCAA Regional berth and guiding the University of Memphis to its first winning season in six years last spring, Jackson continues to serve as a relentless advocate for minorities in college baseball, especially in the coaching ranks. He helped form the American Baseball Coaches Association's Diversity in Baseball Committee and has served as its chairman since its creation in 2018. That body works to improve diversity in the coaching ranks through a professional development program and an increased focus on youth baseball.

Jackson returned to Columbia after having served as a Mizzou assistant from 2011-15. Known as a developer of players, a tireless recruiter, and a strong talent evaluator, Jackson is a well-respected leader in baseball circles, serving on the American Baseball Coaches Association Board of Directors and as chair of their Diversity in Baseball committee.

Prior to his season at Memphis, Jackson was the President of the MLB Draft League from 2020-22, a six-team summer baseball league sponsored by Major League Baseball and featuring a split-season amateur-professional format.

Jackson served as the head coach at Southern University from 2018-20, where he took a nine-win team in 2018 to 32 wins, a conference championship, and the NCAA Tournament the following season, earning SWAC and Louisiana Sports Writers Association Coach of the Year accolades. His 2018 Jaguar team boasted the athletic department's highest men's team GPA and received national recognition for its community service efforts.

Jackson worked for the Boras Corporation as a certified player agent for two years from 2016-17, where he identified prep and college players with the best chance to develop into Major League talent.

He served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Mizzou from 2011-15, working with the Tigers' hitters, outfielders, and infielders. Mizzou made back-to-back trips to the Big 12 Conference Tournament Championship in 2011-12, culminating with the program's first Big 12 title in 2012. The Tigers had multiple nationally-ranked recruiting classes, including 24th in 2012, 12th in 2014 and a consensus Top-30 class in 2015.

Before heading to Missouri, Jackson served as the Midwest Area Scouting Supervisor for the Washington Nationals from 2008-10, overseeing Missouri, Kansas, Arkansas, Iowa, Nebraska and the Dakotas.

His other collegiate coaching stops include assistant stints at St. Louis Community College-Meramec (2008), Nicholls State (2006-07), Jefferson (Mo.) College (2004-05), Coffeyville (Kan.) Community College (2003),



Emporia State (2002) and Fairfield (2001). Jackson also has extensive experience in the summer collegiate leagues, as he has coached in the Cape Cod League and New England Collegiate Baseball League.

Jackson spent two years at St. Louis Community College-Meramec as a student-athlete, where the team finished third at the JUCO World Series in 1995. Following that, he played at Bethune-Cookman University in 1996, leading the squad to its first-ever conference championship and regional appearance. Jackson concluded his playing career at Nebraska in 1997, graduating in 1999 with a bachelor's degree in sociology.

Jackson and his wife, Talia, have two sons, Zion and Lazarus.
