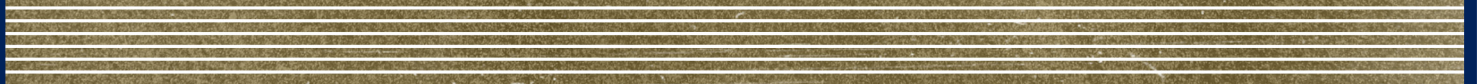

COACHING STAFF

GAVIN HICKIE DIRECTOR OF RUGBY

Gavin Hickie enters his ninth season as the director of rugby at Navy in the fall of 2025. In his nine years in Annapolis, Hickie owns an overall record of 96-17 and is 56-4 since the team was elevated to varsity status. Additionally, he has won a national championship (2023), four-straight Rugby East titles (2022, '23, '24, '25) and coached two Rudy Scholz Award winners.

Navy compiled a 15-2 overall record during the 2024-25 season. The Mids posted a 6-1 Rugby East Conference record to capture their third-straight league championship under Hickie. Navy outscored its opponents 655-248 throughout the season. The Mids averaged 38.5 points per match, while the defense allowed 14.5 points per game.

Highlighting the fall campaign were victories over service academy rivals Army and Air Force. Navy defeated Army, 32-5, in Annapolis, Md., in the men's rugby Star Match. The Mids also took care of Air Force, 79-14, in Glendale, Colo., and claimed the Lt. Col. Kevin Shea Memorial Rugby Cup for the seventh-straight season.

Navy had a league-leading eight athletes named to the Rugby East All-Conference teams. Andrew Baublitz, Roanin Krieger, Tanner Russell and William Webb received First-Team All-Rugby East recognition. JD Bengston and Michael Kalalau garnered second-team honors. Additionally, Avion Ganse and Michael Strehle collected honorable-mention accolades.

Navy won an additional four matches during the spring campaign to finish the regular season as the second-ranked team in the Goff Rugby Report Rankings. The Mids opened the spring with a 27-3 victory over fourth-ranked California in Annapolis. Navy went on to defeat three more nationally ranked teams against 14th-ranked Penn State (29-26), seventh-ranked Mount St. Mary's (27-8) and 13th-ranked Mary Washington (27-22).

The Mids claimed the top seed of the Collegiate Rugby Association of America (CRAA) Division I-A Playoffs for the third-consecutive year in a row. Navy picked up one win in the playoffs when it knocked off No. 15 Penn State, 45-7, in the first round.

Hickie also led 12 athletes to CRAA D1A All-America accolades – Baublitz, Bengston, Ian Bullock, Jake Cornelius, Ganse, Krieger, Michael Kalalau, Tanner Russell, Max Smith, Edmund Soeder, Strehle and William Webb.

The Mids compiled a 17-2 overall record during its second varsity season under Hickie in 2023-24. Navy outscored its opponents, 910-245, and posted an average margin of victory of 40.7 points. The Mids averaged 7.1 tries per match, while only surrendering 1.8 tries per contest defensively.

Navy was the top-ranked team in the nation in each national poll released CRAA in 2023-24. The Mids won nine games against opponents ranked in the top 20 in the final CRAA power rankings poll over the course of the season. Navy defeated second-ranked Life twice (20-14; 27-17), eighth-ranked Arkansas State (57-5), 11th-ranked Mount St. Mary's (32-20), 12th-ranked Army (23-21), 14th-ranked Mary Washington (41-7), 17th-ranked Penn State twice (57-5; 37-12) and 19th-ranked Air Force (50-8).

The Mids posted an 11-0 record during the fall season. Navy won all seven of its games against Rugby East opponents to capture the league title for the second-straight season. The Mids also continued their dominance over service academy rivals Air Force and Army. Navy defeated Air Force, 50-8, in Annapolis to claim the Lt. Col. Kevin Shea Memorial Rugby Cup for the sixth-straight season. The Mids later battled the Black Knights in West Point in the inaugural men's rugby Star Match, which is part of the Army-Navy Star Series presented by USAA. A walk-off penalty kick propelled Navy to a 23-21 victory.



A league-leading nine midshipmen earned Rugby East All-Conference accolades. Krieger, Russell and Vaughn Schmitz received First-Team All-Rugby East recognition. Jake Beitia, Sean MacLaney and Smith garnered second-team honors. Additionally, Jack Aleman, Ben Haugh and Austin Taylor collected honorable-mention accolades.

After winning three of their four matches during the spring season, the Mids claimed the top seed in the CRAA Division I-A playoff east bracket for the second year in a row. Navy opened the postseason with a 41-7 victory over Mary Washington in the first round. The Mids then dominated Arkansas State, 57-5, in the quarterfinals. Navy punched its ticket to the national championship game for the second-consecutive season with a 27-17 win against Life in the semifinals.

Hickie had two athletes nominated for the Rudy Scholz Award once again during the 2023-24 campaign. Krieger and Schmitz were each one of 18 players nominated for the award. Navy and St. Mary's were the only schools with multiple nominees. Additionally, Hickie coached three CRAA DI-A First-Team All-Americans (Jake Cornelius, Haugh, Krieger).

Hickie guided the Mids to a national championship and an 18-0 record in their first season as a varsity program. Navy outscored its opponents, 760-208, and posted an average margin of victory of 30.6 points. Navy's offense averaged 6.2 tries per match, while only surrendering 1.2 tries per contest defensively.

The Mids won eight games against opponents ranked in the top 20 of the College Rugby Association of America (CRAA) power rankings and outscored their ranked foes, 274-128.

Navy opened the 2022-23 campaign during the fall and posted an undefeated 11-0 record to claim its first Rugby East Conference Championship. Highlighting Navy's fall season were wins over academy rivals Air Force and Army. The Mids dominated No. 19 ranked Air Force, 71-0, to claim the Lt. Col. Shea Memorial Rugby Cup for the seventh-straight season. Navy defeated No. 1 ranked Army, 27-14, later in the season for its first win over the Black Knights since 2019.

Navy resumed competition in the spring and won an additional four matches, two of which were against teams ranked in the top 10 of the CRAA power rankings. Navy defeated No. 4 California, 33-28, for its first victory over the Golden Bears. The Mids also won their second match of the season against No. 8 Army, 34-26.

The Mids earned the top seed in the CRAA Division I-A Playoffs and defeated Army, 30-6, in the quarterfinals. Navy surrendered just two penalty kicks in the match, which marked the first time Army had been held without a try against a U.S. school in its nine-year varsity history. The Mids took down Lindenwood, 12-10, in the semifinals to set up a rematch against national powerhouse California in the championship. Navy overcame an early deficit and won the match, 28-22, to earn its first national championship in program history.

Hired in the summer of 2017, Hickie guided the Mids to an overall record of 40-13 over the program's five seasons on the club level. Navy posted at least 10 wins three times under Hickie, including a 12-4 mark during the 2018-19 season.

Two Midshipmen have won the Rudy Scholz Award under Hickie, which is presented annually by the Washington Athletic Club to the top men's college rugby player in the country. Connor McNerney became the first Mid to win the award in 2018. Most recently, Lewis Gray earned the accolade in 2023. Navy is one of only two programs to have multiple winners since the award was introduced in 2016.

The Dublin, Ireland, native graduated from the University College Dublin in 2003. He played professional rugby for Leinster and helped the club win the inaugural Celtic League in 2001. Hickie also played for the London Irish RFC, the Worcester Warriors and the Leicester Tigers. He helped Leicester win the 2007 Guinness Premiership.

Hickie began his coaching career in 2007 as the forwards coach for Leicester Academy. He then served as an assistant coach for the Belmont Shore Rugby Football Club in Southern California and the head coach at Woodrow Wilson High School in Long Beach, Calif.

COACHING STAFF

Hickie moved to the college level when he was named the head coach at Dartmouth in 2012. He led Dartmouth to the Ivy League Championship in XV's and 7s in all five seasons at the helm. The Big Green made the Varsity Cup Quarterfinals (XV's) in 2013, '14 and '16, won the CRC (7s) in 2012 and advanced to the Quarterfinals from 2013-16. Additionally, Dartmouth won the USA Rugby 7s in 2012 and placed third in 2013.

On a national level, Hickie was affiliated with USA Rugby for several years as either an assistant or head coach.

JAMES WILLOCKS

ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF RUGBY

Willocks is entering his fourth season at Navy as assistant director of rugby in the fall of 2025. Since his arrival to Annapolis, the Mids have compiled a record of 56-4, won a national championship (2023) and four-straight Rugby East titles (2022, '23, '24, '25). Additionally, Willocks has coached a Rudy Scholz Award winner (Lewis Gray, 2023), seven Collegiate Rugby Association of America First-Team All-Americans and eight First-Team All-Rugby East recipients.

Willocks works closely with director of rugby Gavin Hickie in recruitment, game plan development and periodization.

His presence was immediately felt in his first season at Navy. The Mids posted an 18-0 record and won their first Division I-A National Championship.

Willocks brings a critical understanding of the performance pathway through youth, collegiate and professional levels. A leading professional coach in player and person development, Willocks has been heavily involved with the Academy systems and will continue to shape the development of the game on and off the field.

Willocks is well versed in collegiate rugby, having been immersed since 2012 when he was appointed an assistant coach at Dartmouth College in New Hampshire. He also served as a strength and conditioning coach for the Dartmouth football program from 2013-16, winning the Ivy League in 2015.

In 2017, Willocks took a sabbatical from New England when he was appointed head coach of powerhouse program Penn State, where he guided the Nittany Lions to the Varsity Cup Semifinals.

Willocks returned to Dartmouth as head coach the following year. He led the team to six Ivy League 15s Championships, five Ivy League 7s Championships, a DI-AA National Championship and the Las Vegas 7s Championship in 2019.

He also served as an assistant coach of USA Rugby Men's Collegiate All-Americans from 2016 to 2018 and head coach from 2018 and 2019.

Along with his coaching at the collegiate level, Willocks is well-versed in coaching professional rugby. He spent three seasons as a defensive coach for the New England Free Jacks. Additionally, he served as an attacks coach for one season with DC Old Glory.

Originally from Balcultha, New Zealand, Willocks attended John McGlashan College in Dunedin for high school where he played for the First XV. He then attended the University of Otago where he graduated with a degree in Physical Education and played premier-level rugby with Alhambra Union Rugby Club. After college, Willocks worked with Otago rugby in the (then) ITM Cup as a strength and conditioning coach.

Willocks resides in Arnold with his wife, Whittaker, and children, Charlie and Bo.



DALLAS ELLISTON

DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS

Dallas Elliston is entering his second season at Navy as the Director of Rugby Operations and Player Development in the fall of 2025. Elliston had previously served as a volunteer coach with the Midshipmen since the fall of 2022. Navy has compiled a 56-5 record, played in two National Championship games, including winning the title in 2023 and four-consecutive Rugby East titles (2022, '23, '24, '25).

Elliston helped guide Navy to a 15-2 overall record during the 2024-25 season. The Mids posted a 6-1 Rugby East Conference record to capture their third-straight league championship. Navy outscored its opponents 655-248 throughout the season. The Mids averaged 38.5 points per match, while the defense allowed 14.5 points per game.

Elliston was born and raised as a farmer in Carl Junction, Miss. He studied Mechanical Engineering and played rugby under Hickie during all four years of his time at the United States Naval Academy - serving as President of the club his senior year. In 2021, Elliston graduated with distinction and was commissioned into the United States Marine Corps.

During his three years in the Marine Corps, Elliston was assigned to Navy men's rugby as an officer representative and its forwards coach. In this role, he used the sport's platform to facilitate an environment for developing and testing the character and leadership of players in line with the overall mission of the Naval Academy.

Under his new role, Elliston will lead program operations and logistics, continue his focus on player development, and maintain responsibility for the coaching and performance of scrums and lineouts within Navy's game model.

Elliston is a class of 2024 Stockdale Associate Fellow from USNA's Stockdale Center for Ethical Leadership and is currently obtaining his Masters of Business Administration at Georgetown University's McDonough's School of Business.

Elliston resides in Annapolis with his wife, Macalah.

Andrew Baublitz, Roanin Krieger, Tanner Russell and William Webb received First-Team All-Rugby East recognition. JD Bengston and Michael Kalalau garnered second-team honors. Additionally, Avion Ganse and junior Michael Strehle collected honorable-mention accolades.
- Krieger led the league in scoring for the second-straight season with 101 points in conference play. He led the Rugby East in penalty kicks (17) and was second in conversion kicks (25). It was the third-consecutive season a Mid led the Rugby East in scoring.
- Navy won an additional four matches during the spring campaign to finish the regular season as the second-ranked team in the Goff Rugby Report Rankings. The Mids opened the spring with a 27-3 victory over fourth-ranked California in Annapolis. Navy went on to defeat three more nationally-ranked teams against 14th-ranked Penn State (29-26), seventh-ranked Mount St. Mary's (27-8) and 13th-ranked Mary Washington (27-22).
- The Mids claimed the top seed of the Collegiate Rugby Association of America (CRAA) Division I-A Playoffs for the third-consecutive year. Navy opened the playoffs with a 45-7 victory over Penn State in the first round. The Mids dropped their quarterfinals match to Lindenwood, 10-3.
- Twelve (12) athletes earned D1A All-America accolades from the CRAA – Baublitz, Bengston, Ian Bullock, Jake Cornelius, Ganse, Krieger, Michael Kalalau, Tanner Russell, Max Smith, Edmund Soeder, Strehle and William Webb.
- Navy outscored its opponents 655-248 throughout the season. The Mids averaged 38.5 points per match, while the defense allowed 14.5 points per game.
