LAST WEEK: SIUE won its second Ohio Valley Conference series, taking two of three from UT Martin in Edwardsville. The Cougars were two extra inning games away from a 4-0 week, dropping 10-inning contests at Saint Louis and against UT Martin.

SERIES STUFF: Mizzou holds a 19-4 advantage in the all-time series and has won the last six meetings. SIUE's last win in the series came in 2011 in Columbia.

TOUGH ROAD: The Cougars opened the season with back-to-back series against 2023 NCAA Tournament teams. Troy was a win away from a Super Regional appearance last year, while Oral Roberts was a World Series team in 2023.

NEWCOMERS: SIUE has 19 newcomers on the 2024 rosters, 18 of whom have seen action in a game this season. Among position players, newcomers have accounted for 167 starts. All but eight starts on the mound have come from returners.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: The Cougars are sixth in the OVC in average (.276). They are fifth in doubles (55) and sixth in total bases (437) and sixth in hits (295).

HOMER ROLL: SIUE's 19 home runs rank eighth in the OVC. Zack Floyd leads the team with three home runs. The Cougars have hit 187 home runs over the last three seasons.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: The Cougars' .964 fielding percentage is sixth in the OVC.

LEAGUE LEADERS: Lucas Spence is the leading hitter in the OVC with a .403 batting average, which ranks 48th in the NCAA. He leads the league in hits with 50 which is 21st in the NCAA.

GOING STREAKING: Spence has hit safely in 17 consecutive games, which is the longest hitting streak on the team this year and the longest in the OVC this year. It is the longest streak by a Cougar since the 2009 season. The record is 24 games by Nick Seibert in 2001.

DELONG ROAD: Friday starting pitcher Tyler DeLong is SIUE's most experienced starter, having made 18 appearances and nine starts in 2023. He made 19 appearances (10 starts) at Austin Peay in 2022.

AND RUNNIN' RUNNIN': SIUE is tied for fourth in the OVC with 45 stolen bases. Wiloughby leads the way with nine. Gage Franck has eight.

THE SKIPPER: Sean Lyons is in his eighth season as SIUE's head coach. He has an overall record of 152-209.

LAST YEAR: SIUE was 26-28 overall and 14-8 at home. The Cougars returned to the OVC Tournament for the second consecutive season under Sean Lyons. The Cougars finished seventh in OVC play at 9-15.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS: Before the season, the OVC's head coaches and sports information personnel tabbed SIUE for a seventh-place finish. D1Baseball.com also picked the Cougars for a seventh-place finish in the OVC.

5 Sean Lyons, Head Coach

Sean Lyons begins his eighth season at the Cougars' helm in 2024. Lyons begins the season with a 141-188 record as the SIUE head coach. He has guided the Cougars to at least 23 wins in each of the last three seasons.

Lyons guided the Cougars to a seventh-place finish in the Ohio Valley Conference and a return to the OVC Tournament for the second straight season in 2023. He also oversaw the completion of the careers of Brennan Orf (Blue Jays) and Avery Owusu-Asiedu (Phillies), who both were drafted into Major League organizations following the season, marking the first time two SIUE players had been drafted in the same season since the 1999 draft saw three Cougars drafted. In addition, pitcher Jake Bockenstedt was signed into the White Sox organization following the draft.

The 2023 Cougars finished seventh in the OVC in batting average at .269 but were third in doubles (105) and home runs (69). Cougar pitchers were sixth in earned run average (6.38) but tied for second in the league with 434 total strikeouts. SIUE was fourth in batting average against at .278.

With a 7-0 shutout of UT Martin April 3, 2022, at Simmons Complex, Lyons earned his 100th win at the helm of SIUE baseball. In 2022, Lyons guided the Cougars to one of their most successful seasons since moving to Division I in 2009. SIUE finished 27-28, the second most wins the program has amassed at the Division I level. He led the Cougars back to the OVC Tournament for the first time since 2015, where SIUE won for the first time, going 2-2 before falling to eventual champion Southeast Missouri.

The 2022 campaign was undoubtedly the program's most successful offensive season since the transition. SIUE hitters combined to hit .303, ten points higher than any other season at Division I. The Cougars slugged .524 and reached base at a .384 clip both

records at the Division I level. SIUE scored 430 runs, bettering the next closest season by 85 runs, despite playing just three more games. The Cougars established a new school record by blasting 99 home runs, which was good for second in the OVC and ranked 21st in the NCAA. SIUE racked up 585 hits and 1,013 total bases, both good for program highs at the Division I level. Under Lyons, Brett Johnson and Richie Well earned All-Region honors following their final seasons in a Cougar uniform. Johnson belted a program-record 23 home runs while driving in 63 runs, to set a new record at the Division I level. He was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. Well had a breakout season of his own hitting 19 doubles to establish a new Division I mark. He hit 14 home runs, which ranks No. 4 on SIUE's single-season list. Well hit .571 (8-14) with eight RBIs at the OVC tournament and was SIUE's first-ever selection to the OVC All-Tournament team. Johnson, Brady Bunten and Kaid Karnes all earned first team All-OVC honors while Brennan Orf was named to the second team.

The 2021 team finished 23-27 overall, matching the most wins under Sean Lyons (2017). SIUE was 13-17 in OVC play, marking the most OVC wins for the Cougars since 2015. SIUE's offense excelled in 2021. The Cougars led the OVC in slugging percentage (.462) and triples (15), while finishing second in the league in home runs (64), runs batted in (296) and total bases (804). Additionally, SIUE was third in doubles (98), fourth in batting average (.278), runs scored (315) and hits (484). Lyons oversaw a pair of All-OVC performers in Brady Bunten and Brett Johnson, both of whom were selected the second team following the season.

Off to a promising start before the suspension of college sports, the Cougars finished the abbreviated 2020 season at 8-7 overall and 3-0 in the Ohio Valley Conference. The schedule featured nonconference wins over Nicholls State, George Washington, Texas-San Antonio and Stephen F. Austin. The Cougars swept their only Ohio Valley Conference series versus Tennessee Tech while featuring a strong pitching staff and an improved lineup. SIUE hit .314 in its three-game sweep of Tennessee Tech, while limiting the visiting Golden Eagles to a .148 batting average. Cougar hurlers fanned 45 hitters over three days.

The Cougars won 19 games in 2019, adding four wins over the season before. SIUE won 11 Ohio Valley Conference games in 2019, but fell a game short of a tournament berth. SIUE earned OVC series wins over Southeast Missouri, UT Martin and Murray State in 2019. As a team SIUE improved on both sides of the field. The Cougars hit .263 as a team, improving their team mark by nearly 20 points, while also dropping their team earned run average. SIUE remained one of the best fielding teams in the OVC.

Two longtime Cougars, Brock Weimer and Dustin Woodcock, wrapped up their Cougar careers under Lyons in 2019. Weimer connected on 12 home runs in 2019 and finished with a school record 35 long balls in his career. His 140 RBIs are ninth most in a career at SIUE. Woodcock finished eighth on the career list for games played and started at SIUE while racking up 48 doubles to rank No. 8 on the all-time list. He also appears in the top 20 with 120 RBIs during his time.

Pitchers Kenny Serwa and Colin Baumgartner continue to establish themselves as front of the rotation pitchers. Serwa earned All-OVC honors despite an injury-shortened season. Serwa made seven starts and tied for the OVC lead with two complete games. Baumgartner tied for third in the league with 15 starts. His 82 strikeouts led the team and is 9.93 strikeouts per nine innings was fifth best in the league.

Playing a challenging nonconference schedule, the Cougars finished at 15-37 overall in 2018. During the season, SIUE faced the likes of Louisiana Tech, Oral Roberts and top-25 ranked Wichita State, while also face a pair of NCAA regional teams - Tennessee Tech and Morehead State in Ohio Valley Conference play. Under Lyons, Jared McCunn finished his two-year career in 2018, leading the team in hitting with a .321 batting average. Weimer continued his strong play at the plate, leading the team in home runs and RBIs for the second straight season. Pitchers Mason McReaken and Nelson Martz finished their SIUE careers under Lyons and began their journey in to pro baseball. McReaken in his second season in the Atlanta Braves organization.

Finishing at 23-29, Lyons established a new school record for wins by a first-year head coach in 2017. In his first season in charge, Lyons oversaw a 14-win improvement from the previous season, marking the 13th largest turnaround in the NCAA. The Cougars' turnaround came largely from a much-improved offense. SIUE enjoyed its best offensive season since the move to NCAA Division I in 2009. The Cougars combined for a .293 batting average, which was the team's highest average since 2010. In OVC play, the average jumped to .316, which was third best in the league. SIUE's 530 hits were second most in the Division I era, and the Cougars' 340 hits during conference play ranked third.

The Cougars scored 335 runs, hit 53 home runs and drove in 319 runs, all Division I era-bests at the time and all despite playing fewer games than several previous seasons. Under Lyons guidance, several players enjoyed breakout seasons at the plate. Sophomore catcher Brock Weimer earned first team All-OVC honors after leading the team with 15 home runs and 50 RBIs. His 15 home runs tied SIUE's single-season record. Senior second baseman Alec Skender ranked fourth in the OVC with a .388 batting average to earn second team All-OVC honors. His average was just one point off the Division I-era school record. He finished the year with 83 hits, which is the most in school history in the Division I-era. Redshirt-freshman Eric Giltz hit .302 for the year, on his way to earning an OVC All-Freshman team selection. Giltz hit .340 during OVC play. Senior slugger Keaton Wright (.317) and junior Dustin Woodcock (.330) each hit over .300 for the season while establishing new career highs in RBIs. Wright drove in 43 runs, while hitting a career-best 12 home runs. Woodcock knocked in 42 runs and tied his career high with six homers. In total, six players among the regulars hit .300 or better for the season.

Defense also proved to be a strong suit for the Cougars. SIUE led the OVC and finished 30th in the NCAA with a .979 fielding percentage. As a team, the Cougars committed just 40 errors in 1,870 total chances. SIUE turned 48 double plays which was second most in the Division I era.

Prior to coming to SIUE, Lyons was the associate head coach at Bradley. Named as the Cougars' head coach in June 2016, he is the fourth head coach in SIUE baseball history. The native of Byron, Illinois, spent seven total seasons on the Bradley staff where he served as recruiting coordinator and hitting instructor. The 2016 season was his first as the program's associate head coach. In his final season at Bradley, the Braves ranked No. 9 nationally averaging 2.32 doubles per game. The Braves were third in the Missouri Valley Conference with a .283 batting average and 116 doubles.

No stranger to the Ohio Valley Conference, Lyons spent six seasons on the Eastern Illinois staff before moving to Bradley. The Panthers won the OVC tournament title in 2008 and were OVC regular season champions in 2009. Also in 2009, the Panthers ranked second in the nation in hitting with a .362 batting average. At EIU, Lyons coached seven MLB draft picks, three Freshman All-Americans and eight OVC first team members.

Lyons played at EIU from 1996-1999, leading the Panthers in hits for three straight seasons. He was selected as one of Eastern Illinois' 20 greatest OVC athletes during the Panthers' celebration of their first 20 years in the OVC.

He earned a Bachelor of Science from EIU in 1999. Lyons and his wife Jill have a daughter, Maleah and a son, Landry.

SIUE Baseball Staff



51 Adam Vasil, Assistant Coach, Pitching Coach

Adam Vasil joined SIUE as the volunteer assistant in September 2021 and was elevated to a full-time assistant following the 2022 season. Vasil's primary focus will be on the Cougars' pitchers and catchers.

In 2023, SIUE pitchers were second in the league in total strikeouts with 434. Opponents hit .278 against SIUE hurlers, which also ranked fourth in the league. The Cougars' team ERA ranked sixth in the league at 6.38.

The Cougars improved by five wins during Vasil's first season on staff and returned to the OVC Tournament for the first time since 2015. SIUE won a pair of games in the tournament, its first ever wins in the Championship.

Vasil came to SIUE after spending the 2021 season at Miami (Ohio) as the director of pitching development and bullpen coach. The Redhawks ranked fifth in the NCAA in strikeouts per nine innings (11.2), 16th in strikeout to walk ratio (3.07), 16th in earned run average (3.61), 22nd in hits per nine innings (7.78) and 25th in WHIP (1.27).

At Miami, Vasil coached three pitchers who went on to play affiliated baseball, including Sam Bachman, who was the ninth overall draft pick of the Angels in 2021.

Before his time at Miami, Vasil was the head assistant Coach at Coker University, a Division II school in South Carolina, where he also served as the lead recruiter and pitching coach. Under Vasil, the Cobras improved their total strikeouts, strikeouts per nine innings, walks and hits allowed.

The native of Cleveland, Ohio, spent the 2019 college season as a graduate assistant pitching coach at the University of Indianapolis where he also assisted game day scouting. There he helped the Greyhounds improve upon their overall earned run average, runs allowed, batting average against and WHIP.

Vasil also worked as a training specialist at the Florida Baseball Ranch (now Florida Baseball Armory) in Plant City, Florida.

Vasil began his college career at Ashland University where he was part of back-to-back conference championships and was a Rawlings Gold Glove nominee. He finished with one season as a graduate at Indianapolis.

He earned his bachelor's from Ashland in 2017 and an MBA from Indianapolis in 2019.



#45 Justin Paulsen, Assistant Coach

Justin Paulsen joined Sean Lyons' staff in as as assistant in August 2023, following four seasons on the staff at Division II Maryville. He spent the last two seasons as the recruiting coordinator and hitting coach.

In 2023, Paulsen helped Maryville to one of its most successful seasons in program history. The Saints won a school record 36 games, ranked in the top 25 for the first time ever in the NCBWA Poll, earned their first bid to the NCAA Division II Midwest Regional, and won their first two regional games.

Paulsen guided offense which broke seven school records including runs scored, doubles, home runs, runs batted in, total bases, hit by pitches, and walks. Paulsen coached two All-Americans, two All-Midwest Region players, and three All-Conference players.

The 2022 Saints won 32 games which was the most in a season at the time. In Paulsen's first year as the hitting coach the offense broke seven school records including runs scored, hits, doubles, home runs, RBI's, total bases, and walks.

Paulsen arrived at Maryville after serving as a student assistant at his alma mater, Missouri State. He helped the Bears to two NCAA Super Regional appearances and a Missouri Valley Conference championship in 2015.

As a player, Paulsen garnered numerous honors in a Bear uniform, including All-MVC honorable mention his senior season, MVC All-Tournament team, All-MVC honorable mention his junior season. H was an All-MVC second team selection and an NCAA All-Regional pick in his sophomore campaign. He was drafted by the San Diego Padres in the 2017 Major League Baseball Amateur Draft and played for two seasons in the Padres organization.

The native of St. Louis, graduated from Christian Brothers High School and attended Jefferson College for a year before playing for Missouri State.



#17 Tanner Holen, Assistant Coach

Tanner Holen joined the SIUE baseball staff as an assistant coach in August 2023. Prior to coming to SIUE, Holen was on staff as an assistant at Ball State.

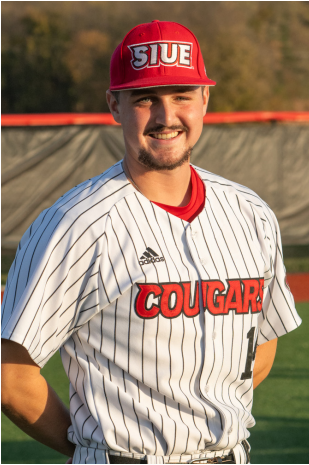
In 2023, Ball State won the Mid-American Conference tournament championship and appeared in its first NCAA Regional Tournament since 2006.

During his time at Ball State, Tanner's primary responsibilities included serving as camp coordinator, developing catchers, assisting with off-campus and on-campus recruiting, and all team operations. Holen helped mentor Ball State catcher Hunter Dobbins who earned recognition on the Mid-American Conference All-Defensive Team. Holen was responsible for all aspects of the Ball State Camps. He also worked extensively with hitting and pitching analytics, and conducting video for pitchers, catchers, and hitters. During games, Tanner was given first base coaching responsibilities and management of the bullpen.

Holen began his coaching career at Western Illinois when he joined the coaching staff in the summer of 2021. During his time at Western Illinois, Holen was responsible for hitting and catching development, recruiting, camp coordination, and creation of scouting reports. The offense in the 2022 spring increased production in doubles, triples, home runs, batting average, on-Base percentage, slugging and stolen bases. In 2022, the Leathernecks led the Summit League and ranked 15th nationally in stolen bases.

Holen earned his master's degree in sports administration from Cincinnati where he played his final graduate season. In 2021 he hit .300 with a .479 OBP, .529 SLG for an OPS of 1.008.
