Des Delivers

- In her first home matches as a Bulldog, junior outside hitter Desiree Sukhov had double-doubles in all three games in the Fresno State Invitational while (literally) shouldering the load offensively.
• Sukhov led the team in kills and attacks in all three matches. In two matches on Friday, the CSU Bakersfield transfer totaled 53 kills on 114 attacks, with 73 swings vs. Santa Clara.
• In the five-set win over Santa Clara Sukhov tallied 30 kills, tied for the fourth most kills in a match in program history and the most since Korrin Wild had 31 kills in a match in 2012.
• Sukhov had 23 kills on a team season-best .512 hitting percentage vs. Santa Clara and had at least 12 digs in all three matches.

Undefeated No More

- The Bulldogs completed the Fresno State Invitational with a thrilling 5-set win over Santa Clara, which entered the match undefeated at 6-0 on the season.
• The Broncos had gone 4-0 at a tournament in Indiana, including a sweep of the host Hoosiers, before beating CSU Bakersfield and CSUN in its first two matches of the Fresno State tournament.
• Fresno State defeated Santa Clara for the first time since 1996.

All-Tournament Honors

- Madelyn Halteman, Reagan Leonard, and Desiree Sukhov were named to the Fresno State Invitational All-Tournament team.
• Halteman and Sukhov earned all-tournament selections for the second time in as many weeks this season after also receiving the honor at the season-opening GBD Invite.

Ms. 3000

- Madelyn Halteman, the longest tenured

Bulldog and the lone fifth-year senior on the 2019 roster, became just the fifth player in program history to record 3,000 career assists as she reached the plateau during the second set against CSU Bakersfield on Thursday.
• Halteman ranks 5th in program history in career assists and her current total of 3,124 assists is just 224 assists shy of fourth place.
• Halteman was an All-MW selection last year ranking second in the MW with 9.88 assists per set, and so far this season she leads the league and ranks 30th in NCAA Div. I averaging 10.95 assists per set.

Defensive Dominance

- Fresno State enters the week ranked 29th in NCAA Div. I allowing just a .175 opposing hitting percentage this season.
• The Bulldogs have held two opponents under .100 this season and held five of their six opponents to a .216 or lower percentage.
• With their strong defense the 'Dogs are averaging nearly two kills per set more than their opponents.

Digs all Around

- A big factor in Fresno State's defensive success has been depth in digging helping the squad rank second in the MW in digs.
• Reagan Leonard leads the way with 4.36 digs per set but Madelyn Halteman, Desiree Sukhov, and Jocelyn Rodriguez also all average more than two digs per set.
• The 'Dogs have six total players with more than 20 digs this season.

Super Support

- Through its first three home matches of the season Fresno State has averaged 1,102 fans, second highest in the MW and fourth most among all California schools. The 'Dogs have a higher average home attendance than Pac-12

SCOUTING LSU (3-2)

- LSU has started 3-2 in 2019 after finishing 12-17 last year. The Tigers were picked seventh among 13 teams in the SEC preseason poll with Taylor Bannister a Preseason All-SEC selection.
• The Tigers have been a strong blocking team thus far with 2.50 blocks per set but are hitting just .163 and average less than 13 digs per set. Bannister leads the team with 3.71 kills per set.
• LSU has made 15 NCAA Tournament appearances, most recently in 2017. The 'Dogs and Tigers have met once before, a 3-0 LSU win at a late-season tournament at Arizona in 1990.

SCOUTING SOUTH DAKOTA STATE (3-3)

- At 3-3 South Dakota State has already reached half its win total from 2018, in which the team finished 6-23. Entering 2019 the team was 18-98 in four seasons under coach Nicole Cirillo.
• The Jackrabbits have wins over Eastern Illinois, Louisiana Monroe, and Prairie View A&M over the first two weeks of the season, averaging just 1.70 blocks with a .265 opposing hit percent.
• Makenzie Hennen leads the team with 3.61 kills per set. The 'Dogs and Jackrabbits will meet for the first time in what will be Fresno State's first ever match against a team from the state.

SCOUTING NORTHERN ARIZONA (3-3)

- Northern Arizona won the Big Sky and played in the NCAA Tournament last year, taking a set off Washington State. The Lumberjacks were picked to repeat their Big Sky title in 2019.
• NAU pushed then-No. 15 Michigan to five sets in Ann Arbor in the first week of the season and defeated Seton Hall and La Salle last week. The team is 67-14 at home in the last seven seasons.
• Senior Abby Akin ranks third in the nation this season with 40 blocks and is hitting .430. Fresno State holds a 6-3 edge in the all-time series but NAU won the last meeting in 2012.

schools Arizona and Colorado.

- Last season Fresno State ranked second in the MW in average home attendance, trailing only 15-time MW champion Colorado State, and was one of just four NCAA Div. I schools in California to average more than 1,000 fans per match.
• The team topped 1,000 fans in 10 of 13 home matches. By comparison, the 'Dogs played only one road match last season (of 13) in which the opponent had more than 1,000 fans (at Colorado State).

Starting Strong

- The Bulldogs won their season opener for the third straight season and the ninth time in the last 12 seasons.
• The 'Dogs have also now started 2-0 in each of the last four seasons.

Aces Aplenty

- Fresno State ranks second in the MW with 1.77 service aces per set while having more aces than its opponent in five of six matches.
• Madelyn Halteman leads the team with eight aces while Desiree Sukhov and Jocelyn Rodriguez each have seven, with Rodriguez committing just two service errors all year.
• The 'Dogs had a season-high 11 aces in the win over Santa Clara, just two shy of the program five-set match record.

Everybody In

- All 15 players on the 2019 roster have seen action over the first two weeks of the season.
• The 'Dogs used 14 different players in the season-opening GBD Invite and the one that didn't play, Amaria Kelley, saw court time vs. CSU Bakersfield after returning from injury.
• The 'Dogs have 11 different players that have seen action in at least five of the first six matches.

Pride Of The Valley

- Fresno State's historic 2018 season was largely fueled by five starters and six total players who remained in the Central Valley.
• The 'Dogs will heavily rely upon home-grown talent again in 2019 as two of those starters, Madelyn Halteman (Turlock) and Jocelyn Rodriguez (Clovis), are back and the team added five more Central Valley players in Amaria Kelley (Sacramento), Mikayla Weiss (Clovis), Savannah Smith (Roseville),

Amilya Thompson (Stockton), and Julia Handy (Hilmar).

Home Cooking

- Dating back to the 2016 season the Bulldogs have won 20 of their last 28 home matches.
• Fresno State finished 9-4 in the Save Mart Center last year and the squad has had a winning home record for three straight years and in six of the last seven seasons.

Underestimated Again?

- Fresno State was picked to finish sixth in the 2019 preseason MW Coaches' Poll despite finishing second in the league last year.
• In the 2018 preseason poll the 'Dogs were picked seventh and ended up second. If they move up five spots again from the preseason poll to the actual final standings they would win their first MW title in 2019.

She Can Dig It

- Junior Reagan Leonard was a 2018 All-MW Honorable Mention selection and was named to the 2019 Preseason All-MW team, becoming just the second Bulldog ever named to the Preseason All-MW team since Fresno State joined the conference in 2012.
• Leonard broke the single-season program record with 605 digs last year, topping the previous high mark of 573 digs set by current Fresno State assistant coach Maggie Eppright in 2015.
• In her first season as the team's starting Libero Leonard led the MW in total digs and was second in digs per set while also breaking the single-match program digs record.

Global Experience

- After just one season as a MW head coach Jonathan Winder was selected to lead the MW All-Star team at the annual Global Challenge tournament in Croatia in July.
• Winder had a familiar face on the roster as Madelyn Halteman was chosen for the team, becoming the fifth Bulldog in the last six years to represent the 'Dogs internationally.
• Among the MW team's seven matches in the tournament was a historic matchup with the Iranian Senior National Team, which only recently has been able to compete in public.

Powered Up

- Fresno State added six transfers for the 2019





season and three of them began their careers at Power 5 schools.

- Savannah Smith played her freshman season at Washington State, helping lead the Cougars to the NCAA Tournament and tallying seven kills in a postseason win over Florida State, before starring at American River College last year.
- Two other Bulldogs redshirted at Power 5 schools as freshmen in 2018 with Julia Handy starting at Arizona and Rebecca Rendahl at Minnesota, which was ranked as high as No. 1 in the nation last year and made the Sweet 16.

**Tough Schedule**

- Fresno State faces many daunting challenges in its 2019 season with significant travel and eight matches against fellow 2018 postseason teams.
- Two of the team's three non-conference road tournaments will be hosted by teams that won their conference and qualified for the NCAA Tournament last season, Green Bay and Northern Arizona.
- The 'Dogs play three total 2018 NCAA Tournament teams (Green Bay, Northern Arizona, Colorado State) and two NIVC teams as well as an SEC foe in LSU.

**Winning on the Road**

- The Bulldogs went 9-4 in true road matches last year and broke the program record for road MW wins going 7-2.
- The 'Dogs won seven MW road matches after the 2016 and 2017 teams combined to go 2-16 in road MW contests (both were 1-8).
- Fresno State ended the season with a winning road record for the first time since 2013.
- The 'Dogs were also 4-3 in neutral site matches last year.

**Postseason Success**

- In 2018 Fresno State made its first postseason appearance in 16 years taking part in the National Invitational Volleyball Championship (NIVC).
- The 'Dogs battled UC Santa Barbara in the opening round and pulled out a 3-2 win, their first postseason victory since beating Stephen F. Austin in the NIVC in 1995.
- Coincidentally, the 'Dogs last prior postseason match, on Dec. 6, 2002, was also against UC Santa Barbara in the NCAA Tournament.

**Fantastic First Year**

- Jonathan Winder was one of just five first year coaches in NCAA Div. I to record 22 or more wins last season.
- He broke the Fresno State record for wins by a coach in his or her first season with the program, as Lindy Vivas won 21 matches in her first season in 1991.

**Best MW Season**

- At 13-5 in MW play Fresno State finished behind only Colorado State (15-3) last year, a program best and the first second place

conference finish since the 2003 team was second in the WAC West division.

- Since joining the MW in 2012 the highest the 'Dogs had ever finished in the league was 4th place. The team finished in eighth place or lower in each of the four prior seasons.
- The 2018 Bulldogs also broke the program record for conference wins in any league, as the team had never won more than 11 matches as a member of any conference.

**Block Party**

- The 2018 Bulldogs tied the single-season program record with 316.0 blocks.
- Fresno State had the same or more blocks than its opponent in 24 of 33 matches last year.
- The Bulldogs were 21-3 last season when having the same or more blocks than their opponent but 1-8 when trailing in blocks.

**Four All-Conference**

- A program-record four Fresno State volleyball players earned All-Mountain West honors last year. Madelyn Halteman, Taylor Slover, and Haile Watson were named to the All-MW team and Reagan Leonard received Honorable Mention, with all earning their first All-MW selections.
- The four All-MW honors were the most for the program as a member of the conference as Fresno State had not received more than two all-conference selections since joining the league in 2012. The four all-conference selections were the most for the program since the 2003 team earned four all-conference awards as a member of the Western Athletic Conference (WAC).

**On Service**

- Fresno State was undefeated (15-0) when leading or tied in aces and 7-11 when trailing its opponent in aces last year.
- The 'Dogs averaged 1.46 aces per set in their 22 wins compared to 1.02 aces per set in the 11 losses.

**Players of the Week**

- Fresno State combined for five total MW Player of the Week honors last year, easily their most weekly honors as a member of the conference.
- Reagan Leonard was named Defensive Player of the Week twice and Haile Watson earned the accolade once while Madelyn Halteman and Taylor Slover each claimed one Offensive Player of the Week honor.

**Taking Down Goliath**

- Fresno State knocked off 14-time MW champion Colorado State, 3-1, last Sept. 29, ending a nine-match losing streak to the Rams with its first win since 2012 against a Colorado State team that has qualified for the NCAA Tournament in 24 consecutive seasons.
- The 'Dogs took down the Rams posting a 13.0-5.0 edge in blocks.

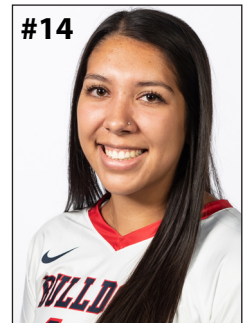

# JONATHAN WINDER

Head Coach • 2nd Season • Irvine, Calif. • Pepperdine, 2008



Jonathan Winder completed a historic first season leading Fresno State Volleyball in 2018. Winder was announced as the new head coach for the Bulldog Volleyball program on Jan. 23, 2018.

Winder guided the 2018 Bulldogs to a 22-11 overall record and 13-5 mark in the MW as the team broke the program record for conference wins in a season and finished in 2nd place in the MW for the first time after being picked seventh in the preseason MW Coaches' Poll. Fresno State finished behind only Colorado State, a program best MW finish and the first second place conference finish since the 2003 team was second in the WAC West division. Since joining the MW in 2012 the highest the 'Dogs had ever previously finished in the league was 4th place.

Fresno State's 22 wins were its most in 16 years, since the 2002 team finished the year 23-7, and Winder broke the program record for wins by a first year coach. The Bulldogs earned an automatic bid to the National Invitational Volleyball Championship (NIVC), the team's first postseason selection since 2002, and a first round NIVC win over UC Santa Barbara on Nov. 29 was the 'Dogs first postseason victory since 1995.

During the 2018 season the Bulldogs started the year 7-1 in non-conference play and began 9-1 in MW play, including a 3-1 home victory over perennial power Colorado State, Fresno State's first win over the Rams since 2012. A program-record four Bulldogs earned All-Mountain West honors, with seniors Taylor Slover and Haile Watson and junior Madelyn Halteman named All-Conference while sophomore Reagan Leonard earned honorable mention. The four all-conference honors were the most for the program since 2003 as the 'Dogs had never before received more than two All-MW accolades as a member of the conference.

The 2018 Bulldogs led the MW in digs and were second in kills and assists and third in blocks in conference play. The 'Dogs set a new program record with 1,999 digs and tied the program record with 316.0 blocks. Reagan Leonard broke the single-season digs record with 605 digs and a 4.65 digs per set average during the year and Haile Watson's 156 blocks ranked 19th in NCAA Div. I and tied for the fourth most in a season in program history.

Winder and his staff made an immediate impact in the community as Fresno State ranked second in the MW in average home attendance behind only Colorado State in 2018. Fresno State was one of just four NCAA Div. I schools in California that averaged more than 1,000 fans per match and topped 1,000 fans in 10 of its 13 home matches. The 'Dogs had a higher average home attendance than Pac-12 schools Cal and Washington State.

A four-time All-American and the 2007 NCAA Player of the Year as a student-athlete at Pepperdine, Winder spent three seasons as an assistant coach for the University of Washington women's indoor volleyball program and the head coach of the Husky beach volleyball team. A 2008 graduate from Pepperdine, his coaching career began at his alma mater where he served as assistant coach for the men's team from 2013-15 after playing professionally and for the U.S. national team.

A native of Irvine, Calif., Winder helped lead Washington to a 105-21 record over the last three seasons. The Huskies won back-to-back Pac-12 championships and had consecutive NCAA Elite Eight appearances in 2015 and 2016 while reaching the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2017. Courtney Schwan, the 2016 Pac-12 Player of the Year, was one of eight All-Americans and 18 different All-Conference Husky student-athletes Winder coached.

Washington reached the No. 1 national ranking for several weeks under Winder as the team finished 1st, 1st, and 2nd in the Pac-12 in his three years with the program. He has recruited extensively in California and brought in multiple top 25 student-athletes in the classes of 2017, 2018, and 2019, including five top 80 players in 2018 class.

In two seasons leading the Husky beach volleyball program Winder led the team to a third place finish in the 2017 Pac-12 Championships after taking fourth place in 2016. He improved the team's record from 4-7 to 11-7, finishing 2017 ranked No. 16 in the NCAA. He coached six All-Pac-12 student athletes on beach with eight selections over 2016 and 2017, second only to national champion USC.

In his first full season as a coach at Pepperdine in 2014 the Waves tied for first in the MPSF with an 18-6 record, reaching the conference tournament semifinals and ending the year ranked No. 4 nationally. Winder initially returned to Malibu in 2013 to work as an academic coordinator in the Pepperdine athletics department. He then moved into his assistant coaching role in June of 2013 under legendary head coach Dr. Marv Dunphy, serving as the team's acting head coach in October 2015 when Dunphy was coaching at the World Championships.

Winder had one of the most storied collegiate men's volleyball careers in NCAA Div. I as he is one of only 11 four-time AVCA All-Americans in NCAA history. As a setter he led Pepperdine to an NCAA National Championship as a freshman in 2005 and was the NCAA National

Newcomer of the Year and a second-team All-American. He earned second-team All-America honors again in 2006 and was first team in 2007 and 2008, leading the team to the final four and earning NCAA National Player of the Year honors as a junior and taking the team to the NCAA Finals as a senior. Winder holds the career assists record at Pepperdine with 5,118, and ranked fifth all-time with 656 digs. He was also a standout in the classroom, earning 3rd team ESPN/CoSIDA Academic All-America honors in 2008 and being an MPSF Academic All-Conference selection in each of his four seasons.

Following his collegiate career Winder became a member of the U.S. National Team and was an alternate for Team USA at the 2012 London Olympics. In 2007, he was on the U.S. squad that finished first at the Pan American Cup and was on the 2009 team that finished in second place. He also helped the U.S. place sixth at the 2010 FIVB World Championships and was part of several other national team rosters, including the 2012 FIVB World League and as Team USA captain at the World University Games in 2006. He also played professionally overseas in France, Germany, Greece, and Romania.

Winder has connections with Fresno as his wife, Jaimie-Rose, is a Fresno native who attended Clovis West High School and Fresno City College. Winder's father-in-law, Vance Walberg, is the boys basketball coach at Clovis West and his sister-in-law, Heather Long, is the girls basketball coach at Clovis North.

Winder graduated from Pepperdine in 2008 with a B.A. in Advertising and earned a Masters of Business Administration in 2015 from the Devry University Keller School of Management. He and his wife have three children including sons Hudson, who was born in January of 2015, and Hayes, born in September 2018, and daughter Sutton, who was born in August of 2016.

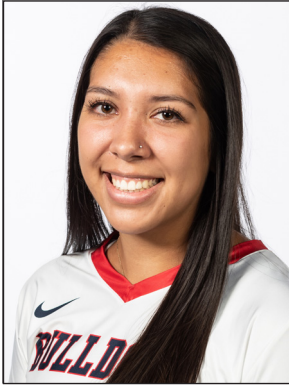
