

ABOUT THE TIGERS

- Mizzou is 12-3 during the 2025-26 campaign.
- The Tigers are a perfect 2-0 in SEC play, earning wins over No. 22 Florida and at Kentucky to open conference action.
- Mark Mitchell** and **Jayden Stone** both scored 20-plus points in Wednesday's 73-68 win over the Wildcats with Mitchell tallying 21 and Stone chipping in 20.
- Overall, Mitchell leads Mizzou with 17.2 points and 5.1 rebounds, while ranking second on the team with 3.0 assists.
- Four Tigers are scoring in double figures with Stone (13.6), **Jacob Crews** (13.1) and **Anthony Robinson II** (11.3) following Mitchell's lead.
- Robinson also has a team-best 3.9 assists per game, while **Shawn Phillips Jr.** leads the Tigers with 1.5 blocks.
- Mizzou is scoring 82.5 points during the 2025-26 campaign, while allowing 71.4

ABOUT THE REBELS

- Ole Miss owns an 8-7 record this season with a 0-2 mark in SEC play.
- The Rebels are coming off a home loss to No. 15 Arkansas, 94-87, on Wednesday.
- Ole Miss is led by Malik Dia, who has a team-best 14.7 points and 6.9 rebounds per game.
- AJ Storr and Ilias Kamardine also score in double figures with 11.3 points, while Kamardine adds a team-best 4.1 assists.
- The Rebels own a scoring offense of 75.1 points through 15 games this season with a scoring defense of 69.6 points.

SERIES HISTORY

- Ole Miss holds a 17-9 edge over Mizzou with all meetings coming since the Tigers joined the conference in 2012.
- While the Rebels hold the advantage in the all-time series, Mizzou has won six of the last eight contests.
- MU won the only meeting between the teams last year with the No. 22 Tigers defeating the No. 16 Rebels, 83-75, behind a combined 48 points from Tamar Bates and Caleb Grill at Mizzou Arena.

HISTORIC FIRSTS

- The Tigers are riding high early in SEC play after accomplishing a number of program firsts.
- Mizzou is coming off the school's first-ever win at Kentucky – having entered with a 0-9 all-time record in Lexington.
- With the win, the Tigers also improved to 2-0 in SEC play for first time in school history.
- Now in its 14th season in the conference, MU last owned a 2-0 league record as a member of the Big 12 in 2009-10.

LET'S KEEP IT GOING

- Now that the Tigers recorded their first 2-0 start in SEC play in their history, they now turn their attention toward 3-0.
- Mizzou is aiming for its first 3-0 league start since it began the 2000-01 season perfect through three as a member of the Big 12.
- The Tigers are also trying to win their first two road games in conference play for the first time since 1998-99.

AGAINST THE BEST

- Not only has Mizzou completed a rare 2-0 start but to make it even more impressive, it did it against the top two teams in the SEC Preseason Poll.
- Florida was named the preseason favorite prior to the year with Kentucky ranked second.
- It marks the third time in 14 seasons MU defeated the top two teams in the poll – also 2021 (Tennessee & Kentucky) and 2023 (Kentucky & Arkansas).

DIFFERENCE MAKERS

- The biggest difference for the Tigers in SEC play has been the return of **Trent Pierce** and **Jayden Stone** from injury.
- In the two SEC wins, the duo has averaged a combined 22.0 points, 11.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.0 steals in their returns to play.
- A starter last season, Pierce missed the first 13 games with a lower-body injury, while Stone had missed the last seven games of non-conference action with a hand injury.

ROBINSON FINDING HIS RHYTHM

- Junior **Anthony Robinson II** has played his best basketball as of late and is starting to find his offensive rhythm this season.
- In the last five games, Robinson is averaging 14.8 points and 5.4 assists – more than tripling his scoring output from the prior four contests.
- Anthony Robinson II** Last 5 Gms Prior 4 Gms

- Overall, Robinson is scoring 11.3 points this year and leads Mizzou with 3.9 assists.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

- Anthony Robinson II** has rounded out his game as the offense runs through him.
- In the last six games, Robinson has tallied at least five assists in five contests – averaging 5.5 during the stretch.
- In Wednesday's win, the junior tallied a career-best 10 helpers at Kentucky – the most by a Tiger since Terrence Phillips had 10 in 2017.
- Overall, Robinson now ranks eighth in the SEC and 177th nationally with his 3.9 assists per game.

THE CREWS MISSILE

- Graduate student **Jacob Crews** has been one of the top shooters nationally this season.
- Crews leads the Tigers with 39 made 3-pointers and a clip of 50.0 percent from beyond the arc.
- He currently ranks third in the nation in 3-point percentage and 102nd with 2.60 triples per game.
- Overall, Crews is third on the team with 13.1 points this year.

MR. VERSATILE, MARK MITCHELL

- Mark Mitchell** has led the charge for Mizzou and has started the season on an elite level.
- Mitchell is averaging a team-best 17.2 points and 5.1 boards, while ranking second with 3.0 assists.
- In fact, he is one of only 11 players in the nation (and only player in the SEC) averaging 17 points, five boards and three assists.

TOP RANKS FOR MITCHELL

- With his strong start to the season, **Mark Mitchell** ranks among the nation's best in multiple stats.
- The senior currently ranks ninth in the SEC and 110th nationally with his 17.2 points per game.
- Efficiency is the key in Mitchell's game as he ranks second in the conference and 73rd nationally with a field-goal clip of 55.6.
- Mitchell is also one of the nation's best at getting to the free-throw line – ranking 53rd in attempts (105) and 70th in makes (73).

ONE OF THE BEST SHOOTING TEAMS

- Overall, **Mark Mitchell**'s efficiency has also been a team stat as the Tigers rank as one of the best shooting teams in the country.
- MU is making 51.4 percent of its field goals this season with a 3-point clip of 36.5 percent.
- Mizzou ranks 16th nationally with its 51.4 percent overall clip, 19th in effective field goal percentage (58.1), 25th in 2-point percentage (60.1) and 60th with its 3-point clip of 36.5.

CONSISTENT SHOOTING

- The key to the Tigers ranking among the nation's best shooters is their consistency.
- Mizzou has eclipsed 50 percent shooting in 10 of 15 games this season.
- The Tigers are one of 13 schools with 10 games of at least 50 percent shooting.

50 PERCENT EQUALS WINS

- As Mizzou continues to make 50 percent of its field goals, it continues to pile up the wins.
- The 50 percent mark is almost a guaranteed win for the Tigers as MU is now 40-1 under Coach Gates when hitting the mark, including 22-0 since the start of the 2024-25 season.

MAGIC NUMBER IS 72

- The goal on the offensive end for the Tigers this season is to score 72 points.
- Mizzou is a perfect 12-0 when tallying at least 72 points but are 0-3 when failing to reach the mark.
- Overall, the Tigers are averaging 82.5 points during the 2025-26 season.

DOUBLE-DIGIT THREATS

- One key to the MU's success on the offensive side this season is its number of weapons.
- Of the 13 players to feature for MU this year, 11 have scored in double figures at least once.
- Trent Pierce** became the latest Tiger to reach the mark, scoring in double figures in his season debut last Saturday.

ROBINSON ANCHORS DEFENSE

- Anthony Robinson II** entered the season as the frontrunner for the league's Defensive Player of the Year accolade and has not disappointed.
- Robinson currently ranks third in the SEC and 27th nationally with 2.27 steals per game.

THE LONE RETURNER

- The reason why junior **Anthony Robinson II** is a top candidate for SEC Defensive Player of the Year is his history from past seasons.
- Robinson was named to the SEC's five-man All-Defensive Team as a sophomore. In fact, he is the only player returning from last year's team (other four were graduating seniors).

STONE COLD JAYDEN

- After a successful start to his Mizzou career, the Tigers certainly missed **Jayden Stone** during his time out with a hand injury.
- Before his injury, Stone was the first Tiger to score 10-plus points in his first six career games at Mizzou since Jordan Clarkson in 2013.
- In two games since returning from injury, Stone is averaging 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds.
- Mizzou is now 8-0 with him in the lineup this season but just 4-3 in games he missed.
- Overall, Stone is second on MU in scoring (13.6) and rebounding (5.0) – shooting 59.4 percent from the field and 41.7 from 3-point range.

PIERCING IMPACT

- Trent Pierce** has also returned from injury to play a significant role in Mizzou's 2-0 start in the SEC.
- In two games in the lineup, Pierce is tallying 7.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 3.0 assists.
- He scored five-straight points late in the victory over Florida, giving the Tigers the lead for good.
- In Wednesday's win at Kentucky, Pierce collected a career-best four steals to go with five points, five boards and three assists.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- The Tigers have enjoyed a lot of success on the glass in 2025-26.
- Mizzou is collecting 36.7 rebounds per game this season, compared to 30.2 for opponents.
- MU has really enjoyed success on the offensive glass – ranking 37th nationally by with an offensive rebounding clip of 36.9 percent.
- The team's +6.5 margin ranks fifth in the SEC and 50th nationally. The Tigers have not finished with a +5.0 margin since outrebounding teams by 8.7 boards in 2012-13 (40.8 to 32.1).
- Rebounding is also a key for success. The Tigers are outrebounding teams by 10.3 in wins (38.3 to 28.0) but in losses, opponents hold a 9.0 edge (39.0 to 30.0).

PHILLIPS DOUBLES UP

- Senior center **Shawn Phillips Jr.** has made a splash early in his tenure in the Black & Gold.
- Phillips has collected two double-doubles this season – one in the opener at Howard (16 points and 11 boards) and another versus Prairie View A&M (12 points and 13 rebounds).
- The double-double in the opener is the first for a Tiger in his MU debut since Ronnie DeGray in 2021.
- Through 13 games this season, Phillips has tallied 7.7 points and ranks third with 4.8 boards – shooting 67.7 percent from the field.
- Phillips also leads Mizzou, ranks sixth in the SEC and 106th in the country with 1.46 blocks.

GETTING TO THE LINE

- One area where the Tigers would like to improve is getting to the three-throw line.
- Last season, Mizzou ranked second nationally with 19.7 makes per game from the free-throw line and third with 27.0 attempts.
- This year, however, the Tigers are 10th in the SEC in attempts per game (22.7) and 15th in makes from the charity stripe (15.3).
- MU returned its top two players in free-throw attempts in **Mark Mitchell** (212) and **Anthony Robinson II** (140), while also adding **Sebastian Mack**, who led UCLA with 136 attempts last year.

AND-ONE

- Not only does **Mark Mitchell** lead the team in free throw makes and attempts this season but he also is elite at finishing through contact.
- Mitchell has a team-best 19 and-ones in 2025-26 – averaging 1.3 per game.

T.O. LENDS HELPING HAND

- Sophomore **T.O. Barrett** has helped carry the load from the point guard position this season.
- In 15 games, Barrett is third on the team with 2.5

assists per game. His 37 total assists are already more than triple his rookie-season total (12).

- Barrett is also continuing to improve as the season progresses – recording at least three in seven of the last nine games.

WELCOME BACK, PART 1

- The first two Tigers to make successful returns to the lineup after missing action to start the season with injuries were **Annor Boateng** and **Trent Burns**.
- Boateng missed the season's first five games and is now tallying 4.3 points in nine games.
- After missing his true freshman season and the first six games this year, Burns made his debut on Nov. 25 with seven points, three boards and one block versus South Carolina State.

BIG VICTORY

- The Tigers made an early statement on Nov. 12, posting an 83-60 victory over Minnesota.
- The 23-point win marks the largest for MU in 147 games versus the Big Ten Conference – surpassing its previous high of 22 (Illinois in 2022).

MITCHELL EARNS PRESEASON NODS

- Senior **Mark Mitchell** is one of the top returners in the SEC and in the nation this season.
- Mitchell is one of 50 players named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Preseason Watch List – which is presented to the men's national player of the year by the USBWA.
- The senior was also named to the Preseason All-SEC Second Team.
- Mitchell leads Mizzou with 17.2 points and 5.1 rebounds in 15 games this campaign, while ranking second with 3.0 assists.

TOP RETURNING SCORER

- Senior **Mark Mitchell** led the Tigers in scoring as a junior and is back for more in 2025-26.
- Mitchell tallied 13.9 points per game – shooting 50.5 percent from the field and leading the team in free-throws made (142) and attempts (212).
- In fact, Mitchell's 13.9 points are the most by a returning Tiger since Marcus Denmon in 2011-12 (he averaged 16.9 in 2010-11).

TIGERS SIGNS TOP CLASS

- The Tigers made a splash in November by signing one of the nation's top-ranked recruiting class.
- MU signed **Jason Crowe Jr.** (No. 5 in ESPN100), **Toni Bryant** (No. 14) and **Aidan Chronister** (No. 83).
- Overall, Mizzou originally had the No. 1 class on signing day and now ranks No. 2 nationally, behind Duke and its top-ranked class.

BREAKOUT CANDIDATE

- Anthony Robinson II has been identified as one to watch this season.
- Robinson was named one of 10 breakout players for the 2025-26 campaign by Andy Katz and one of 20 by Jon Rothstein.
- Robinson tallied 9.0 points per game during his sophomore season, leading Mizzou with 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

RETURNING EXPERIENCE

- The Tigers are ready to take on the 2025-26 campaign with a number of familiar faces.
- Mizzou is the only team in the SEC with three returning starters from last season with **Mark Mitchell**, **Trent Pierce** and **Anthony Robinson II** all back for MU.
- Overall, it marks the first time that MU returns three starters since the 2020-21 campaign.

FLYING HIGH

- There is one thing you can't teach on the court and that is height, which Mizzou owns a lot of.
- The Tigers average height in 2025-26 is 79.79 inches (nearly 6-foot-8).
- Mizzou's height is nearly an inch taller than the second-previous tallest team in school history (79.00 in 2017-18) and more than a half inch taller than any other team in the SEC.

- Trent Burns (7-5) is also tied for the tallest player in MU history and second tallest player nationally.

CREWS IMPROVEMENT

- Jacob Crews' strong shooting early this season shouldn't be much of a surprise as he finished his first season in the Black & Gold strong as well.
- In his last 14 games of 2024-25, Crews shot 38.9 percent from 3-point range after sinking 29.2 percent in his first 19 games at Mizzou.
- Crews has gone even further this season as he is now averaging 13.1 points with a 3-point mark of 50.0 percent.
- Crews has connected on a team-best 39 triples through 15 games this season – last season, he had 17 through the season's first 15 contests.

MITCHELL DOES IT ALL FOR MIZZOU

- Mark Mitchell is not just a scorer and does a little bit of everything for the Tigers.
- Mitchell led the team in scoring (13.9) last season, second in rebounds (4.7), third in assists (64), fifth in steals (32) and first in blocks (25).
- In fact, Mitchell was one of just 14 players in the nation to total 450 points, 150 rebounds, 60 assists, 30 steals and 25 blocks last season.

LEARNING FROM THE POINT GOD

- Anthony Robinson II spent some of his summer learning from Chris Paul as he was one of 12 players nationally to earn an invite to his camp.
- Robinson participated in the Chris Paul Elite Guard Camp from July 29 to August 1 this summer.

OH CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

- Two Tigers are set to serve as team captains during the 2025-26 campaign.
- Mark Mitchell and Anthony Robinson II are both set to serve in leadership roles this season.

- In the front office, former MU players include **Josh Kroenke** (Nuggets President), **Quin Snyder** (Hawks coach), **DeMarre Carroll** (Suns assistant), **Larry Drew** (Clippers assistant) and **Jarrett Sutton** (Pelicans scout).

NBA FAMILY TIES

- A pair of current Tigers have family ties that reach to the NBA.

In just three seasons as Whitten Family Men's Basketball Head Coach, Dennis Gates has made an immediate impact and reestablished University of Missouri on the national stage. Now in his fourth year on the Mizzou sideline, he aims to build off his early progress as the Tigers chase championships with him leading the program.

MISSOURI

- Named SEC Coach of the Year by USA Today in 2022-23.
- Named to the Naismith Coach of the Year Watch List twice in his three seasons, finishing as a top-10 semifinalist in 2025.
- Led Mizzou two NCAA Tournament bids (2023 and 2025) in his three seasons, including the program's first postseason victory in 13 years and first-ever appearance in the SEC Semifinals in 2023.
- His 25 victories 2022-23 are the fifth-most by any first-year SEC coach in conference history – trailing only Tubby Smith, John Calipari, Eddie Sutton and Trent Johnson.
- Led the Tigers to 12 wins over ranked teams, including three top-five wins in 2024-25 – a first for Mizzou since 1988-89.
- Two Tigers have played in the NBA after playing for Gates – Kobe Brown (LA Clippers) and D'Moi Hodge (LA Lakers). Overall, seven Tigers have joined NBA or G-League franchises in Gates' three seasons at Mizzou.
- Coached two All-SEC honorees, one SEC Sixth Man of the Year, one SEC All-Defensive Team honoree and two SEC Scholar-Athletes of the Year.

CLEVELAND STATE

- 2019-20 and 2020-21 Horizon League Coach of the Year.
- Rebuilt the Vikings program – winning 50 games, including a 39-19 mark his final two seasons.
- Won two Horizon League regular-season titles (2020, 2021) and the 2021 Horizon League Tournament crown.
- Led the Vikings to the 2021 NCAA Tournament – the school's first trip in 12 years – and 2022 Postseason NIT.
- Mentored two Horizon League Defensive Players of the Year plus five all-conference and five All-Defensive Team honorees.

FLORIDA STATE

- Spent eight seasons on Leonard Hamilton's staff at FSU, mirroring the Seminoles' rise to national prominence.
- FSU advanced to four NCAA Tournament in his eight years, including the Elite Eight in 2018 and Sweet 16 in 2012 and 2019.
