



Daktronics - NATYCAA Cup Scoring Criteria - NJCAA Scholarship/Non-Scholarship-



Overview

Each college can use its best five women's sports and best five men's sports toward a total college score.

General Scoring

Scoring is based on a maximum of 20 points, with the national champion in each sport being awarded 20 points, the runner up receives 19 points, etc. Where place finishes are not played out, the teams tying for that place will share the points awarded for all of the place-finishes that those teams would fill. If the third- and fourth-place finishes are not contested, the two semifinalists would receive 17.5 points (splitting 18 points + 17 points). When the fifth through eighth place finishes are not contested, those teams would each receive 14.5 points (16+15+14+13 points divided by four), and so on.

- A. In the sports of **Men's and Women's Cross Country, Men's and Women's Swimming, Men's and Women's Track and Field, Indoor Track and Field, Men's Wrestling, and Women's Bowling**, points are awarded directly in proportion to the team's finish at the nationals. National Champions are awarded 20 points, second place earns 19 points, third place receives 18 points, etc.
- B. In the sports of **Baseball, Softball, Men's and Women's Soccer and Women's Volleyball**, points are distributed through maximum of 16 teams. In men's and women's basketball, men's and women's soccer national champions receive 20 points, national runners-up receive 19 points, semifinalists may share third and fourth place and receive 17.5 points. National Championship finalists may share fifth through eighth places and receive 14.5 points each, and qualifiers share ninth through sixteenth places and receive 8.5 points each.
- C. In the sports of **Men's and Women's Basketball**, points are distributed through a maximum of 20 places. In DI and DII, champions receive 20 points, national runners-up receive 19 points, DI semifinalists share third and fourth place and receive 17.5 points, shared points for the following: 5th-8th, (14.5), 9th-16th (8.5) and 17th-24th (1.25). DII will score out to 6th (20-15 points) share 7th-8th (13.5), 9th and 10th scored out, shared points 13th-16th (6.5), 17th-18th (3.5), 19th-20th (1.5). DIII score for 12 teams participating similar structure as above with National Champion, 2nd-6th scored out, shared points 7th-8th, 9th-10th and 11th-12th.

- D. In the sport of **Football**, DI final four and remaining points determined from final poll. DIII has a championship game and remaining points determined from final poll. The national champion receives 20 points and the runner-up 19 points. Remaining points distributed through the final poll.
- E. In the sports of **Men's** and **Women's Golf**, championship finishers are awarded points in order, with champion receiving 20 points, runner-up receiving 19 points, etc at the respective national championship.
- F. In the sports of **Women's Beach Volleyball, Women's Wrestling, Flag Football, Clay Target** and **Women's Lacrosse**, there is a limited field and are currently not scored.
- G. In **Men's** and **Women's Tennis**, qualification for nationals occurs and the team champion earns 20 points, 19 points for runner up, 3rd is 18 points so on down the remaining nationals' qualifiers that score points.
- H. **Half Marathon** is considered an event and not currently scored.

* Schools that have more than one team competing in scholarship level (DI/DII) will have lower non-scholarship level scores go toward Daktronics Cup but will not receive adjustment points toward Learfield Cup.
