- **Visitors**: Effective **January 15, 2022** visitors (ages 5 and older) are required to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination (paper or digital), or proof of a negative test within the previous 48 hours, along with photo ID (ie: driver's license, school ID) for all group events open to the public that are:
- in the Kidera Gymnasium, swimming pool, Golisano Training Center, performance spaces, or chapel
- at the Bill Gray's Regional Iceplex
- and any indoor campus event open to the public where 100 or more guests are expected
- Campus Safety will coordinate staff to check documentation.
- Plan to provide:
- Identity: Photo ID (driver's license or school ID). If a child doesn't have a
 photo ID, they need to be accompanied by a parent/guardian or school
 official.
- And either:
 - Vaccine documentation: Original vaccination card or other documentation (in printed or digital form, including digital vaccine passport) showing full vaccination.
 - Or a negative test result from the previous 48 hours: A printout or digital pdf of your lab test result, or a time-stamped photo of your athome test result.
- Masks: The indoor masking requirement continues for everyone on campus.
