

## COACHING STAFF



### Kip Simons

Head Coach  
Sixth Year at Navy  
Ohio State '94

Kip Simons, a decorated head coach at Air Force and Olympic performer, was announced on Sept. 14, 2015 as the new head gymnastics coach at Navy. Simons came to Annapolis after 10 years as the head coach of Air Force.

He's had a near flawless transition to Navy and has seen his Midshipmen teams make an immediate impact on the national scene. Over his first five years in Annapolis, the Mids have qualified for and competed at the NCAA Championship Meet in each campaign. (Navy was on its way to a fifth straight trip before the COVID-19 pandemic halted the 2020 season in mid-March). Regionally, Simons and the Mids have captured the ECAC Championship in 2016, 2018 and 2019. Prior to Navy's ECAC title in 2016, the last time the team had been atop the podium was 1989. Additionally, the 2019 squad earned team titles at the All-Academy Championship and the USAG Collegiate Championship.

His Midshipmen teams have also shown themselves to be top-notch scholars in the classroom as four times in his first five years, Navy has ranked amongst the top-10 national in the CGA All-America Scholar-Athlete program for team GPA. All together, 44 Mids have earned individual honors for posting GPAs above 3.2; nine in 2020, eight in 2019, eight in 2018, nine in 2017 and 10 in 2016.

In an abridged 2020 campaign, Navy was on its way to a season to remember as the program collected a win the Star Meet over Army (its fourth in five years) and placed first at the All-Academy Championship for the second consecutive year over Air Force and Army. Consistent throughout the year, the Mids scored 402.0 points or more in five of their seven competitions and eventually concluded the shortened season with the fifth-best scoring average in the NCAA ranks at 406.63. Individually, four Mids earned CGA All-American honors, Ben Provost (HB), Cash Buske (HB), Josh Williams (R) and Connor Van Loo (V). As a whole, Navy gymnasts garnered an additional 24 All-ECAC and 12 USAG Collegiate All-America awards.

Simons was recognized as the ECAC, USAG Varsity and CGA East Regional Coach of the Year for his efforts in 2020.

The success for Simons and the Midshipmen hit new levels during the 2019 season when the

program won the Star Meet on the road in front of a hostile Army crowd, won the All-Academy Championship for the first time since 2009, placed first at the USAG Collegiate Championship for the first time since 2008, repeated as ECAC champions and then set a program-record with a 10th place result at the NCAA Championship Meet. The team scored a 393.123 in its respective qualifying session to usurp California. Navy's score also placed ahead of Army's result in the second session. Ryan McVay (HB), Ryan Orce (PB), Dan Clark (PH) and David Toussaint (FX) all advanced to the NCAA Championship Meet.

Simons garnered accolades as the ECAC, USAG Varsity and CGA East Regional Coach of the Year in 2019.

Academically, Simons had the Midshipmen performing at a high level in the classroom as well as they posted a cumulative GPA of 3.131 for the 2018-19 school year to rank eighth in the nation. Individually, eight Mids earned CGA All-American Scholar-Athlete nods. Team captain Christian Correale led the way once again as he was voted a Google Cloud Second Team All-American.

As a third-year head coach in 2018, the Mids qualified for the NCAA Championship with the 10th-highest National Qualifying Average (401.550) in the nation. At the competition at UIC, the Mids finished in fifth place in session one with a score 390.921. Overall, that ranked the Mids 11th out of 12 teams. Lucas Beltran (V), Frank Bradley (V), Trevor North (PB), and David Toussaint (PH) all advanced to the NCAA Championship Meet and the individual event finals.

Simons garnered the CGA East Regional Coach of the Year and the ECAC Coach of the Year awards.

In the classroom, Christian Correale was selected as a Google Cloud Academic All-American Third Team honoree. As a team, Navy ranked tenth in the nation with a cumulative GPA of 3.049.

During his second year in Annapolis in 2017, the Mids recreated the magic of 2016 and qualified as a team for the NCAA Championship for the second straight season. Seeded 12th in the field, Navy surpassed that mark and netted 400.65 points in the second session at West Point, N.Y. to finish

11th overall at the meet, edging California by 0.4 points. A pair of championship final qualifiers in Jonny Tang (AA) and Lucas Beltran (FX, V) led the Mids to the highest finish in program history at the national competition.

While competing at the 2017 USAG and ECAC Championships, Navy gymnasts secured five individual event titles: Jonny Tang (ECAC - AA, FX), Tanner West (ECAC - PB), Lucas Beltran (USAG - V) and Ben Provost (USAG - HB).

For its work outside the gym, Navy ranked seventh in the nation with a cumulative GPA of 3.21. The program also earned 2017 Academic Progress Rate (APR) public recognition from the NCAA.

Simons was recognized as the 2017 CGA East Regional Coach of the Year.

In his first season as the Mids' head coach in 2016, the team incurred new levels of success both in and out of the gym. Simons and Navy captured the program's first ECAC Championship since 1989 with a score of 423.4 to tie with Army West Point for the title. A program-record 424.1 score at the All-Academy Championship helped the team earn the league's automatic qualifying spot for the NCAA Championship and break the tie for ECAC supremacy. The Mids' spot as a team at the NCAA Championship was just the second ever in program history and first since 2009. In the national meet in Columbus, Ohio, Navy competed in the first team session and recorded a 410.1 score. Three individuals from the team advanced to the events finals: Jonny Tang (AA), Connor Gonzales (R) and Eric Poletti (R).

Prior to the NCAAs, Navy earned 15 All-ECAC honors for top-six performances at the ECAC Championship with Mitchell Larios (V and PB), Eric Morrison (PH) and Gonzales (R) taking home event titles.

In the classroom, Connor Westrick was selected as a CoSIDA Academic All-American Third Team honoree. As a team, Navy ranked fifth in the nation in with a team grade point average of 3.355.

Simons was recognized as the 2016 CGA East Regional Coach of the Year, as well as the 2016 ECAC Men's Gymnastics Co-Coach of the Year.

An internationally renown gymnast since 1988, Simons was a four-year member of the

United States Senior National team and competed on two world championship teams, as well as with the gold medal winning teams at the 1994 Goodwill Games and 1995 Pan-American Games. His competitive career culminated with a spot on the 1996 United States Olympic team. At the 1996 Olympics in Atlanta, Simons was a member of the U.S. team that finished fifth overall.

After retiring from international competition, Simons moved into collegiate coaching at the University of California in 2001. In five seasons from 2001 to 2005, the Bears twice finished in third place at the NCAA Championships and had four individuals win national championships. Simons was named Associate Head Coach of the Bears for his final season in Berkeley.

Beginning with the 2005-06 season, Simons started a 10-year reign in charge of the gymnastics program at the United States Air Force Academy. A five-time USAG Varsity Head Coach of the Year, the Falcons thrived under his leadership and expertise. In both 2012 and 2014, Air Force earned rankings as high as eighth nationally. Simons took a team to the NCAA National Qualifying Meet and saw 15 gymnasts advance into the NCAA Championships in each of his final five years in Colorado Springs. On three occasions under his tutelage Falcon athletes earned NCAA All-American nods, Greg Stine twice in 2008 (all-around and rings) and Tim Wang in 2014 (pommel horse).

In USAG National Championship competition, Simons and Air Force won six straight team titles from 2010 through 2015 and collected 28 individual event titles.

While at Air Force, Simons was the recipient of four CGA Collegiate Division National Head Coach of the Year awards (2010, 2011, 2012, 2013), as well as two NCAA Regional Head Coach of the Year (2008, 2010) and Mountain Pacific Sports Federation Coach of the Year (2006, 2014) honors, respectively.

A 1994 graduate from Ohio State University, Simons earned numerous honors throughout his four years with the Buckeyes, including Big Ten Freshman of the Year and the Nissen-Emery Award, as the nation's top senior gymnast. He was a four-year member of the All-Big 10 and earned conference titles on the parallel bars (1992, 1994), still rings (1992) and high bar (1993). Simons garnered two NCAA All-America certificates during his time in Columbus. In September 2006, the Varsity "O" Association inducted him into Ohio State's Athletic Hall of Fame.

For his work and success throughout the sport, Simons was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Hall of Fame in the summer of 2010. He was joined in the 2010 induction class by 1996 Olympic team gold medalist Dominique Moceanu, 1992 Olympic team bronze medalist Wendy Bruce-Martin, 2000 Olympian Jennifer Parilla, two-time U.S. Men's Olympic team head coach Kevin Mazeika and 2000 U.S. Olympic trampoline coach Robert Null.

## Craig Holt

Assistant Coach  
22nd Year at Navy  
Syracuse '95

Craig Holt enters his 22nd season with the Navy program. After 16 years as an assistant coach with Dr. Sho Fukushima through 2015, he stayed on staff under the leadership for new head coach Kip Simons. Holt brings a wealth of experience and knowledge in the sport of gymnastics as both a former athlete and assistant coach.

Combining his talents with Simons since the fall of 2015, Holt and the program have reached new heights with four straight trips to the NCAA Championship (Navy was on its way to a fifth straight trip before the COVID-19 pandemic halted the 2020 season in mid-March). Prior to this run of competition on the highest national stage, Navy had only been to the NAAs in 2009. Navy's success has resulted Holt earning CGA East Regional Assistant Coach of the Year honors in 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020.

Regionally, the Mids have captured the ECAC Championship in 2016, 2018 and 2019. Prior to Navy's ECAC title in 2016, the last time the team had been atop the podium was 1989. Additionally, Holt and the Mids have earned back-to-back All-Academy Championship titles in 2019 and 2020 and the USAG Collegiate Championship in 2019.

In an abridged 2020 campaign, Navy was on its way to a season to remember as the program collected a win the Star Meet over Army (its fourth in five years), placed first at the All-Academy Championship, scored 402.0 points or more in five of their seven competitions and eventually concluded the shortened season with the fifth-best scoring average in the NCAA ranks at 406.63. Individually, four Mids earned CGA All-American honors, Ben Provost (HB), Cash Buske (HB), Josh Williams (R) and Connor Van Loo (V). As a whole, Navy gymnasts garnered an additional 24 All-ECAC and 12 USAG Collegiate All-America awards. Holt is directly involved in the coaching of Navy's rings and high bar units.

In his 20th season on staff with Navy Men's Gymnastics, Holt and the Mids achieved nearly every goal set in front of them in 2019 as they were victorious over Army in the Star Meet and later Air Force and Army at the All-Academy Championship. In the postseason, Navy rolled to team titles at the USAG Collegiate Championship and the ECAC Championship meets. The final touch on Navy's 2019 season was a 10th-place result at the NCAA Championships with a score of 393.123 to best both California and Army. For Navy's success, Holt was named the CGA East Regional, USAG Varsity and ECAC Co-Assistant Coach of the Year with his fellow Navy assistant coach Colin Payne.

In 2018, the Mids competed on the grandest stage, the NCAA Championship for the third straight year as Navy tallied the 10th-highest national qualifying average during the regular season. At the NAAs, Navy placed 11th overall and finished ahead of Air Force in the 12-team field. Four Mids earned their way into the event finals of the NCAA Championship, while four athletes won five combined individual titles over the USAG or ECAC Championship meets.

The recipient of the 2017 CGA East Regional and ECAC Men's Gymnastics Assistant Coach of the Year awards, Holt and the Mids had another standout campaign during the 2017 season. Navy qualified for and competed as a team at the NCAA Championship for the second straight year and came away with a program-best 11th place finish to surpass the team from Cal in the standings. Individual highlights from 2017 include five event titles at the ECAC and USAG Championship from a total of four different gymnasts.

2016 was a banner year for Holt and the Navy program as the team captured the ECAC Championship and an automatic bid into the NCAA Championship. Navy's ECAC crown was its first since 1989, while a team appearance in the NAAs had only occurred once prior back in 2009. Three Mids advanced from the team qualifying meet to the event finals of the NCAA Championships, Jonny Tang (all-around), Connor Gonzales (rings) and Eric Poletti (rings). In addition to their success at the national meet, Navy accrued 15 All-ECAC honorees at the ECAC Championship. For the team's stellar performance during the season, Holt was recognized as the CGA East Regional Assistant Coach of the Year, as well as the ECAC Men's Gymnastics Co-Assistant Coach of the Year.

During 2013-15 seasons, Holt has helped three athletes qualify for and compete in the NCAA Championships. In April of 2015 at the University of Oklahoma, Jonny Tang was an entrant in the all-around competition, while Mitchell Larios took on the nation's best on the vault. In 2013, Chris Junghans finished 12th overall in the all-around competition and just missed placing in the top 10 by 0.4 points.

Prior to Junghans, Holt helped coach Andrew Faulk to his spectacular 2012 senior campaign, which included a 13th-place finish at the NCAA Championships. In 2011, Holt was named ECAC Tri-Assistant Coach of the Year as he helped guide Dylan Parrott and Andrew Faulk to the NCAA Championships.

In 2009, Holt assisted in helping the Midshipmen to a memorable season, as they finished with an impressive 15-4 record and a N-Star victory at Army. In addition, the Mids won their second-straight All-Academy Championship, placed second at the ECAC Championship and advanced as a team to the NCAA Qualifying Meet for the first time in program history.

His efforts in the gym have not gone unrecognized, as he has been named the NCAA East Region Assistant Coach of the Year (2007), USAG Collegiate Division Assistant Coach of the Year (2020, 2019, 2008, 2006), ECAC Assistant Coach of the Year (2020, 2019, 2017, 2016-Co, 2011, 2007 and 2003) and CGA Regional Assistant Coach of the Year (2020, 2019, 2018, 2017, 2016, 2007-Co).

During the summer of 2005, Holt coached the United States team in the 2005 Maccabiah Games in Israel. Holt guided the United States to a second-place team finish with gold medal performances in the floor exercise and pommel horse. In addition to his coaching duties, Holt also served as a judge at the Maccabiah Games.

Holt came to the Academy after serving as an assistant coach for one season at William & Mary and two years at his alma mater, Syracuse.

As a gymnast, Holt was an NCAA finalist on the rings in 1994. He is a 1995 graduate of Syracuse, where he earned a degree in physical education. Holt earned his master's degree in exercise physiology from Syracuse in the summer of 2002.

Payne joined the Naval Academy program in September of 2017 after years of success in the youth ranks, including his most recent stop at the noted Bart Conner Gymnastics Academy.

"I am extremely excited to announce the addition of Colin Payne to our coaching staff and the Navy Gymnastics Family," remarked head coach Kip Simons. "Colin has been around the program for just brief time and he has made an immediate impact on our student athletes. Colin brings passion and has a well-trained technical eye for the development of gymnasts."

During his first three years with the program, Payne has made an immediate impact and has drawn recognition for the team's success with East Regional Co-Assistant Coach of the Year honors coming from the CGA in 2018, 2019 and 2020, in addition to the nod as ECAC Co-Assistant Coach of the Year in 2019 and 2020.

The 2020 Navy squad had a season to remember as the program collected a win the Star Meet over Army, placed first at the All-Academy Championship, scored 402.0 points or more in five of their seven competitions and eventually ended the abridged season with the fifth-best scoring average in the NCAA ranks at 406.63. Individually, four Mids earned CGA All-American honors, Ben Provost, Cash Buske, Josh Williams and Connor Van Loo. As a whole, Navy gymnasts garnered an additional 24 All-ECAC and 12 USAG Collegiate All-America awards.

Payne and the Mids turned in one of the best seasons in program history in 2019 as the team defeated Army for the second straight Star Meet, won the All-Academy Championship for the first time since 2009, the USAG Collegiate Championship for the first time since 2008 and the ECAC Championship for the second year. The season culminated with Navy finishing 10th at the NCAA Championship and outscoring both California and Army.

In his first year with the Mids in 2018, the team competed at the NCAA Championship meet, as well as won the 2018 ECAC Championship. Individually, four athletes attained a total of five combined individual titles at the USAG and ECAC Championship events.

A member of the coaching staff at the Bart Conner Gymnastics Academy for over five years beginning in July 2012, Payne had a first-hand role in the growth and maturation of numerous future and current NCAA gymnasts. Above and beyond DI athletes, Payne coached Jordan Kovach, a member of the United States Junior National Team, while Kovach was at BCGA.

Prior to coaching in Oklahoma, Payne worked at the Harpeth School of Gymnastics near Nashville, Tennessee during the 2011-12 school year.

A native of Hendersonville, Tenn., Payne is a 2017 graduate from the University of Oklahoma. Payne earned a bachelor's degree in anthropology.

# 2021 NAVY GYMNASTICS

## SEASON PREVIEW

The Navy men's gymnastics program will begin its 2021 campaign on Saturday, January 30 when it participates in a virtual meet against Ohio State. The matchup between the Mids and the Buckeyes features a pair of CGA's preseason top-10 teams as Navy was picked ninth, while Ohio State stood fifth. One of the fastest rising programs in the NCAA ranks under the guidance of sixth-year head coach Kip Simons, the talented Midshipmen squad has earned annual bids to the NCAA Championship in each of Simons' first four years and were well on their way last season as they had the nation's fifth highest qualifying average when the COVID-19 pandemic caused an abrupt conclusion to their campaign in mid-March. This season will have a different look for Navy as the Mids will be opening a few weeks later than normal and with more reliance on virtual meets. This Saturday is the first of five competitions that Navy will compete in via a virtual setting. First touch between the Mids and Buckeyes is set for 12 p.m.

### 2021 Roster

The 2021 version of Navy Men's Gymnastics is deep and talented with 23 members on the roster ready to see action. Amongst those 23 gymnasts, Simons and his staff will lean on a strong and deep 13-man upperclass with five seniors and eight more juniors. The sophomore class consists of three gymnasts, while seven freshman join the ranks this season.

### Who's Back

The senior class is made up of a variety of multi-dimensional gymnasts with **Max Gerber** serving as the team captain. Gerber is joined by **Jake Carlson, Travis Keller, Ryan McVay** and **David Toussaint**. Throughout their first three seasons of competition all five gymnasts have garnered postseason accolades whether it

be on the conference or national-level ...

## Who's New

Kip Simons and his assistant coaches Craig Holt and Colin Payne recruited a gifted seven member freshmen class that should pay immediate dividends for the Mids in 2021 in a variety of event lineups. The class ranges from Massachusetts with **Syam Buradagunta**, to the southeast with North Carolina native **Caleb Hickey** and to the west with a pair of Texans, **Ronan McQuillan** and **John Wendeborn**. The class is rounded out with a trio of local talents as **Erik Engelke** hails from Henrico, Virginia, while **Ian Dinmore** and **Matthew Rosendahl** are both from Maryland, Odenton and Upperco, respectively.

## Preseason Rankings

The College Gymnastics Association released its 2021 CGA Preseason Coaches Poll and the Navy gymnastics team found itself ranked ninth overall in the nation. The Mids are coming off a standout 2020 campaign that saw the program win the Star Meet over Army, place first at the All-Academy Championship, score 402.0 points or more in five of their seven competitions and eventually end the abridged season with the fifth-best scoring average in the NCAA ranks at

406.63. The COVID-19 pandemic ended the 2020 collegiate men's gymnastics season following the meets on the weekend of March 7-8. Prior to the COVID shutdown, the Mids had appeared in four straight NCAA Championship Meets from 2016 through 2019.

Stanford, the 2019 NCAA champions, headline the 2021 CGA Preseason Coaches Poll with 221 points and 12 first-place votes. Oklahoma, the winner of the four NCAA Championship titles from 2015 to 2018 is right behind the Cardinal with 208 points and a pair of first-place votes. The Michigan Wolverines are picked third with 187 points and received the final first-place vote. Nebraska (171) and Illinois (156) to round out the top-five. Four more Big Ten programs make up the second half of the top-10 as Penn State (154), Ohio State (141) and Minnesota (119) are situated in front of Navy, who was ranked ninth with 102 points. Iowa is right behind with 98 voting points.

The Midshipmen are the only non-Power 5 school in the top-10 and are the highest ranked service academy program as Army sits 12th overall, one spot ahead of Air Force. Amongst its ECAC rivals, Navy is the highest ranked squad.

## 2021 Season at a Glance

Navy kicks off its 2021 season on Saturday with a virtual competition versus Ohio State. Two weeks later, the program will have its first in-person meet of the season with the All-Academy Championship on Feb. 13 in West Point, N.Y. The three-team service academy showdown between Air Force, Army and Navy. Navy's second of four regular season virtual meets is slated for Wednesday, Feb. 17 versus Stanford, followed by Feb. 27 against Penn State and March 20 versus Springfield College. The other in-person competitions include road meets at William & Mary on Feb. 21 and at Army for the Star on March 6, and a home tilt against William & Mary on March 13. This year's postseason lineup consists of the USAG Collegiate Championships on March 26-27, the ECAC Championship on April 3 and the NCAA Championships on April 16-17. The University of Minnesota will host the two-day national championship meet in Minneapolis.

## What is a Virtual Meet?

A contest between multiple teams that will be competing from their respective gyms/arenas with judges receiving a live stream of the action and reporting scores back in real-time. The procedures and pacing of the competition should be similar to an in-person meet. Fans will also be able to view the competition on the Virtius platform that will showcase both teams' respective routines, as well as a live scoring component.

- Father was a gymnast at the University of Washington and trained for the senior U.S. National Team; he was also the first American in history to do a triple back on the floor - at the U.S. Nationals in 1993

## 2020 YEAR-IN-REVIEW

- Finished the condensed regular season ranked fifth in the nation with a national qualifying average of 406.633. Competing in seven meets through March 7 when the COVID-19 pandemic cancelled all collegiate seasons, the Mids surpassed the 400-point plateau five times, including scores of 410.5 in a victory over Cal on March 7, 407.8 in the team's win at the 2020 Navy Open on January 18 and 407.7 points at the 2020 All-Academy Championship when they outscored Army and Air Force in San Antonio on February 8.
- With the abridged season, the Collegiate Gymnastics Association announced that the organization would award 2020 CGA Regular Season All-American honors. For their respective efforts senior Ben Provost, sophomores Josh Williams and Cash Buske, and freshman Connor Van Loo all garnered All-American status for finishing in the top-eight nationally of each of their particular events: Provost (high bar), Williams (rings), Buske (high bar) and Van Loo (vault). This is the first time since 1973 that a Navy gymnast has earned All-American status.
- Kip Simons was named NCAA East Regional (his fifth in five years at Navy), USAG Varsity and ECAC Coach of the Year
- Craig Holt and Colin Payne were named NCAA East Regional, USAG Varsity and ECAC Assistant Coaches of the Year.
- Freshman Connor Van Loo was named ECAC Rookie of the Year.
- In the national rankings at the end of the season (March 9), Navy's vault and high bar lineups were each the third highest scoring in their respective events. The Mids' rings lineup ranked fourth, while its floor exercise team was the fifth highest scoring based on the four-score average ranking system. Additionally, Navy's pommel horse (No. 7) and parallel bars (No. 9) lineups ranked in the top-10.
- In the individual standings; the above listed CGA All-Americans led the way for Navy as Williams (rings) and Buske (high bar) both ended up in sixth place, respectively amongst national gymnasts. Van Loo was the eighth ranked vaulter, while Provost was eighth on the high bar. Additional Navy gymnasts in the top-20 nationally include, senior Frank Bradley (No. 16-floor exercise), sophomore Dan Clark (No. 15-pommel horse), junior David Toussaint (No. 17-pommel horse and No. 18-vault), junior Ryan McVay (No. 18-rings), senior Lucas Beltran (No. 16-vault).
- The Mids were declared the 2020 ECAC Champions due to their ranking as the top-scoring team in the conference. Navy also saw Van Loo selected as the ECAC Rookie of the Year, while Simons was named the ECAC Coach of the Year and Holt and Payne garnered nods as Co-ECAC Assistant Coaches of the Year.
- In the postseason awards announcement from the ECAC, Navy earned 24 All-ECAC honors with its high bar lineup sweeping all six accolades: Buske, Provost, juniors Max Gerber and McVay, freshman Giovanni Gambatese and senior Ryan Orce. The Mids' floor exercise corps had five honorees: Bradley, Williams, Van Loo, Toussaint and Provost. The list of All-ECAC vault award winners was four deep with Van Loo, Beltran, Toussaint and junior Travis Keller. Additional members of the All-ECAC team consisted of Clark, Toussaint, Orce and junior Jake Carlson on the pommel horse; Williams, McVay and Carlson on the rings and Gerber and McVay on parallel bars.
- Navy had the highest individual scorer on four separate events amongst ECAC-only gymnasts: Clark (pommel horse), Williams (rings), Van Loo (vault) and Buske (high bar).
- The USA Gymnastics organization also released its postseason awards in lieu of the championship event. Navy led the way with 12 2020 USAG Men's Collegiate All-Americans. With two representatives on each event the list of Midshipmen honorees consists of Bradley and Williams on the floor exercise, Clark and Toussaint on the pommel horse, Van Loo and Beltran on the vault, Williams and McVay on the rings, Gerber and McVay on the parallel bars and Buske and Provost on the high bar.
- Provost, Orce, Gerber and senior Cian McConnell were all recognized as 2020 USAG Scholar-Athletes.
- In Navy's postseason team awards announcement, Navy's underclass swept the honors Williams was named the MVP and Hardest Worker, while fellow sophomore Alexander Brown was selected as the Most Improved. Van Loo concluded his stellar debut season as Navy's Freshmen of the Year.
- Outscored Army on three separate occasions during the regular season starting with the West Point Open (395.45 – 388.55), then at the Star Meet (404.4-380.9) and finally at the All-Academy Championship (407.7 – 394.1).
- Highlights of the 2020 Army-Navy Star Meet from Navy's Macdonough Hall started on the first apparatus, the floor exercise, and continued through the last, the high bar as the Mids led wire-to-wire. Navy was up 4.75 points after its first turn on its way to a 23.5-point margin of victory. Navy outscored Army on every event and saw its gymnasts finish atop the individual event leaderboards five different times. Provost won the high bar, while tying for the floor exercise crown with Toussaint, who additionally came in first on the vault. Junior Jake Carlson was the high-scorer on the pommel horse, while Williams dominated on the rings.
- Won the All-Academy Championship for the second consecutive year as the Mids scored 407.7 points to surpass both Army (394.1) and Air Force (387.5). As a team, they placed first in four of the rotations; the floor exercise, rings, parallel bars and high bar. Individually, Williams finished first on the floor exercise and rings, while Beltran won the vault. Provost was the fourth Navy gymnast to come in first as he was the top scorer on the high bar. Prior to 2019, Navy's last All-Academy victory was in 2009.
- As a program, Midshipmen gymnasts collected 12 ECAC weekly performance honors: Van Loo (Rookie of the Week – five times); Toussaint (Gymnast of the Week – once / Specialist of the Week – once); Beltran (Specialist); Gambatese (Rookie); Williams (Specialist); Provost (Specialist) and McVay (Gymnast).
- Bradley served as team captain.

### Nine Midshipmen Earn 2020 All-America Scholar-Athlete Accolades

The College Gymnastics Association recently announced its 2020 national academic teams as well as its All-America Scholar-Athletes. Nine individual Midshipmen were amongst the 114 national student-athletes recognized as All-American Scholar-Athletes on either the first or second teams

Recent graduates Frank Bradley, Cian McConnell, Ryan Orce and Ben Provost, rising senior Jake Carlson and Max Gerber, rising juniors Dhiren Lutchman and Josh Williams and rising sophomore Connor Van Loo all received accolades for posting GPAs above 3.2 during the 2019-20 school year.

Bradley (astrophysics), Provost (applied mathematics), Orce (mathematics) and McConnell (aerospace engineering) all garnered first-team status for their respective GPAs of 3.5 or higher.

Carlson (general engineering), Gerber (aerospace engineering), Lutchman (ocean engineering), Van Loo (robotics & control engineering) and Williams (quantitative economics) earned All-American Scholar-Athlete Second Team honors for their GPAs between 3.2 and 3.49.

Criteria for the award consists of a student-athlete be at least a sophomore, earn a varsity letter in their sport and have attained a minimum 3.30 cumulative grade-point average (changed from 3.20 for the 2008-09 academic year). Nominees are first voted on by district, then all first-team all-district winners are placed onto a national ballot from which the Academic All-America teams are selected.

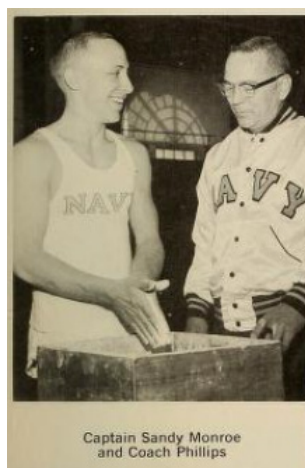
