Game Facts

Previous Game: The Aggies picked up a key road victory on Saturday, defeating the defending Big South Champions Liberty by 60-56. The Aggie defense held the Flames to their lowest field goal and 3-point field goal percentages of the season, and to more than 10 points below their scoring average. The Aggies had four player score in double figures--the most in a single game this season. Amber Calvin led the team with 21 points, including 5 3-pointers, and three steals. JaQuayla Berry had 11 points, while Nikia Gorham and Adriana Nazario each had 10 points in the contest. It was A&T's second straight victory.

Charlotte Scouting Report: The Aggies are 3-18 in program history against Charlotte. In their last meeting on Dec. 21, 2011, the 49ers defeated the Aggies, 87-63, in Charlotte. The Aggies had four players score in double-figures, led by 16 points from JaQuayla Berry. The 49ers shot 55 percent against the Aggies in their last tilt. Amanda Dowe and Jennifer Hailey each had double-doubles last season against the Aggies. This season, the 49ers are 6-2. Charlotte returns all five starters from last year's team that finished 16-14 overall and 8-6 in the Atlantic 10 conference. Charlotte was picked to finish third in the conference this season, and senior Jennifer Hailey was named to the preseason All-Atlantic 10 First Team and All-Defensive Team. Hailey is averaging 14.9 points and 12.1 points this season. Amanda Dowe is averaging 12.5 points and 10.8 rebounds a game this season as well. The 49ers are averaging 70.5 points per game this season, while holding opponents to 60.8 points.

Tracking the Aggies

Keeping Cool with A.C.: Redshirt junior Amber Calvin, who was named to the Preseason All-MEAC 2nd Team, is first on the team in scoring with 97 points (12.1 ppg) and tied for first in assists with 21 (2.6 apg). She led the Aggies with 19 points from the bench, including four 3-pointers, on Nov. 16 against Iona in the team's home opener victory. She led the team with an individual and team season-best 28 points on Nov. 20 at Siena, with 11-for-14 shooting including five 3-pointers. Her 11 field goals set a new career high. She tallied 11 points on Nov. 28 at Richmond. She led the Aggies with five assists and four steals, with seven rebounds on Dec. 1 against N.C. Central. She led the team with 21 points (including five 3-pointers) in the Dec. 15 victory at Liberty. She holds the team lead in 3-pointers made with 18, and is shooting .545 (18-for-33) from beyond the arc. Last season, Calvin was second on the team in scoring with 393 points (13.6 per game) and led the team in assists (117), becoming the sixth player in program history to total more than 100 assists in a single season.

Calvin also finished the year with 198 rebounds (3.2 per game) and 57 steals. Calvin was named the A&T Female Athlete of the Year in 2012 for her performance.

Berry Good on Offense: The Aggies will be relying on senior JaQuayla Berry in the forward position in 2012-13. Berry is second on the team with 78 points (9.8 ppg) and first with 58 rebounds (7.3 rpg) to start the season. Berry has a team-best 16 steals on the year. She's also averaging a team-high 30.1 minutes per game this season. Berry recorded 12 points with 9 rebounds against Omaha on Nov. 12. Berry tallied a season-best 19 points (with 15 in the second half) on Nov. 28 at Richmond from the bench. She totaled a season-best 13 rebounds on Nov. 25 against Winston-Salem State. She led the team with nine rebounds on Dec. 1 against N.C. Central. She had 11 points in the Dec. 15 win at Liberty. Berry, who had 1,041 career points entering into her last season, will be a valuable utility player for the Aggies, playing as a forward or fourth guard. She was named to the Preseason All-MEAC 1st Team. Berry earned 2nd Team All-MEAC honors last year after finishing last season with 414 points (14.3 per game), 214 rebounds (7.4 per game) and 65 steals. She led the team in scoring, rebounding and steals in 2011-12.

King of the Court The Aggies hope to see plenty of production from junior Tracy King this season. King recorded 11 points with seven rebounds on Nov. 16 against Iona in her first start of the season. She also had a steal in that contest. She led the team with 22 points in the 40-point victory against N.C. Central, with three assists, two blocks and two steals. King is third in scoring (55 points) and second in rebounding (34). King, who tore her meniscus in January, is looking to have a healthy, full season this year. Before her injury last season, King was a scoring leader, averaging 13.5 points and 5.9 rebounds per game. She totaled 229 points and 101 rebounds in 17 games in 2011-12, and was named MEAC Defensive Player of the Week twice. She led the MEAC in free throw shooting at 88 percent before her injury.

Support from Nazario: Sophomore Adriana Nazario has started at the point guard position for the Aggies this season. She is fifth on the team with 45 points (5.6 ppg) and is tied with Amber Calvin for the team lead with 21 assists. Nazario is tied for third on the team with 10 steals. She tallied a career-best two blocks against Omaha on Nov. 12. She recorded a season-best four steals and five assists on Friday, Nov. 16 against Iona. She tallied a season-best 11 points with five rebounds on Nov. 28 at Richmond. She had 10 points with three assists on Dec. 15 at Liberty. Nazario finished last season with 68 points, 51 rebounds, 38 assists and 13 steals in 23 games.

Gorham Leads Center: Holding down center for the Aggies this year is senior Nikia Gorham. She's posted 47 points and 29 rebounds with four blocks and six steals to start the season. She tallied eight points, three rebounds and two steals on Nov. 20 at Siena. She posted nine points, five rebounds and two steals on Nov. 28 at Richmond.

Against N.C. Central, she had seven points, three rebounds and two blocks. She had a season-high 10 points on Dec. 15 at Liberty. Gorham entered her final season with 565 points, 487 rebounds, 83 blocks and 60 steals in her career. Gorham shot 50 percent from the floor last season, as she averaged 7.6 points and 6.1 rebounds a game.

Bringing in Bursey: Sophomore Ariel Bursey has had a solid start to the season. She is sixth on the team in scoring with 37 points. Bursey posted nine points against No. 18 Nebraska on Nov. 9 to tie for the team lead in that contest with JaQuayla Berry. She matched a season-high with nine points against Iona on Nov. 16. Bursey has totaled 18 rebounds, seven assists and two steals this season. She ended the 2011-12 season with 133 points, 26 steals and 88 rebounds.

Adept Adair: Redshirt sophomore Tiffanie Adair, a preseason All-MEAC 2nd Team selection, has provided 24 points and seven rebounds in 60 minutes this season. She led the team with 12 points on 5-for-6 shooting on Nov. 25 against Winston-Salem State. She earned six MEAC Rookie of the Week selections last year. In conference play in 2011-12, Adair averaged 12.9 points and 8.3 rebounds per game. She also finished first in the conference with a 62.6 shooting percentage in MEAC contests, going 77 for 123 from the floor in 15 games. Adair finished the season third on the team in scoring, second in rebounding and first in field goal percentage (.580) in 2011-12.

Relying on Ross: Redshirt freshman Eboni Ross has been helpful from the bench for the Aggies this season. She was named MEAC Rookie of the Week on Dec. 3. She is third on the team with 32 rebounds (4.0 rpg) and is first on the team with 10 blocks. She provided four points, nine rebounds, three assists and a season-best four blocks for the Aggies on Nov. 25 against Winston-Salem State. She made her first career start on Nov. 28, and had four points and three rebounds. She had seven points, three rebounds and three blocks on Dec. 1 against N.C. Central. She's totaled 26 points, three assists, and five steals this season as well.

2012-13 Outlook: Taking over as head coach in May, Tarrell Robinson inherited a roster that included a career 1,000 point scorer and two-time All-MEAC player (JaQuayla Berry), a guard who totaled more than 100 assists in a season and who was an All-MEAC Rookie (Amber Calvin), a 6-time MEAC Rookie of the Week and an All-MEAC Rookie (Tiffanie Adair), and a two-time MEAC Defensive Player of the Week (Tracy King). The Aggies finished 15-16 overall and 9-7 in the MEAC last season. The Aggies were picked to finish fifth in the MEAC this year in a preseason poll.

Tracking the Aggies

The Aggie Attack: The North Carolina A&T women's basketball program has been a dominant force in the MEAC in the last seven seasons. The Aggies tallied a 130-88 overall record (.596) and a 84-32 mark in the MEAC (.724) from 2005-2012. The Aggies won three MEAC regular-season titles in that span, including three consecutive seasons of 20-plus victories. The Aggies won 26 games in the 2008-09 season, setting a MEAC record. The Aggies garnered a No. 14 seed in the 2009 NCAA Tournament. It was the highest seed ever given to an HBCU basketball team, men's or women's team, up to that season. Their 15 wins during the 2007-08 and 2008-09 season are also MEAC records for conference wins. The Aggies look to continue their winning ways in the 2012-13 season under first-year head coach Tarrell Robinson, who was a part of those record-setting seasons.

Rankings in the MEAC: The Aggies rank eighth in the conference in scoring offense and third in scoring defense this season. A&T is second in the conference with a .386 field goal percentage, and first with a .387 3-point field goal percentage. The Aggies are first in rebounding defense, with an average of 35.7 per game. Redshirt junior Amber Calvin is 17th in the MEAC in scoring with 10.9 points per game. Senior JaQuayla Berry is 7th in the MEAC with 7.7 rebounds per game. Redshirt junior Amber Calvin is fifth in the conference in field goal percentage (.481) and first in the MEAC in 3-point field goal percentage (.565). Redshirt freshman Eboni Ross is tied for fourth in the conference with 1.4 blocks per game.

Tarrell Robinson was named the sixth head coach in the history of the North Carolina A&T women's basketball program on May 2, 2012. He returns to A&T after spending three years as an assistant coach, recruiting coordinator and associate head coach at Virginia Commonwealth under head coach Beth Cunningham. Before his stint at VCU, Robinson spent four successful seasons at A&T under legendary head coach Patricia Cage-Bibbs. Robinson made a name for himself as a talented recruiter, having brought in highly touted players to A&T and helping to lead the Aggies to consecutive MEAC regular-season championships starting in 2007.

Robinson inherits a talented club, including three players he recruited in Amber Calvin, Nikia Gorham and JaQuayla Berry. In 2011-12, Berry became the 12th player in program history to hit the 1,000 points milestone, and she is a two-time All-MEAC selection, earning first-team honors in 2011. Calvin is closing in on the program's all-time assist record, and was named the A&T Department of Athletics Female Athlete of the Year in 2012.

Robinson, a 2001 graduate of A&T, helped Bibbs resurrect a dormant program. After a 9-19 season in 2005-06, Robinson assisted Bibbs in signing what turned out to be some of the best players in school history, starting with Fayetteville, N.C., native Ta'Wuana Cook. Cook went on to be the program's first MEAC Rookie of the Year, its second all-time leading scorer and its all-time leader in assists. He was also instrumental in signing two-time MEAC all-tournament performer Lamona Smalley and 2009 MEAC Player of the Year Brittanie Taylor-James. When Jaleesa Sams, who was ranked as high as No. 31 nationally by Scouts.com, signed to play at A&T in 2007, the women's basketball team had its most highly-touted recruit in history.

Robinson's recruiting efforts paid off. From 2007-09, Robinson and his recruits helped the Aggies compile a 51-15 record and their first MEAC tournament championship since 1994. The Aggies earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2009, and were awarded a 14th seed. At the time, it was the highest seed ever given to an historically black college or university. Cook, Sams, Taylor-James and Berry are all 1,000-point career scorers and all-conference performers. His tenure as an Aggie assistant also yielded 13 all-conference selections. He was promoted to associate head coach prior to the 2008-09 season, after establishing himself as one of the best recruiters in the MEAC.

After leaving A&T for VCU, Robinson continued to excel as a recruiter. He was promoted to associate head coach in May 2011 at VCU after serving as the program's recruiting coordinator. He helped the Rams make three-consecutive postseason appearances from 2009-12. The Rams also made it to the third round of the WNIT in 2010 and 2012. He helped land back-to-back classes that ranked among the best in the Colonial Athletic Association, including players that ranked among the Top 30 in their respective positions. His 2011-12 class included the Ram's most highly recruited player in center Aprill McRae, who was named the 22nd post player in the nation by ESPN.

Robinson was also invited to the prestigious Nike Villa 7 Consortium in 2011 and 2012. The Nike Villa 7 Consortium is a partnership with the VCU Center for Sport Leadership, and brings together the country's elite assistant basketball coaches to help prepare the next generation of college basketball leaders. Prior to his successful stints at A&T and VCU, Robinson coached at the high school level and was a graduate assistant for the A&T men's basketball program. Robinson worked for two seasons as the assistant boys basketball coach at High Point (N.C.) Andrews High School, where he helped Andrews compile a 42-13 record and a pair of appearances in the NCHSAA State Tournament.

Before coaching at Andrews, Robinson spent two seasons as an assistant coach for the A&T men's basketball program under head coach Curtis Hunter. He served as the graduate assistant for the men's basketball team for the 2001-02 season. Robinson also made his mark as a student-athlete at A&T. He played on the men's basketball team from 1997-2001, and had a stellar playing career at A&T. He scored 934 career points, grabbed more than 700 rebounds and blocked 35 shots during his career. He led the Aggies in rebounding his junior season. Robinson attended E.E. Smith High School in Fayetteville, N.C., where he was an Honorable Mention McDonald's All-American and lettered three years on the varsity level. He was an all-conference and all-regional performer as a senior, and helped lead the Golden Bulls to a conference championship and regional runner-up finish in the state playoffs.

Robinson earned his B.A., degree in psychology in 2001 and was enrolled in the graduate program at A&T, where he was a candidate for a master's degree in Human Performance and Leisure Studies. Robinson and his wife, Kelli, have three children, Jordan, Jada and Lauren.
