- **University of Missouri** baseball closes out a four-game home stand with a nonconference matchup against **Missouri State** Tuesday (April 23) evening at Taylor Stadium.
- The Tigers are coming off a 2-2 week that included a road victory over MSU in Springfield last Tuesday, as well as their sixth one-run victory in SEC play with an 8-7 decision over defending national champion LSU on Saturday.
- **Brock Daniels** brings a nine-game hit streak into Tuesday's game and is hitting a club-best .420 (21-for-50) in the month of April.
- Mizzou has won the last three contests in its series with MSU and holds a 33-31 overall edge against the Bears.

MIZZOU MOMENT

April 27, 1983...In the two programs' first-ever meeting as NCAA Division I foes, Mizzou took down in-state rival Missouri State (then Southwest Missouri State), 1-0, as RHP **Greg Larsen** and LHP **Dave Otto** combined to blank the Bears in extra innings at Simmons Field.

The whitewashing marked the first of two straight shutout efforts by Larsen, who went on to fan nine Kansas State hitters in a complete-game, 10-0 rout of the Wildcats three days later to earn Big Eight Pitcher of the Week honors.

The victory also marked MU's first encounter with MSU's then-first-year head coach Keith Guttin, who has been at the helm for all but two of the Bears' 64 meetings with Mizzou entering Tuesday's game — his final scheduled matchup with the Tigers.

SERIES HISTORY

- Missouri brings a 33-31 all-time series edge over Missouri State into Tuesday's game.
- The Tigers notched a 6-2 victory last Tuesday in their first matchup of 2024 with the Bears in Springfield.
- Jackson Lovich** led the Missouri offense with a 3-for-5 performance that included a key RBI single as part of the Tigers' two-run first inning, as well as a seventh-inning home run that helped seal the win.
- Additionally, six Mizzou pitchers combined to limit the Bears to two runs, led by **Daniel Wissler's** strong 4 1/3 inning stint to open the contest.
- MU claimed both meetings with the Bears last spring, including a 10-1 rout of MSU at Hammons Field (April 11) and a 7-6 walk-off victory in Columbia (April 18).
- The Tigers hold a 19-14 edge in games played against the Bears in Columbia, including four wins in their last five meetings at Taylor Stadium, dating back to 2018.
- Mizzou has won eight of the last 10 meetings overall since 2018.
- Tigers head coach **Kerrick Jackson** is a perfect 1-0 in his career vs. Missouri State, which will be led for the final time in the rivalry by 42-year head coach Keith Guttin, who brings a 31-31 career coaching mark vs. Mizzou into the contest.

SCOUTING MISSOURI

- Missouri posted a 30-24 regular-season finish last spring, including a 10-20 SEC mark.
- Kerrick Jackson** was named the 15th head coach in Mizzou history in June, returning to Columbia to lead a program for which he served as an assistant coach from 2011-15 under Mizzou Hall of Fame head coach (and current pitching coach) **Tim Jamieson**.
- The Tigers return three regular starters from last season, led by senior 3B **Trevor Austin**, who batted .311 with eight homers and 10 steals to help bolster the MU offense.
- Senior 2B **Matt Garcia** turned in a solid debut season with the Tigers, providing clutch hitting and lock-down defense on the MU infield.
- MU should also receive a lift from sophomore 1B **Jackson Lovich** and junior OF **Juju Stevens**, who each made key contributions in limited duty in 2023.
- Several newcomers could also make early contributions, including junior INF **Danny Corona**, who helped Wake Forest to a 2023 College World Series berth, C **Jedier Hernandez**, a standout behind the plate for Seton Hall the last two seasons, and sophomore OF **Jerik Curtis**, a Texas Tech transfer who brings significant speed to the Tiger outfield.
- On the mound, sophomore RHP **Logan Lunceford** is back to help anchor Mizzou's weekend rotation after posting 68 strikeouts to lead all SEC freshman hurlers last spring.
- Junior LHP **Javyn Pimental** also contributed mightily

to the Tigers' mound efforts in 2023, making eight starts for the Tigers.

- Mizzou should also benefit from the potential return of veterans LHP **Ian Lohse** and RHP **Carter Rustad**, who missed significant portions of 2023 due to injury following promising starts to the campaign.
- New arms like RHP **Josh McDevitt** and RHP **Bryce Mayer** could compete for starting rotation spots, while RHP **Jacob Peaden** may give the back end of the Tigers' bullpen a strong presence.

MIZZOU BY THE NUMBERS

- 1B **Jackson Lovich** and 2B **Matt Garcia** share the SEC lead with three triples on the season.
- The Tigers' 10 triples this season rank second in the SEC.
- Lovich recorded a career-best 13-game hit streak, February 24-March 15, batting .388 (19-for-49).
- After a slow start to the conference season, Garcia has been red-hot in SEC play over the last two weekends, hitting a combined .435 (10-for-23) with six RBIs in the Tigers six contests against Georgia (April 11-13) and LSU (April 19-21).
- Garcia turned in his best weekend of SEC play to date at Georgia, leading the Tigers with a .500 batting average, including a career-best four-hit performance in the series opener; he drove in a pair of runs in that contest, then went 2-for-5 with three RBIs in the finale, belting his first home run of the season as well.
- For the week of April 8-14, Garcia went 8-of-17 (.474) with a .824 slugging percentage.
- INF **Bruck Daniels** has been Mizzou's hottest hitter in the month of April, batting .420 (21-of-50) with 19 RBIs and six steals in helping the Tigers go 8-5.
- Daniels, who ranks fourth in the SEC with four sacrifice flies on the season, brings a career-best nine-game hit streak into Tuesday's game. The sophomore from St. Louis has hit .417 (15-for-36) and driven in 10 runs over the course of the streak (dating back to April 7).
- OF **Jackson Beaman** has been the Tigers' most dangerous hitter in nonconference play with a .421 average in 16 non-SEC games this spring.
- C **Jedier Hernandez** has also enjoyed hitting in Columbia, registering a .367 batting mark ant 16 RBIs in his first 16 appearances at Taylor.
- LHP **Ryan Magdic** has proven to be a valuable weapon out of the bullpen, securing either a save or a victory in each of his last three relief appearances (April 6-20).
- Magdic turned in a dominant 3.1 inning stint to lift Mizzou to a 6-5 win over Georgia in 10 innings on April 12, then closed out the Tigers' 8-7 victory over LSU on Saturday.
- LHP **Ian Lohse** turned in a pair of scoreless outings last week, including 3.0 innings Sunday vs. LSU in his first start since March 25, 2023.
- The Tigers rank fourth in the conference in stolen bases (53).
- INF **Trevor Austin** leads the club with nine home runs, topping his previous season high (2023) with a three-run blast April 12 at Georgia, hiking his career total to 25 round-trippers.
- Austin has been hit by 14 pitches so far this season, ranking third in the SEC; additionally, his total of six sacrifice bunts is tied for third in the conference.
- The Tigers are 9-5 in one-run contests this spring, including a 6-1 mark in SEC play.
- Mizzou is hitting .295 as a team with two outs, logging 101 of its 217 RBIs on the year after the second out in an inning has been recorded.

SCOUTING MISSOURI STATE

- Led by 42nd-year head coach **Keith Guttin**, the Bears enter the week 17-21 overall after claiming two of three Missouri Valley Conference contests from Valparaiso over the weekend.
- The Bears are hitting .276 as a team, led by sophomore OF **Zack Stewart's** .331 average and 16 home runs.
- Freshman OF **Caden Bogenpohl** has added 14 round-trippers for the Bears, who have clubbed 68 homers through just 38 contests.
- On the mound, RHP **Brandt Thompson** heads the weekend rotation with his 5-0 season mark and 2.41 ERA. RHP **Kaleb Thomas** and RHP **Hunter Day** have been MSU's most consistent weapons out of the bullpen, logging a combined 30 appearances and 61.1 total innings.

FRESH LOOK

- Mizzou has received contributions from up and down its roster, and the Tigers' talented crop of freshmen have been some of their most consistent performers.
- MU's four primary freshman position players — SS **Drew Culbertson**, DH **Thomas Curry**, OF **Tucker Moore**, OF **Kaden Peer** and C **Mateo Serna** — have each made significant contributions in their rookie seasons.
- Culbertson logged hits in six straight games (April 7-16), including three consecutive two-hit performances.
- For the year, Culbertson has recorded seven multi-hit outings to date, swiping nine bases (in 11 attempts), while making 31 starts for the Tigers.
- Curry has hit four homers, which is good for fourth on the club, and notched four multi-RBI efforts, while drawing 16 walks.
- Curry, who has logged time as the Tigers' cleanup hitter while starting 22 contests to date, recorded a four-RBI afternoon vs. Northern Kentucky (March 3) and registered four multi-hit performances in his first 10 collegiate games.
- Moore has spent time in the leadoff spot in the MU batting order, recording four multi-hit performances and reaching base safely in 21 of his 28 games.
- Peer has heated up in April, hitting .270 with two home runs and a pair of three-RBI games in SEC play this month.
- Serna has drawn 13 starts behind the plate as a rookie. The Floridian has recorded hits in each of his last four starts, including a key homer in an April 16 win at MSU.
- The Tigers have received contributions from a trio of freshman hurlers as well, with RHP **Charlie Miller** logging 12 strikeouts over 10.2 innings and RHP **Josh McDevitt** making three starts. Additionally, RHP **Ben Smith** has made a pair of relief appearances for MU.

APRIL ACCOLADES

- Mizzou is off to an 8-5 start to the month of April, making it the Tigers' most successful month of the 2024 season to date.
- In SEC play, the Tigers have won five of their nine April contests, including a three-game sweep of No. 6 Florida (April 5-7), an extra-innings road win over Georgia (April 12) and an 8-7 victory over defending national champion LSU this past weekend.
- With its .615 winning percentage this month, April also marks MU's best overall month since March 2023, when the Tigers finished 13-5 (.722).
- The Tigers have not posted a .500 month of April since 2019, when they went 12-5 (.706).
- As a team, the Tigers have hit .275 and averaged 6.8 runs per April contest.
- INF **Brock Daniels** has been MU's most productive hitter this month, going 21-for-50 (.420) with three home runs and 19 RBIs.
- INF **Matt Garcia** has been red hot in April as well, raising his average from .167 to .259 by going 18-for-48 with 14 RBIs this month, including five multi-hit performances.
- LHP **Ryan Magdic** has emerged as a dominant force out of the MU bullpen in recent weeks, including three April relief outings over which he has fanned 10 hitters and allowed just two runs over 6.0 combined innings, earning a victory and two saves.

SEEING DOUBLE

- The Tigers' April resurgence has been boosted significantly by a pair of Brocks: RHP **Brock Lucas** and INF **Brock Daniels**.
- Lucas, a sophomore from St. Elizabeth, Mo., enters the week with a 4-0 mound mark and team-best 2.73 ERA.
- Earlier this spring, Lucas posted a string of 11 1/3 consecutive scoreless innings (March 17-April 2).
- Lucas has limited the opposition to a minuscule .200 opponent batting average.
- In his 12 outings, Lucas has logged seven scoreless appearances, including three extending at least 4.0 frames.
- Similarly, Daniels has been a dominant force at the plate for the Tigers, particularly in the month of April, when the St. Louis native has registered seven multi-hit performances in his 13 games.
- Daniels has produced 19 of his 24 RBIs over the same stretch and has raised his overall season batting average 151 points (from .211 to .362).
- Daniels brings a career-best nine-game hit streak into Tuesday's game, hitting .417 (15-for-36) over the same stretch.

A HUB FOR MID-MISSOURI

- The University of Missouri generates \$5 billion in economic impact for the state of Missouri.
- The larger University of Missouri System, comprised of four universities, generated \$6.5 billion in economic impact on the Show Me State.
- The University of Missouri supports nearly 50,000 direct and indirect jobs, both full and part time, in the state.
- Mizzou Athletics generated \$319.1 million in economic impact over the last fiscal year.
- The Tigers support and sustain 3,591 jobs annually.
- Mizzou Athletics has generated \$15.9 million in state and local taxes.

TARGET: TREVOR

- INF **Trevor Austin** has made a habit of reaching base throughout his four-year career with the Tigers, particularly when it comes to serving as a target, logging 43 free bases due to hit by pitches.
- Austin, the SEC's active leader in HBPs, was hit by a pitch in Saturday's home victory over LSU, running his 2024 total to 14 HBPs, which ranks third in the SEC.
- As a result, the Jefferson City native has climbed into a tie for third place on Mizzou's all-time HBP chart, matching **Jacob Friday's** (2005-08) career total.
- Austin is eight HBPs away from matching **John Hay** (1989-93) in the No. 2 position on the list.
- **John McKee** (2004-07) owns the Tigers' all-time mark of 70 HBPs.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Mizzou notched its first SEC road win of 2024 on April 12 with its 6-5 victory in 10 innings at Georgia.
- The victory marked the Tigers' first conference road win since April 15, 2023 (at Texas A&M).
- Coupled with last Tuesday's nonconference victory over Missouri State in Springfield, the Tigers now have six road wins in 2024.
- In their 17 road contests this spring, the Tigers have been led by freshman SS **Drew Culbertson's** .295 batting mark.

MIZZOU MILESTONES

- Several Tigers have reached or are approaching significant career milestones this season.
- 2B **Matt Garcia** and 3B **Trevor Austin** sit atop the Tigers' leaderboard for career hits among active players with 149 and 148, respectively.
- Austin, who played in his 150th career game April 7 vs. Florida, ranks third all-time at Mizzou in HBP (43) to go along with his 25 career homers, the latter of which is just seven shy of cracking the Tigers' all-time top 10 list.
- RHP **Logan Lunceford** surpassed the 100-strikeout milestone for his career April 12 at Georgia; the sophomore enters the week with 107 punchouts to his credit.
- LHP **Ian Lohse** enters the week within striking distance of the 100-K plateau as well with 97 K's on his resume.
- C **Jedier Hernandez's** game-winning hit vs. Florida on April 5 marked the 100th hit of his collegiate career.
- Mizzou's April 2 contest with UT Martin marked **Kerrick Jackson's** 200th career game as a Division I head coach.
- INF **Danny Corona** recorded the 100th hit of his collegiate career March 19 vs. Kansas at Kauffman Stadium.

HOW SWEEP IT IS

- Mizzou completed its second SEC series sweep of a top 10 conference foe in as many seasons, securing its first-ever sweep of No. 6 Florida (April 5-7).
- The Tigers, who also swept Georgia (May 12-14) and No. 4 Tennessee at Taylor Stadium (March 17-19) last spring, logged three consecutive one-run victories over the Gators.
- Mizzou pitching limited a potent UF lineup to a .196 batting mark for the series.
- RHP **Logan Lunceford** turned in 6.0 shutout innings in the opener, holding the Gators to a single hit, while combining with RHP **Carter Rustad** on a two-hit, 2-1 victory in 11 innings.
- The Tigers fanned a season-high 14 hitters in the series finale and averaged 12.0 strikeouts per game for the series.
- At the dish, C **Jedier Hernandez** turned in a series to remember, hitting a club-best .417 while driving in key runs in each victory. He plated the game-winning run on an 11th inning single in the opener, brought home the tying run in the sixth inning of game two, then drove home two more runs in the finale.

NON-CON DOMINATION

- Mizzou has claimed 12 nonconference victories over the first 10 weeks of the season, continuing a string of recent dominance in nonconference play.
- MU logged a 20-3 mark against non-SEC foes last spring, after going 18-3 in nonconference in 2022.
- MU has an overall mark of 50-17 in non-SEC competition since the start of the 2022 season.
- Over the last decade, the Tigers' dominance has been equally impressive, with MU winning 100 more nonconference games than it has lost (177-77).

RANK AND FILE

- With their three wins over sixth-ranked Florida, the Tigers can now boast of four total SEC wins over ranked opponents this season.
- Mizzou notched its first win over a top 25 foe March 23 with a 2-1 victory over No. 21 Kentucky.
- The victory over UK also marked head coach **Kerrick Jackson's** first conference win — as well as the first SEC win for a Black head coach in the circuit's history.
- This year, the Tigers could face as many as eight ranked SEC foes in weekend series, as each of their scheduled league opponents have spent time in at least one top 25 poll this spring.

TERRIFIC WITH TWO

- The Tigers have been clutch this season with two out, both at the plate and on the mound.
- Mizzou's offense has recorded 101 two-out RBIs in just 41 games, while hitting .295 (143-for-484) after the second out has been recorded in an inning.
- This past weekend vs. LSU, MU went 10-for-33 (.303) with two out, scoring seven two-out runs in Saturday's 8-7 victory.
- The weekend of April 11-13 at Georgia, the Tigers hit .325 (13-for-40) with two out, producing 11 RBIs.
- Against vs. No. 6 Florida, Mizzou recorded eight two-out RBIs, including all four of its runs in its game two victory (April 6).
- INF **Brock Daniels** and OF **Jackson Beaman** have been MU's most consistent two-out threats, hitting .545 (12-for-22) and .400 (10-for-25) in such situations, respectively.
- Mizzou pitchers have been equally dominant, holding the opposition to a collective .218 (98-for-449) two-out batting average this spring.

CAN'T SLOW OUR ROLL

- In the Tigers' 18 wins this season, MU baserunners have been successful on 31-of-36 steal attempts.
- Mizzou posted five stolen bases each of its two wins over UT Martin (April 2-3), going 10-for-10 in steal attempts against the Skyhawks.
- The Tigers' last five-steal performance came on April 11, 2023 at Missouri State.
- INF **Brock Daniels** was a perfect 5-of-5 in steal attempts the week of April 2-7, including the first three-steal effort by a Tiger since 2022.

- For the season, Mizzou ranks fourth in the SEC with 53 steals (in 66 attempts) this season.
- OF **Jeric Curtis** leads the Tigers with 14 steals, which is good for sixth overall in the SEC.

GOING STREAKING

- Mizzou ran its win streak to five straight games with its third consecutive win over Florida on April 7.
- In going 5-0 the week of April 2-7, the Tigers put together their longest win streak since claiming six in a row, March 12-22, 2023.
- INF **Brock Daniels** was MU's top offensive threat during the five-game stretch, batting .474 with 10 RBIs and five steals.
- INF **Trevor Austin** was a thorn in the opposition's side as well, scoring 10 times after posting a .600 on-base percentage and recording at least one hit in each game.
- The Tigers were lethal on the basepaths, going 14-for-14 in steal attempts.
- On the mound, MU fanned 59 batters in five games, reaching double-figure strikeout totals in four of those, including a season-best 14 K's April 7 vs. UF.
- Like Austin, OF **Jeric Curtis** logged a hit in all five games, including three consecutive two-hit performances (April 2-5).

PRIMETIME PIMENTAL

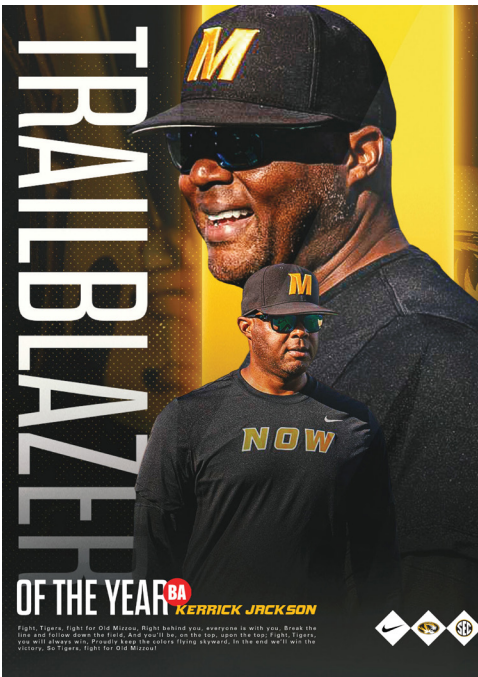
- Junior LHP **Javyn Pimental** has been one of the Tigers' key linchpins on the mound, bringing a .219 batting average against into the week.
- Pimental registered dominant starts against top 25 teams in three straight weekend starts to open SEC play; the lefty notched his first victory of the season with 6.0 innings vs. No. 21 Kentucky (March 23), allowing just one run while fanning five; the previous week, he held No. 1 Arkansas hitless through four innings and posted 5.0 scoreless frames overall.
- For the season, the Hawaii native has fanned 39 batters — a single-season best for the junior — in 36.0 innings spanning eight total appearances.

SEC MOUND MASTERY

- The Mizzou pitching staff met the challenge of SEC play, logging a team ERA of 3.84 over a nine-game stretch, March 22-April 7.
- Against three ranked opponents (Kentucky, Vanderbilt and Florida), the Tigers have limited the opposition to .223 hitting and an average of just 4.6 runs per game over the nine-game stretch.
- Mizzou's three weekend starting pitchers — RHP **Logan Lunceford**, LHP **Javyn Pimental** and RHP **Carter Rustad** — combined to hold the opposition to 20 earned runs over their 48.0 total innings, while striking out 42 hitters.
- Additionally, the MU bullpen was equally as effective, holding the Wildcats and Commodores to a .211 BAA.
- RHP **Bryce Mayer** turned in 5.1 scoreless innings, combining with LHP **Daniel Wissler**, LHP **Ryan Magdic** and RHP **Victor Quinn** for 12.0 scoreless frames of relief work.

LOVIN' LOVICH

- 1B **Jackson Lovich** returned from a two-week absence due to injury April 5 vs. Florida.
- Lovich went 2-for-4 in his first game back, doubling in the 11th inning to spark the Tigers' game-winning rally.
- The sophomore saw his career-best 13-game hit come to an end March 16 at No. 1 Arkansas.
- The Overland Park, Kan., product batted .388 (19-for-49) with four of his five home runs on the season and 15 RBIs during his streak, which ran from February 24 through March 15.
- Lovich has slugged .540 for the season and reached base safely via a hit or walk in the Tigers' first 18 contests (also through March 15).
- He currently shares the top spot on the SEC leaderboard for triples (3), despite missing eight contests due to injury.



TIGER TRAILBLAZER

- **Kerrick Jackson** has already enjoyed a personal moment of 'NOW' as the St. Louis product became the first Black head coach in SEC history with his appointment to the Tigers' top job.
- Jackson, who recorded the first SEC victory for a Black head coach with MU's March 23 win over No. 21 Kentucky, also picked up a significant honor from *Baseball America* in December, earning the publication's 2023 Trailblazer of the Year honor.
- Jackson has left his mark in just four seasons as a Division I head coach, including leading Southern to the 2019 Southwestern Athletic Conference crown and an NCAA Regional berth, as well as guiding Memphis to its first winning season in six years last spring.
- Additionally, Jackson has impacted the college baseball landscape through his work on the American Baseball Coaches Association's Diversity in Baseball Committee, a body for which he has served as chairman since its creation in 2018. The council works to improve diversity in the coaching ranks through a professional development program and an increased focus on youth baseball.

IN THE 'NOW'

- New Tiger bench boss **Kerrick Jackson** has undertaken the challenge of revitalizing Missouri's tradition-rich program, part of which has included a re-branding of sorts.
- Casual observers of any number of Mizzou's fall or preseason workouts will undoubtedly have taken note of a new and unique slogan around Taylor Stadium. Jackson and his staff introduced the **#MizzouNOW** branding — an acronym for No Opportunity Wasted — providing his student-athletes an entirely new way of approaching the game and the way they go about working to achieve their common goal of returning Mizzou to national prominence.
- **#MizzouNOW** was developed with a focus on appreciating the present and working toward taking advantage the opportunities immediately in front of the Tigers.

SHOW-ME STATE TO THE SHOW

- Major League Baseball's 2024 Opening Day saw four former Missouri baseball standouts on 40-man big league rosters earlier this month.
- Tiger legend RHP **Max Scherzer** begins his 17th Major League season on the Texas Rangers' 15-day IL due to offseason surgery, but could return to the reigning World Series champs earlier than originally expected.

- Scherzer claimed his second World Series title last fall, helping the Rangers to their first world championship in a five-game series with Arizona.
- Mizzou Athletics Hall of Famer RHP **Kyle Gibson** begins his first season with the St. Louis Cardinals after helping his former club, Baltimore, capture an AL East Division title last season.
- Gibson, a 2009 first-round MLB Draft selection, brought a 104-100 career big league mound mark into the 2024 season. The right-hander is also a three-time MLB Roberto Clemente Award nominee.
- RHP **Tanner Houck** was named to the Boston Red Sox Opening Day roster, marking the beginning of the former Tiger hurler's fourth season in The Show.
- Houck, a 2017 first-round pick of the Red Sox, won a career-high six games last season, one year after logging eight saves and a 3.15 ERA for Boston.
- RHP **Pete Fairbanks** also earned an Opening Day roster spot and will once again help anchor the Tampa Bay Rays bullpen.
- Fairbanks, a ninth-round choice of the Rangers in 2015, logged a career-best 49 relief appearances in 2023, posting a 2.58 ERA and 25 saves — the most MLB saves in a season by a Mizzou alum.
- The right-hander's 43 career big league saves also represent an all-time MLB high for a Missouri baseball product.

TIGER KINGS

- Speaking of **Max Scherzer**, the three-time Cy Young Award winner became the fourth Tiger to earn multiple World Series championships as an active player last fall, adding to his 2019 title with Washington.
- Another former Mizzou stalwart, Rangers special assistant to the G.M. **Ian Kinsler** (2003), also claimed his second World Series ring with the victory, following his first title as an active player with Boston in 2018.
- In all, eight Mizzou baseball alums have won World Series titles as players: In addition to Kinsler (2018) and Scherzer (2019 and 2023), **Homer Summa** (1929 and 1930), **Darold Knowles** (1973 and 1974), **Mike Shannon** (1964 and 1967), **Glenn Wright** (1925), **Charlie James** (1964) and **Tim Laudner** (1987) also claimed Fall Classics during their respective big league careers.

WELCOME WAGON

- Twenty different players have made their Mizzou debuts over the first nine weeks of the season.
- In the Tigers season opener at Cal Poly, seven newcomers found their names in the lineup: RHP **Bryce Mayer**, 3B **Danny Corona**, C **Jedier Hernandez**, DH **Thomas Curry**, CF **Jeric Curtis**, SS **Drew Culbertson** and LF **Tucker Moore**.
- On the mound, several new faces contributed to the Tigers' series win, with LHP **Ryan Magdic** and RHP **Jacob Peaden** combining for 4.0 hitless innings of relief in a 3-1 victory, while RHP **Charlie Miller** and C **Mateo Serna** also saw action in game three.
- The following week, OF **Kaden Peer** made a pair of starts in the outfield, while RHP **Kaden Jacobi**, RHP **Victor Quinn** and RHP **Josh McDewitt** all made their first appearances for the Tigers in San Diego.
- On MU's initial home stand, four more newcomers have introduced themselves to the Mizzou faithful: RHP **Miles Garrett** made his debut vs. SEMO, before RHP **Xavier Lovett** and OF **RJ Jimerson** made their first appearances vs. NKU (March 2) and RHP **Ben Smith** worked an inning in the series finale with PFW.
- Finally, INF **Jack Holubowski** made his Mizzou debut March 26 against Illinois, starting at first base for the Tigers.

COMING HOME

- Head coach **Kerrick Jackson** did not have to look far when adding the initial pieces of his Mizzou coaching staff. He selected former Tiger head coach **Tim Jamieson** for his pitching coach, completing a homecoming for the Mizzou Athletics Hall of Famer.

- Jamieson brings 28 years of experience on the MU campus into his new role as the Tigers pitching coach.
- In 22 seasons as Mizzou's head baseball coach, Jamieson led the Tigers to 698 wins, trailing only **Gene McArtor** (733) on MU's coaching wins list.
- He coached eight All-Americans at Mizzou and saw 75 of his players drafted, including 19 Major Leaguers.
- Jamieson returns to his hometown of Columbia after serving as pitching coach under Jackson in his lone season at Memphis, where the duo helped lead the Tigers to their first winning season since 2017.
- Prior to his stop at UM, Jamieson spent three seasons (2020-22) as pitching coach at Southern Illinois, helping the Salukis compile a 96-42 record.
- Jamieson garnered 1996 Big 8 Coach of the Year and 2007 Big 12 Co-Coach of the Year honors, as his Missouri teams won 35 games or more nine times during his head coaching career.
- He led Mizzou to seven consecutive NCAA postseason appearances from 2003 to 2009, including the program's first Super Regional berth in 2006. He was also selected to lead USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team as head coach in 2011.
- Jamieson, a graduate of Columbia Rock Bridge High School, is married to a Mizzou graduate, the former Cindy Thornton.

SPEAKING OF HOMECOMINGS...

- Another new Mizzou assistant coach (and former Tiger) is making a return to his old stomping grounds. **Bryson LeBlanc** joined Jamieson on **Kerrick Jackson's** first MU staff after spending five seasons on the coaching staff at UC San Diego.
- LeBlanc, who was named one of D1Baseball.com's picks for its '100 Assistant Coaches Athletic Directors Should Know' list this past fall, patrolled the MU outfield for Jamieson on the previously mentioned 2006 Regional-winning club.
- He helped guide UC San Diego through its transition to the NCAA Division I level, including a 34-18 campaign last spring that culminated in the program's first Big West Conference title.
- In all, 46 of LeBlanc's former players have been selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 who have been taken in the top 10 rounds. Six of those have advanced to the big leagues.

HALL WORTHY

- Even before his return as a member of the Tigers' new coaching staff, **Tim Jamieson** knew he'd be making a trip to Columbia in 2023 after his selection for induction to the Missouri Intercollegiate Athletics Hall of Fame in late May.
- Jamieson became the fourth former Tiger head baseball coach to be tabbed for Mizzou's highest athletic honor, joining **Don Faurot**, **John 'Hi' Simmons** and **Gene McArtor**.
- Jamieson took the Tigers to a Big Eight Conference championship in 1996, completing a worst-to-first turnaround — the first in Big Eight history — and in 2012 the Tigers won the Big 12 Conference Tournament title.
- Overall, he took nine teams to the NCAA Tournament, including seven straight appearances from 2003-09 and a Super Regional trip in 2006.

KERRICK JACKSON

FIRST YEAR • NEBRASKA '99

A veteran coach with experience at all levels of baseball, **Kerrick Jackson** was tabbed as Missouri's 15th head coach in June 2023.

Since that time, Jackson has undertaken the challenge of revitalizing the Tigers' tradition-rich program. These efforts have included hiring a diverse staff, recruiting a new-look roster and providing his pupils an entirely new way of approaching the game—and the way they go about working to achieve their common goal of returning Mizzou to national prominence.

While the work is well underway, Jackson will officially become the first Black Southeastern Conference head baseball coach to lead his team into action when the Tigers open their 2024 campaign in February. Furthermore, he will be just the fourth Black collegiate coach to guide a Power Five baseball program and the first to do so since the 2021 season.

In recognition of these efforts, *Baseball America* named Jackson its 2023 Trailblazer of the Year in December, capping an already historic year for the new Mizzou coach.

In addition to his success on the diamond as a collegiate coach, including leading Southern University to the 2019 Southwestern Athletic Conference crown and an NCAA Regional berth and guiding the University of Memphis to its first winning season in six years last spring, Jackson continues to serve as a relentless advocate for minorities in college baseball, especially in the coaching ranks. He helped form the American Baseball Coaches Association's Diversity in Baseball Committee and has served as its chairman since its creation in 2018. That body works to improve diversity in the coaching ranks through a professional development program and an increased focus on youth baseball.

Jackson returned to Columbia after having served as a Mizzou assistant from 2011-15. Known as a developer of players, a tireless recruiter, and a strong talent evaluator, Jackson is a well-respected leader in baseball circles, serving on the American Baseball Coaches Association Board of Directors and as chair of their Diversity in Baseball committee.

Prior to his season at Memphis, Jackson was the President of the MLB Draft League from 2020-22, a six-team summer baseball league sponsored by Major League Baseball and featuring a split-season amateur-professional format.

Jackson served as the head coach at Southern University from 2018-20, where he took a nine-win team in 2018 to 32 wins, a conference championship, and the NCAA Tournament the following season, earning SWAC and Louisiana Sports Writers Association Coach of the Year accolades. His 2018 Jaguar team boasted the athletic department's highest men's team GPA and received national recognition for its community service efforts.

Jackson worked for the Boras Corporation as a certified player agent for two years from 2016-17, where he identified prep and college players with the best chance to develop into Major League talent.

He served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Mizzou from 2011-15, working with the Tigers' hitters, outfielders, and infielders. Mizzou made back-to-back trips to the Big 12 Conference Tournament Championship in 2011-12, culminating with the program's first Big 12 title in 2012. The Tigers had multiple nationally-ranked recruiting classes, including 24th in 2012, 12th in 2014 and a consensus Top-30 class in 2015.

Before heading to Missouri, Jackson served as the Midwest Area Scouting Supervisor for the Washington Nationals from 2008-10, overseeing Missouri, Kansas, Arkansas, Iowa, Nebraska and the Dakotas.

His other collegiate coaching stops include assistant stints at St. Louis Community College-Meramec (2008), Nicholls State (2006-07), Jefferson (Mo.) College (2004-05), Coffeyville (Kan.) Community College (2003),



Emporia State (2002) and Fairfield (2001). Jackson also has extensive experience in the summer collegiate leagues, as he has coached in the Cape Cod League and New England Collegiate Baseball League.

Jackson spent two years at St. Louis Community College-Meramec as a student-athlete, where the team finished third at the JUCO World Series in 1995. Following that, he played at Bethune-Cookman University in 1996, leading the squad to its first-ever conference championship and regional appearance. Jackson concluded his playing career at Nebraska in 1997, graduating in 1999 with a bachelor's degree in sociology.

Jackson and his wife, Talia, have two sons, Zion and Lazarus.
