A&T RETURNS FOR RARE DECEMBER HOME GAME

- North Carolina A&T has played in 396 games at Corbett Sports Center, only 37 of those games have been played in December.
- The Aggies are 26-11 when they play at home in December. The Aggies will be playing at home against a non-conference foe for the first time since playing Southern Virginia on Dec. 5, 2007.
- This will mark the Aggies first the Aggies have played a non-conference Division I foe at home in December since losing to Campbell 68-67 on Dec. 11, 2004.

A&T's LAST TIME OUT

- The Aggies are coming off of a 77-66 loss to Big East school Seton Hall on Sunday. A&T guard Jean Louisme came off the bench to score 14 points. Adrian Powell also scored in double figures with 11.
- The Aggies have not won consecutive non-conference road games since beating SW Missouri and UNC Wilmington in back-to-back non-conference games in 1990.
- Seton Hall only had four players score, but three of those players scored 20 or more, including Fuquan Edwin's 26 points on five 3-pointers.

A&T's OPPONENT

- The Colonels come into as one of the top Division I mid-majors in the country. The Colonels are ranked No. 16 in the latest Mid-Major Top-25 poll.
- The Colonels are 9-1 and boasts wins over MEAC schools Norfolk State (by 24), Delaware State (by 33) and N.C. Central (by 6). The Aggies and the Colonels also have another common opponent this season in Radford. ECU beat the Highlanders 83-75. The Aggies have yet to play Norfolk State, Delaware State or Radford, and lost to NCCU 66-62.
- ECU is coming off its first loss of the season, a 66-53 defeat at the hands of No. 10 Illinois. The Colonels 9-0 start was their best in 66 years. Before the loss to Illinois, they were the only undefeated mid-major in the country.

The Aggies placed four players in double figures led by DaMetrius Upchurch's 14. The Aggies outrebounded The Pride 47-37.

Lamont Middleton scored a game-high 23 points, but the Wolverines outrebounded the Aggies 37-28 at Corbett Sports Center.

Adrian Powell and Austin Witter had 10 points apiece but the Aggies shot just 33 percent from the floor in the loss to Wright State.

Sean Kilpatrick scored 29 points on 8-for-12 shooting from 3-point range to lead No. 24 Cincinnati to a blow out win over A&T.

The Aggies shot just 29.7 percent as Iowa State cruised to victory. The Cyclones outrebounded the Aggies 53-30. Jean Louisme had 11.

The Aggies caught fire and defeated Campbell in Las Vegas handily. The Aggies were led Lamont Middleton and Bruce Beckford who had 19 points apiece.

For the third straight season, the Aggies earned city bragging rights by defeating UNC Greensboro. A&T took over with an 18-5 first-half run.

An intentional foul in the late seconds led to four consecutive N.C. Central free throws as they defeated A&T at Corbett. It was their 3rd straight win over A&T.

Austin Witter blocked eight shots and grabbed 13 rebounds to lead A&T to the key road win. Lamont Middleton led the way with 24 points on 12-for-14 FTs.

Seton Hall hit 11 3-pointers and had three players score 20 points or more to defeat the Aggies at the Prudential Center. Fuquan Edwin led the way with 26.

LINEUP CHANGES

• The Aggies are still trying to find their way as they enter January and the conference season. Point guard Jeremy Underwood began the season as the Aggies starter, but now comes off the bench as Lamont Middleton mans the position. Middleton along with Austin Witter are the only two Aggies to have started every

game this season.

- Middleton started the season as the Aggies starting shooting guard. That position belonged to Jean Louisme, who started out the season as the Aggies sixth man. Louisme replaced senior R.J. Buck in the starting lineup before being replaced by freshman Khalid King.
- The job of sixth man now belongs to senior center DaMetrius Upchurch. Upchurch started the season as the starting center, but over the last six games, freshman Bruce Beckford has been the Aggies starter.
- Senior forward Adrian Powell left the starting lineup for two games, but after a 29-point performance against N.C. Central, he made a return back to the starting role. He is averaging 16.3 points since he return to his starting role four games ago.

IMPRESSIVE HISTORY

- The Aggies are looking for their first winning season in 15 years. The Aggies have not won the MEAC Championship since 1995 and the last time A&T was in the MEAC title game was 1997.
- Head coach Cy Alexander enters his first season as the Aggies head coach. He is only the Aggies seventh head coach since the 1950 season.
- The Aggies have won a conference-best 15 tournament championships, including seven in a row from 1982-88. They also own 11 regular-season MEAC Championships.

THE SERIES WITH SETON HALL

- North Carolina A&T head coach Cy Alexander is familiar with the Colonels after coaching Tennessee State of the OVC for six seasons.
- Alexander was 7-8 against the Colonels during his six-year stint at Tennessee State.
- The Aggies will face the Colonels for the first time in school history.

NEXT UP...

- The Aggies will take a nine-day break from competition before facing Texas Tech of the Big 12.
- The Aggies will face the Red Raiders for the first time in school history.
- The Aggies last trip to Texas resulted in a 75-71 loss to Houston.

ALEXANDER HAS A HISTORY WITH A&T

North Carolina A&T head coach Cy Alexander is in his first season as the Aggie head coach. Alexander coached against the Aggies for many seasons. He spent 11 seasons as an assistant at MEAC foe Howard (1976-87). He then became the head coach at S.C. State from (1987-03), where he went

up against the Aggies for 16 more seasons. Alexander was 23-14 against the Aggies during his time at S.C. State.

- Alexander is one of only 17 active Division I head basketball coaches who is the all-time winningest coach at one Division I school while coaching at another. Alexander won 277 games at S.C. State.
- As an assistant at Howard, Alexander went up against the Aggies 10 times for the MEAC Championship. The Aggies won seven of those matchups and were able to advance to the NCAA Tournament five times as a result.

MIDDLETON COMES TO AGGIELAND

- Lamont Middleton is a junior college transfer out of Wake Tech Community College.
- His father, Lamont Middleton, Sr., played for St. John's in the early 90's.
- Middleton had an exceptional preseason as he finished with 13 points against Fayetteville State and followed that by scoring 32 points in the Aggies Blue & Gold inter-squad scrimmage. In the Aggies final tune up, he had 20 points against Barber Scotia.
- Middleton has scored 20 or more points three times this season with 23 against Utah Valley (11/12), 24 against UNC Greensboro (11/28) and 24 against NJIT.
- Middleton is from Bronx, N.Y., but he finished his final year of high school at Raleigh Enloe High School. Middleton did not play basketball at Enloe his senior season because of age.
- He averaged 19.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists during his last season at Wake Tech.

A KING-SIZED SHOT

- North Carolina A&T head coach Cy Alexander has been looking for someone to fill the role of shooting guard all season. Lamont Middleton, R.J. Buck and Jean Louisme have all tried to fill the role. There is now a new candidate thanks to one shot.
- In practice in December, Alexander told King if he hit a shot on the next play, it would insert him into the starting lineup against Seton Hall on Dec. 19.
- King curled off a screen and hit a deep three from the corner on the play. Alexander kept his promise, and King earned his first career start.

THE AGGIE SEVEN

- The North Carolina A&T has one of the most experienced teams in the MEAC.
- The Aggies feature seven seniors from five different areas and four different states. Dominique Behohn-Tolly is from Cameroon. DaMetrius Upchurch (Raleigh, N.C.), Adrian Powell (Conover, N.C.), Austin Witter (Princeton Junction, N.J.), R.J. Buck (Lusby, Md.), Lawrence Smith (Bowie, Md.)

and Jean Louisme (Fort Myers, Fla.) are the other six seniors.

- The Aggies senior class is looking for their first MEAC Championship and they are hoping to advance to at least the semifinals for the first time in their careers.
- Five of the Aggies seven seniors are four-year seniors, including Buck, Smith, Witter, Powell and Upchurch.
- The Aggies five four-year seniors are a combined 41-66 heading into today's game. They are a combined 22-27 in the MEAC.

WITTER WEEKLY DEFENSIVE HONORS

- North Carolina A&T forward Austin Witter earned MEAC Defensive Player of the Week honors for the week ending on Dec. 16.
- Witter earned the honors thanks to an 8-block, 13-rebound performance that included 11 defensive rebounds. Witter was two blocks shy from breaking former teammate Thomas Coleman who set the mark with nine blocks against Coppin State on Jan. 14, 2007.
- Witter is the only Aggie on the roster with more than 500 points, 300 rebounds, 150 assists and 80 blocks.
- He ranks 22nd in the nation in blocked shots and third in the conference.
- Witter leads the Aggies in rebounding at 6.7 per game. He has two double-figure rebounding game this season with 10 vs. Jacksonville State on Nov. 24.

BRUCE, BRUCE

- Bruce Beckford has become a force for the Aggies in the middle.
- Beckford has started the last seven games for the Aggies at center, and has responded by averaging 9.7 points, 6.3 rebounds and 0.7 blocks. Also during his seven starts, he is 28-for-50 from the field, including an 8-for-8 performance against Campbell.
- Beckford was a late signee for the Aggies after Cy Alexander was named the head coach. He has the big body Alexander is looking for in the post.
- Beckford played his high school basketball at Montrose Christian, one of the most prestigious high school programs in the country. He was a late bloomer in the program, and therefore, he is still improving as he enters the college ranks.

A&T TRENDS AND STREAKS

- After making just 31 3-pointers over their first seven games, the Aggies have 31 3-pointers in their last four games.
- The Aggies are shooting .698 from the free throw line this season. The Aggies have not shot better than 70 percent from the free throw line since the 1990-91 season when they shot 71.6 percent on their way to a 17-10 record.
- The Aggies have lost their last two games at home this season. They have not lost three in a row at home since 2006.
- The Aggies were 7-for-15 (.467) from 3-point range against NJIT on Dec. 13. It marked the first time in 13 games the Aggies shot better than .400 from 3-point range. The last time the Aggies shot better than 40 percent from 3-point range was Feb. 25, 2012 at S.C. State.
- The Aggies have blocked at least one shot in their last 37 games. The last time the Aggies failed to block a shot was Nov. 14, 2011 at Iowa. They have at least three blocks in their last five games.
- North Carolina A&T has won its last 16 games when it has scored at least 70 points or more.

THE AGGIE STARTERS

- The Aggies have started five different lineups this season. Each of their four wins was done with a different starting lineup.
- Adrian Powell and Austin Witter are competing for the most career starts. Powell has made 66 career starts, while Witter has made 65. The Aggies are 29-37 when Powell starts, and they are 27-38 when Witter starts. The Aggies are 14-26 when DaMetrius Upchurch starts.
- Austin Witter and Lamont Middleton are the only two Aggies who have started every game.

THE AGGIE NEWCOMERS

- North Carolina A&T head coach Cy Alexander inherited most of his newcomers, but also signed two of his own.
- Guards Lamont Middleton, Shaun Stewart and Khalid King were already in place when Alexander stepped on the scene in April as the Aggies head coach.
- Once in place, Alexander added center Bruce Beckford and forward Corvon Butler.
- During tryouts, the Aggies later added walk-on guard Ahmad Abdullah.
- Five of the six Aggie newcomers have seen action this season.
- Middleton and Beckford are the only new comers to make starts this season.

THE SHOOTING

- North Carolina A&T has failed to shoot better than 50 percent in every game except one this season. But they have held five of their opponents to under 40 percent shooting and are 4-1 when they do so.
- The Aggies are holding opponents to just .323 shooting from the 3-point arc.
- The Aggies have not shot better than 40 percent in their last three games. Opponents have not shot better than 42 percent against the Aggies in the last six games.

FREE THROW SHOOTING

- The Aggies have three players ranked in the top 10 in free throw shooting in the conference. Senior guard Jean Louisme is third in the conference at .892, junior guard Jeremy Underwood is sixth at .844 and junior guard Lamont Middleton is eighth at .802.
- The Aggies are third in the conference in free throw shooting and have shot better than 70 percent from the line six times this season. They shot better than 70 percent eight times last season.
- The Aggies made 34 free throws against UNCG on Nov. 28. It was the most free throws the Aggies have made in four years.

Cy Alexander



Head Coach

1st season • Catawba, 1975

Cy Alexander became the ninth North Carolina A&T men's basketball coach in the modern era on April 20, 2012. Alexander brings with him a wealth of experience in constructing a championship program within the MEAC.

Alexander led S.C. State to seven MEAC tournament title games, winning five of those contest over a 16-year span. Before Alexander arrived in Orangeburg, the Bulldogs had captured only one MEAC regular-season title, and they reached just one MEAC tournament final. In addition, the school was coming off of its ninth straight losing season.

When his tenure ended at S.C. State, Alexander had won nearly 60 percent of his games and more than 70 percent of his conference games. Alexander will be asked to restore the Aggies tradition of winning MEAC titles. The Aggies own a league-leading 15 MEAC tournament titles, but have not been crowned champions since 1995.

Alexander's time in the MEAC began in 1976. He spent 11 seasons as an assistant coach at Howard University under A.B. Williamson. In 1987, he was named the head coach at S.C. State. He was able to compile a 277-202 record overall and a 191-79 record in the MEAC. Alexander's teams at S.C. State finished first or second 13 times.

In year one at S.C. State, he was 16-13. By year two, the Bulldogs finished 25-8, broke the school record for wins and advanced to the NCAA tournament after winning the school's first MEAC tournament title. During the same season, the Bulldogs gained national prominence by winning the San Juan Shootout. One of the victories in the shootout included a win over No. 11 Villanova. Alexander was now on his way to piecing together what became one of the most successful coaching runs in MEAC history.

Alexander's efforts helped him win three MEAC Coach of the Year honors while at S.C. State, including the 2003 honor for leading the Bulldogs to their fifth MEAC crown. His S.C. State teams received the prestigious American Sports Wire Black College National Championship three times (1996, '98, '00).

After the '03 season, Alexander became the head men's basketball coach at Tennessee State University. Alexander spent six seasons with the Tigers. Alexander led TSU to the 2008 OVC championship game, the school's first in 10 years. Alexander is a Winston-Salem, N.C., native, who has a 354-317 career record over 23 seasons. His other coaching acknowledgements include being named Palmetto State Coach of the Year by the Greenville Basketball Club. He has also been inducted into the Catawba and S.C. State Hall of Fames. In 1996, he was named American Sports Wire National Coach of the Year.

Alexander has served as a member of the Black Coaches Association and the National Association of Basketball Coaches. He is also a member of several organizations, including Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity.
