Today's game marks the final regular and home game for the Panthers. The seniors will be celebrated as they play on Blackshear Field for their last hooray. The best part is the celebration just won't end with the seniors, they will also celebrate their 2021 season as the SWAC Western Division Champions.

#### How it Happened:

Freshman Jaden Stewart had an impressive outing in the 52-3 loss to FBS ranked 16 Texas A&M Saturday at Kyle Field. Panthers claims 2021 Western Division Title.

In one of the toughest games of the season Stewart ran for his first career 100 yard game against the only highest-ranked FBS opponent this season.

The Panthers got a 25 yard field goal from Luis Reyes in the bottom of the third quarter to give PVAMU their only score of the game.

Senior Drake Cheatum led the Panthers defense with 12 tackles and one INT, while senior Tre'Shaud Smith had seven tackles and one pass break up. Seven of Cheatum's tackles were solo stops.

#### What to know about the Panthers:

- As a team PV is ranked 27th allowing 1,211 rushing yards.
- Raked 32 averaging 2.50 sacks per game

#### Who to watch:

- Cheatum currently ranks 7th in FCS with five INT's
- Jawon Pass ranks in the top 35 for total yards with 2,365 yards posted on the season. Pass is averaging 263 yards per contest after gathering a total of 2,365 on the season.
- Stewart leads the Panthers on the ground with 504 total rushing yards he is averaging 56 yards per game.
- Mullins leads the receivers with 478 catch and go yards averaging 53 yards per game
- Darius Campbell and Jamias Presley each rank in the top 25 with 11 pass break ups apiece

#### Scouting the Delta Devils:

Mississippi Valley is 3-7 on the season winning their last contest against the Hornets of Alabama State 44-31

- Caleb Johnson leads the team in rushing with a total of 786 yards averaging 78.6 yards per game.
- Jalani Eason leads the Delta Devils in the air averaging 135.2 per game. He has nine touchdowns on the season
- Jacory Rankin is MVSU's top receiver with a total of 603 receiving yard averaging 60.3 per contests.
- Defensively Valley is led by Keonte' Daniels, who has a total of 60 tackles, two INT, six Pass Break Ups and one force fumble.

# PRAIRIE VIEW A&M



**ERIC DOOLEY**

**HEAD COACH 4TH SEASON - SOUTHERN-NEW ORLEANS '99**

Entering his fourth season on The Hill, Eric Dooley was named Prairie View A&M University's head football coach on December 22, 2017. Under Dooley, the Panthers have become one of the nation's most explosive and productive offenses in the country.

The 2019 campaign saw the Panthers post a 6-5 record, including another State Fair Classic win over Grambling and continued dominance over Texas Southern in the Labor Day Classic.

The Panthers ranked No. 4 nationally in total offense while garnering top 25 rankings in passing offense, rushing offense, scoring offense, passing efficiency, passing defensive efficiency and sacks allowed. The Panthers led the SWAC in total offense and ranked second -- 35th nationally -- in total defense. Individually, seven Panthers earned all-conference honors, including Dawonya Tucker, who became statistically one of the top all-purpose threats in the country, and Jaylen Harris, who ranked second nationally in passes defended.

Under Dooley's tutelage, Tucker and quarterback Jalen Morton rewrote PVAMU record books with their on-field exploits. In his first season on The Hill, the Panthers became the first team in program history to have three 60-point scoring games in one season.

PVAMU ended the season with back-to-back 60-point games against Alabama St. (66-13) and Texas Southern (60-14) while recording the largest margin of victory over the archrival Tigers in program history. PVAMU set a school record with 815 yards total offense in a win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff in which QB Jalen Morton set a single-game school record with 255 rushing yards.

Dooley, the 33rd head coach in program history, joined Panther Football after spending the previous four seasons at Grambling State University as offensive coordinator (2014-17), including one year as quarterbacks coach (2014) and two years as receivers coach (2016-17). Dooley helped the Tigers to three consecutive Southwestern Athletic Conference Western Division titles (2015-17), two SWAC Championships (2016-17), and an HBCU National Championship (2016).

While at GSU, his offenses averaged at least 31 points per game in all four seasons, and ranked first or second in the SWAC in scoring offense each of the last three seasons. In 2016, he was named American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Assistant Coach of the Year. Under Dooley's guidance in 2015, Grambling ranked fourth in the nation in scoring (41.3 points per game), scored 65 touchdowns, and

averaged 470.0 yards per game. The Tigers have produced the SWAC Offensive Player of the Year each of the last three seasons (QB Johnathan Williams 2015, QB Devante Kincade 2016-17).

A pair of players during Dooley's tenure are currently in the NFL (2016 free agent WR Chester Rogers -- Indianapolis Colts, 2017 third-round draft pick Chad Williams -- Arizona Cardinals). In three seasons as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Arkansas-Pine Bluff (2011-13), the Golden Lions offense improved each year under his direction.

In 2011, QB Ben Anderson earned SWAC Freshman of the Year accolades while ranking second in the league in passing offense. In 2012, UAPB set a school record for wins (10), and won its first outright SWAC Championship since 1966 and were crowned HBCU National Champions.

During Dooley's tenure, tackle Terron Armstead became a third-round pick by the New Orleans Saints in the 2013 NFL Draft. Those seven seasons as offensive coordinator were preceded by 14 years as an assistant coach in various roles at Southern University (1997-2010). In his one season as running backs coach (1997), he helped to produce a pair of All-SWAC rushers,

including SWAC Player of the Year, Steve Wofford. As receivers coach at Southern (1997-2010), he developed the two most prolific receivers in school history (Michael Hayes, Juamorris Stewart).

Dooley played wide receiver at Grambling under legendary coach Eddie Robinson (1985 -- 1988), winning two SWAC Championships. He earned his Bachelor's degree from Southern University New Orleans (1999), and his Master's degree from Southern University Baton Rouge (2005).

His professional playing experience includes earning a free agent contract with the Canadian Football League's Calgary Stampeders, one year with the AFL's Arizona Rattlers and one year with the World League's Taipei Dragons (China). He also spent time coaching at his alma mater, Alcee For-tier Senior High, as the wide receiver coach, and as offensive coordinator at McMain High School, both in New Orleans, La. Some of his off-field activities include being a member of the American Football Coaches Association as well as being a member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated.

Dooley and his wife, Alicia, enjoy the gift of three children, Taajah, Kattera, and Dy'mond.

## PANTHER STADIUM

The state-of-the-art Panther Stadium officially opened its doors on Sunday, Sept. 4, 2016 with the Labor Day Classic.

That night, nearly 15,000 spectators saw PVAMU take down Texas Southern 29-25 in another thrilling chapter between these cross-town rivals.

Panther Stadium seats 15,000 and is home to the 55,000-square foot Athletics Administration Building which sits in the

west end of the stadium.

The stadium sits in the former home of the original Blackshear Field that hosted Prairie View A&M's football and track teams from 1948 to 2014.

The Panthers currently hold a 12-6 home record since the opening of Panther Stadium at Blackshear Field. In this venue's still growing history, the Panthers have never had a losing record in a given season.

# 2021 SWAC CHAMPIONS

## 2021 WOMEN'S INDOOR TRACK & FIELD

The Southwestern Athletic Conference Indoor Track and Field Champions won the crown for the first time since 1989.

The Lady Panthers scored 172 points, easily outdistancing defending champion Alabama State (141.5). UAPB (90.5), Southern (55) and Alabama A&M (49) rounded out the top five.

Kaizha Roberts was named the Most Outstanding Field Performer for the meet, winning the long jump and taking the silver medal in the triple jump and 60 meter dash. PVAMU Head Coach Angela Williams was named the conference's coach of the year.



## 2021 SWAC WOMEN'S BOWLING

The Prairie View A&M bowling team took the long road, but the journey proved worth it in the end.

Thrust into the unenviable task of defeating Jackson State twice to win the Southwestern Athletic Conference Women's Bowling Tournament, the Lady Panthers did just that, defeating the Lady Tigers in a pair of 4-2 decisions for the program's fifth tournament championship.



## 2021 SWAC MEN'S GOLF

The Prairie View A&M men's golf team stormed to the top of the leaderboard to claim the 2021 Southwestern Athletic Conference Men's Golf Championship and have won three consecutive championships.

Lorenzo Elbert dominated the links, taking home Low Medalist and First Team All-SWAC honors with a three-round total of 213. Elbert was the lone golfer to shoot under par throughout the championships, finishing 3-under. PVAMU finished ahead of runner-up Alabama State by 10 strokes.



## 2021 SWAC OUTDOOR TRACK & FIELD

The 2021 Southwestern Athletic Conference Outdoor Track and Field Championships PVAMU never looked back to take the crown, the team's first since 2018.

Anchored by consistent efforts across the board – with particularly impressive outings in the pole vault, decathlon, long jump, and relay events – Prairie View A&M would go to the podium 13 more times throughout the meet to maintain its grip on the lead.

The Panthers capped their title-winning effort with a dramatic nail-biter of a finish in the 4x400 meter relay – where Timothy Demeritt overtook Jackson State in the final moments – and racked up a grand total of 204 points to easily outpace runner up Alabama State.

Sunne Rodriguez-Weems and Wote both scored 30 points, with the latter earning Most Outstanding Track Performer honors during the meet. Head Coach Chris Clay was named SWAC Coach of the Year.

### DE Quinton Bell - Oakland Raiders, 7th Round, 230th Pick

Bell is the first draft pick from Prairie View A&M since Matthew Teague who was drafted by the Dallas Cowboys in the tenth round in 1981. Bell made the transition from wide receiver to defensive end in his final season with the Panthers. In the 2015 he played in six games and caught two passes for 24 yards. During the 2016 season, Bell started in three games and appeared in 10 games where he caught nine passes for 138 yards and one touchdown against Rice (10/22) and caught two passes against Jackson St. (10/29) for 28 yards. In his final season as wide receiver he also caught eight passes for 97 yards. In 2018 the Bell made the switch to defensive end making 14 solo tackles and 32 tackles for a total 46 tackles in his senior season. He had 7.5 sacks for 38 yards.
