ONE DOWN, ONE TO GO

- North Carolina A&T picked up a crucial win over Bethune-Cookman on Saturday, and will try to complete a sweep of its two-game home-stand with a win over Florida A&M Monday night at Corbett Sports Center.
- The Aggies are in a must-win situation with three straight road games on the horizon. A&T head coach Cy Alexander will return to S.C. State, where he won five MEAC Championships, on Feb. 16. The Aggies will then face the No. 3 team in the conference in Savannah State and the conference's No. 2 team in N.C. Central.
- The Aggies are 12-12 and looking for their first winning season in 15 years. They are also trying to finish among the Top-3 teams in the conference, which would give them a first-round bye in the MEAC Tournament, scheduled for March 11-16 in Norfolk, Va.

A&T's LAST TIME OUT

- After falling behind by 11 points in the first 12 minutes of the game, the Aggies used the offense of Lamont Middleton and Adrian Powell, and the defense of Austin Witter to beat Bethune-Cookman.
- It was the Aggies first win over the Wildcats in four tries. Middleton led A&T with 17 points, while Adrian Powell finished with 13.

A&T's OPPONENT

- Florida A&M comes into tonight's game having lost 11 of their last 13 games. They are coming off of a 51-43 loss to N.C. Central on Saturday.
- Earlier this season, the Aggies had their way with the Ratters in Tallahassee, Fla. The Aggies held FAMU to 22.8 percent shooting in a 68-40 win. None of the Rattlers scored in double figures, but they were led by Muhammad Abdul-Aleem who had nine points. Abdul-Aleem had 13 points against the Eagles on Saturday.
- The Rattlers do have three players averaging in double figures led by Jamie Adams' 14.5 points per game. Reggie Lewis averages 10.9 points and Jamari Bradshaw averages 10.4 points.

The Aggies placed four players in double figures led by DaMetrius Upchurch's 14. The Aggies outrebounded The Pride 47-37.

Lamont Middleton scored a game-high 23 points, but the Wolverines outrebounded the Aggies 37-28 at Corbett Sports Center.

Adrian Powell and Austin Witter had 10 points apiece but the Aggies shot just 33 percent from the floor in the loss to Wright State.

Sean Kilpatrick scored 29 points on 8-for-12 shooting from 3-point range to lead No. 24 Cincinnati to a blow out win over A&T.

The Aggies shot just 29.7 percent as Iowa State cruised to victory. The Cyclones outrebounded the Aggies 53-30. Jean Louisme had 11.

The Aggies caught fire and defeated Campbell in Las Vegas handily. The Aggies were led Lamont Middleton and Bruce Beckford who had 19 points apiece.

For the third straight season, the Aggies earned city bragging rights by defeating UNC Greensboro. A&T took over with an 18-5 first-half run.

An intentional foul in the late seconds led to four consecutive N.C. Central free throws as they defeated A&T at Corbett. It was their 3rd straight win over A&T.

Austin Witter blocked eight shots and grabbed 13 rebounds to lead A&T to the key road win. Lamont Middleton led the way with 24 points on 12-for-14 FTs.

Seton Hall hit 11 3-pointers and had three players score 20 points or more to defeat the Aggies at the Prudential Center. Fuquan Edwin led the way with 26.

Four Aggies scored in double figures as the Aggies overcame a 17-point first-half deficit to defeat Eastern Kentucky at Corbett Sports Center.

The Red Raiders overcame a 12-point deficit to defeat the Aggies in Lubbock, Texas. The Red Raiders outrebounded the Aggies 49-22.

The Roadrunners outscored A&T 25-7 to open the second half as the Aggies lost their second straight. Lamont Middleton had 12 points and seven rebounds.

A&T returned home and earned a home win over Radford. It was just the Aggies second win over Radford in seven tries. Lamont Middleton had 21 points.

Adrian Powell and Jean Louisme scored 23 points apiece to lead the Aggies to a tough road win over Georgia Southern. Beckford hit two big shots late.

The Wildcats shot 46 percent from 3-point range to down the Aggies in Daytona Beach once again. The Aggies haven't won at B-CU since 1995.

The Aggies held FAMU to 22.6 percent shooting in a blowout win in Tallahassee, Fla. The Aggies held FAMU to the lowest scoring output in series history.

North Carolina A&T held the Bison to 25 percent shooting for the game. The Aggies jumped out to a 38-13 halftime lead in the easy victory.

The Aggies just 36.5 percent and turned the ball over twice late in the game as Morgan State came to Greensboro and earned a 55-52 win over the Aggies.

Jeremy Underwood hit a game-winning 3-pointer with 9 seconds remaining to lead the Aggies to victory. Austin Witter blocked the game-winning shot attempt.

The Aggies lost a 16-point second half lead, but held on thanks to two Jeremy Underwood baskets to beat UMES. Lamont Middleton had 17 points.

A&T shot just 29.4 percent from the floor in a loss to Delaware State in Dover, Del. Jean Louisme led A&T with 16 points and Austin Witter had 12 boards.

The Aggies shot 64.5 percent in the second half and 50 percent for the game as they defeated Bethune-Cookman for the first time in four tries.

CAN POWELL GET TO 1,000

- North Carolina A&T forward Adrian Powell has an outside chance to become the 28th player in school history to score 1,000 points.
- Powell needs 104 points to reach the milestone with the Aggie having at least eight games remaining on their schedule.

• If Powell averages 13.0 points per game over the Aggies next eight, he will make history. Powell is averaging 12.7 points per game this season and 8.8 points per game for his career.

• Powell has scored in double figures 17 times this season, and he is averaging 14.6 points per game in MEAC play.

IMPRESSIVE HISTORY

- The Aggies are looking for their first winning season in 15 years. The Aggies have not won the MEAC Championship since 1995 and the last time A&T was in the MEAC title game was 1997.
- Head coach Cy Alexander enters his first season as the Aggies head coach. He is only the Aggies seventh head coach since the 1950 season.
- The Aggies have won a conference-best 15 tournament championships, including seven in a row from 1982-88. They also own 11 regular-season MEAC Championships.

THE SERIES WITH BETHUNE-COOKMAN

- The Aggies come back to Corbett to play Florida A&M at 8 p.m. The Aggies handled the Rattlers in Tallahassee, Fla., earlier this season with a 68-40 win.
- The Aggies lead the all-time series 43-26, and they are 20-7 against the Aggies at Corbett Sports Center.
- The Aggies are 7-3 against the Florida A&M Rattlers over the last 10 meetings.

NEXT UP...

- The Aggies head down to Orangeburg, S.C., to play what should be a special return for A&T head coach Cy Alexander. Alexander spent 16 seasons as the head coach of S.C. State, where he won five MEAC Championships. A&T associate head coach Jay Joyner played at S.C. State during the mid 90's under Alexander.
- Alexander has never coached against the Bulldogs. But the Aggies hold a 45-41 series lead over the Bulldogs.
- The Aggies have won the last three meetings against S.C. State, and 8 of the last 10. The Aggies last trip to Orangeburg resulted in a 79-75 win.

ALEXANDER HAS A HISTORY WITH A&T

North Carolina A&T head coach Cy Alexander is in his first season as the Aggie head coach.

- Alexander coached against the Aggies for many seasons. He spent 11 seasons as an assistant at MEAC foe Howard (1976-87). He then became the head coach at S.C. State from (1987-03), where he went

up against the Aggies for 16 more seasons. Alexander was 23-14 against the Aggies during his time at S.C. State.

- Alexander is one of only 17 active Division I head basketball coaches who is the all-time winningest coach at one Division I school while coaching at another. Alexander won 277 games at S.C. State.
- As an assistant at Howard, Alexander went up against the Aggies 10 times for the MEAC Championship. The Aggies won seven of those matchups and were able to advance to the NCAA Tournament five times as a result.

MIDDLETON COMES TO AGGIELAND

- Lamont Middleton is a junior college transfer out of Wake Tech Community College.
- His father, Lamont Middleton, Sr., played for St. John's in the early 90's.
- Middleton had an exceptional preseason as he finished with 13 points against Fayetteville State and followed that by scoring 32 points in the Aggies Blue & Gold inter-squad scrimmage. In the Aggies final tune up, he had 20 points against Barber Scotia.
- Middleton has scored 20 or more points five times this season with 23 against Utah Valley (11/12), 24 against UNC Greensboro (11/28), 24 against NJIT (12/13), 21 against Radford (1/3) and a season-high 25 at Bethune-Cookman (1/12).
- Middleton leads the Aggies in scoring (13.9) and assists (2.9). He is 5-for-8 from 3-point range in his last two games.
- He averaged 19.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists during his last season at Wake Tech.

WEEKLY HONORS FOR AGGIES

- The North Carolina A&T basketball team has received several weekly honors this season. The most recent honor went to Austin Witter, who was named MEAC Defensive Player of the Week for a second time on Feb. 4. Senior forward Adrian Powell and freshman center Bruce Beckford earned weekly honors on Jan. 7.
- Powell became the first Aggie to earn MEAC Player of the Week honors in two years when he won the honor. Beckford would win his second MEAC Rookie of the Week recognition.

THE AGGIE SEVEN

- The North Carolina A&T has one of the most experienced teams in the MEAC.
- The Aggies feature seven seniors from five different areas and four different states. Dominique Behohn-Tolly is from Cameroon. DaMetrius Upchurch (Raleigh, N.C.), Adrian Powell (Conover, N.C.), Austin Witter (Princeton Junction, N.J.), R.J. Buck (Lusby, Md.), Lawrence Smith (Bowie, Md.)

and Jean Louisme (Fort Myers, Fla.) are the other six seniors.

- The Aggies senior class is looking for their first MEAC Championship and they are hoping to advance to at least the semifinals for the first time in their careers.
- Five of the Aggies seven seniors are four-year seniors, including Buck, Smith, Witter, Powell and Upchurch.
- The Aggies five four-year seniors are a combined 48-71 heading into today's game. They are a combined 26-30 in the MEAC.

WITTER CLOSES IN ON BLOCKED SHOTS RECORD

- North Carolina A&T senior forward Austin Witter is closing in on the Aggies single-season blocked shots record. Witter has 75 blocks on the season. It puts him 11 blocks short of breaking former teammate Thomas Coleman's single-season record of 85, which he set during the 2008-09 season.
- Witter has earned MEAC Defensive Player of the Week honors once this season in the week ending on Dec. 16.
- He ranks ninth in the nation in blocked shots and leads the conference in the same category. Witter has blocked at least one shot in the Aggies last 17 games. In the last five games, he has 20 blocked shots.
- He also leads the MEAC in defensive rebounding (6.0) and ranks fifth in the conference in rebounding (7.1).

BECKFORD RETURNS TO THE AGGIES LINEUP

- Bruce Beckford returned to the Aggies lineup Monday night against Delaware State on after missing two games with a back injury. Beckford left the game after the first three minutes against Morgan State on Jan. 26.
- Before being injured against Howard, Beckford started 16 straight games and won MEAC Rookie of the Week honors twice.
- The second time he won the honor for the week of Dec. 31-Jan. 6. His previous honor was for the week ending Dec. 23.
- Beckford became the first Aggie to win weekly rookie honors since Thomas Coleman did it in 2007.
- Beckford is averaging 7.2 points and 4.5 rebounds per game while shooting .530 from the floor.

A&T TRENDS AND STREAKS

- The Aggies ended a streak that they have not been proud of. For the first time in 26 games, the Aggies defeated an opponent when scoring 59 points or less. The Aggies defeated UMES 46-44 on Feb. 2 to end the streak. Prior to the UMES win, the last time the Aggies won a game by scoring 59 points or less was on Feb. 2, 2009 with a 56-55 win over Hampton.
- The Aggies are unbeatable when scoring in the 80's. The Aggies have won 12 straight when scoring 80 points or more.
- The Aggies shot 50 percent from the floor against Bethune-Cookman on Feb. 9, marking the first time they accomplished the feat in 10 games.
- The Aggies have not shot better than 70 percent from the free throw line since the 1990-91 season when they shot 71.6 percent on their way to a 17-10 record.
- The Aggies have blocked at least one shot in their last 48 games. The last time the Aggies failed to block a shot was Nov. 14, 2011 at Iowa. They have at least two blocks in their last 17 games.

THE AGGIE STARTERS

- The Aggies have started seven different lineups this season. The Aggies most frequent lineup has been Powell, Witter, Beckford, Louisme and Middleton. The Aggies are 4-4 when they start.
- Adrian Powell and Austin Witter are competing for the most career starts. Powell has made 79 career starts, while Witter has made 78. The Aggies are 38-41 when Powell starts, and they are 36-42 when Witter starts. The Aggies are 16-27 when DaMetrius Upchurch starts.
- Austin Witter did not on Feb. 9, making Lamont Middleton the only Aggie to start every game.
- When Witter did not start on Feb. 9 against Bethune-Cookman, it marked the first time in 37 games Witter failed to start.

THE AGGIE NEWCOMERS

- North Carolina A&T head coach Cy Alexander inherited most of his newcomers, but also signed two of his own.
- Guards Lamont Middleton, Shaun Stewart and Khalid King were already in place when Alexander stepped on the scene in April as the Aggies head coach.
- Once in place, Alexander added center Bruce Beckford and forward Corvon Butler.
- During tryouts, the Aggies later added walk-on guard Ahmad Abdullah.
- Five of the six Aggie newcomers have seen action this season.
- Middleton, King and Beckford are the only new comers to make starts this season.

THE RECORD

- The Aggies have held 14 opponents to under 40 percent shooting and are 10-4 when they do.
- The Aggies have shot better than their opponents 14 times this season, and are 12-2 when they do. They are 0-10 when they fail to shoot better than their foes.
- A&T is currently 12-12 record. The Aggies have not finished above .500 in 15 seasons. The Aggies haven't been above .500 this late in the season since the 2008-09 season when they were 14-13 on Feb. 16, 2009.

FREE THROW SHOOTING

- Adrian Powell has improved at the free throw line. Before 2013 began, Powell was shooting 51.4 percent from the line. In the 10 games since the New Year began, Powell is shooting .683 from the line (28-for-41).
- The Aggies still have three players in the top 15 in free throw shooting, including Jeremy Underwood who is fifth in the MEAC at .797. Jean Louisme is ninth in the conference at .792 and Middleton is 11th at .755. Middleton has been to the line more than any other MEAC player with 143 attempts.

Cy Alexander became the ninth North Carolina A&T men's basketball coach in the modern era on April 20, 2012. Alexander brings with him a wealth of experience in constructing a championship program within the MEAC.

Alexander led S.C. State to seven MEAC tournament title games, winning five of those contests over a 16-year span. Before Alexander arrived in Orangeburg, the Bulldogs had captured only one MEAC regular-season title, and they reached just one MEAC tournament final. In addition, the school was coming off of its ninth straight losing season.

When his tenure ended at S.C. State, Alexander had won nearly 60 percent of his games and more than 70 percent of his conference games. Alexander will be asked to restore the Aggies tradition of winning MEAC titles. The Aggies own a league-leading 15 MEAC tournament titles, but have not been crowned champions since 1995.

Alexander's time in the MEAC began in 1976. He spent 11 seasons as an assistant coach at Howard University under A.B. Williamson. In 1987, he was named the head coach at S.C. State. He was able to compile a 277-202 record overall and a 191-79 record in the MEAC. Alexander's teams at S.C. State finished first or second 13 times.

In year one at S.C. State, he was 16-13. By year two, the Bulldogs finished 25-8, broke the school record for wins and advanced to the NCAA tournament after winning the school's first MEAC tournament title. During the same season, the Bulldogs gained national prominence by winning the San Juan Shootout. One of the victories in the shootout included a win over No. 11 Villanova. Alexander was now on his way to piecing together what became one of the most successful coaching runs in MEAC history.

Alexander's efforts helped him win three MEAC Coach of the Year honors while at S.C. State, including the 2003 honor for leading the Bulldogs to their fifth MEAC crown. His S.C. State teams received the prestigious American Sports Wire Black College National Championship three times (1996, '98, '00).

After the '03 season, Alexander became the head men's basketball coach at Tennessee State University. Alexander spent six seasons with the Tigers. Alexander led TSU to the 2008 OVC championship game, the school's first in 10 years. Alexander is a Winston-Salem, N.C., native, who has a 362-322 career record over 23 seasons. His other coaching acknowledgements include being named Palmetto State Coach of the Year by the Greenville Basketball Club. He has also been inducted into the Catawba and S.C. State Hall of Fames. In 1996, he was named American Sports Wire National Coach of the Year.

Alexander has served as a member of the Black Coaches Association and the National Association of Basketball Coaches. He is also a member of several organizations, including Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity.
