Last Game: The Aggies advanced to Round 2 of the MEAC Tournament with a 66-53 win against Morgan State. The Aggies will take on Coppin State on Thursday, and will look to redeem themselves from their 85-63 loss to the Eagles on Jan. 23. Monday's win was A&T's first tournament win since March 14, 2009. The Aggies out-rebounded the Bears, 51-45, in the contest and held them to a 27 field goal percentage. Junior JaQuayla Berry had a double-double and led the team with 14 points and a career-high 16 rebounds. Freshman Adriana Nazario had 13 points and a team-best seven assists in the game. All-Rookie sophomore Tiffanie Adair had 12 points and seven rebounds in the contest. The Aggies are looking for their third Tournament crown in program history, and their second under Head Coach Patricia Cage-Bibbs.

Against the MEAC: The Aggies are 84-32 overall against MEAC opponents under Patricia Cage-Bibbs, and are 9-7 in conference games in the regular season. In the regular season, the Aggies averaged 68.9 points and 46.2 rebounds per MEAC game. Against MEAC opponents in the regular season, the Aggies shot .390 from the floor, .266 from beyond the arc, and .696 from the line. Four Aggies averaged more than 10 points per game in MEAC play this season. The Aggies finished the regular season 5-3 at home and 4-4 on the road in conference play.

Tracking the Aggies

Berry Key on Offense: Junior JaQuayla Berry, who was an All-MEAC player last season and named to the All-MEAC Second Team this season, is first on the team with 397 points (14.2 ppg) and first in rebounds (212, 7.6 rbg). She hit double-digits in seven straight games from Nov. 12 to Dec. 12, and in a season-best 11 straight games from Dec. 21 to Feb. 6. On Dec. 3 at N.C. Central, she had a season-best 28 points with 14 rebounds. She earned "Best individual off-the-radar weekend performance" honors from Graham Hays of ESPN.com for the Dec. 3 game. She had 27 points with nine rebounds off the bench on Dec. 22 at Wofford. She posted 20 points and 10 boards on Jan. 7, and on Jan. 21, she collected 14 points and 11 boards at Morgan State. She had 15 points and nine rebounds on Jan. 23 at Coppin State. Berry collected with 17 points and 10 rebounds on Feb. 4. Against N.C. Central on Feb. 18, she tallied 23 points and a career-high 16 rebounds for her sixth double-double of the season. She collected her 1,000th career point on Feb. 27 at the free throw line at the

18:18 mark in the second half. She finished that game with her seventh double-double of the season with 17 points and 13 boards. She now has 1,026 career points, 467 rebounds and 191 steals. She is the 12th person in program history to reach 1,000 points and the seventh under Patricia Cage-Bibbs. She posted 14 points and matched a career-high with 16 rebounds against Morgan State to lead the Aggies in Round 1 of the Tournament.

Amber Alert: Redshirt sophomore guard Amber Calvin is coming back strong after missing last season due to an ACL injury and surgery. She collected double figures in eight straight games from Nov. 18 to Dec. 21, and in the last seven consecutive games of the regular season. She led the team with a career-high 24 points, aided by a career-high six 3-pointers, on Nov. 18. She posted 17 points on Dec. 3 at N.C. Central with a team-high seven assists. She led the team in scoring on Dec. 18, with 18 points and four assists. Calvin tallied a team-high 20 points, five assists and two steals on Jan. 21. On Jan. 23 at Coppin State, she had a team-high 18 points with seven rebounds. She had the game-winning 3-pointer and free throws on Jan. 28. She led the team in scoring with 19 points, including four 3-pointers, with six rebounds and a steal against FAMU on Feb. 6, and posted 16 points and three assists on Feb. 18. She posted her fifth career 20+ point game on Feb. 25, with 23 points (five 3-pointers) and a career-high 9 assists. Calvin set a new career-high with 33 points at Savannah State on Feb. 27, and collected three assists to surpass the 100 assist in a season mark. That's the ninth time in program history that a player has collected 100 or more assists in a season. She's hit double figures 20 times this season. Calvin is second on the team in points (367, 13.1) and first in assists (111, 4.0).

King of the Court: Sophomore guard Tracy King has had a strong year before sustaining a season-ending meniscus tear injury on Jan. 16. King was named to the Iona College Tip-Off All-Tournament team, averaging 17.5 points and 7.0 rebounds in the tournament. She posted a career-high 26 points with five steals in the Nov. 21 win over ACC opponent Clemson. She led the team with 14 points on Nov. 25 against Siena and set a career-high with six steals. She was named the MEAC Defensive Player of the Week for her performance from Nov. 20-27, which included 16 rebounds, 11 steals and 40 points. She won MEAC Defensive Player of the Week again for two games from Dec. 19-25. That week, she collected 17 points, 15 rebounds, three steals and three assists. She had a team-high 23 points on Dec. 29, and followed that with a team-high 24 points on Jan. 2. She led the team with 17 points, a career-high six assists and four steals on Jan. 9 in a career-high 35 minutes. She leads the team in free throw percentage (77-88, .875) and is fifth in rebounds (101, 5.9 rpg). King is fourth in scoring (229, 13.5 ppg).

Youth and Skill: N.C. A&T is the sixth youngest team in NCAA DI, behind Pittsburgh, Delaware State, Marquette, St. Francis and Southern Utah. The Aggies feature eight freshmen and five sophomores on their 15-person team. Eleven athletes are first-year players in the program.

Adept Adair: Sophomore Tiffanie Adair garnered MEAC Rookie of the Week honors five times in the last seven weeks. The MEAC record is six Rookie of the Week selections made by Cathy Robinson of FAMU in the 1992-93 season. Adair tallied 20 points, 12 rebounds, two assists and one steals for the Aggies from Jan. 9-15. Adair had a strong night on Jan. 21, collecting 20 points with nine rebounds, and five assists in 40 minutes. On Jan. 28, she posted a double-double with 15 points and 10 boards to lead the team. She posted her second consecutive double-double with 19 points and 10 boards on Jan. 30. She averaged 14 points and nine rebounds from Jan. 30-Feb. 5. She had another career game on Feb. 11, scoring a career-best 27 points with a career-best 15 boards. It was the second most number of rebounds an A&T player has tallied this season, and most since Amber Bland had 15 on Nov. 29, 2008. Adair posted 14 points and 14 rebounds on Feb. 13, and 12 points and 10 rebounds on Feb. 18 for her third straight double-double. She had 20 points on Feb. 25. She finished the season with her seventh double figure game with 19 points on March 1. Adair holds the highest scoring and rebounding averages among all A&T first year players this season, at 8.3 points and 6.2 rebounds per game. She has started in the last 12 games of the regular season, and has totaled 181 points and 114 rebounds in that span. She recorded 12 points and seven rebounds on March 5 in Round 1 of the MEAC Tournament. She's first in the MEAC in field goal percentage with .573. She's third on the team in scoring (242, 8.3) and second in rebounds (180, 6.2).

Coppin State Scouting Report: The Aggies are 6-6 against Coppin State under Patricia Cage-Bibbs, and before losing to the Eagles on Jan. 23, the Aggies had won their last five matchups. The Eagles welcomed back all of their starters and five other letterwinners. The Eagles were selected to finish sixth in the MEAC in a preseason poll, and finished the regular season fourth in the conference. Senior center Jeanine Manley, who scored 38 points against A&T on Jan. 23, is leading the Eagles with a scoring average of 13.2 points per game. She is the only player averaging double figures points for Coppin State. Senior forward Crystal Whittington is averaging 7.0 rebounds per game to lead the team. Manley is close behind, averaging 5.9 rebounds. Coppin State followed up a six-game losing streak with a five-game winning streak this season. After losing to Hampton on Jan. 14, the Eagles won their next eight straight contests. Coppin State ended the season with four consecutive wins. The Eagles defeated N.C. Central 76-37 in Round 1 of the MEAC Tournament. In that contest, Shawntae Payne scored 17 points and Crystal Whittington had 13 points and 12 rebounds.

Tracking the Aggies

Fortune 500: North Carolina A&T head coach Patricia Cage-Bibbs became the 51st coach in NCAA DI history to join the 500 win club on Monday, Feb. 27 as the Aggies defeated Savannah State, 88-74 on the road. She is 27th on the active DI head coach wins list with 500. She also became the first head coach to win all 500 games as the head coach of a Division I HBCU program, and she was the second MEAC coach to join the 500 club, after Norfolk State's James Sweat. Bibbs became the 38th active head women's basketball coach to capture 400 career wins during the 2007-08 season. She won No. 400 on Nov. 23, 2007 with an 88-62 victory over UNC Asheville.

Fun MEAC Tournament Facts: North Carolina A&T joined the MEAC in 1970. North Carolina A&T has won 26 games in the MEAC Tournament entering into the 2012 Tournament, the second-most victories in the Tournament, and two MEAC Tournament championship titles (1994 and 2009). North Carolina A&T has had two coaches win the Tournament's Outstanding Coach Award (Tim Abney-1994, Patricia Cage-Bibbs-2009), and two players win the Tournament Outstanding Players Award (Nisha Watson-1994, Amber Bland-2009). The Aggies who have been named to the All-Tournament First Team are: Sheila Rivers (1988), Deidra Cheeks (1988 & 1991), Helena Creamer (1991), Angela Hill (1993 & 1994), Nisha Watson (1994 & 1996), Lamona Smalley (2008 & 2009), and Amber Bland (2009).

The Aggie Attack with Coach Bibbs: The North Carolina A&T women's basketball program has been a dominant force in the MEAC in the last six seasons. The Aggies are 84-32 in the MEAC and 130-87 overall since Head Coach Patricia Cage-Bibbs joined the program in the 2005-06 season. The Aggies have won three MEAC regular-season titles in the process, and have collected three straight seasons of 20-plus wins. The Aggies won 26 games in the 2008-09 season, setting a MEAC record. The Aggies garnered a No. 14 seed in the NCAA Tournament. It was the highest seed ever given to an HBCU basketball team, men's or women's team, up to that season. Their 15 wins during the 2007-08 and 2008-09 season are also MEAC records for conference wins. The Aggies look to continue their winning ways in the 2011-12 season with Head Coach Patricia Cage-Bibbs.

Rankings in the MEAC: At the end of the 2011-12 regular season, North Carolina A&T was second in the MEAC in scoring offense with an average of 69.0 points per game, and 11th in the MEAC in scoring defense, averaging an allowed 68.5 points. The Aggies were fourth in field goal percentage (.388), eighth in 3-point field goal percentage (.268) and fourth in free throw percentage (.686) in the conference. N.C. A&T was second in assists (13.3 per game), and third in steals (11.0 per game). The Aggies were fifth in the standings with a 9-7 MEAC record and 14-15 overall record for a .483 winning percentage. Junior JaQuayla Berry was ninth in the conference in scoring (14.2 ppg), and eighth in rebounds (7.3 rpg). Tiffanie Adair was first in field goal percentage (.564). Amber Calvin was first in free throw percentage (.868), fourth in assists (4.0 apg) and fourth in 3-point field goal percentage (.358). Nikia Gorham was third in the MEAC for offensive rebounds (3.9 rpg) and JaQuayla Berry was third in defensive rebounds (5.3 rbg).

Patricia Cage-Bibbs entered coaching to help her alma mater Grambling State University put its fledgling women's basketball program on secure ground. Twenty-seven years later she is partly responsible for helping the fledgling sport of women's basketball flourish.

More importantly, she helps it flourish at the historically black college and university level. Bibbs' commitment to being the best raises the level of competitiveness among her colleagues. Bibbs' excellence first made the Southwestern Athletic Conference better through parity and now the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference is benefiting.

While the MEAC's level of play has increased, the reason for bringing Bibbs to N.C. A&T had more to do with resurrecting a program that won 51 games from 1997-2005. As Bibbs enters her seventh season, she has led the Aggies to a 115-72 record overall and a 75-25 mark in the MEAC, as well as three MEAC regular season championship titles, a MEAC Tournament championship title, a NCAA Tournament appearance and two WNIT appearances.

She enters the 2011-12 season just 14 wins shy of 500 career victories. If she can reach that milestone this season, it would make her the first head coach to collect her 500th victory while coaching at a HBCU.

The 2010-11 season saw the Aggies with their fifth straight season with a winning record, and an over .500 finish in the MEAC. The Aggies lost to Howard in the MEAC Tournament, who finished second place.

The 2009-10 season was another historic year for the women's program. Bibbs led the Aggies to their third straight 20-win season as well as their third straight regular-season MEAC Championship. It was Bibbs' 13th career regular-season title. What followed has to be an example of Bibbs' resiliency as a head coach. She recovered the Aggies from a first-round loss in the MEAC Tournament to No. 8 seed S.C. State, to make an inspiring run through the Women's National Invitational Tournament. In a rout, N.C. A&T defeated Wake Forest at Wake Forest. It was the school's first-ever win over an ACC school. The Aggies followed up that win with a victory over UNC Charlotte on the road. The win made the Aggies the first historically black college or university to win two consecutive games in a postseason tournament. Despite losing to Miami to end the season in Coral Gables, Fla., the Aggies played a competitive game against the eventual WNIT runner-up.

More history was made under Bibbs during the 2008-2009 season. Bibbs' rebuilding efforts produced the fruit many Aggie fans were looking for when she led the Aggies to their first MEAC Tournament Championship in 15 years. She led the Aggies back to the top in a dominating manner as the Aggies average margin of victory in the MEAC tournament was 22.7 points. It was Bibbs' 10th conference championship. The Aggies went on to play Florida State in the NCAA tournament, marking Bibbs' seventh appearance. The 2008-09 season also saw Bibbs lead the Aggies to a school-best 26-7 record. She won her 10th conference coach of the year honor the same season. The MEAC head coaches voted Bibbs MEAC Coach of the Year for two consecutive seasons (2008 and 2009). Bibbs also broke the school record for wins in consecutive years. In three seasons from 2007-10, Bibbs led the Aggies to a 44-4 record in the MEAC.

History followed Bibbs in 2007-08 as well. She became the 38th active head women's basketball coach to capture 400 career wins. Bibbs' triumphs in the MEAC didn't stop there. During the 2007-08 season, Bibbs led the Aggies to a 25-8 overall record and a 15-1 record in the MEAC. Bibbs' success earned the Aggies women's basketball program its first postseason appearance in 14 seasons when the Aggies were awarded an automatic bid to the WNIT.

Bibbs took over the women's program at N.C. A&T in March of 2005, and immediately raised the expectations for a program that had not won the MEAC championship since the 1993-94 season. She won nine games her first season, and then nearly doubled that win total in her second season from 2006-2007 by leading the Aggies to a 17-13 record and a second-place finish in the conference with a 12-6 mark.

Before coming to N.C. A&T, Bibbs established Hampton University Women's Basketball as a MEAC power from 1997-2004, where she posted a 127-83 record as their Head Coach. Before coming to Hampton, Bibbs served as the head women's basketball coach at her alma mater Grambling State University in Grambling, La. for 13 seasons. With the Lady Tigers, she had a .665 winning percentage, totaling a 244-123 record.
