THIS GAME

- » The Lopes host Mississippi Valley State tonight before playing five of the next seven away from GCU Arena.
- » With a win, GCU would clinch its best start to a D-I season. The Lopes are currently tied for their best start at 7-1.
- » This will be the sixth meeting in the last seven seasons between the Lopes and Delta Devils.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Despite struggling in rebounding and free-throw shooting, the Lopes grinded out a win over UTSA.
- » GCU pushed through to win a game when being outrebounded by 15+ for the first time at the D-I level.
- » Jovan Blacksher Jr. set a career high with 25 points, topping his previous best of 22 set against Nevada last year.

STORYLINES

- » The Lopes feature four players that shoot over 38% from 3-point range (min. 10 makes) in Jovan Blacksher, Holland Woods, Gabe McGlothan and Chance McMillian. Only six other schools can claim that: Loyola Chicago, Oral Roberts, Purdue, South Dakota State, Villanova.
- » GCU has matched its 2015-16 team for best start (7-1) to a season in the D-I era. The Lopes finished that season 27-7.
- » Jovan Blacksher Jr. ranks among the nation's top 100 in numerous stats, highlighted by assist-to-turnover ratio (29th, 3.36), steals (30th, 17), and field goal att. (31st, 117).
- » The Lopes have logged 10 or more offensive rebounds in all but one game this season and rank ninth nationally in the category (14.9 per game).
- » GCU is one of three WAC schools to rank in the top 150 in KenPom ratings, checking in at 132. New Mexico State is 113 and Stephen F. Austin is 145.
- » The Lopes rank 12th nationally in rebound margin (+10.8).
- » Holland Woods II ranks 29th among active D-I players in career scoring with 1,651 points.
- » GCU was picked to finish second (behind NM State) by the WAC's head coaches. Jovan Blacksher Jr. was a consensus first-team All-WAC preseason pick, while Holland Woods II landed on the media's second team.



An 88-49 blowout at GCU Arena marked the fourthlargest victory margin in the Lopes' Division I era.

The Lopes' motors were slow to warm up, but they revved up to turn the Delta Devils into Dust Devils with a 36-8 stretch that lasted 16 minutes at GCU Arena.

GCU moved to 3-0 by winning points in the paint, 56-4, and holding a third consecutive opponent to less than 40% shooting. This one was even stingier with Mississippi Valley State hitting 28.8% of its shots and only 20% from inside the arc, surviving on 13 makes from 3-point range. That made for plenty of rebounds, giving GCU its greatest rebounding advantage of its Division I era at plus-30 (56-26).



» PRESEASON ALL-WAC HONOREES

The Lopes fared well in the All-WAC preseason polling of the conference's head coaches. GCU is slotted in at No. 2 in the WAC standings with two players earning preseason recognition in the expanded conference.

Jovan Blacksher Jr. - Preseason All-WAC first team (consensus)

Blacksher progressed from WAC Freshman of the Year to earning All-WAC second team and WAC Tournament Most Valuable Player last season. He ranked second in the WAC and 31st nationally at 5.4 assists per game, a 50% bump from his freshman year while also increasing his scoring and steals averages to 12.0 and 1.6, respectively. He also improved to 80.7% free-throw shooting and 32.3 3-point shooting.



Hollands Woods II - Preseason All-WAC second team (media)

Woods, a graduate of nearby Apollo High School, started 12 of 25 games as an ASU senior last season while shooting 32% on a 3-pointers. The graduate transfer was Portland State's playmaker for his first three seasons, culminating in a 2019-20 campaign with averages of 17.7 points, 5.2 assists and 2.1 steals. Entering GCU with 99 career starts, Woods ranks 23rd in the nation for career points (1,555).





Homer was a head coach for 34 seasons including 22 seasons leading the Valparaiso program. He amassed 640 career victories and is a member of the College Basketball Hall of Fame. He now resides in Phoenix with his wife, Janet.

Scott was an assistant under Homer at Valparaiso before taking the reins of the Baylor program in 2003. He is one of the top-20 longest tenured head coaches in D-I men's basketball, leading the Bears to the 2021 National Championship in what some characterized as one of the greatest rebuilds in sports history. Scott has amassed 397 wins as a head coach.

Bryce played under both Homer (head coach) and Scott (assistant coach) at Valpo before taking over the program in 2011 and accumulating 124 wins in five seasons. Add 40 more at Vanderbilt and Bryce has 188 as a head coach.

Scott and Bryce account for two of the 16 current D-I coaches whose fathers also coached D-I basketball.

The 6-foot-3 point guard, who also played for the Chicago Bulls and New Orleans Hornets, was known for his perimeter shot (37% 3-point shooting).

» LOCKER ROOM REVAMP

Home for the Grand Canyon basketball players might not be their campus apartments any longer. An offseason remodel expanded and modernized the teams' spaces and opened just in time for the 2021-22 season.


A purple archway leads each team first into a player lounge, which was added as part of 350 additional square feet of player space for each team. Those rooms are equipped with massage chairs, refrigerators, 98-inch televisions and new recessed lighting.

The locker room impresses with video boards of each player's photo embedded with graphic designs over each locker. Overhead, a giant GCU logo shines down with purple lighting washing the ceiling.

"I like the lights," junior Jovan Blacksher Jr. said. "It's got the purple and you can't even tell where it's coming from.

"My first year, we had a good locker room but this went to a whole different level."

"I love it," fifth-year player Sean Miller-Moore said. "Way more spacious. I think we deserve it. Hopefully, we can make it last with some dubs. We've got the music going and we can set the vibe to get ready to play or lift or whatever it is."



» LOPES RETURN DOWNTOWN

GCU is returning to downtown Phoenix for the Jerry Colangelo Classic. The Lopes will take on San Francisco on Dec. 18 at Footprint Center.

"We are thrilled to be a part of the Hall of Fame's Jerry Colangelo Classic and to be playing in downtown Phoenix," Bryce Drew said. "Being in our hometown NBA arena will be a great experience for both our players and our fans. We played San Francisco last year and know how strong of a program they are, so we are looking forward to another opportunity to compete against them."



GCU will be part of a quadruple-header event that also features Gonzaga vs. Texas Tech, USC vs. Georgia Tech and Northern Arizona vs. San Diego. Including the Lopes, the field includes five teams that qualified for the 2021 NCAA tournament.

This will be the second consecutive year that GCU will pair up with San Francisco at a neutral site. The Lopes and Dons were originally set to meet in the 2020 Colangelo Classic, but after the event's cancellation, the matchup took place in the Far West Classic at Las Vegas' T-Mobile Arena. The Dons came away with a 68-65 victory.

"Coach Drew has done a great job in a short period of time at GCU," San Francisco head coach Todd Golden said, "and playing them in the Phoenix Suns Arena is the kind of game that will prepare us well for our conference slate."

Last season, Golden's Dons got off to a 10-7 start against a difficult nonconference schedule that featured an upset win over No. 4 Virginia. San Francisco ended the regular season on a six-game skid and went 1-1 in the WCC Tournament.


GCU returns to the venue for the fourth time in five years and will compete in the third straight iteration of the Colangelo Classic.



With a win over Utah Valley in the regular-season finale, GCU clinched a share of its first ever WAC regular-season title. At 9-3, the Lopes finished with the conference's best record and clinched the WAC Tournament's top seed in Bryce Drew's first season as head coach.



On the 23rd anniversary of Bryce Drew's making of "The Shot," he led Grand Canyon to its first WAC Tournament title and first trip to the NCAA tournament. The Lopes bucked the trend of championship game losses to conference power New Mexico State by dominating the Aggies to a 15-point halftime lead and 18-point victory.

Bryce Drew is in his second season as Grand Canyon's men's basketball head coach in 2021-22 after being named the 14th head coach in program history prior to the 2020-21 campaign.

Drew wasted no time getting acclimated to his new school, leading the Lopes to their first appearance in the D-I NCAA tournament in his inaugural season. GCU won its first WAC regular-season title and its first WAC tournament title, advancing to March Madness and a date with No. 2 seeded Iowa. The Lopes went 17-7 overall and 9-3 in conference play amid a season plagued by the coronavirus pandemic. In a span of 12 months, Drew recruited new players (including WAC Newcomer of the Year Asbjørn Midtgaard), established a new culture and program identity and won a pair of WAC titles, all while facing various levels of practice restrictions and testing requirements due to COVID-19.

The Drew era opened with four straight victories including an impressive 87-77 win over Nevada at GCU Arena. The Lopes won their first seven WAC games including the school's first sweep of New Mexico State. On the regular season's final day, GCU defeated Utah Valley to win its first regular-season title and claim the top seed in the conference's tournament.

GCU had a dominant run in the 2021 WAC tournament, defeating No. 5 seed Seattle U 81-47 and No. 3 New Mexico State 74-56.

Drew made his fourth appearance in the NCAA tournament as a head coach, doing so at three different schools.

Prior to GCU, Drew has had successful head coaching stops at his alma mater, Valparaiso, and at Vanderbilt, where he qualified for his third NCAA tournament visit as a head coach in 2017. Drew enters GCU with a career coaching record of 164-108 (.603), including a program-record season of 30 wins in his final year at Valparaiso.

Drew averaged 25 wins per season at Valparaiso and won the Horizon League regular-season championship four times during his five-year tenure (2011-16). He led the Crusaders to their first NCAA tournament berth in nine years with 2013 and 2015 visits.

Drew moved to Vanderbilt to take on the SEC challenge in 2016 and coached his first Commodores team to five wins against top-25 teams and an NCAA tournament berth. He came to the Phoenix area to land his first Vanderbilt recruit, Saben Lee, who starred in the 2019-20 season with 18.6 points and 4.2 assists per game.

In 2017, Drew assembled the greatest recruiting class in Vanderbilt history when he signed two five-star prospects. One of those players, Darius Garland, played only five games that season but was drafted fifth by the Cleveland Cavaliers in the 2019 NBA Draft.

In 2019-20, Drew worked as an ESPN studio and game analyst, visited college and pro coaches and spent time with his wife, Tara, and 5-year-old son, Bryson. Drew's Christian faith has been embedded in his life, as a Fellowship of Christian Athletes member, Athletes in Action player and a coach at faith-based universities.

Drew played six NBA seasons after being drafted 16th overall by the Houston Rockets in 1998, where he started 41 games in 2000-01. In 1999, the NBA awarded him with the Henry P. Iba Citizen Athlete Award for sportsmanship.

The 6-foot-3 point guard, who also played for the Chicago Bulls and New Orleans Hornets, was known for his perimeter shot (37% 3-point shooting) but he is most famous for "The Shot" he made in the 1998 NCAA tournament to lead the No. 13 seeded Valparaiso Crusaders over No. 4 seeded Ole Miss.

Valpo kept the Cinderella slipper for another round, beating Florida State to become the program's first Sweet 16 team. Drew finished with a school-record 2,142 points. He averaged 17.7 points and 5.2 assists for his career, which ended with All-America third-team honors. His No. 24 was retired.

Drew comes from a basketball family and played for his dad Homer at Valparaiso. His brother Scott began his coaching career at Valparaiso in 2002 and has since turned the Baylor basketball program around with a 379-222 record in 18 seasons and a 2021 national championship. Drew's sister Dana was a Mid-American Conference Player of the Year at Toledo.

Grand Canyon University Arena is Phoenix's premier mid-sized indoor venue and serves as the primary home of Lopes men's and women's basketball and men's and women's volleyball teams as well as a wide assortment of university-sponsored and outside events.

The arena has provided the Lopes a definitive homecourt advantage since opening its doors before the 2011-12 basketball season. With a seating capacity of 7,000 and a prime location on campus, the venue is regularly packed to the rafters with students and fans, providing an electric atmosphere ripe for success. Since its opening, the men's basketball team has been dominant in the arena, posting an overall record of 134-35 (.793), including five seasons of at least 15 wins.

GCU Arena hit new levels in 2018-19. With an average crowd of 7,170 fans, GCU Arena was the fullest venue in college basketball with a percent capacity of 102.42%.

Home attendance has tripled since the arrival of the arena, with a per-game average of over 7,100 fans coming through the doors in 2018-19. While crowds of over 7,000 used to represent milestones, it has become a common occurrence at GCU Arena. All but two nonconference games were filled above the arena's 7,000seat capacity in the 2018-19 season.

The facility originally broke ground in the summer of 2010 and was completed before the start of the following basketball season. It is owned and operated by the university.



The Havocs are some of the most dedicated and rowdy fans in all of collegiate sports. Often 3,500 students strong, they turn GCU athletic venues into some of the rowdiest environments in all of college sports.

Known for their constant energy, support and pride, the Havocs support and encourage GCU athletic teams, promote school spirit and build Lope pride.

Tabbed as the "Biggest Party in College Basketball," the Havocs bring the noise and excitement every game with different cheers and chants to give every team a competitive advantage when playing at home. In 2018, GCU Arena was ranked 22nd in the country for best college basketball atmospheres, and was quoted as "easily one of the rowdiest fan bases in the entire country.".



The Havocs mission is is to be the most spirited, energetic and disruptive student section in the country. Havocs strive to create the most unique game day experience in college basketball and a sense of camaraderie for all students.

The Havocs cheer at more than just home events, sending droves of students to rival New Mexico State and to the WAC Tournament in Las Vegas. The support has garnered national attention over the past five years including being featured on ESPN's Scott Van Pelt's SportsCenter show.
