NAU OPENING DRIVE

- Avenging their home opening loss from last season, the Lumberjacks beat the Sam Houston Bearkats 10-3 in Huntsville, Texas last Saturday.
- Holding the Bearkats to just a field goal, it was the best defensive performance since 2011 when Northern Arizona allowed just 3 points to Idaho State and the best defensive scoring game on the road since allowing 3 points to Northern Colorado in 2006.
- The Lumberjacks handed the Bearkats their first loss in a home opener since 2015 and now enter their own home opener against North Dakota.
- The Lumberjacks are 80-24-2 all-time in home openers, with 24 straight wins from 1993 to 2016, but have won just two of the past five since 2017.

Wrapping up the 2018 season against the No. 25-ranked Fighting Hawks in Flagstaff, the Lumberjacks pulled ahead 14-0 in the first quarter behind a 9-yard touchdown run by Aramis Aldredge and a 30-yard touchdown reception by Emmanuel Butler from Brandon Porter. Both offenses struggled to move the ball, with North Dakota finishing at 192 yards while Northern Arizona had 270. The Lumberjacks defense produced 6 sacks and 2 interceptions, with Maurice Davison taking one back 51 yards for a touchdown late in the third quarter. Playing without a traditional quarterback, the Lumberjacks run game finished with 184 yards led by Cory Young's 79, Aldredge's 50 and Porter's 44 while Butler's 65 yards receiving led the team by nearly 50 yards.

NORTH DAKOTA SERIES INFO

- After playing just twice in their respective histories, Northern Arizona and North Dakota faced off five times as Big Sky Conference foes during the Fighting Hawks' eight years playing a conference schedule. Full Big Sky Conference members from 2012-13 to 2017-18, North Dakota's football program played a Big Sky Conference schedule in 2018 and 2019 due to contractual requirements while being considered an FCS Independent.
- Northern Arizona is 4-0 in Flagstaff against North Dakota, with the most recent victory coming in their last meeting back in 2018. The Lumberjacks defeated the Fighting Hawks 39-10 in 1967 and 41-0 in 1985 in the first two meetings between the programs before a nearly 30-year gap in meetings ended in 2012 when North Dakota entered the Big Sky Conference.
- The Lumberjacks won the first two conference meetings, a 45-38 road victory in 2012 and a 48-27 win at home in 2013, before dropping back-to-back games in Grand Forks 30-28 in 2014 and 38-31 in 2016. Northern Arizona's loss in 2014 came when the Lumberjacks entered the game 7-2, with a 5-1 record in the Big Sky, and helped spoil the program's hopes of a FCS Playoff berth. Similarly, the 2016 loss came with the Lumberjacks entering the game at 5-4, 4-2 in the Big Sky, effectively ending their dreams of a playoff berth.
- Northern Arizona and North Dakota signed a two-game agreement with the Lumberjacks hosting North Dakota this season before traveling to Grand Forks in 2023.

NORTH DAKOTA SCOUT

- Opening the 2021 season at 2-1 to earn a No. 10 ranking in the FCS, North Dakota dropped three consecutive games to eventual FCS Playoff participants North Dakota State, South Dakota and Southern Illinois. Finishing the season 5-6 overall and 3-5 in the Missouri Valley Football Conference, North Dakota landed 8th in the conference behind six playoff teams.
- Defeating Idaho State 35-14 in 2021, North Dakota has won three consecutive games against Big Sky schools after finishing the 2019 season with wins over Northern Colorado (45-38) and Southern Utah (36-18). Effectively finishing 5-3 in the Big Sky during the season, though ineligible for the conference title, the Fighting Hawks last finished under .500 against the Big Sky in 2017.
- Picked to finish seventh in the Missouri Valley Football Conference, the Fighting Hawks opened the season with a 38-17 loss to Nebraska, though they were tied 7-7 at halftime and 17-17 with 4:22 remaining in the third quarter before the Cornhuskers scored 21 consecutive points to close out the game. Hosting No. 24 Northern Iowa on Saturday, the Fighting Hawks turned a 13-7 deficit into a 22-13 lead in the second half leading to a 29-27 victory. The win became North Dakota's 36th consecutive victory in a home opener.
- QUARTERBACK: Through two games this season, quarterback Tommy Schuster is 45-of-61 for 428 yards passing and three touchdowns to just one interception. Completing 73.8 percent of his passes this season, Schuster is ahead of his pace from a year ago. Completing 65.5 percent of his passes in 2021, Schuster finished the season with 2,493 yards, 13 touchdowns and seven interceptions in 11 games. While he ran for just 89 total yards last season, Schuster scored a touchdown on the ground against Northern Iowa to put the team ahead 29-20 with 7:08 remaining in the fourth quarter. Over the past two seasons, other players have combined to attempt just 26 passes with four of those coming from wide receivers. Schuster debuted during the spring season, starting all seven games for North Dakota and earned All-MVFC Second Team honors in addition to All-MVFC Newcomer Team honors.
- RUNNING BACK: Tyler Hoosman and Isaiah Smith lead the Fighting Hawks in carries with 27 and 18 respectively through two games this season. Hoosman has scored twice on the ground with 142 yards while Smith is at 114 yards, including a long of 63 against Nebraska. Smith also ranks second on the Fighting Hawks with 70 receiving yards on seven catches, with 65 yards and five catches coming against Northern Iowa. Last season, Otis Weah paced the team on the ground, with Smith second in both carries (52) and rushing yards (356). Listed as a running back on the team's depth chart and a receiver on its roster, Red Wilson is fourth on the team with seven

catches and 53 yards through the air this season.

- **RECEIVER:** An All-MVFC Second Team Preseason pick following a team-high 535 rushing yards and 52 receptions a year ago, Bo Belquist leads the Fighting Hawks with 11 catches and 125 yards through two games this season. Also listed as starters, Garrett Maag (4 catches, 39 yards) and Marcus Preston (1 catch, 12 yards) are a part of a passing attack that includes 13 players with receptions this season. Just one other receiver, Nick Kupfer has caught more than one pass this season with 2 receptions for 22 yards.
- **TIGHT END:** Catching two of Schuster's three touchdown passes this season, Adam Zavalney has a score in both games so far this year. Currently at seven catches and 57 yards receiving, Zavalney caught 20 passes for 303 yards and four touchdowns a year ago. North Dakota lists two tight end positions on its depth chart with Jaden Norby the other starter ahead of Max Grunderson and Trae Steckler.
- **OFFENSIVE LINE:** An All-MVFC Second Team Preseason pick, left tackle Donny Ventrelli enters his fourth season as a starter for the Fighting Hawks after taking over in 2019. Ventrelli is one of just two returning starters on the offensive line, with right guard Easton Kilty an 11-game starter in 2021 at right tackle and left guard. North Dakota State transfer Seth Anderson is listed as the starter at left guard, with red-shirt freshmen Danny Carroll and Sam Hagen entering their first years as starters at center and right tackle respectively.
- **DEFENSIVE LINE:** Listing three starters along the defensive line, North Dakota has Jaelen Johnson, Jalen Morrison and Ben McNaboe as its starters. McNaboe ranks second on the team with eight tackles in addition to 2.5 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks and one forced fumble against Nebraska. Last year, McNaboe recorded 19 tackles, 3.0 tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks. Johnson has two tackles, including a sack, this season after finishing with 17 tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss and a sack.
- **LINEBACKER:** Devon Krzanowski, an All-MVFC Second Team Preseason selection and an honorable mention last season, has recorded seven tackles and 1.0 tackle for loss this season after leading the team with 68 tackles, 5.0 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks last season. Josh Navratil currently ranks second with eight total tackles, including 2.0 tackles for loss and two sacks. Ted Mullin's eight sacks and 0.5 sacks is just behind Navratil, with Caden White's seven tackles and Marcus Vaughn-Jones' five tackles rounding out the team's leaders at the position. Wyatt Pedigo has just three tackles this season, but has recorded an interception in both games this season.
- **CORNERBACK:** CJ Siegel, another All-MVFC Second Team Preseason pick, has six tackles and one pass breakup through two games this season. Last season, Siegel finished with 28 tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss, 2.0 sacks and one interception. Listed as the other starter, Richard Agyekum appeared in two games last season with one tackle. The other corners on the two-deep, Edmund Ocansey and Devin Hembry, entered the season with no career games at North Dakota. Ocansey redshirted last year and Hembry arrived from Northeastern Oklahoma A&M.
- **SAFETY:** Kadon Kauppinen leads the Fighting Hawks with 10 tackles through two games in addition to a forced fumble and a pass breakup. Kauppinen played in just five games last season, but recorded 15 tackles and 2.0 tackles for loss. Fellow first-team safety Jayson Coley has three tackles in two games, but finished with 14.0 tackles, 3.0 tackles for loss, an interception, a pass breakup and two blocked kicks last season. Also listed on the two-deep, Ethan Ball has five tackles this season.
- **SPECIALISTS:** Averaging 40.4 yards per punt last season, with 19 of his 43 kicks landing inside the 20 or being fair caught, Cade Pesterson earned All-MVFC Second Team Preseason honors entering the year. Five of his seven kicks this season have been fair caught, with three also landing inside the 20. Kicker Brady Stevens has made one of two kicks this season, connecting on a 23-yarder against Nebraska and missing a 45-yarder against Northern Iowa. Steven has also made all five of his PAT attempts this season, and kicked four of his nine kickoffs for touchbacks. Long snapper David Neuberger is a true freshman in his first season for North Dakota and is backed up by linebacker Dylan Boecker.

LOOKING BACK

- Holding the Sam Houston Berkats to just a field goal, coming on their second drive

of the game with 11:54 remaining in the second quarter, the Northern Arizona Lumberjacks' defense shut out the Bearkats over the final 42 minutes of the game. The three points were the least allowed by a Northern Arizona team since 2011 against Idaho State and the fewest allowed on the road since 2006 at Northern Colorado. The game also was the fewest combined points in a victory, 13, since 2001 against Stephen F. Austin. The loss was Sam Houston's first in a home opener since 2015 against Lamar.

- With the Bearkats finishing with just 111 yards passing, it was the lowest total for an opponent since Montana State's 103 in 2019. With Montana State's run game carrying much of the load that game, the 111 yards was also the lowest passing total for an opponent that finished under 300 yards of offense since North Dakota in 2018.
- The Lumberjacks forced a pair of turnovers against the Bearkats, an interception for Cosmas Kwete that deflected off an official and a fumble recovery by Mark Ho Ching following a strip sack by Jhasi Wilson and Eloi Kwete. Ho Ching's fumble recovery led to the lone touchdown of the game, a 1-yard run by quarterback RJ Martinez. Martinez now has six career touchdown runs in 10 games as a Lumberjack, just one behind Kevin Daniels' seven career rushing touchdowns in 17 games.
- Northern Arizona's defense recorded four sacks in the second quarter and Sam Houston's offense produced just 142 yards of total offense across their final eight drives of the game after the opening two drives resulted in 110 yards of offense and two field goal attempts.
- Coleman Owen's 65 receiving yards pushed him past the 1,000-yard mark for his career, jumping up to a tie for 30th all-time. Owen's 1,036 career receiving yards have come in 22 career games. At his current pace, with more than two seasons of eligibility remaining, Owen is on pace to surpass 2,500 career yards and potentially rank among the top 6 all-time.
- Similarly, fellow receiver Hendrix Johnson recorded his fifth career 100-yard receiving game last Saturday against Sam Houston following his 8-catch, 101-yard performance. Now at 16th all-time with 1,731 career yards, Johnson's pace puts him on pace to rank among the Top 5, and possibly Top 3 in school history.
- Having led 10-3 entering the fourth quarter, Northern Arizona improved to 13-1 under head coach Chris Ball when leading after the third quarter.

LOOKING AHEAD

- Both Coleman Owen and Hendrix Johnson will continue their push up the all time receiving yards list, with Owen now less than 100 yards away from 2022 NAU Athletics Hall of Fame inductee Charlie Brown's 1,134 from 1968-69. Johnson is now just 14 yards away from 15th all-time and 235 away from tying Tyrone Peterson for 10th in school history.
- Stacy Chukwumezie entered the season at 21st all-time with 1,510 career receiving yards and will continue to shift up the all-time list once he returns from a knee injury suffered last season at Northern Colorado.
- Both Owen and Johnson ranked among the nation's Top 51 in yards per reception last year, at 18.18 for Johnson (27th) and 16.58 for Owen (51st) while Chukwumezie's career average of 17.5 could give the Lumberjacks a trio of big play threats when the latter returns.
- Now at 120 career receptions, Johnson is also 16 away from tying Ify Umodu for 10th all-time on NAU's career receptions list. Entering the season averaging 3.89 catches per game through his first 28 games, Johnson was on pace for at least 194 which would place him among the Top 3 all-time.
- Kevin Daniels enters the 2022 season coming off of Northern Arizona's first 1,000-yard rushing season since 2015 after the freshman finished off the 2021 campaign with 1,146 rushing yards to rank sixth in the FCS overall and third in rushing yards per game at 114.6.
- After the first two games of the season, Northern Arizona's defense is allowing just 131.5 yards per game to rank 11th in the FCS. At 335.5 yards of Total Defense, the Lumberjacks rank 36th in the FCS and 17th in Team Passing Efficiency Defense with a 104.75.

FALL FIRSTS

- Opening the season against Arizona State, five Lumberjacks made their first career start

- Debuting with the Lumberjacks after transferring in from Morgan State, Isaiah Gere-na started at tight end in his first career game for Northern Arizona. Gere-na recorded the first catches of his Northern Arizona career.
- Jonas Leader extended his streak of consecutive starters to 28 straight games dating back to 2019 when he opened the season at right tackle against the Sun Devils.
- On the defensive side, George Steele started at cornerback in his first career appearance for the Lumberjacks while Heston Lameta started at linebacker for the first time in his four-year career. Steele recorded his first tackles as a Lumberjack in the game.
- Two of the Lumberjacks three specialists started for the first time at Northern Arizona, with long snapper Sean Farfan and punter Eemil Herranen debuting for the Lumberjacks
- Others to make their first career appearance for the Lumberjacks include BJ Fleming, Alonzo Davis, Davondre Bucannon, Alec Wyble-Meza, Malachi Williams, Caiaphas Ardoin, Micah Carreon, Logan Bayus, Ethen Cluff, Alani Ma'afu and Richard Kwete.
- Davis, Williams, Ardoin, Carreon and Bayus all recorded their first career tackles, while Wyble-Meza recorded his first career rushes and reception.
- Against Sam Houston, Cosmas Kwete's interception was the first of his college career at Northern Arizona or Washington State while Mark Ho Ching's fumble recovery was the first of his career, spanning 17 games with the Lumberjacks.
- After playing in two games last fall, Andrew Mason started at left tackle against Sam Houston after Northern Arizona shuffled its line, the first start of his career with the Lumberjacks.
- Handling a pair of kickoffs, kicker Clay Gross made his first appearance for the Lumberjacks in his third year with the program.

ROUGH RUN AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

- Northern Arizona has dropped 10 consecutive games against ranked opponents since defeating No. 25 North Dakota 31-16 to conclude the 2018 season.
- In 2021, Northern Arizona fell to No. 1 Sam Houston, No. 7/8 UC Davis and No. 9 Montana in Flagstaff as well as No. 19 Sacramento State on the road. During the spring season, the Lumberjacks lost to No. 22 Eastern Washington and No. 2/3 Weber State on the road as well.
- North Dakota arrives in Flagstaff ranked No. 22 in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 and received votes in the FCS Coaches Poll, while Northern Arizona received votes in the Stats Perform Poll. The Lumberjacks were last ranked inside the Top 25 in September 2018, but fell to Missouri State 40-8 on the road.
- Northern Arizona has also lost four consecutive games when nationally ranked, last winning as a ranked team in November 2017 over Montana State, 37-36, in Flagstaff as the No. 24 team in the nation.

HOME OPENER HISTORY

- Sitting at 80-24-2 all-time in home openers dating back to 1915, Northern Arizona will look to get back on trap this week against North Dakota following a rough stretch in recent history.
- After winning 24 straight home openers from 1993 to 2016, the Lumberjacks have won just two of the past five seasons. The back-to-back losses in home openers from 2017 and 2018 were the first consecutive home opener losses since 1965 and 1966. The Lumberjacks won 11 straight home openers from 1975 to 1985 and won five more in a row before the loss in 1992 that set the stage for the 24 consecutive wins.
- Northern Arizona lost to Sam Houston in last year's home opener, the third loss in five years. The last time the Lumberjacks dropped four home openers in the span of six years was a stretch of three straight losses to Whittier, Adams State and Pepperdine from 1954 to 1956 after a loss to E. New Mexico in 1952.

ANOTHER 15 UNDER CENTER

- Just as former Lumberjack quarterback Case Cookus did in 2015, quarterback RJ Martinez earned the Big Sky Freshman of the Year following his 2021 season.
- Finishing with 1,714 passing yards, 14 touchdowns to two interceptions and a 0.91 in-

terception percentage, Martinez impressed in his debut season. Adding 187 rushing yards on 53 carries, Martinez also added five scores on the ground.

- Finishing sixth in the Stats Perform Jerry Rice Award voting, given to the top freshman in the FCS, Martinez earned Big Sky Conference Player of the Week honors for his performance against Idaho State and Honorable Mention CFPA FCS National Performer of the Week for his game against Southern Utah.
- Debuting against Arizona and leading Northern Arizona to its first victory over the Wildcats since 1932, Martinez took over and started seven games for the Lumberjacks in 2021.
- Martinez was the third Northern Arizona player to land on the Jerry Rice Award Watch List, with teammate Hendrix Johnson added during his freshman season in 2019 and former Northern Arizona quarterback Case Cookus winning the award in 2015.

TEXAS SUCCESS

- Northern Arizona's victory over Sam Houston made it four straight wins in the state of Texas dating back to the 2014 season. The 10-3 victory followed 2018's 30-10 win over UTEP, 2015's 34-28 win over Stephen F. Austin and 2014's 27-21 win at Abilene Christian.
- Northern Arizona's last loss in Texas came in 2004 against Stephen F. Austin, a 24-17 overall loss.
- The Lumberjacks will return to Texas in 2024 when they travel to San Antonio to face Incarnate Word on Sept. 21 for their third game of the regular season. After hosting Incarnate Word in 2025 and 2026, Northern Arizona will return to San Antonio again in 2027.

ONE OF THE BEST AGAINST THE FBS

- Last year's victory against Arizona was Northern Arizona's third against an FBS opponent since 2012 when it snapped a 22-game losing streak against UNLV. The Lumberjacks followed with a win over UTEP in 2018 and then topped Arizona. Now 3-7 against the FBS since 2012, Northern Arizona is second to only Eastern Washington (4 wins) in the Big Sky and second in win percentage against FBS opponents during the same time span.
- Three Big Sky teams have not won a game against an FBS opponent since 2012, with Montana State's most recent win in 2006, Weber State's in 1993 and Northern Colorado still looking for its first ever FBS win.
- Four others have just one win and win percentages of .111 or worse, while Portland State and UC Davis at two wins across 16 and 13 FBS games.
- Two Lumberjacks remain from the 2018 victory against UTEP as well as last year's win against Arizona. Jonas Leader and Stacy Chukwumezie played in both games for the Lumberjacks. Anthony Sweeney played in the win over UTEP in 2018, but missed last season's win over Arizona due to an injury.
- In addition to playing at Arizona State to open the season, Northern Arizona will head to Sam Houston in the second game of the year as they return the home game they played against the Bearcats last season. In the time since facing Sam Houston last fall, the Bearcats elected to make their stay in the new-look WAC short. Accepting an invitation from Conference USA, Sam Houston will play a WAC football schedule this season, but will not be eligible for the postseason as the program already surpassed the FCS limit for scholarships as it prepares for its move to the FBS in 2023.
- After 34 years in the Southland Conference, Sam Houston will spend just two in the WAC before moving up to Conference USA.

FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 2007

- While Sam Houston will depart the WAC next season, 2022 will be Southern Utah's first year in the conference after leaving the Big Sky this past summer.
- After playing each season since 2008, including as members of the Big Sky Conference from 2011 to 2021, the teams will not face off for the Grand Canyon Trophy again until 2028.
- The Lumberjacks won three straight meetings in 2021, with a pair of games in the spring season and another last fall, and four of the past five games between the

programs. Now leading 16-10 in the all-time series, Northern Arizona will face Southern Utah for a 12 game series beginning in 2028 through the 2039 season.

SUPER SENIORS

- With the NCAA granting players an additional year of eligibility following the COVID-19 pandemic forcing the Big Sky Conference and the FCS into a spring season in 2021, the Lumberjacks still have a handful of players deep into their collegiate careers.
- While many of the longest-tenured Lumberjacks have now graduated, including Luis Aguilar, DJ Arnson, Tristen Vance and Carson Taylor who rank near or at the top of the program's all-time games played list, a few remain in their sixth or seventh year of college football.
- Stacy Chukwumezie enters his fifth season with the program and seventh in college football. Beginning his career with two seasons at Cerritos College, Chukwumezie played in four games for the Lumberjacks during the 2018 season before redshirting the season. In his 25 career games, Chukwumezie has caught 86 passes for 1,510 yards.
- Morgan Vest also enters his seventh collegiate season overall having began his career at South Carolina in 2016 before a pair of seasons at Kilgore College in 2017 and 2018. After missing the 2019 season due to an injury, Vest produced a pair of impressive seasons for the Lumberjacks in the Spring 2021 and Fall 2021 seasons, earning multiple All-Big Sky Conference honors with the Lumberjacks.
- Demetrick Watts II spent three seasons at Humboldt State from 2016 to 2018 before moving to Akron for two years. Playing for the Lumberjacks last season, Watts II enters the 2022 season with six years of experience and will complete his career this fall.
- Jonas Leader, Anthony Sweeney and Dyvine Wallace all enter their sixth collegiate season, all with the Lumberjacks after redshirting in the 2017 season. Three other Lumberjacks began their college careers in 2017, with Alonzo (LJ) Davis (Southern Utah), PJ Poutasi (Cal) and Logan Bayus (Colorado Mesa) all will finish their college careers with the Lumberjacks this season. While Poutasi is in his second season at Northern Arizona, Davis and Bayus arrived in Flagstaff after five seasons at their previous schools.

JACKS WITH DEGREES

- With the additional year of eligibility, seven current Lumberjacks have earned degrees before their playing careers have come to an end.
- Stacy Chukwumezie, Heston Lameta, Jonas Leader, Anthony Sweeney, Morgan Vest, Dyvine Wallace and Demetrick Watts return for the Lumberjacks this season with degrees.

OPTIONS ABOUND ON O

- Named the Big Sky Conference Freshman of the Year and finishing sixth in the voting for the Jerry Rice Award as the top freshman in all of the FCS, RJ Martinez started seven games while passing for 1,714 yards, completing 61.8 percent of his passes for 14 touchdowns and just two interceptions. Adding five touchdowns on the ground with 187 rushing yards, Martinez proved to be a capable dual threat at the helm of Northern Arizona's offense. Finishing with 369 passing yards, 57 rushing

yards and four total touchdowns, Martinez earned Big Sky Conference Player of the Week for his performance against Idaho State. Martinez was also named an honorable mention for CFPA FCS National Performer of the Week after finishing with 417 passing yards, 65 rushing yards and seven total touchdowns against Southern Utah.

- Jeff Widener and Niko Haen return to the Lumberjacks having both started last fall, while the Lumberjacks added the 4A Conference Player of the Year, Angel Flores of Casa Grande, in their recruiting class after the freshman threw for 2,671 yards last fall and added 1,292 rushing yards in his high school career.
- Paired with Martinez in the backfield, running back Kevin Daniels leads a strong group of backs after earning All-Big Sky Second Team honors and Freshman All-American honors for his 1,146 rushing yards, 6.2 yards per carry and seven touchdowns. George Robinson and Draycen Hall offer Northern Arizona two other capable rushing threats, with Hall also at 341 career receiving yards in his 16 games for the Lumberjacks. Tyson Grubbs also carried the ball for Northern Arizona last fall, scoring his first career touchdown against Montana. Daniels enters the fall with his most recent game standing as one of the best in program history having rushed for 280 yards and five touchdowns in the season finale against Cal Poly.
- Balancing Northern Arizona's offense and offering Martinez the targets needed to continue the impressive start to his career, Coleman Owen and Hendrix Johnson lead a deep crop of receivers. Finishing with 43 catches, 713 yards and six touchdowns, Owen earned Freshman All-American honors and All-Big Sky Honorable Mention while ranking among the Top 10 of the conference for receiving yards and touchdowns. Johnson, also an All-Big Sky Honorable Mention, finished with 28 catches for 509 yards and five touchdowns, with his 18.2 yards per catch second in the Big Sky and 27th in the FCS. Stacy Chukwumezie returns for his final season as a Lumberjack after going down with a knee injury last fall while Jamal Glaspie also produced a dominant performance against Idaho State with 11 catches, 167 yards and two touchdowns. Johnson and Chukwumezie enter the season at 20th and 21st on Northern Arizona's all-time receiving list while Owen is just 53 yards away from becoming the 33rd receiver in program history with 1,000 career receiving yards.
- With returners Terrell Hayward, Elijah Taylor, David Haen, Ethen Cluff and Jorim Powell adding existing depth, the Lumberjacks also added a trio of receivers, Caiaphas Ardoin, Koda Bridges and BJ Fleming.
- Seeking to replace longtime Lumberjack Matthew Kempton at tight end, Northern Arizona added Isaiah Gerena from Morgan State. An early enrollee who spent the spring with the Lumberjacks, Gerena was named All-MEAC Second Team as a freshman in 2021, catching 22 passes for 188 yards. Alishawuan Taylor is poised to take on a larger role at tight end after playing in eight games during the spring and fall 2021 seasons with Xander Werner remaining a unique threat within the offense while spending time at tight end. In addition to Gerena, Northern Arizona added Braden Kramer in its recruiting class.
- Blocking upfront for Martinez, Daniels and the rest of Northern Arizona's offense, the Lumberjacks' offensive line will be led by a pair of seniors, a handful of underclassmen with significant playing experience and a wide range of new arrivals.

- Having spent time at both right guard and right tackle during his Northern Arizona career, Jonas Leader enters his senior season with 35 career games played and 27 consecutive starts dating back to the 2019 season. An All-Big Sky Second Team selection in the spring and a Third Team pick in the fall, Leader helped lead the way to the 36th-ranked total offense and the 29th-ranked rushing attack in the FCS and was named to the Big Sky Preseason All-Conference Team. Immediately slotting into a key role on the offensive line upon his arrival last fall, PJ Poutasi started all 11 games at left guard for the Lumberjacks in the fall with Daniels producing the first 1,000-yard rushing season by a Lumberjack since the 2015 season.
- The two seniors will hold down positions on the offensive line while seven other Lumberjacks have starting experience over the past three seasons. The versatile Jalen Hooper started 10 games in the fall, with six games coming at center and another four at right guard while Noah Barta started seven games at right guard following three at the position during the spring. Stepping in as a freshman, Blake Gamez started four games at center while battling injuries during the fall after playing in three games during the spring, with Caiden Miles, Maxwell Flores, Angel Flores, and Eriq Williams also starting games during their careers. The wide range of additions on the offensive line include Michael Flood from UTEP with Kaden Hicks, Cash Koepke, CJ McMillan and Alexis Sanchez joining the program from their high schools.
- Northern Arizona will also need to replace former All-American kicker Luis Aguilar, who served as the program's primary kicker since the 2018 season. Collin Robbins and Clay Gross return to the Lumberjacks while freshman Marcus Lye joins the Lumberjacks with the trio battling for the job.

DEEP ACROSS THE DEFENSE

- With nearly 20 defensive linemen listed on Northern Arizona's roster, the Lumberjacks will see an influx of new names at the front of their defense alongside six core returners.
- Eloi Kwete leads the way among Northern Arizona's key returners, starting 11 games at defensive end last fall. Finishing with 45 tackles overall, Kwete ranked fourth on the team. Adding 8.0 tackles for loss and 4.0 sacks, and Kwete's totals placed second for the Lumberjacks. Defensive tackle Sheldon Newton also played in 11 games with three starts, finishing with 22 tackles, 2.5 tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks. Debuting during Northern Arizona's spring season, Newton quickly made an impact in the middle of the Lumberjacks' line and closed out the season with a sack in two of the final three games.
- Mark Ho Ching and Nehemiah Magalei's 10 games played tied for third among Northern Arizona's returners. Ho Ching returned to the line after missing the 2021 spring season, finishing with 13 tackles, 2.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. Meanwhile, Magalei started five games in the fall after debuting as a true freshman in the spring season and recorded 12 tackles, 2.0 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. Starting six games at defensive tackle and playing in eight total, Cosmas Kwete finished with 5.0 tackles for loss, the fifth-most on the team. Recording 11 quarterback hurries in the eight games, Kwete's total stands as the most by any Lumberjack since 2009. Similar to Magalei, AJ Maluia debuted in the spring season and played in six games during the fall.
- While many of Northern Arizona's defensive line additions arrive as true freshmen, Logan Bayus brings plenty of collegiate

experience from Colorado Mesa. Earning All-RMAC Honorable Mention honors with 41 tackles, 5.5 tackles for loss, 3.0 sacks and five quarterback hurries last fall, Bayus returns to his home state after playing in 26 games for the Mavericks since 2017. Additionally, Micah Carreon, Alani Ma'afu and Warren-Stevens Tayou enrolled early and spent spring camp with the Lumberjacks. Ezekiel Duncan and Jaxon Richards also joined the Lumberjacks during the offseason and arrived for the fall.

- At linebacker, Northern Arizona is looking to replace Tristen Vance and Harrison Beemiller who each started 11 games in the middle of the Lumberjacks' defense last fall. Serving as the primary third middle linebacker last season, Jhasi Wilson played in all 11 games for Northern Arizona and finished 10th on the team with 29 tackles. Adding 4.0 tackles for loss, 1.0 sacks, a pair of forced fumbles and a fumble recovery in the fall, Wilson has played in 22 career games since 2019. Despite missing all of the fall 2021 season, Heston Lameta stands as Northern Arizona's second-most experienced linebacker with 13 games played in 2019 and the spring season. Demetrick Watts II, Tommy Ellis and Jonathan Hunter all played in at least five games last fall, splitting time on defense as well as special teams. Northern Arizona also added Camilo Arquette and Brandon Wong as part of the 2022 recruiting class.
- While the middle of Northern Arizona's defense may be inexperienced, the back end boasts a pair of All-Big Sky Conference safeties and multiple past contributors. Coming off an All-Big Sky Second Team selection in the fall and a unanimous First Team honor in the spring, Morgan Vest enters his final season with the Lumberjacks. Tallying 159 tackles in his 16 games over the past two seasons, Vest also picked off five passes last spring to rank sixth in the FCS and tie for the sixth-most in program history. Vest was named to the Big Sky Preseason All-Conference Team ahead of the season and could be in contention for an All-American honor. After missing the fall with an injury, Anthony Sweeney rejoins Vest in the secondary after recording 24 tackles, two pass breakups, 1.0 tackles for loss, one interception and one quarterback hurry in the spring that earned him All-Big Sky Second Team honors. During his most recent full season, Sweeney finished with a team-high 83 tackles in 10 games during the 2019 season, adding five pass breakups, second on the team, and forcing two fumbles to rank third on the team.
- Also returning after missing the second half of his true freshman season due to an injury, Brady Shough impressed in his short time on the field. Picking off a pass against Arizona and returning it for a touchdown, Shough scored the first points of the game in Northern Arizona's eventual upset. Similarly, Kamdan Hightower also returns from an injury that cost him most of the fall after he debuted with a pick-six of his own in the spring season. Shough finished with 11 tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss and two pass breakups during his debut season while Hightower recorded seven tackles and a pass breakup during his spring debut. Dyvine Wallace and Jakobe Walton add depth at safety, nickelback and corner after playing in eight and 10 games respectively last fall, with Wallace 15th on the team with 17 tackles and Walton contributing 15 of his own.
- At cornerback, Colby Humphrey stands as Northern Arizona's top returner with 44 tackles, two interceptions and seven pass breakups last season, with the breakups ranking 11th in the Big Sky. A starter in six games, Humphrey will be joined by Jacob Mpungi as the most experienced corners with the former run-

ning back starting five games at corner last season.

- Northern Arizona's 2022 recruiting class initially included nearly double-digit signees with the additions also including a few transfers. Among the transfers are former Southern Utah corner Alonzo Davis, who appeared in 32 games for the Thunderbirds and earned All-Big Sky Second Team honors following the spring season, and George Steele, formerly at Jacksonville State, who rejoined his former high school defensive coordinator Rudy Griffin after playing in 34 games and recording 73 tackles as a member of the Gamecocks.
- Just as they must do on offense, Northern Arizona needs to replace a former All-American at punter. With DJ Arnsen graduated, the Lumberjacks will turn to Eemil Herranen or freshman Marcus Lye as the primary punter.

FAMILY ATMOSPHERE

- Once again, the Lumberjacks have three sets of brothers on their roster.
- With Eloi Kwete a Lumberjack since 2019 and brother Cosmas joining his twin brother as a transfer from Washington State in 2020, Northern Arizona added one more from the family as Richard Kwete signed head of the 2021 season. The trio of brothers is poised to play together for the first time after Richard redshirted last fall.
- Twin brothers Niko and David Haen both debuted for Northern Arizona last fall, with the former starting for the first time against Montana and the latter catching his first career pass against Sacramento State.
- With Tyson Grubbs entering his third season with the Lumberjacks, his brother Devon Grubbs joined the Lumberjacks in the summer from Desert Vista in Phoenix.

ARIZONA ALL-STARS

- Once again, the Lumberjacks have nearly 70 players on their roster from the state of Arizona with roughly 20 in-state players among Northern Arizona's two-deep. That accounts for around 61% of the team's players staying in state in Flagstaff.
- Of Northern Arizona's preseason honorees, four are Arizona natives in Kevin Daniels, Jonas Leader, Cosmas Kwete and Eloi Kwete.
- Of the team's nearly 60 additions to the roster, more than half played their high school careers in Arizona. Once again, Northern Arizona's 2022 recruiting class landed among the Top 10 of the FCS with another recruiting class currently among the FCS Top 10 for 2023.

INSTANT ADDITIONS

- Adding a handful of transfers from around the FCS as well as one from the FBS and one from Division II, the Lumberjacks supplemented their high school recruiting class with a few others.
- George Steele (Jacksonville State) and Alonzo (LJ) Davis (Southern Utah) add key starting experience to a secondary in need of some additional help at cornerback and in the secondary as a whole.
- Offensively, running back Alec Wyble-Mexa (BYU), Isaiah Gerena (Morgan State) and Keison Evans (Idaho) bring depth to their respective positions on the offense while Eemil Herranen (McNeese State) slots in as the team's new starting punter. Jaxon Richards (Lamar) also returned to his home state after spending a year in Texas.

STICKING AROUND THE SIDELINES

- Having finished his playing career last fall, Harrison Beemiller remained with the Lumberjacks as he took on the role of graduate assistant this offseason.
- Spending three seasons with the Lumberjacks after transferring from SD School of Mines, Beemiller earned All-Big Sky Second Team honors during the Spring 2021 season and honorable mention honors last fall.
- Starting 28 games as a Lumberjack, Beemiller's career included finishing with the second-most tackles for loss in a single game at 4.5 against the Arizona Wildcats.

PULLING FROM THE PAST

- Adding another familiar face to his coaching staff, head coach Chris Ball brought in Rudy Griffin as his new defensive line coach during the offseason.
- A graduate of Alabama, Griffin played for the Crimson Tide from 2003 to 2005, when Ball, deputy head coach Bob Connelly and special teams coordinator Dave Ungerer were on the staff. Griffin also served as a graduate assistant at Washington State when Ball was the Cougars' defensive coordinator and Ungerer was the special teams coach.
- Griffin spent two years as a starter at The Citadel before making the move to Alabama, where he walked on, redshirted and became a two-year starter.
- Northern Arizona isn't Griffin's first stint in the Big Sky Conference, having spent two years with the Idaho State Bengals. Most recently, Griffin coached at Lowndes High School in Georgia where the Lumberjacks signed defensive lineman Ezekiel Duncan and receiver Chase Belcher from over the winter. Griffin also coached defensive back George Steele, a transfer from Jacksonville State, while the two were at Hewitt-Trussville High School in Alabama.

A DECADE OF EXPERIENCE

- An All-Big 12 honorable mention defensive back during his final season playing at Missouri, Kenji Jackson spent more than five years at Missouri State in addition to his time as a graduate assistant with Missouri, two seasons as a defensive analyst with Arkansas and one year as a graduate assistant at Northwestern.
- Jackson recorded 183 tackles and seven interceptions from 2008 to 2011 at Missouri before taking on the roles of graduate assistant and defensive quality control assistant. After jumping to Northwestern for a year, Jackson spent an extended run at before moving to Arkansas for a pair of seasons.
- A native of Mansfield, Texas, Jackson's hiring sets up the Lumberjacks to continue recruiting the state heavily after adding four players from Texas in the past two recruiting classes.

FUN ON FAMILY WEEKEND

- Set to play the Cal Poly Mustangs on Family Weekend on Oct. 8, Northern Arizona will look to continue its success during the occasion in 2022.
- Since 1954, Northern Arizona is 47-20 overall on Family Weekend and has won four straight games, and 13 of the past 14 games. Cal Poly played Northern Arizona on Family Weekend in 2014, winning 38-35.
- The Lumberjacks have scored 30 or more points in seven of the past eight Family Weekend games and dominated three of the

past four with a 48-17 victory last season against Idaho State, a 41-23 win against Northern Colorado in 2019 and a 37-16 win against Illinois State in 2017.

- The Lumberjacks have surely been aided by the large crowd the weekend brings, with crowds surpassing 10,000 in six of the past eight years. The run includes a crowd of 12,640 against Montana in 2013 and 11,545 against Cal Poly in 2014.

AT HOME ON HOMECOMING

- Scheduled to take on the Montana State Bobcats, the No. 4-ranked team in both the FCS Coaches Poll and the Stats Perform FCS Top 25, Northern Arizona hosts Homecoming on Nov. 5.
- Beating Southern Utah 59-35 last fall, Northern Arizona improved to 58-35-2 all-time on Homecoming Weekend. The team has won 8 of its past 9 Homecoming games, and broken the 50-point mark in three of those games.
- Northern Arizona last played Montana State on Homecoming in 2000, winning 32-9, and has beaten the Bobcats on Homecoming in 1995, 1993, 1991, 1985, 1971 and 1969 for a 7-0 record all-time.
