Description: Annual Football game between rivals St. John

and sportsmanship.

Objective: All proceeds from ticket sales go to benefit Camp Good

Days, a residential camping programs at located on Keuka Lake, New York. For 40 years, the camp has provided services for: children with cancer, who have a parent or sibling with cancer /or children who have lost a parent or sibling to cancer. No child is turned away from Camp Good Days. All programs and services are offered free of charge

for the participants

How has this project impacted campus or local community or target audience:

Each year as part of the program the football studentathletes from Brockport and Fisher spend a day at Camp Good Days and Special times interacting with the campers. For the college student-athletes, this is an opportunity to make a camper smile as well as develop a relationship with those campers to show them that someone cares about them. In fact, one of our former football student-athletes who suffered from brain cancer was a camper when he was younger.
