Game Facts

Previous Game: The Aggies won their sixth straight game, defeating Norfolk State by 78-47 in the quarterfinals round of the MEAC Tournament. It was their second victory over the Spartans in six days, and their first against them in the Tournament. Redshirt freshman Eboni Ross led the team with 18 points and eight rebounds. Junior Tracy King provided 13 points, while redshirt junior Amber Calvin added 12. The Aggies collected a season-high 12 3-pointers in the game. It was the 12th time this season that the Aggies have held an opponent to 50 or fewer points in a game. The Aggies are holding opponents to a 54.2 scoring average, which is the lowest in a season in program history. The Aggies look to win their first Tournament title since 2009.

Howard Scouting Report: The Aggies are 25-43 overall against the Bison and are 3-8 against Howard in MEAC Tournament play. This year, the Bison finished in third place with a 12-4 MEAC record. Howard advanced to the semifinals after narrowly beating Morgan State, 62-60. Nicole Deterville's layup with 0.5 seconds left gave Howard the win. Senior Saadia Doyle, the second person in program history to collect 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds, earned first-team All-MEAC honors. She is the third person in MEAC history to be in both of those clubs. She had 23 points and 12 rebounds to lead the Bison in both categories in Wednesday's win over Morgan State. Cheyenne Curley-Payne added 17 points and 10 rebounds as well for Howard, along with a team-best four assists and two steals. Howard shot just 39 percent from the floor against Morgan State.

Tracking the Aggies

Berry Good on Offense: Senior JaQuayla Berry has been a leader on both ends of the floor this season. Berry, who was named to the All-MEAC First Team this year, is first on the team with 370 points (12.3 ppg) and 182 rebounds (6.1 rpg). Berry has a team-best 55 steals on the year. Berry tallied 19 points (with 15 in the second half) on Nov. 28 at Richmond from the bench. She totaled a season-best 13 rebounds on Nov. 25 against Winston-Salem State. She also led the team with a season-best 29 points and had nine rebounds and four steals in the victory over William & Mary on Dec. 21. She had a career-best 14 field goals in the game against William & Mary. She picked up her first career MEAC Player of the Week honors on Dec. 24 for averaging 22.0 points and 7.5 rebounds from Dec. 18-21. Berry led the team with 16 points at Virginia Tech on Dec. 28. She led the team with 15 points, seven rebounds, three assists and a block on Jan. 3 at UNCW for her sixth straight double-figures game. She posted 16 points and eight rebounds on Jan. 12 at Bethune-Cookman. She tallied

her first double-double of the year on Jan. 14 with 19 points and 12 rebounds. She had 14 points and 9 rebounds against Morgan State on Jan. 26. Berry had 23 points and shot 10-for-11 from the line on Feb. 2 at UMES. She led the team with 17 points against Bethune-Cookman on Feb. 9. She led the team with five steals against Florida A&M on Feb. 11. She had 13 points at N.C. Central on Feb. 23 for her ninth straight double-figures contest. Berry earned Second Team All-MEAC honors last year after finishing last season with 414 points (14.3 per game), 214 rebounds (7.4 per game) and 65 steals.

Keeping Cool with A.C.:

Redshirt junior Amber Calvin, who was named to the All-MEAC Third Team, is third on the team in scoring with 300 points (10.0 ppg) and is second in assists with 71 (2.4 apg). She is tied for first on the team with 55 steals. Calvin led the Aggies with 19 points from the bench, including four 3-pointers, on Nov. 16 against Iona. She led the team with a season-best 28 points on Nov. 20 at Siena, with 11-for-14 shooting including five 3-pointers. Her 11 field goals set a new career high. She led the team with 21 points (including five 3-pointers) in the Dec. 15 victory at Liberty. She was named MEAC Player of the Week on Dec. 17. She recorded 16 points, four assists and two steals against Elon on Dec. 31. She had 11 points against Howard on Jan. 19, and 16 against Morgan State on Jan. 26. She led the team with 19 points at Delaware State. She matched a season-high with five assists at S.C. State. She led the team with 24 points on Feb. 18 at Savannah State. Last season, Calvin was second on the team in scoring with 393 points (13.6 per game) and led the team in assists (117), becoming the sixth player in program history to total more than 100 assists in a single season.

King of the Court:

The Aggies are gaining plenty of production from junior Tracy King this season. King is second in scoring (306 points--10.2 ppg) and second in rebounding (166--5.5 rpg) this year. She is second on the team with 53 steals. King led the team with 22 points in the 40-point victory against N.C. Central. She had 14 points on 7-for-10 shooting against Charlotte on Dec. 18. She recorded 20 points with four assists on Dec. 21 against William & Mary. She posted a team-high 18 points and seven rebounds on Jan. 12 at Bethune-Cookman. She recorded her first double-double of the season with 14 points and 11 rebounds on Jan. 14 at FAMU. She had 22 points (all in the second half with 12-for-14 free throw shooting) and a career-high 13 rebounds on Jan. 26 against Morgan State. She had 17 points to lead the team on Jan. 28 against Coppin State. She was named MEAC Defensive Player of the Week on Feb. 25. King recorded her third double-double of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds with five assists on March 4 against Savannah State. Before her knee injury last season, King averaged 13.5 points and 5.9 rebounds per game for the Aggies. She totaled 229 points and 101 rebounds in 17 games, and was named MEAC Defensive Player of the Week twice in 2011-12.

Relying on Ross: Redshirt freshman Eboni Ross has been a key part of the A&T team this season, earning MEAC Rookie of the Year honors. She was named MEAC Rookie of the Week on Dec. 3, Jan. 7, Jan. 21, Feb. 11, Feb. 18 and Feb. 25. Ross is fourth on the team in scoring with 239 points, (8.0 ppg), third on the team with 166 rebounds (5.5 rpg) and is first on the team with 51 blocks. She provided nine rebounds, three assists and four blocks for the Aggies on Nov. 25 against Winston-Salem State. She recorded 11 points along with seven rebounds, a block and two steals in the victory over George Washington on Jan. 6. She totaled 17 points, five rebounds and two blocks in the Jan. 14 win over FAMU. She had a season-high 10 rebounds against Coppin State on Jan. 28. Ross posted 15 points and a team-best nine rebounds with a season-high 6 blocks at Delaware State on Feb. 4. It was the most blocks in a game since LaPorsha Lowry had six at Howard on Feb. 5, 2007. She had five blocks on Feb. 9 against Bethune-Cookman. Ross provided a team-high 15 points, six rebounds and two blocks over Florida A&M on Feb. 11. She collected a team-high 15 points, and team-high four blocks on Feb. 16 at S.C. State. On Feb. 23, she recorded a double-double with a season-high 18 points and 10 rebounds with three blocks at N.C. Central. She had 11 points and nine rebounds with a block on March 2 against S.C. State, and 11 points on March 4 against Savannah State for her sixth straight double-figure game. She had 10 points and 10 rebounds with five blocks on March 7. She matched a season-high with 18 points against Norfolk State on March 13.

Support from Nazario: Sophomore Adriana Nazario is fifth on the team with 195 points (6.7 ppg) and leads the team with 73 assists. She tallied 11 points with five rebounds on Nov. 28 at Richmond. She had 10 points with three assists on Dec. 15 at Liberty. Nazario had a team-high and season-high six assists on Dec. 21 in the victory against William & Mary. She recorded 10 points on Jan. 3 at UNCW. Nazario set a season and career-high with 14 points against George Washington on Jan. 6. She had 12 points against Coppin State on Jan. 28. She had nine points and two assists against Florida A&M on Feb. 11. She had 12 points and an assist against S.C. State on March 2. Nazario finished last season with 68 points, 51 rebounds, 38 assists and 13 steals in 23 games.

MEAC Honors: Amber Calvin was named Player of the Week on Dec. 17. JaQuayla Berry was named Player of the Week on Dec. 24. Tracy King was named MEAC Defensive Player of the Week on Feb. 25. Eboni Ross was named Rookie of the Week on Dec. 3, Jan. 7, Jan. 21, Feb. 11, Feb. 18 and Feb. 25. A&T was picked to finish fifth in the preseason MEAC poll.

Tracking the Aggies

The Aggie Attack: The North Carolina A&T women's basketball program has been a dominant force in the MEAC in the last seven seasons. The Aggies tallied a 130-88 overall record (.596) and a 84-32 mark in the MEAC (.724) from 2005-2012. The Aggies won three MEAC regular-season titles in that span, including three consecutive seasons of 20-plus victories. The Aggies won 26 games in the 2008-09 season, setting a MEAC record. The Aggies garnered a No. 14 seed in the 2009 NCAA Tournament. It was the highest seed ever given to an HBCU basketball team, men's or women's team, up to that season. Their 15 wins during the 2007-08 and 2008-09 season were also MEAC records for conference wins. In 2010, A&T defeated Wake Forest and Charlotte before falling to Miami in the third round of the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT). North Carolina A&T became the first MEAC team and HBCU to win two consecutive basketball games in a national postseason tournament.

Rankings in the MEAC: The Aggies are second in the conference with an 13-3 record behind the 16-0 Hampton Pirates. A&T ranks fourth in the conference in scoring offense (62.4) and third in scoring defense (54.2) this season. A&T is first in the conference with a .421 field goal percentage, and first with a .336 3-point field goal percentage. Senior JaQuayla Berry is 10th in the conference with an average of 12.3 points per game. Redshirt junior Amber Calvin is first in the MEAC in free throw percentage (.873) and first in 3-point field goal percentage (.422). Redshirt freshman Eboni Ross is first in the conference with a .531 field goal percentage and second in the conference with 1.7 blocks per game. (Through all games on March 13.)

Robinson Leads A&T: The Aggies are 22-8 under A&T head coach Tarrell Robinson. His 22 wins are the most by a women's basketball head coach in his or her first year at the helm of the program. Joyce Spruill went 13-15 in her first year of the program in 1982-83. Patricia Cage-Bibbs led the Aggies to a 9-19 record in her first season with A&T in 2005-06. The 22 wins are also the most the Aggies have won since the 2009-10 season, when they went 23-11.

Tarrell Robinson was named the sixth head coach in the history of the North Carolina A&T women's basketball program on May 2, 2012. He returns to A&T after spending three years as an assistant coach, recruiting coordinator and associate head coach at Virginia Commonwealth under head coach Beth Cunningham. Before his stint at VCU, Robinson spent four successful seasons at A&T under legendary head coach Patricia Cage-Bibbs. Robinson made a name for himself as a talented recruiter, having brought in highly touted players to A&T and helping to lead the Aggies to consecutive MEAC regular-season championships starting in 2007.

Robinson inherits a talented club, including three players he recruited in Amber Calvin, Nikia Gorham and JaQuayla Berry. In 2011-12, Berry became the 12th player in program history to hit the 1,000 points milestone, and she is a two-time All-MEAC selection, earning first-team honors in 2011. Calvin is closing in on the program's all-time assist record, and was named the A&T Department of Athletics Female Athlete of the Year in 2012.

Robinson, a 2001 graduate of A&T, helped Bibbs resurrect a dormant program. After a 9-19 season in 2005-06, Robinson assisted Bibbs in signing what turned out to be some of the best players in school history, starting with Fayetteville, N.C., native Ta'Wuana Cook. Cook went on to be the program's first MEAC Rookie of the Year, its second all-time leading scorer and its all-time leader in assists. He was also instrumental in signing two-time MEAC all-tournament performer Lamona Smalley and 2009 MEAC Player of the Year Brittanie Taylor-James. When Jaleesa Sams, who was ranked as high as No. 31 nationally by Scouts.com, signed to play at A&T in 2007, the women's basketball team had its most highly-touted recruit in history.

Robinson's recruiting efforts paid off. From 2007-09, Robinson and his recruits helped the Aggies compile a 51-15 record and their first MEAC tournament championship since 1994. The Aggies earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2009, and were awarded a 14th seed. At the time, it was the highest seed ever given to an historically black college or university. Cook, Sams, Taylor-James and Berry are all 1,000-point career scorers and all-conference performers. His tenure as an Aggie assistant also yielded 13 all-conference selections. He was promoted to associate head coach prior to the 2008-09 season, after establishing himself as one of the best recruiters in the MEAC.

After leaving A&T for VCU, Robinson continued to excel as a recruiter. He was promoted to associate head coach in May 2011 at VCU after serving as the program's recruiting coordinator. He helped the Rams make three-consecutive postseason appearances from 2009-12. The Rams also made it to the third round of the WNIT in 2010 and 2012. He helped land back-to-back classes that ranked among the best in the Colonial Athletic Association, including players that ranked among the Top 30 in their respective positions. His 2011-12 class included the Ram's most highly recruited player in center Aprill McRae, who was named the 22nd post player in the nation by ESPN.

Robinson was also invited to the prestigious Nike Villa 7 Consortium in 2011 and 2012. The Nike Villa 7 Consortium is a partnership with the VCU Center for Sport Leadership, and brings together the country's elite assistant basketball coaches to help prepare the next generation of college basketball leaders. Prior to his successful stints at A&T and VCU, Robinson coached at the high school level and was a graduate assistant for the A&T men's basketball program. Robinson worked for two seasons as the assistant boys basketball coach at High Point (N.C.) Andrews High School, where he helped Andrews compile a 42-13 record and a pair of appearances in the NCHSAA State Tournament.

Before coaching at Andrews, Robinson spent two seasons as an assistant coach for the A&T men's basketball program under head coach Curtis Hunter. He served as the graduate assistant for the men's basketball team for the 2001-02 season. Robinson also made his mark as a student-athlete at A&T. He played on the men's basketball team from 1997-2001, and had a stellar playing career at A&T. He scored 934 career points, grabbed more than 700 rebounds and blocked 35 shots during his career. He led the Aggies in rebounding his junior season. Robinson attended E.E. Smith High School in Fayetteville, N.C., where he was an Honorable Mention McDonald's All-American and lettered three years on the varsity level. He was an all-conference and all-regional performer as a senior, and helped lead the Golden Bulls to a conference championship and regional runner-up finish in the state playoffs.

Robinson earned his B.A., degree in psychology in 2001 and was enrolled in the graduate program at A&T, where he was a candidate for a master's degree in Human Performance and Leisure Studies. Robinson and his wife, Kelli, have three children, Jordan, Jada and Lauren.
