- Fans will also be treated to a Corgi race at the half, while a special \$5 ticket promotion is available for the game.

ABOUT THE TIGERS

- Missouri is 8-2 this season, suffering back-to-back defeats at Notre Dame and No. 21 Kansas.
- Senior **Mark Mitchell** leads the Tigers with 18.4 points and 6.2 rebounds, while ranking second with 3.0 assists per game.
- Graduate student **Jacob Crews** is also scoring in double figures with 13.8 points per game.
- Junior **Anthony Robinson II** adds 9.6 points and leads Mizzou with 3.2 assists per game.
- The Tigers are averaging 87.4 points per game in 2025-26, while allowing 70.1.

ABOUT THE HORNETS

- Alabama State owns a 3-6 record this season, falling in its last three games.
- The Hornets are coming off a season where they went 20-16, won the SWAC Tournament and earned one win in the NCAA Tournament.
- Asjon Anderson leads Alabama State with 17.9 points and 4.4 assists per game, while Micah Simpson is second on the team with 16.9 points.
- Cameron Palesse has a team-best 5.0 rebounds.
- Through nine games, the Hornets are averaging 79.4 points, while allowing 81.4

SERIES HISTORY

- The schools are meeting for the third time on the court and for the second-straight season.
- The Tigers have won both previous meetings, including an 82-65 win last season in the non-conference finale.
- Four Tigers scored in double figures in last year's victory, led by 16 points from Tamar Bates.

MIZZOU VERSUS SWAC

- MU has won 28 of 29 meetings versus the SWAC with 27-of-29 games decided by double digits.
- The Tigers have already defeated one SWAC team this season, defeating Prairie View A&M, 91-73, on Nov. 17.

MR. VERSATILE, MARK MITCHELL

- **Mark Mitchell** has led the charge for Mizzou and has started the season on an elite level.
- Mitchell is averaging a team-best 18.4 points and 6.2 boards, while ranking second with 3.0 assists.
- In fact, he is one of just seven players in the nation averaging 18 points, six rebounds and three assists.

TOP SCORER

- While **Mark Mitchell** can do it all, he's still best known for his scoring ability.
- Mitchell leads Missouri with 18.4 points, which is the highest average by a Tiger through the season's first 10 games since Jordan Clarkson (19.4) and Jabari Brown (19.0) in 2013-14.

TOP RANKS FOR MITCHELL

- With his strong early start, **Mark Mitchell** ranks among the nation's best in multiple stats.
- Leading the way is placing among the nation's top 100 in scoring – ranking fifth in the SEC and 73rd in the country with his 18.4 points.
- Efficiency is the key as Mitchell also places 47th nationally with a field-goal percentage of 59.0.
- Mitchell is also one of the nation's best at getting to the free-throw line – ranking fifth in attempts (84) and 23rd in makes (58).

THE CREWS MISSILE

- Graduate student **Jacob Crews** has been one of the top shooters nationally this season.
- Crews leads the Tigers with 28 made 3-pointers and a clip of 48.3 percent from beyond the arc.
- He currently ranks 20th in the nation in 3-point percentage and 70th with 2.80 triples per game.
- Crews has made at least three triples in six of the last seven games – shooting 23-of-48 during the stretch (47.9 percent).

STONE IMPACT

- One player the Tigers are missing as of late is graduate student **Jayden Stone**.
- Ranked third on the team in scoring with 13.1 points, Stone has missed the last four games with a hand injury.
- With Stone in the lineup, MU averaged 14.4 more points – shooting 12.7 percent better from the field and 17.1 percent better from three.

- Stone was the first Tiger to score 10-plus points in his first six career games at Mizzou since Jordan Clarkson in 2013.

ROBINSON LEADS MU DEFENSE

- Junior **Anthony Robinson II** entered the 2025-26 season as the frontrunner for the league's Defensive Player of the Year accolade.
- Robinson was named to the SEC's five-man All-Defensive Team as a sophomore. In fact, he is the only player returning from last year's team.
- After finishing last season 38th nationally in steals, Robinson has picked up where he left off, leading Mizzou with 22 swipes in 10 games in 2025-26, placing 52nd with 2.20 per game.

ONE OF THE BEST SHOOTING TEAMS

- The Tigers have not wasted any of time finding their shooting touch in 2025-26.
- MU is making 52.4 percent of its field goals this season with a 3-point clip of 36.5 percent.
- Mizzou ranks 10th nationally with its 52.4 percent overall clip, 17th in effective field goal percentage (59.2) and 39th with its 3-point clip of 36.5.

CONTROLLING THE PAINT

- The best way to have a high shooting percentage is to take close shots and that's exactly where the Tigers have thrived in 2025-26.
- MU is doubling teams in the paint this season, 440-220 – an average of 44.0 to 22.0 (+22.0).
- The Tigers have outscored their opponent in the paint by at least 10 points in 8-of-10 games.
- Mizzou's most dominant contest inside was a 60-2 advantage against VMI on Nov. 9.

HOT SHOOTING LEADS THE WAY

- The key to the Tigers ranking among the nation's best shooters is their consistency.
- Mizzou has eclipsed 50 percent shooting in seven of 10 games this season.
- The Tigers are one of eight schools with seven games of at least 50 percent shooting.

50 PERCENT EQUALS WINS

- As Mizzou continues to make 50 percent of its field goals, it continues to pile up the wins.
- The 50 percent mark is almost a guaranteed win for the Tigers as MU is now 37-1 under Coach Gates when hitting the mark, including 19-0 since the start of the 2024-25 season.

40 PERCENT OR LOWER

- The Tiger have been nearly as strong by holding teams to shoot under 40 percent.
- Mizzou is currently one of 37 schools (of 365) to hold a team under 40 percent shooting six times in 2025-26.
- Overall, the Tigers rank 64th nationally with a field goal percentage defense of 40.1 percent.

SHOOTING ADVANTAGE

- Combining the team's strong shooting and strong defense on opponent's shots, the Tigers own one of the largest advantages in the country.
- Mizzou is one of three schools in the country with five games of shooting 50 percent or better and holding foes to 40 percent or under in the same contest.
- Overall, the Tigers have a 12.3 percent advantage in shooting marks this season – the 13th-best edge in the nation.

DOUBLE-DIGIT THREATS

- One key to the MU's success on the offensive side this season is its number of weapons.
- Of the 12 players to feature for MU this year, 10 have scored in double figures at least once.
- Twice this season, Mizzou has had at least six players score 10 points in a game this season.

SECOND-CHANCE POINTS

- When the Tigers do miss a shot, they have been very strong still converting that into points.
- Missouri is currently averaging 17.0 second-chance points per game.
- Twice this year, MU has totaled 30-plus second-chance points in a game – 30 versus VMI (Nov. 9) and 36 versus South Carolina State (Nov. 25).
- Prior to the season, MU had not scored 30 points after offensive boards in a single game since a double overtime win against Texas A&M in 2014.

PHILLIPS DOUBLES UP

- Senior center **Shawn Phillips Jr.** has made a splash early in his tenure in the Black & Gold.
- Phillips has collected two double-doubles in four games – one in the opener at Howard (16 points and 11 boards) and another versus Prairie View A&M (12 points and 13 rebounds).
- The double-double in the opener is the first for a Tiger in his MU debut since Ronnie DeGray in 2021.
- Through eight games this season, Phillips has tallied 98.9 points and 6.1 rebounds – shooting 67.4 percent from the field.

GETTING TO THE LINE

- A large key to MU's success the past two seasons is the team's march to the free-throw line.
- Last season, the Tigers ranked second nationally with 19.7 makes per game from the free-throw line and third with 27.0 attempts.
- MU returned its top two players in free-throw attempts in **Mark Mitchell** (212) and **Anthony Robinson II** (140), while also adding **Sebastian Mack**, who led UCLA with 136 attempts last year.
- Through 10 games this year, MU is averaging 17.1 made free throws per game.

WELCOME BACK

- Two Tigers have made successful returns to the lineup after missing multiple weeks to start the season with injuries.
- Sophomore **Annor Boateng** missed the season's first five games and is now averaging 6.0 points in five games.
- After missing his true freshman season and the first six games of his redshirt season, **Trent Burns** made his debut on Nov. 25 with seven points, three boards and one block versus South Carolina State.

EFFICIENT DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Senior **Jevon Porter** had his most productive game in the Black & Gold on Nov. 17.
- Against South Dakota, Porter recorded his first double-double as a Tiger with 19 points and 12 boards, making all nine of his field goals in the win.
- Porter had the best shooting day by a Tiger since Amari Davis shot 10-of-10 at Ole Miss in 2022.
- Porter is the first Tiger to shoot 100 percent from the field and record a double-double since Ricardo Ratliffe did so in 2012 against Oklahoma.
- Overall, Porter is tallying 6.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game this season.

DOMINATING WINS

- Mizzou has made a habit of running away from opponents this season.
- The Tigers have won six games this season by 20 or more points – one of 11 schools to do so.
- Highlighting the dominating wins was a 23-point victory over Minnesota, marking Mizzou’s largest in 146 games against Big Ten opponents.
- Overall, the Tigers rank 31st nationally with a scoring margin of +17.3 points.

RETURNERS & TRANSFER BALANCE

- The new-look Tigers feature a strong balance of returning players and newcomers.
- The seven returners to see action hold a slight edge in points, assists and steals, while the five newcomers have the edge in boards and blocks.

MITCHELL EARNS PRESEASON NODS

- Senior **Mark Mitchell** is one of the top returners in the SEC and in the nation this season.
- Mitchell is one of 50 players named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Preseason Watch List – which is presented to the men’s national player of the year by the USBWA.
- The senior was also named to the Preseason All-SEC Second Team.
- Mitchell leads Mizzou with 18.4 points and 6.2 rebounds in 10 games this campaign, while ranking second with 3.0 assists.

TOP RETURNING SCORER

- Senior **Mark Mitchell** led the Tigers in scoring as a junior and is back for more in 2025-26.
- Mitchell tallied 13.9 points per game – shooting 50.5 percent from the field and leading the team in free-throws made (142) and attempts (212).
- In fact, Mitchell’s 13.9 points are the most by a returning Tiger since Marcus Denmon in 2011-12 (he averaged 16.9 in 2010-11).

TIGERS SIGN NO. 1 CLASS

- Not only are the Tigers unbeaten on the season but Mizzou also signed the nation’s top-ranked recruiting class in November.
- MU signed **Jason Crowe Jr.** (No. 5 in ESPN100), **Toni Bryant** (No. 14) and **Aidan Chronister** (No. 83).
- Overall, Mizzou has the No. 1 class by ESPN, ahead of No. 2 Michigan State.

BREAKOUT CANDIDATE

- **Anthony Robinson II** has been identified as one to watch this season.
- Robinson was named one of 10 breakout players for the 2025-26 campaign by Andy Katz and one of 20 by Jon Rothstein.
- Robinson tallied 9.0 points per game during his sophomore season, leading Mizzou with 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

RETURNING EXPERIENCE

- The Tigers are ready to take on the 2025-26 campaign with a number of familiar faces.
- Mizzou is the only team in the SEC with three returning starters from last season with **Mark Mitchell**, **Trent Pierce** and **Anthony Robinson II** all back for MU.
- Overall, it marks the first time that MU returns three starters since the 2020-21 campaign.

CREWS IMPROVEMENT

- **Jacob Crews'** strong shooting early this season shouldn’t be much of a surprise as he finished his first season in the Black & Gold strong as well.
- In his last 14 games of 2024-25, Crews shot 38.9 percent from 3-point range after sinking 29.2 percent in his first 19 games at Mizzou.
- Crews has gone even further this season as he is now averaging 13.8 points with a 3-point mark of 48.3 percent.
- Crews has connected on a team-best 28 triples through 10 games this season – last season, he had seven through the season’s first 10 contests.

TOP-10 OFFENSE NATIONALLY

- The key to the Tigers’ success in 2024-25 was their offensive attack.
- Mizzou ranked ninth in the nation by averaging 83.6 points per game.
- The Tigers posted their highest scoring offense since 1989-90 (86.8) and fourth-highest overall in school history.

- Mitchell led the team in scoring (13.9) last season, second in rebounds (4.7), third in assists (64), fifth in steals (32) and first in blocks (25).
- In fact, Mitchell was one of just 14 players in the nation to total 450 points, 150 rebounds, 60 assists, 30 steals and 25 blocks last season.

LEARNING FROM THE POINT GOD

- **Anthony Robinson II** spent some of his summer learning from Chris Paul as he was one of 12 players nationally to earn an invite to his camp.
- Robinson participated in the Chris Paul Elite Guard Camp from July 29 to August 1 this summer.

OH CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

- Two Tigers are set to serve as team captains during the 2025-26 campaign.

- **Mark Mitchell** and **Anthony Robinson II** are both set to serve in leadership roles this season.

TAKING THE SHOW ON THE ROAD

- The Tigers went on the road to open the 2025-26 season, putting on a show at Howard.
- Mizzou's win marks the first time it won a road season opener since 2003, while the 21-point win is its largest since in a road opener since a 52-29 win at Saint Louis in 1941.
- The Tigers were the only power conference school to open with a win in a true road game.

MILESTONE WATCH

- **Jacob Crews** became the latest Tiger to reach 1,000 points for his career – doing so on Nov. 25 versus South Carolina State.



DENNIS GATES

Whitten Family Men's Basketball Head Coach



In just three seasons as Whitten Family Men's Basketball Head Coach, Dennis Gates has made an immediate impact and reestablished University of Missouri on the national stage. Now in his fourth year on the Mizzou sideline, he aims to build off his early progress as the Tigers chase championships with him leading the program.

MISSOURI

- **Named SEC Coach of the Year by USA Today in 2022-23.**
- Named to the Naismith Coach of the Year Watch List twice in his three seasons, finishing as a top-10 semifinalist in 2025.
- Led Mizzou two NCAA Tournament bids (2023 and 2025) in his three seasons, including the program's first postseason victory in 13 years and first-ever appearance in the SEC Semifinals in 2023.
- His 25 victories 2022-23 are the fifth-most by any first-year SEC coach in conference history – trailing only Tubby Smith, John Calipari, Eddie Sutton and Trent Johnson.
- Led the Tigers to 11 wins over ranked teams, including three top-five wins in 2024-25 – a first for Mizzou since 1988-89.
- Two Tigers have played in the NBA after playing for Gates – Kobe Brown (LA Clippers) and D'Moi Hodge (LA Lakers). Overall, seven Tigers have joined NBA or G-League franchises in Gates' three seasons at Mizzou.
- Coached two All-SEC honorees, one SEC Sixth Man of the Year, one SEC All-Defensive Team honoree and two SEC Scholar-Athletes of the Year.

CLEVELAND STATE

- **2019-20 and 2020-21 Horizon League Coach of the Year.**
- Rebuilt the Vikings program – winning 50 games, including a 39-19 mark his final two seasons.
- Won two Horizon League regular-season titles (2020, 2021) and the 2021 Horizon League Tournament crown.
- Led the Vikings to the 2021 NCAA Tournament – the school's first trip in 12 years – and 2022 Postseason NIT.
- Mentored two Horizon League Defensive Players of the Year plus five all-conference and five All-Defensive Team honorees.

FLORIDA STATE

- Spent eight seasons on Leonard Hamilton's staff at FSU, mirroring the Seminoles' rise to national prominence.
- FSU advanced to four NCAA Tournament in his eight years, including the Elite Eight in 2018 and Sweet 16 in 2012 and 2019.
- Instrumental in recruiting four-straight top-15 classes, which produced five NBA Draft picks over four years – Jonathan Isaac (No. 9 selection in 2017), Malik Beasley (No. 19 in 2016), Mfiondu Kabengele (No. 27 in 2019), Dwayne Bacon (No. 40 in 2017) and Terance Mann (No. 48 in 2019).


