LEADING OFF

◆ Arkansas State is beginning its 29th season at Tomlinson Stadium-Kell Field, which was completed in 1993.

◆ **Tommy Raffo** is entering his 14th season at the helm of the A-State baseball program.

◆ **Ben Klutts** has received a good amount of preseason hype, being named All-Sun Belt Conference at third base, as well as earning an all-league nod from Perfect Game. On Tuesday, he was named to the Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award Watch List.

◆ A-State is facing Mississippi Valley State for just the sixth and seventh times in school history, despite the schools being separated by just under 3 1/2 hours. The Red Wolves have won four straight in the all-time series, including outscoring MVSU 28-3 in two games in 2020.

◆ Arkansas State is 10-3 in home openers in the previous 13 seasons under Raffo and 27-3 since 1992 - its first season in the Sun Belt Conference.

◆ Tuesday's contest begins a seven-game home stand for the Red Wolves. Originally a 10-game home stretch, the three-game series against Arkansas-Pine Bluff this past weekend was called off due to effects from recent winter storms in Northeast Arkansas.

SETTING THE STAGE

► Arkansas State is set to open its 2022 home slate Tuesday with the first of two midweek contests against Mississippi Valley State, in what is a delayed Opening Day at Tomlinson Stadium. First pitch is set for 6 p.m. Tuesday, with Wednesday's contest set for a 3 p.m. start. Both games will be broadcast live on ESPN+, while the radio broadcast of both games can be heard on The Ticket Radio Network (95.3/96.9/104.1/970 AM).

ABOUT THE DELTA DEVILS

- Mississippi Valley State enters the weekend with a 2-3 ledger after being swept at Nicholls this past weekend, giving up 10-plus runs in all three ballgames. The Delta Devils' two wins this season came against Rust College on opening weekend in Itta Bena. MVSU was picked last in the SWAC East Division in the preseason.
- Infielder **Darrien Chapman** leads MVSU at the dish with a .500 clip and team-best six RBI, while **Narvin Booker** owns a team-high seven hits entering Tuesday.
- MVSU hits .313 as a team, which leads the SWAC, while being hit by pitch 18 times, which is 12th most nationally. The Delta Devils are also 19th in the NCAA with 17 stolen bases on the year, led by six from infielder **Maury Weaver**.
- The Delta Devils are set to start **Calvin McClendon** on Tuesday, followed by **Isaiah Valenzeula** on Wednesday. McClendon started last Friday's contest at Nicholls, going 4.0 innings and allowing six runs (four earned) with two strikeouts and six walks against the Colonels. Valenzeula started Game 2 against Nicholls, allowing six runs (five earned) on nine hits with three strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
- MVSU, one of six HBCUs in Mississippi, was originally known as Mississippi Vocational College after its establishment in 1950. The university is located five miles from GreenWOOD (home of the Viking Cooking School), not to be confused with Greenville, which is 50 miles away on the banks of the Mississippi River.

TEAM NOTES

"HEART & HUSTLE"

- A pair of Arkansas State baseball standouts were honored prior to the annual Grand Slam Banquet on Monday, Feb. 14, with **Carter Holt** and **Jaylon Deshazier** earning the 2021 and 2022 Ed Way "Heart and Hustle" Awards. Holt's honor coming Monday is due to the event not being held in 2021 due to COVID-19.

LAST TIME OUT

- Arkansas State is looking to record its first win of the young season after dropping a rain-shortened 15-5 decision at No. 3 Ole Miss on Wednesday. **Ben Klutts** homered in the fifth before the Rebels responded with three more in the bottom half of the inning just before unplayable field conditions at Swayze Field forced officials to halt the contest. Klutts recorded a season-best two hits, while **Wil French** and **Brandon Hager** both reached base twice.

"MAMA, I'M COMING HOME"

- After its four-game road swing to open the season, Arkansas State now returns home for seven consecutive home games, the longest home stand since nine consecutive home contests to begin the 2020 season.

"UNDER PRESSURE"

- Arkansas State baseball traditionally plays a pretty tough schedule, and that is no difference this year. This season's slate features two games apiece against Arkansas and Ole Miss, as well as a road series at Missouri State. That's without mentioning this weekend's series against NCAA Tournament participant Samford.
- A-State's schedule includes 11 opponents who finished 2021 with a winning percentage of .500 or better, as well as five who reached the NCAA Tournament.

"OL' MAN RIVER"

- Arkansas State baseball only crosses the mighty Mississippi River for 12 games out of its 55 regular-season contests this season - one of them on the bluffs of Ol' Man River at Memphis in May.
- In those 12 outings, only three are outside of the Central Time Zone... at Georgia Southern.

ON THE WORLDWIDE LEADER

- Currently, 36 games on A-State's regular season schedule will be broadcasted live on one of ESPN's digital broadcast platforms (ESPN+, SEC Network+, etc.), which doesn't include all Sun Belt Conference Tournament outings and any other that may be added as the season progresses.
- While we definitely encourage those unable to make home games to watch live or listen live, nothing replaces the atmosphere of a ballpark *immediately smells hotdogs*

"HOMEGROWN"

- Arkansas State's 2022 roster is full of homegrown talent not just from the state of Arkansas, but the Northeast Arkansas region as well as the nearby Missouri bootheel and Memphis metro area.
- A total of 24 Red Wolves hail from the Natural State, including four Craighead County natives: Wil French (Jonesboro), Sam Fagan (Jonesboro), Jake Algee (Brookland), Sawyer Bentley and Cross Jumper (Jonesboro)

"THE TOM EFFECT"

- Arkansas State's home ballpark, Tomlinson Stadium, tends to be pitcher-friendly confines, with the wind often blowing in towards home plate.
- A-State totaled 60 home runs last season, but 42 of those came on the road and just 18 at home (30 percent). The Red Wolves gave up 58 big flies a season ago, but just 14 came in 17 games at "The Tom." (24.1 percent).

OFFENSIVE/POSITION PLAYER NOTES

"BENNY & THE JETS"

- ▶ Third baseman **Ben Klutts** is looking to live up to the preseason hype he's getting after a First Team All-Sun Belt nod in 2021. Klutts was named Preseason All-Sun Belt, as well as being tabbed to Perfect Game's Preseason All-SBC squad. *Collegiate Baseball* went even a step further, naming him as its pick to be the league's Player of the Year when it's all said and done.
- ▶ D1 Baseball also listed Klutts as the 45th-best third baseman in its preseason rankings of Top 50 Third Basemen.
- ▶ The Poteau, Okla., native hit .320 as a junior last season with seven home runs and 28 RBI, upping that average to .340 in conference play.
- ▶ Klutts was one of just 44 players in college baseball named to the preseason watch list for the Bobby Bragan Collegiate Slugger Award.

NEW FACE BEHIND THE BACKSTOP

- ▶ Arkansas State faces a tough task of replacing Liam Hicks behind the plate, who was selected by the Texas Rangers in the ninth round of the 2021 Major League Baseball Draft. Hicks led A-State with a .344 average, but was stellar at getting on base (.464) and slugging .548.
- ▶ But not to worry, the A-State coaching staff is confident in the newest backstop in Arkansas transfer **Cason Tollett**. Before signing out of high school, Tollett was one of the top 300 players nationally in the class of 2019 and one of the top 25 catchers.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!

- ▶ Over the last few seasons, Arkansas State's offense has been among the top of the Sun Belt Conference. Last year, the Red Wolves ranked second in both on-base percentage (.363) and home runs (60), as well as third in slugging (.432) and fourth in average (.267), runs scored (303) and RBI (269).

"CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL"

- ▶ A-State cranked out 60 home runs last season - tied for the second most in school history and THE most in the Raffo era. While A-State lost the top two home-run hitters from last season in Tyler Duncan and Drew Tipton, it still brings back some pop in **Ben Klutts** and **Jaylon Deshazier**, who both knocked out 7 bombs last season.
- ▶ Entering Tuesday's midweek affair, the Red Wolves average 1.25 homers per ballgame, which leads the Sun Belt.

HAGER BOMBS!

- ▶ Arkansas State's twins **Brandon Hager** and **Jacob Hager** both homered last weekend at Samford. Brandon started a pair of contests as designated hitter, launching a two-run shot on Friday, while Jacob homered in Saturday's contest. The longballs marked career firsts for each.
- ▶ Jacob led the Red Wolves at the plate on the weekend, going 6-for-10 from the 9 spot in the order and playing in the corner outfield spots.

JD CLIMBING THE CHARTS

- ▶ Speaking of Deshazier, the Pine Bluff native is nearing the top 10 in program history in career home runs. Deshazier enters the weekend with 18 career jacks, needing just three to tie for ninth alongside **Kyle MacDonald** (2018-19), **Chris Rich** (2004-05) and **Brad Burkhead** (2004-05) with 20.
- ▶ He also enters the weekend with 99 career RBI - just eight away from tying **Logan Uxa** (2010-13) for 10th with 107, and nine from matching volunteer assistant **Zach George's** (2011-15) career total of 108.

TOLER RANKED AMONG TOP 2023 DRAFT PROSPECTS IN THE 'BELT'

- ▶ Sophomore first baseman Jared Toler received some preseason hype from D1 Baseball, being listed as one of the top 20 players out of the Sun Belt for the 2023 MLB Draft. The Benton, Ark., native came in at No. 18 - the No. 2 infielder.
- ▶ Toler hit .226 as a freshman last year, drawing 36 starts at first. Coaches are hoping that an increased plate discipline from the fall leads to a strong second year, as he looks to cut down on his 41/22 K-to-BB walk ratio.

"YOUNG, SCRAPPY & HUNGRY"

- ▶ Several young Red Wolves are looking to make their debuts this weekend, including Jonesboro natives **Wil French** and **Sam Fagan**. The Valley View High School teammates have reunited after Fagan redshirted last year.
- ▶ French, along with Marion native **Daedrick Cail**, saw time in the field and in the lineup on opening weekend at Samford. Cail led A-State with a 2-for-3 day on Sunday, while French led off in all three contests, recording a pair of doubles.

PITCHING NOTES

THE OLD AND THE NEW

- ▶ Arkansas State's pitching staff features a strong mix of both old and new faces this season, led by new pitching coach **Alan Dunn**, who was hired over the summer after a successful nine-year stint at LSU. One of the most respected pitching minds in college baseball, Dunn was the 2015 *Collegiate Baseball* National Pitching Coach of the Year and was part of nine NCAA Tournament teams in Baton Rouge.
- ▶ A-State returns all three weekend starters from last season in **Brandon Hudson**, **Will Nash** and **Carter Holt**, as well as midweek staple **Tyler Jeans**.
- ▶ The Red Wolves boast several new faces on the bump, including **Justin Medlin**, who had a stand-out fall en route to contending for a role in the starting rotation. A-State also bolstered its corps of lefties after playing most of last season without a single left-handed arm.
- ▶ The Scarlet and Black lost a pair of key back-end bullpen arms from last season in Jack Jumper and Kollin Stone, but made up for it by bringing in flamethrower **Treshon Paschal** and former Wagner closer **Kevin Wiseman**.
- ▶ Also new for this season comes to Tomlinson Stadium itself, in the form of a brand-new bullpen area in right-center field, removing the Red Wolves' "arm barn" from out of the field of play.

CHARLTON, WISEMAN AMONG TOP PROSPECTS

- ▶ A couple of Arkansas State bullpen arms were given some preseason praise from D1 Baseball.com, as **Max Charlton** and **Kevin Wiseman** were listed as top Sun Belt Conference prospects in their respective draft classes.
- ▶ Wiseman was ranked among the top 40 draft prospects for the 2022 MLB Draft out of the Sun Belt, coming in at No. 34. The Wagner transfer looks to play a big role in the late innings after leading the Seahawks in saves last season.
- ▶ Charlton was ranked among the pitcher-heavy top-20 Sun Belt Conference 2023 MLB Draft prospects, coming in at 20th. The sophomore from Lenexa, Kan., appeared in 12 games last season, drawing a pair of starts.

HOLT-ING IT DOWN

- ▶ **Carter Holt** is set to make his second starter of the season on Tuesday after not pitching in game action since Opening Day on Feb. 18 at Samford. Holt went 3 2/3 innings and struck out five in a no-decision. The senior was a key component of A-State's starting rotation, holding down the Game 3 starter role.
- ▶ Holt was strong, especially down the stretch in conference play, for the Red Wolves and gave the Scarlet and Black a strong chance to win every time out. In fact, in his last nine outings of 2021, the Red Wolves held an 8-1 record.
- ▶ The Jackson, Tenn., native recorded seven straight outings of five innings or more, including five straight with six innings. He also went on a stretch of four consecutive quality starts.

JONESBORO, Ark. — Jaylon Deshazier went 6-for-6 at the plate and finished a triple shy of the cycle as part of an Arkansas State offense that produced 21 hits in a 22-2 victory over Mississippi Valley State Wednesday night at Tomlinson Stadium/Kell Field.

Deshazier belted a first-inning two-run homer as part of a four-run frame for the Red Wolves (4-4), as their 21 hits against the Delta Devils (0-7) was the most by an A-State team since tallying 23 against Appalachian State on May 4, 2019. The 22 runs scored was also the most since that date, when A-State ousted the Mountaineers 27-4.

MVSU plated a run in the top of the first, but after A-State's four-run first, it was all Red Wolves as the Scarlet and Black scored 16 unanswered before MVSU added a run in the top of the eighth. In addition to the four runs in the first, A-State scored a run in the second and seventh, five in the fourth, two in the fifth, three in the sixth and six in the eighth to cruise to victory.

Josh Albat picked up the win in relief, pitching 2.0 hitless innings in which he struck out four batters and walked two. Jesse Kutskie started the contest, pitching 2.2 innings with three hits allowed, three strikeouts, a walk and a run. A-State used five total pitchers, with Chase Nix closing out the night with a hitless ninth. A-State pitching allowed just five hits while MVSU's defense coughed up six errors.

Deshazier was one of six Red Wolves to tally multiple hits in the contest, with Liam Hicks going 3-for-3 with a team-high five runs scored. Ben Klutts went 3-for-6 with three runs while Eli Duncan, Sky-Lar Culver and Colten Nix recorded two hits each. Hicks and Klutts both notched triples while A-State posted six doubles as a team. Jake Gish also added three RBI on an eighth-inning homer.

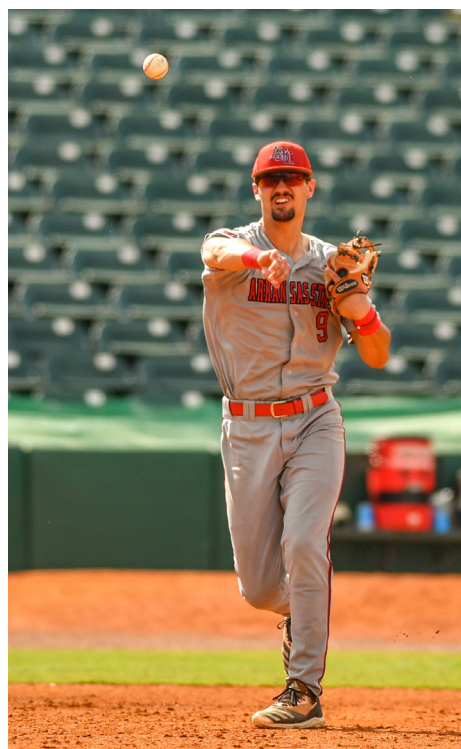
