EXPERIENCE: 9th season at UAB

Randy Norton enters his ninth season as the UAB women's basketball team in the 2021-22 season.

Since Norton arrived on campus in 2013, he has guided the Blazers to at least 15 wins in seven of the last eight seasons. From 2017-2020, he led the Green and Gold to three consecutive 20 win seasons for the first time in school history. He led UAB to its first C-USA Regular Season title in 2017-18. Norton was named the 2017-18 C-USA Coach of the Year after leading the Blazers to a record-setting 27-7 overall record and a 13-3 conference record. The Blazers finished with 12 or more conference wins from 2017-2020.

The Blazers have also found success in the classroom under the direction of Norton. The team has recorded 12 straight semesters with a 3.0 GPA and twice earned the Conference USA Academic Excellence Award (2017-18, 2019-20).

2020-21 (10-13, 3-11 - 6th place)

- Became the second winningest coach in program history after UAB's 78-58 win over Chattanooga on Dec. 6, surpassing Audra Smith's 138 wins
- Coached three players to All-Conference USA Teams, with Margaret Whitley and Zakyia Weathersby being named to the All-Conference USA Second Team and Caitlynn Daniels to the All-Freshman Team
- All 15 student-athletes on the roster made the 2020-21 Conference USA Honor Roll, with four earning the C-USA Commissioner's Academic Medal

2019-20 (20-11, 12-6 - 5th place)

- Guided the Blazers to their third straight 20 win season for the first time in program history and third straight season with 12 or more conference wins
- Coached two players to All-Conference honors, including three-time All-Conference First Team selection Rachael Childress
- Earned a win over in-state rival Auburn (Nov. 21) for the first time since 1992
- Gave Old Dominion two of their six losses including an OT victory in Norfolk (March 5) to give the Monarchs their only home loss of the season
- Set program record for 3-point FG% in a season (38.1%) which ranks third best in C-USA single-season history
- Coached Rachael Childress to Top-5 NCAA All-Time 3-pointers made, C-USA career record for 3-pointers made and UAB program record for 3-pointers made
- Over a dozen players named to C-USA Commissioner's Honor Roll
- Two players earned C-USA Commissioner's Academic Medal
- Two players named CoSIDA District 4 All-Academic First Team
- Conference USA Academic Excellence Award winners

2018-19 (26-7, 12-4 - 2nd place) WNIT Second Round

- Led the Blazers to a second straight 25+ win season going 26-7 overall and 12-4 in C-USA play
- Coached three players to All-Conference honors, including two-time first-team All Conference selection Rachael Childress
- Went on a 10 game win streak from Nov. 28-Jan. 5, the longest in his time at UAB
- Guided UAB to the second round of the WNIT tournament, defeating Troy in the first round 93-89



- Statement victory over Oklahoma in the Bahamas Nov. 22
- Set program records for 3-pointers made (291) and triples attempted (811), triples in a game (18) against Coppin State Dec. 20
- Nine players named to C-USA Commissioner's Honor Roll
- Three players C-USA Commissioner's Academic Medal earners

2017-18 (27-7, 13-3 - 1st place) WNIT Second Round

- Guided the Blazers to their first-ever Conference USA Regular Season title, the program's first title since winning the 1993-94 Great Midwest Regular Season crown
- Named Conference USA Coach of the Year, the first UAB coach to garner the recognition in the C-USA era and the first Coach of the Year award winner since Jeannie Milling earned Sun Belt Coach of the Year honors in 1989-90
- UAB recorded the most wins in program history with a 27-7 overall recorded, while their 13-3 record in C-USA play was the most in conference wins in school history
- Helped UAB earn its first 20-win season since 2010-11 and the ninth all-time
- Finished 72 in the women's basketball RPI and remained in the top-100 throughout conference play for the first time in program history
- Coached the Green and Gold to their first appearance in the postseason since the 2010-11 season
- Guided UAB to its first postseason victory since winning the WBI title game, 68-60, over Cal State Bakersfield on March 27, 2011 and its first win in the WNIT since an 81-77 decision over Davidson on March 15, 2007 with its 60-50 win over Chattanooga
- Saw the team break multiple school records, including made 3-pointers in a season (267), 3-point field goal percentage (37.6), assists (590), assist/turnover ratio (1.5), while breaking single-game school records in made 3-pointers (17) and assists (34)
- Three All-Conference USA players in Rachael Childress (first team), Deanna Kuzmanic (first team) and Miyah Barnes (first team)
- Rachael Childress earned Conference USA Player of the Week (02/05/18) as well as National Player of the Week as part of the NCAA Starting Five (02/07/18)
- Deanna Kuzmanic was named to the Academic All-Conference team for the second time in her career, becoming the third player in program history to garner the recognition twice. She also was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District 4 team, the second player in program history to do so
- Under Norton, Kuzmanic became the 28th member of UAB's 1,000-point club with a career-high 35 points against Louisiana Tech on Feb. 24
- Conference USA Academic Excellence Award winners

2016-17 (15-15, 7-11 (T-8th place)

- The Blazers shot a UAB record 37.3 percent from the 3-point line
- UAB drained 218 3-pointers, the second most by a team in a single season in program history
- The Blazers connected on 187 3-pointers in league action, breaking the C-USA record for 3-pointers made by a team in a single season
- UAB's 37.3 percent from beyond the arc in league play marked fifth-highest percentage shot by a team in C-USA history
- The Blazers 58-point victory over Miles was the second largest win in program history
- Rachael Childress took home the 2017 Freshman of the Year award, just the fourth Blazer to earn the honor
- Two All-Freshman team members in Rachael Childress and Miyah Barnes
- Sophomore Deanna Kuzmanic earned the league's Spirit of Service Award, which aims to recognize the community service efforts of the league's student-athletes, based upon significant community service, good academic standing and participation in their elected sports
- Kuzmanic was one of just five players named to the league's all-academic team. In order to be eligible, student-athletes have to maintain a 3.2 GPA and be a valuable contributor to the team. Kuzmanic joins four other student-athletes
- 2015-16
- The Blazers held their opponents to the lowest rebound average in UAB history (32.7)
- UAB tallied 130 blocked shots, the third most by a team in program history
- The Blazers led C-USA in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 57.2 points per contest
- Chelsea Black and Brittany Winborne were named to the All-Conference USA Second Team
- Deanna Kuzmanic garnered C-USA All-Freshman Team honors
- The Blazers recorded a 3.39 cumulative team GPA, the highest team mark since 2006

2014-15 (21-13, 11-7 - T-4th place)

- Finished the season with an 18-13 record and 11-7 mark in league play
- UAB's 36.1 percent mark from long range ranks second for 3-point field goal percentage in program history



- The team drained 198 3-pointers, the fourth most by a team in program history
- The Blazers shot a combined 75.2 percent (361-of-480) from the free-throw line, the second highest percentage in program history
- Janae Smith earned a spot on the First-Team All-Conference USA squad

2013-14 (16-15, 7-9 (8th place))

- UAB shot 33.7 percent from deep, the sixth highest percentage in program history
- The Blazers swatted 141 shots, the most by a team in UAB history
- Karisma Chapman earned First-Team All-Conference USA honors after averaging 20.6 points per game including 16 double-doubles in her senior campaign

Prior to UAB

Prior to UAB, Norton spent three years as the Associate Head Coach at Missouri and seven years as an assistant at Illinois State under Robin Pingeton. In ten years as an assistant, Norton helped guide his teams to six postseason berths, including the 2005 and 2008 NCAA Tournament.

Playing Career

A 1986 graduate of the University of Iowa, Norton played both basketball and baseball for the Hawkeyes. On the hardwood, he was a guard on 1979 Big Ten Conference title team and the 1980 team that advanced to the NCAA Final Four.

On the diamond, Norton was a four-year letterwinner for the Hawkeyes. He spent three seasons in the Montreal Expos (now Washington Nationals) organization before moving into coaching.

Personal

An Iowa City, Iowa, native, Norton and his wife Claire, have four children: Tom, Carly, Allie and Nick along with nine grandchildren. Tom and Allie graduated from Truman State, Carly graduated from St. Ambrose, where all three played college basketball. Nick is a graduate from UAB and was a three-year starter at point guard for the men's basketball team before finishing his career at Drake University. Nick played for the South Bay Lakers, the G-League affiliate for the Los Angeles Lakers, during the 2019-20 season.

UAB LATELY

UAB (2-0) was led by Zakyia Weathersby's game-high 26 points in the Blazers' 81-50 victory over Chicago State on Saturday afternoon. Margaret Whitley added 11 and Maria Roters scored 10 for the Blazers. Weathersby leads Conference USA with 20.0 ppg and 11.0 rpg.

MVSU LATELY

MVSU (0-1) fell to Ole Miss 94-44 in its only game this season. Ronni Williams led the Delta Devilettes with 12 points.

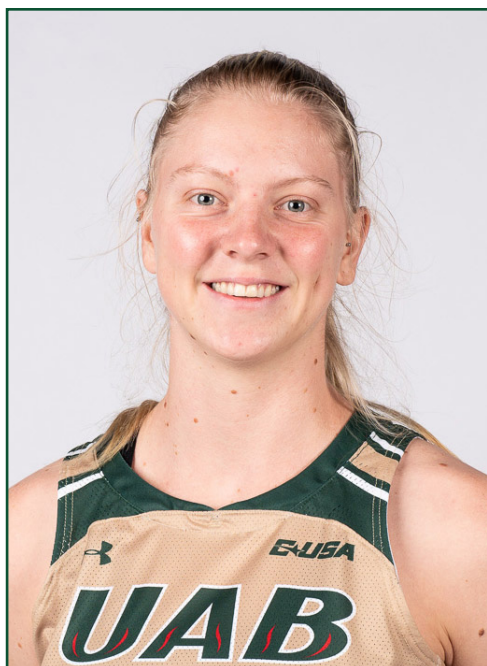
