♦ Navy to Battle Army in First of Two Meetings in 2007

The Navy sprint football team (1-0) will make its first visit to the Allegiance Bowl in Saratoga Springs, N.Y., in program history when it takes on Army (1-0) this Saturday at 12 noon. The matchup will be the first of two this season, as the Midshipmen will travel to West Point to take on the Black Knights in the annual Star Game on Friday, Nov. 2.

Navy heads into Saturday's contest with a six-game winning streak over Army and a 33-30-1 advantage in the all-time series. The Midshipmen have come away victorious in each of the last five non-league contests against the Black Knights, all of which were at the Pride Bowl in New Jersey.

♦ Navy Dominates Frostburg State JV, 47-8, in Season Opener

Navy sprint football quarterback **D.J. Green (Jr./Indianapolis, Ind.)** threw for two touchdowns and ran for two more as the Midshipmen opened the 2007 season with a dominating 47-8 win at Frostburg State JV on Sunday night.

Green, who played only into the early part of the third quarter, completed 14-of-20 passes for 225 yards and also rushed for 37 yards on nine carries.

"D.J. was very solid tonight," stated Navy head coach Maj. Jake Jenkins, USMC, who earned a victory in his first game at the helm of the program. "He had a lot of poise and good command. He really displayed leadership on the field."

While the offense churned out 466 yards of total offense, Navy's defense held the Bobcats offense to just 36 yards of offense, 45 of which came on the first play of the game.

"I was really happy with the hustle our defense showed," said Jenkins. "They really went after the ball on every play."

"Our offensive line was impressive the whole game. They really pushed the line of scrimmage forward and opened up some huge holes against guys that were sometimes twice their weight."

Navy took a 6-0 lead with 10:45 remaining in the first quarter when running back **Richard Engel (Sr./Medford, N.J.)** took a pitch and scored from eight yards out. However, Frostburg State JV grabbed the lead late in the first quarter on a 74-yard interception return and converted on its two-point pass to take an 8-6 advantage.

However, Navy responded with touchdowns on each of its next-five possessions, four of which came in the second quarter, to establish a commanding 41-8 cushion. Green rushed for back-to-back touchdowns before Engel found the endzone from one yard out and Green delivered scoring strikes from eight and 13 yards to wide receiver **Todd Barriger (Sr./Prescott, Mich.)**.

Barriger finished the game with seven receptions for 122 yards, including a 48-yard grab in the first quarter. Wide receiver **Tommy Tellson (Jr./Bedford, Texas)** also hauled in three passes for 47 yards on the evening. As a whole, the passing game threw for 282 yards in the victory.

Navy finished the contest with 184 yards rushing, with running back **Enrique Harris (Jr./Crawfordville, Fla.)** leading the way with 66 yards on 14 carries.

In his first collegiate game, linebacker **Alex Segler (Fr./Plano, Texas)** led the defense with eight tackles and assisted on one for a loss. Fellow linebackers **Emery Persinger (Fr./Cheswick, Pa.)** and **Brian Smith (Jr./Gainesville, Fla.)** also chipped in with five stops apiece. Defensive lineman **Galen Landis (Jr./Hershey, Pa.)** posted one and a half sacks and two and a half tackles for a loss, while linebacker **Chris Combelick (Jr./Camel, Ind.)** registered one and a half sacks.

Navy's defense registered 10 tackles in the backfield for a loss of 77 yards, broke up three passes, recovered a fumble and picked off a pass.

◆ Last Meeting ... Navy 17, Army 6 (Nov. 3, 2006)

Navy tailback Richard Engel ran the ball 34 times for 168 yards and two touchdowns to lead the Midshipmen to a 17-6 win over Army to capture the N-Star in front of 1,432 fans at Rip Miller Field. The win pushed Navy's winning streak over Army to six-straight games and third-straight N-Star victory.

The Midshipmen concluded the season with a 5-1 mark, 3-1 in CSFL action. The Black Knights ended their campaign with a 3-3 record, 2-2 in league play.

Engel gained 122 of his 168 yards in the opening half on 20 carries, many of which he followed the blocks provided by fullback Enrique Harris, who produced 61 yards on 11 rushing attempts.

Defensive lineman Dave Novotney led the defensive unit with 11 tackles, two of which came in the backfield. Linebacker Ryan Engle produced nine tackles, while sophomore linebacker Brian Smith also contributed nine tackles, five of which came during the third quarter. Defensive back Mike Molloy came up with eight tackles and batted away a pass.

Offensively, quarterback Chris Marsh ended the night 7-of-17 passing for 94 yards and no interceptions. Wide receiver Tommy Tellson caught three passes for 36 yards.

◆ Engel Approaching Career Rushing Touchdowns Record

Navy senior running back Richard Engel (Medford, N.J.) enters this week's action fifth on the career rushing touchdowns list, only three shy of matching the record of 23 touchdowns held by Matt Sobecki between 1994-97.

In 18 career games, Engel has found the endzone on 20 occasions. The product of Medford, N.J., opened the year with a two-touchdown effort at Frostburg State JV on Sept. 9. He has scored two touchdowns in three-straight games and four of the last-five contests.

One year ago, Engel led the CSFL in rushing with 659 yards and nine touchdowns on 115 carries (5.7 ypc). Engel became the first Navy running back to win the rushing title since Sobecki churned out 984 yards in 1997.

The Navy sprint football team will be making the first of two trips in 2007 up to New York State this weekend. This marks the third time within the last-five years and the fourth time in program history that the Mids have played two games in the Empire State. The Midshipmen have played both Army and Cornell on their home fields in 2003 and 2005, while traveling to Army and Columbia in 1958.

◆ You'll Have Nothing and Like It

Navy's defense opened the 2007 campaign with a dominating performance at Frostburg State JV, posting -34 yards rushing and 36 yards of total offense. ◆ Maj. Jake Jenkins, USMC, Takes Over the Reigns

Maj. Jake Jenkins, USMC, is in his first season as the head coach of the Navy sprint football team. He takes over a program that has won more CSFL/ELFL titles (31) and the highest winning percentage (.819) among any other school in league history.

Maj. Jenkins is no stranger to the ranks of the sprint football community, as he was a three-year letterwinner on Navy's sprint football squad from 1993-95. A two-time all-league defensive lineman, Maj. Jenkins served as the defensive team captain of a 1995 squad that posted a perfect 6-0 record and claimed the ELFL title.

"Given Maj. Jenkins's experience, leadership and past success with the Navy sprint football team, we expect the same level of commitment and enthusiasm that has been a trademark of the program throughout its entire history," stated Naval Academy Director of Athletics Chet Gladchuk. "A program as steeped in tradition as sprint football aspires to nothing less than the national championship every year."

"I am proud to return to my alma mater to give back to a team that meant so much to me as a midshipman," stated Jenkins. "The tradition is long and rich here and I look forward to adding what I can to the legacy of the team. The league is extremely competitive and adds to the foundation of experiences that will shape these future leaders."

Following commissioning from the Naval Academy in 1996, Maj. Jenkins graduated from The Basic School in March 1997 and Infantry Officers Course in August 1997. From there, he was assigned to 3rd Battalion 5th Marines where he held the billets of Rifle Platoon Commander, Rifle Company Executive Officer and CAAT Platoon Commander. As a Rifle Platoon Commander he deployed as part of the boat company in the 31st MEU and participated in the joint Exercise Cobra Gold in Thailand.

In February of 2000, he was assigned to Recruiting Station Baltimore where he held the billet of Operations Officer.

After graduating from the Expeditionary Warfare School in May 2004, he reported to 1st Battalion 8th Marines, where he assumed command of Headquarters and Service Company and deployed to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom II. Upon return from Iraq, he assumed command of Charlie Company.

While in Command of Charlie Company, Maj. Jenkins was deployed in support of JTF Katrina in order to assist with search and recovery, and humanitarian assistance. He later deployed as part of the 24th MEU and participated in the evacuation of 15,000 American Citizens from war-torn Lebanon. Charlie Company was entrusted with providing security for the U.S. Embassy in Beirut throughout the evolution. He also took part in Operation Infinite Moonlight, a bilateral event with the Jordanian Army.

Personal decorations include Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement medal with combat distinguishing device and Combat Action Ribbon.

Maj. Jenkins, 35, is married to the former Kristen Corbett of Catonsville, Md. They have three daughters, Ryleigh (4), Mackenna (3) and Haidyn (7 months).
